## Show Rules & Regulations

This Show is held under the Rules of the Governing Council of the Cat Fancy, and is OPEN TO ALL. A copy of the Rules may be obtained from the GCCF, 5 King's Castle Business Park, The Drove, Bridgwater, Somerset, TA6 4AG price £2.00. **Ignorance of any Rule will not be accepted as an excuse of breach.** Please read, CAREFULLY, the GCCF General Guidelines on Entering Shows' later in this Schedule. The cats will be received at the entrance to the Show Hall on Show day from **8:00am to 9:45am**. Every cat, including those for Exhibition, MUST be examined by a Veterinary Surgeon before being penned. Disqualification and forfeiture of fees will follow contravention of this Rule. Where an exhibit has been rejected or disqualified by a Veterinary Surgeon, the Show Manager shall obtain from the Veterinary Surgeon the reasons of rejection or disqualification and shall forward these to the Secretary of the GCCF within 48 hours of the Show. A copy of this shall also be given to the exhibitor.

There shall be no withdrawals after the official closing date to this show. Any exhibit withdrawn PRIOR to the closing date will be charged for any administration costs incurred up until this point.

Judging will commence at 10:00am PROMPT. The Show will be open to the public from 12:30 until 5:00pm.

All Exhibits must be accompanied throughout their journey by the owner or owner's bona fide representative and must be brought to the show in a suitable container. The GCCF recommends top opening baskets.

The proper fees must accompany all entries. PLEASE NOTE: ANY PAYMENT FOR ENTRY FEE WHICH IS NOT HONOURED, (i.e. REFERRED TO DRAWER) WILL BE SUBJECT TO A SURCHARGE OF £10 THE EXHIBITOR WILL BE EXPECTED TO PAY NOT ONLY THE COST OF THE ENTRY BUT THIS EXTRA £10 BY POSTAL ORDER.

**REGISTRATION:** All Exhibits (except those entered in the Household Pet Section) must be registered with the GCCF. Registration details can be obtained from the GCCF office. All cats which have changed ownership since registration MUST be transferred AT LEAST 21 DAYS PRIOR TO SHOW DAY.

EVERY EXHIBIT MUST BE PROVIDED WITH A WHITE SANITARY TRAY AND CLEAN PLAIN WHITE OR NEAR-WHITE BLANKET OR BLANKETS WITHOUT DISTINCTIVE MARKING OR EDGING, WHICH MAY BE ARRANGED IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO ASSIST THE COMFORT OF THE EXHIBIT. CELLULAR BLANKETS ARE NOT ALLOWED BUT WHITE VET-BED OR LIKE MATERIAL WITH WHITE OR GREEN BACKING MAY BE USED IF PREFERRED. A HOT WATER BOTTLE OR HEAT REFLECTING MATERIAL MAY BE USED, PROVIDED THEY ARE COVERED BY THE BLANKET, IN ACCORDANCE WITH GCCF RULES. ANY OTHER FORM OF HEATING WILL LEAD TO DISQUALIFICATION.

All exhibits must have water, but food containers must be removed when judging commences at 10:00am and may not be returned until 12:30pm. Judges are instructed to pass any pen that is distinguished in any way. No advertisement or written matter of any kind, other than the official award cards etc. may be put on pens. Exhibits are received on condition that the Club shall not be responsible for any loss or damage, to cats, boxes or baskets. Whilst the Committee do all in their power to prevent improper removal of a cat or kitten, it is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to ensure the safety of their exhibits. The Show Manager(s) and Committee reserve the right to limit the number of exhibits at the show and to accept or refuse any entry.

### VETERINARY CLEARANCE CERTIFICATES

Exhibitors whose cats have been rejected at shows please note the following points:

When sending your clearance certificate to the G.C.C.F. Veterinary Officer, please include your copy of the rejection slip.

1. Please DO NOT send these certificates by recorded delivery post as this can cause considerable delays in receipt of your certificates. If you wish to satisfy yourself that your letter has reached the Veterinary Officer please enclose a stamped addressed postcard to acknowledge receipt, for signature, and this will be returned to you.
2. Exhibitors should NOT attend shows until they have received a letter accepting and confirming clearance from the G.C.C.F. Veterinary Officer. It is recommended that this letter be taken to shows within one month of issue.

