**BLACK ADULT MALE:** 1. CC. RISCHLING'S ADATESH HENDRIX. 15. M. 6.6.08. Still a young looking lad of just over 9 months. Round head; medium sized ears with good space between; cheeks developing to a square muzzle line; level bite, short broad nose, firm chin; round eyes of a good copper shade. Good weight and muscular tone to developing cobby body; broad chest; short well boned legs, neat paws; balanced tail. Coat short and dense on sides of body, lying a little flat on spine line; jet black in shade, sound to roots. A very gentle natured boy who handled well, and was shown in good condition.

**BLACK ADULT FEMALE:** 1. CC. & BOB. CHANCE'S CHELSO FRITTON SADIE. 15. F. 28.5.08. It was hard to believe that this girl was only 10 months, showing good maturity and balance for her young age. Round head with good depth and breadth and; neat ears with good space between; cheeks developed well to muzzle line; level bite, short broad nose, firm chin; round eyes well set in head of a deep copper shade. Balanced cobby body of good weight and development; broad chest; short well boned legs, neat paws; balanced tail. Excellent coat, really short, dense, and firm; jet black, sound to roots. Shown in very good condition, and easy to handle. I believe she was made up to Champion on the day. She was also my choice for Best British Adult. Congratulations to her owner and breeder.

2. McGLASHAN'S KIZUKE TINKERBELL. 15. F. 15.3.08. Quite a small lady for her 1yr. showing good British type. Round head; medium ears with good space between; cheeks rounded to muzzle line; level bite, short broad nose with a slightly pronounced nose break, firm chin; round eyes of a pale golden shade. Slightly small sized cobby body of good weight and muscular tone; short well boned legs, and neat paws; balanced tail. Coat soft in texture with good density; jet black in shade just paling to roots. A gentle lass who handled well, was and shown in good condition.

**BLACK SILVER SPOTTED ADULT:** BOB. COULTHURST'S CH. ESSYLT CAMEO-CELESTE. 30s. F. 21.7.07. An attractive young lady of nearly 2yr. showing good British type. Round head; neat ears; cheeks developed to muzzle line; level bite, broad short nose, firm chin; round expressive eyes of pale green. Good weight to cobby body. Coat short, dense, and firm; dense black spots to a silver ground colour. Shown in good condition. Easy to handle.

**AOC SPOTTED NEUTER:** 1. PC & BOB withheld. GEARD'S PR. VINDELIS SATIN LILY. 30a. FN. 15.11.06. A shy and rather nervous lady of just over 2yr. showing good British type. Round head; neat ears with good space between; cheeks developed to muzzle line; level bite, short broad nose, firm chin; round eyes of pale gold. Good sized cobby body, standing a little tall on well boned legs, and neat paws; balanced tail. Coat short, firm, with good density; blue spots seemed to have faded into her bluish-fawn ground colour; good necklaces and bracelets; ringed

tail. I was sorry to withhold the PC. The reason was owing to her lack of distinctive blue spots. A very shy girl. Shown in good condition.

**AOC SILER SPOTTED NEUTER:** 1. PC. & BOB. BARDSLEY'S TUFTON RED SOX. 30ds. MN. 30.3.08. A solid well grown lad for his 11 months, showing good British type and balance. Round head; neat ears with good space between; round cheeks developing to muzzle line; firm chin, level bite, broad short nose; round expressive eyes of a good copper shade, giving him a handsome expression. Good weight and muscular tone to his developing cobby body; broad chest; well boned legs, neat paws; balanced tail. Good coat, short, dense and firm; clear rich red spots to a pale silvery ground colour; spots well defined on sides of body, broken on spine line, slightly elongated on hind quarters, spots on paws and abdomen; well ringed tail; good necklaces and bracelets; a gentle lad who was very friendly. A pleasure to handle, and shown in good condition.
