AC Self Exotic Adult Male; BOB CHESTERMAN'S CH SIMCRIS HONEY BEAR (EXO e, 18/1/14). Young Cream Exotic lad of good type. Excellent width to his head with fairly neat ears. Bold copper eyes of very good size & shape. Very short broad nose. Quiet good width to his cheeks. Level bite & fairly good chin. Coat of medium cream, slightly shady. Just a little flat today. Well grown body, fairly cobby in shape. Short tail to balance.

British AOC Spotted Kitten Female; 1 BOB MARTIN'S WELLMAR PATHWAY TOTHEMOON (BRI a 24, 1/11/14). Super young Blue Spotted Tabby girl of lovely type. Lovely rounded head with quite good breadth between fairly neat ears – they just need to close and settle a little as she matures. Lovely deep copper eyes, well rounded and of good size. Short broad nose. Excellent width to her cheeks. Level bite. Good chin. Her coat shows quite good density and was well prepared. Pale mushroom ground colour to her head and legs, but currently a paler silvery beige tone to her body. The spots are mid blue in tone. Showing quite a lot of linkage at present, but she is still very young. One full necklace and one broken necklace. Super cobby body that was well grown. Strong legs with well rounded paws. Short tail to balance. A promising lass.

AOC Tortie Burmese Neuter; 1 PC BOB YARDLEY'S UK GR CH PAPAGENA CARYS (BUR j, 30/9/11). Mature Lilac Tortie lady of excellent balanced type and such a typical Burmese expression. Gently rounded head with ears that are set well. Mid chartreuse eyes of good shape and size, very expressive. Good width to her cheeks. Nose showing good break. Level bite. Good chin. Good depth to her muzzle. Coat well presented and good satin texture, close lying. Mid lilac and cream well intermingled throughout. Muscular body of good length, very well grown. Strong yet slender legs with good oval paws. Medium tail, tapering to rounded tip. 2 SMITH'S CH JANZANCO RAZZAMATAZZA (BUR j, 7/5/13). Another Mature Lilac Tortie lady of good type – just lacking the maturity and balance of the winner at present. Gently rounded head with ears that are set well. Mid chartreuse eyes of good shape and size. Fairly good width to her cheeks. Nose showing good break. Just slightly longer in the muzzle than the winner. Level bite. Good chin. Quite good depth to her muzzle. Wonderful coat that was well presented. Lovely satin texture and very close lying. Mid lilac and cream well intermingled throughout. Muscular body of good length, very well grown. Strong yet slender legs with good oval paws. Medium tail, tapering to rounded tip.

SIMPSON'S UK OBIGR PR PAPAGENA NADINA (BUR h, 23/7/98). Veteran Chocolate Tortie Burmese lady of good balanced type. Lovely to see her again, but she really is starting to show her very advanced years now. Short wedge with gently rounded head & ears of good size held well. Expressive eyes of good size & shape – the colour is starting to fade with age now. Nose showing good break. Excellent width to cheekbones. Level bite. Very good depth to chin. Her coat texture is just a little open. A warm shade of mid chocolate intermingled with shades of red throughout. Well muscled body of good length. Slender legs with good oval paws. Medium tail, tapering to rounded tip. Lovely temperament.

MARSHALL'S IGR CH & PR MILLGILL THEATRICALS (BUR j, 14/3/06). Mature Lilac Tortie lady whom I've admired much in the past. She ran the winner quite close for BOB. Balanced type with good rounded head & medium ears set well. Luminous mid chartreuse eyes of excellent size & shape. Nose showing excellent break. Good width to cheeks. Level bite & good depth to chin. Coat of excellent satin texture & close lying. Mid lilac & cream throughout. Very well grown with good muscle tone. Medium tail, tapering to rounded tip. Just lost out to the winner on that tricky 'star quality' today, but I do love her.