If your cat is rejected by the Show's Veterinary Officer please make sure you have received the forms you require from the Show Manager before you leave the show hall. The G.C.C.F. Veterinary Officer may be contacted through the G.C.C.F. Offices.

### DEFINITION OF CLASSES

Breed	Open to all untitled Cats or Neuters of the specific breed. Must be GCCF Registered.
Olympian	For full Imperial Grand Champions and Imperial Grand Premiers only.
Imperial	For full Grand Champions and Grand Premiers only
Grands	For full Champions and Premiers only
Breeders	For Cats And Kittens Bred by the Exhibitor.
Junior	For Cats under two years old on day of Show.
Adolescent	For Cats aged 9 - 15 months on day of Show.
Senior	For Cats two years to seven years old on day of Show.
Veteran	For Cats seven years old and over on day of Show.
Kittens	For entire Kittens four to nine months old only on day of Show (unless otherwise stated).
Adults	For Cats nine months old and over on day of Show.
Neuters	For Neutered males or spayed females. May only compete in Classes specifically for Neuters.
Radius	For Exhibitors living WITHIN 25 miles of the Show Hall
Visitors	For Exhibitors living MORE THAN 25 miles from the Show Hall
Debutante	For Cats and Kittens who have never been exhibited at a Show held under G.C.C.F. Rules.
* Maiden	For Cats and Kittens that have not won a 1st, 2nd or 3rd prize at a Show held under G.C.C.F. Rules.
* Novice	For Cats and Kittens that have not won a 1st prize at a Show held under G.C.C.F. Rules.
* Limit	For Cats and Kittens that have not won more than four 1st prize at a Show held under G.C.C.F. Rules.
Aristocrat	For cats that have won one or more Challenge, Premier or Intermediate Certificates.
* Wins as a Kitten do NOT count in Adult Classes nor do those as an adult count when the exhibit is Neutered. Exhibitors are reminded that only wins achieved BEFORE closing date may be taken into account.	
Assessment	For Experimental Breeds only. The full name of the Breed should be given on the entry form and entrants must provide the official Standard of Points supplied by the appropriate Breed Club if this does not appear in the G.C.C.F. Standard of Points. This should be placed on the pen by THE EXHIBITOR for the use of the Assessment Class judge.

## GENERAL GUIDELINES ON ENTERING SHOWS

Where possible, always complete your show entry form from your GCCF registration document (i.e. Registration or Transfer Certificate) for the cat that is to be exhibited, PRINTING the details carefully to avoid any misinterpretation of your handwriting.

If you have not received your registration document at the time of entry, complete the show entry form with the details from the pedigree, giving the first choice of name if it is a non-prefix registration, and put RAF (Registration Applied For) or TAF (Transfer Applied For), or both, in the Reg'd. No. box. It is wise to enclose a stamped self-addressed acknowledgement postcard with all registration and transfer applications, particularly for cats entered for shows, so that you know that the application has been received by the GCCF.

Try to keep a copy of your entry form - then, when you receive registration details and number, check these against the entry form and notify the Show Manager in writing of any differences in the details as well as giving the registration number, if applicable. This may not be in time for the printing of the Show Catalogue, but the Show Manager should attach your letter to your entry form, which will save unnecessary notification of discrepancies when that show is checked. All Catalogue errors are checked against the original entry form and any exhibitors' letters are used for reference. Show management's are permitted to accept corrections, at their own discretion, up to the close of the show (on show day); such a change must not be a change of exhibit.

If you are entering several cats from your household and the registered owners (exhibitors) differ within that household/family, check with the Show Manager whether using one entry form is acceptable or not and, if it is, indicate VERY CLEARLY which exhibitor owns which cat, ensuring all owners sign the entry form. It may be less confusing and more acceptable to the Show Manager for each owner to use separate entry forms, but joint owners of an exhibit/exhibits should always use the same form and both must sign.

### STATUS OF ERRORS - WHAT TO EXPECT

**MINOR ERRORS.** These warrant a notification for your reference if the error occurs more than once and it is apparent that registration details were available at the time of entry or before the date of the show. Continuous repetition of the same error after notification will be referred to the Executive Committee.

