### **Short Hair Cat Society**

#### **Devon Rex Kitten, Male**

##### **1 - Wilson's Nidoran Cooper (DRX as), M, 03/01/15**

Little baby Blue Smoke Devon Rex boy, just old enough to be at the show of good size and weight for age. Overall, his head is a touch on the narrow side, even taking his young age into account. Broad cheekbones in comparison to head width with large oval eyes set at a slight slant giving good Devon expression. Needs a little more whisker break. Large ears are wide at base and quite low set. Fair whisker break; chin on the shallow side. In profile, needs more stop and slight bump to slightly long nose. Firm, muscular little body and elegant limbs. Tail balances. Not much coat at present and too short to wave except for a little rexing on his legs. Currently, a band of guard hairs down his spine. A very sweet little boy with a lot to say for himself. Well presented in very good condition.

#### **Devon Rex Kitten, Female**

##### **1 BoB - Humphreys' Rogus Helena of Troy (DRX w 63), F, 03/12/14**

A very nice little Odd-Eyed White Devon Rex girl of just over 4 months and of good size and weight. Lovely strong little head. Very wide high cheekbones. Large ears are very wide at base and are nicely low set. Large oval eyes slope to outer edge of ears giving super Devon expression. Strong muzzle with defined whisker break and decent chin. In profile, rounded brow to flat skull leads to good stop and short nose. Muscular little body and strong elegant limbs with small oval paws. Tail balances. Coat is soft and of good density and is very well rexed right down to her toes. Coat is perhaps a tiny touch on the long side. A very sweet, confident little girl, very well presented in excellent condition.

##### **2 - Wilson's Nidoran Kumori Yosei (DRX ns), F, 04/01/15**

Litter sister to the little blue boy above. Sweet little Black Smoke Devon Rex baby girl of good size and weight for age. Broad high cheekbones and large oval eyes at slight slant giving typical Devon expression. Large ears are wide at base and quite low set but could do with a touch more width between. Definite whisker break, chin a touch shallow, bite level. In profile, fair stop and short nose. Firm little body and strong elegant limbs. Tail balances. Coat is soft in texture and shows some wave. A sweet, wriggly baby well presented in very good condition.

#### **AV Foreign Novice Adult**

##### **1 - Threapleton's Aalspotz Bounty Hunter (OCI bs 24), M, 04/07/14**

##### **2 - Aroha's Nidoran Morning Glory (DRX g), F, 21/12/13**

Blue Tortie Devon Rex girl of 15 months - a touch on the small side but of good weight for size. Nice width to head with high broad cheekbones and large oval eyes set at slight angle giving good Devon expression. Needs a little more whisker break (plenty of curly whiskers!). Bite level. Chin on the shallow side. Large ears are wide at base and set low on head with good width between. Firm, muscular body. Tail just balances. Coat showing some rexing and is of good length and density but is a little coarse in texture. A rather timid, wriggly girl. Very well presented in very good condition.

**3 - Lincoln's Linczozo Clementine (ABY o), F, 08/06/14**

### **AV Foreign Junior Adult, Male**

**1 - Nichol's Glastocats Walter White (LPL b 03 32), M, 08/07/14**

Choc Darker Points and White LaPerm Longhair boy of just 9 months. Very well grown for his age and of very good weight. Head is modified wedge with gentle contours, prominent whisker pads and medium whisker break. Good whiskers. Straight nose curving gently to convex curve at brow. Level bite and firm chin. Large expressive almond shaped Aqua eyes. Medium large ears are set at a slight angle and are slightly cupped in shape. Although he is a big boy, body and legs are not too heavily boned and are in proportion. Plume developing on tail which is of good length to balance. Coat is developing well and is of good medium long length, well waved with the correct springy texture. A sweet boy very well presented in excellent condition.

