The Rosemoor Jewel Fund

Donations to The Rosemoor Jewel Fund help to support the ornate and beautiful formal gardens, the "Jewels of Rosemoor".

From the intricately designed rose gardens, redolent with the heady perfume of hundreds of roses, featuring old and new varieties, including Amber Queen ('Harroong') and the popular white, cluster-flowered Iceberg ('Korbin'). To the more informal Cottage Garden where shrub roses frame the traditional thatched shelter, along with clematis and scrambling honeysuckle.

These gardens contrast with the vibrant mixed border plantings of the square garden with its golds and purples, and striking red dahlias. The tranquil hues of the spiral garden are more restful on the eye, with colours flowing from yellow to blue, lilac and mauve; typified by delicate lilac blue Michaelmas daisies, to pink, peach and peaceful white.

Gardens of Reflection

Every RHS garden has an area where visitors can reflect on the happy times which loved ones have enjoyed at the garden. The Formal Gardens are dedicated to all those who have loved Rosemoor.