Examples of minor errors include:

- (a) Spelling errors
- (b) Separation of cat's names that should be one word, and vice versa
- (c) Administrative/breeder's prefix omitted from, or partially incorrect name given for, exhibit
- (d) Overseas titles preceding the name of an exhibit, sire or dam, etc
- (e) Full breed number known but not given
- (f) Sire and Dam reversed or named incorrectly
- (g) Breeder, joint when single and vice versa

**INCORRECT DATE OF BIRTH.** This is usually classed as a minor error unless it affects an entry into classes based on age groups when it could warrant disqualification of the exhibit from such classes; but if the incorrect date of birth affects the age suitability as a whole, then the exhibit will be disqualified from the Show.

**NB AGE LIMITS:** Kittens - not less than 14 weeks and under 9 calendar months on date of show Adults - not less than 9 calendar months on date of show

**INCORRECT NAME OF EXHIBIT/OWNER/BREEDER.** If registration/transfer were obviously available at the time of entry or before the date of the Show, disqualification is inevitable. The following discrepancies are those which usually arise:

- EXHIBIT Totally incorrect name
- REGISTERED OWNER Joint when they should be single and vice versa
- (EXHIBITOR) Declaration not signed by registered owner(s)

*NB The exhibitor(s) must be the registered owner(s) of the cat and not necessarily the person who actually takes the cat to the show.*

- BREEDER Totally incorrect name or names

*NB The breeder of a cat is always the registered owner of the dam on the date of the cat's birth*

**REGISTRATION/TRANSFER NOT RECEIVED BY GCCF 21 DAYS BEFORE THE DATE OF THE SHOW**

These entries will be disqualified. Remember the effective date of all registrations and transfers is the first date of valid receipt by the GCCF, and if you enclose your own stamped addressed acknowledgement card with your application form, this will be stamped with the GCCF Office date of receipt.

**TRANSFER OF EXHIBIT FROM EXHIBITOR TO A NEW OWNER RECEIVED BY THE GCCF MORE THAN 21 DAYS BEFORE THE DATE OF THE SHOW.**

Entries such as these will also be disqualified, as the exhibitor's entry form becomes invalid.

**INCORRECT CLASS ENTRY**

These will be disqualified from the class concerned - so always check with the Show Manager if in doubt about which class to enter. If a breed number is changed officially, it is important that you notify the Show Manager immediately.

**CAT REGISTERED ON THE REFERENCE REGISTER**

No cat registered on this Register is eligible to be shown and therefore these entries will be disqualified.

The only exception to this is when a new breed becomes recognised; and then, cats of the breed may be shown even if they are registered on the Reference Register as long as this was the only reason for the Reference registration.

Exhibitors may appeal against any disqualification resulting from show checking, giving their reasons. The appeal will be referred to the Executive committee if considered valid and, if not, a letter of explanation will be sent to the exhibitor(s). The above advice, however, is aimed to keep your show entries trouble-free, not to mention the show checking.

**EARLY REMOVAL. THERE SHALL BE NO EARLY REMOVALS GRANTED. EXHIBITORS MUST ENSURE THAT THEY ARE ABLE TO STAY UNTIL THE OFFICIAL CLOSE OF THE SHOW.**

**Entries close on 6<sup>th</sup> March 2012** (postmark) and should be sent to the assistant show manager. The Committees reserve the right to retain a percentage of all entry fees to cover essential expenses in the event of a strike, emergency or any other unforeseen circumstances which cancel the show. Entry Fees, once received and accepted, cannot, under any circumstances, be returned, except as under rule 4.

A stamped addressed envelope must accompany all correspondence if a reply is desired. Exhibitors desiring acknowledgement of entries must enclose a stamped addressed postcard **or you may provide your email address on your application form.**

All exhibits at the show must have a current vaccination certificate against feline infectious enteritis. **YOU WILL BE ASKED TO PRODUCE THIS CERTIFICATE AT THE SHOW**, failure to do so will result in rejection under Section A, unless the exhibitor undertakes to provide proof of vaccination, valid for that show, by sending the certificate to the GCCF Office within 7 days of the show. Failure to do so will lead to disqualification from the show and the exhibit's name will be placed on the veterinary rejection list until proof of vaccination is received by the Office. Please note Homeopathic vaccination is NOT acceptable.

You are advised against using any shampoo that changes a cat's colour as this may lead to disqualification.

**Rule 21.** Exhibitors are reminded that they are responsible for the cost of any veterinary treatment required by their cat(s) in their absence from the Show Hall.