#### **Any Cat or Kitten Living More Than 30 Miles from the Show**

**1 - Lee's Imp GMC Billy Boo (SH Red), MN, 1 yr 7 mths**

Super striking Red shorthair boy with huge round eyes, who I have met before. Very playful, energetic boy like an enormous kitten with huge paws. A lot of fun. Lovely coat. Very well presented in excellent condition.

**2 - Creaton & Walker's UK & Imp GMC Rainbowdreamcatcher (SH Tortie & White), FN, 9 yrs 11 mths**

A very striking, mature girl with a lovely coat texture. A self possessed lady with a very relaxed temperament. Very well presented in very good condition.

**3 - Hope and Phillips' Buttons (SLH Chocolate Point), MN, 20 mths**

A well grown young boy with a very well prepared coat and a lovely plumed tail. A sweet boy who was slightly spooked by the noises at the end of his row. Very well presented in very good condition.

### **AC Selkirk Rex Cat**

**1 - Green's Ashblue Foreverandever (SRL a 11), M, 13/05/14**

Blue Shaded Selkirk Rex Longhair boy of 11 months and very well developed for his age.

Head is round, broad and full cheeked with medium width muzzle and well padded whisker pads. Nice broad cheeks and a firm chin. Bite level. Large, round eyes. Medium sized ears were correctly set and well apart. Soft break in profile with downward slope to short nose. Body rectangular in shape and still has to fill out a little, as m Ishtar be expected at this age. Good balancing tail of medium length. Coat of good length and fair density with plenty of unstructured curls although it was very slightly sticky in feel. Overall well presented in very good condition.

**2 - Green's Ashblue Solitaire (SRL a), F, 24/03/14**

Blue Longhair Selkirk Rex girl, 1 year of age and a little on the small side with quite a bit of maturing still to do. Round, broad head with full cheeks. Bite level. Chin could be deeper but overall muzzle is of good width with full whisker pads and giving a good rectangular impression. Short nose. Large round eyes are set well apart. Medium sized ears could be set a touch lower. Coat is of good length and shows some wave but could be denser. A slightly shy girl well presented in good condition.

**LaPerm Cat Club**

**AC Adolescent Neuter**

**1 - Wulund's Quincunx Mina Harkerl (LPL a), FN, 01/07/14**

A nice little Blue LaPerm Longhair girl only just adult of good size and weight for age. Head well proportioned modified wedge being of medium length and longer than wide with prominent whisker pads. Firm chin. Larger sized, slightly flared, well set ears, being at an angle to the head and not too high. Medium large, expressive eyes were rounded when out of pen but almond shaped when relaxed. Medium long body with medium length legs to match. Tail of good balancing length and well plumed. Coat of good quality and density for her age, with good wave and springiness to the touch. A little bit hissy. Well presented in very good condition.

**AC Junior Neuter**

**1 - Lovell's Pr Cloudborn Barb Dwyer (LPL b 25), MN, 30/05/13**

A weighty, well grown, Chocolate Tabby LaPerm Longhair boy of not yet two years. Head is well proportioned modified wedge, longer than it is wide. Nice broad muzzle with medium whisker break. Firm chin. Level bite. Lovely expressive medium large almond shaped Amber eyes. Medium sized, flared, cupped, well furnished ears set at correct angle to the head. Coat is just long enough, well curled and of good springy texture. Good plume to medium length tail. A nice boy well presented in very good condition.

**AC Veteran Neuter**

**1 - Lovell's Pr Colonial Honey (LPL b 21 32), FN, 29/04/07**

Chocolate Tabby Darker Points mature LaPerm Longhair lady of good size and weight. Head is modified wedge with gentle contours just longer than wide. Muzzle perhaps a touch short and square in shape but with prominent whisker pads and strong chin. Medium sized, almond shaped expressive eyes at a slight slant to corner of medium sized ears which are set at an angle to the head. Medium length coat is wavy, with ruff at neck. Medium length tail could be much more plumed. A total sweetheart, very well presented in very good condition.
