Usual Somali Adult (1 entered for bob)

BOB Miss Burns OSIGC SUPATOFT SOMANTIX TYGALILY (SOL n) F dob 9.3.10. Super girl in full coat who just purred away, she shows moderate wedge with gentle contours slight nose break with firm chin, her ears set well apart, cupped and pricked and her large almond shaped eyes of greeny colour are so expressive and she has a wonderful smile, her coat was divine full ruff and breeches, and her ticking excellent she knows she is lovely.

Aoc Somali Adult (1 entered for bob)

BOB Miss Burns GR CH SUPATOFT SOMANTIKKSJAZZMYN (SOL a) F dob 10.4.12. Mature girl who perhaps for needs bit more chin and her mouth slightly untidy but overall she is of good type and she had lovely ticking with mushroom base and she had lovely eyes very expressive thoroughly enjoyed being handled. Moderate wedge gentle contours good width to top of head her body had good muscle tone and her tail balanced. Well presented.

Red Cream Tortie Tabby & White Maine Coon Adult (2 entered)

1st CC& BOB Mrs Jones TIFFANY LARENDA (MCO f 03 22) F dob 21.12.14. Tortie classic tabby and white I really like this girl she is so balanced and of lovely type head being slightly longer than wide shallow concave curve at nasal bridge chin of good depth and width with square muzzle her cheek bones support her ears beautifully, she has full round eyes set slightly oblique, of greeny colour, her body is feeling muscular already and her chest is developing good width, her rump is starting to look square and she has substantial bone her limbs ending in large round tufted paws, her tail is long furnished and tapering to tip, she has super markings with black eyeliner and black tear drops, she has white nose chin chest front paws back legs under tummy with blacks mingled with reds her classic markings are there and she has super temperament her coat is minimal undercoat with top glossy waterproof coat which feels silky groomed beautifully I think this girl is very promising.

2nd Mrs Smith FLOWERFOX TIGERLILY (MCO f 22) F dob 1.1.15. This young girl of 11mths was very unbalanced at present, She was also quite grumpy and upset today, she had head slightly longer than wide shallow concave curve at nasal bridge, medium length nose with slightly narrow chin with acceptable depth and she needed more width to her muzzle, her cheekbones needed bit more width to support those ears, which she tended to hold out to the side, her eyes were of good shape, her body was developing muscle tone and she had good bone with substantial limbs large round tufted paws, her tail was furnished and balanced. Her pattern was good and her coat was developing length with good texture and she was well presented.

Aoc Maine Coon Adult Male (1 entered and 1 for bob)

1st cc w/h Mrs Allen NO DOUBT MELLUANDIA (MCO es 03) M dob 8.2.14. My goodness this lad is huge, he had lot width to top of the head and his head was only just longer than wide, on inspection his profile was for me too straight, he had long broad nose and although his chin was of quite good width it lacked depth, although he had good width at muzzle his cheekbones should have supported his ears but he insisted on holding them to the side, his eyes were of good shape his body was developed well with good muscle tone and he was substantial with broad chest, excellent bone to legs large round tufted paws, his tail did balance, his coat was coming in and felt of good texture his silvering was only just there and the lad was very shy and didn't show himself off to his best. He really didn't like being handled. So sorry to withhold.

Aoc Maine Coon Adult Female (1 entered and 2 for bob)

Ac Colourpoint or Mitted Ragdoll Kitten (2 entered)

1st&BOB Mrs Wood RAGADEE CLEOME (RAG a) F dob 6.4.15. Lovely young blue point girl broad head with flat plane, rounded muzzle perhaps for perfection could do with bit more chin, cheeks developing well, gentle dip in profile medium length nose, medium sized ears set well apart with slight forward tilt, large well opened eyes, slightly oblique, excellent depth blue colour, body developing muscle tone, medium length limbs ending in large round tufted paws, her tail was long and bushy and i felt a movable slight fault half way up

tail, she had lovely even grey blue points with whitey blue body her coat was developing length and was dense with silky feel well presented girl of super temperament.

2nd Mrs Beatson ADIFTLO YOURSTRULY HATTY (RAG n 04 21) F dob 2.4.15. Seal tabby mitted, this lad was very adolescent and unbalanced, he had broad and slightly rounded head which lacked a gentle dip and only just had flat plane, he had acceptable chin but lacked the rounded muzzle his ears were of good shape but he was tending to round his eyes which were of a pale blue almost aqua on the rim. His body was developing muscle tone and he had medium length limbs ending in large round paws, his tail balanced he was developing coat length but it felt silky. His points need more depth to the colour to define his mittens he had quite good tabby markings he was bit shy but quite sweet, well presented.