Any person whose cat(s) have been rejected under Sections C or D must not officiate as a Judge or Steward or in any other capacity which requires the handling of cats at shows until a clearance certificate as required by the GCCF has been obtained.

The use of small battery driven fans in pens can be dangerous, and could be considered a distinguishing mark.

### IMPORTANT NOTICE

The minimum age for kittens at this show is 14 weeks. No Kitten born after the 31<sup>ST</sup> DECEMBER 2011 will be accepted.

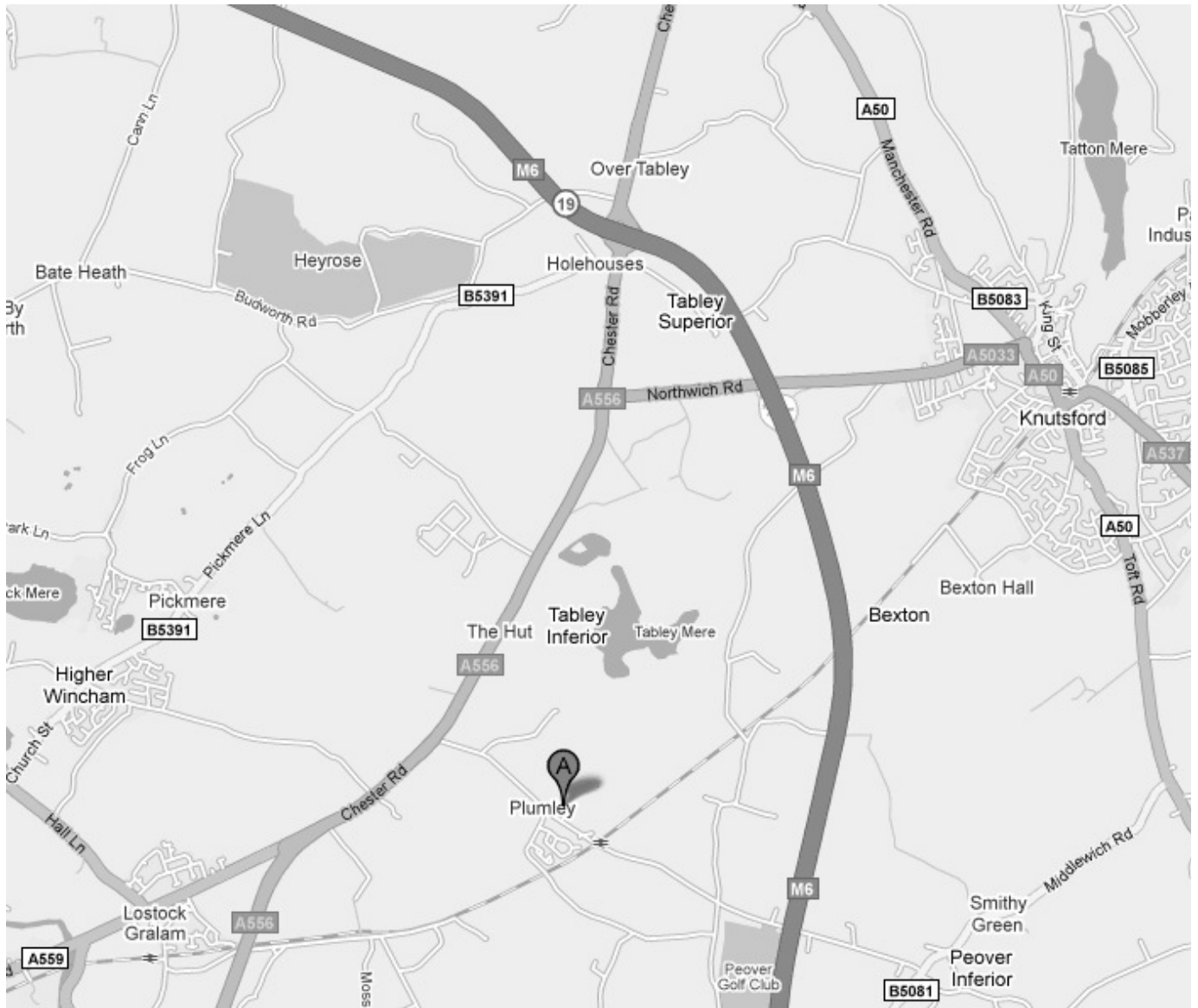
