MRS. PAT PERKINS – SHOW REPORT

My thanks to Chris and her grand team for the invite to the “Lancs” a local and favourite show for me. There was a good entry with some quality exhibits, a pleasure to handle. Special thanks to Jennifer Maddrell for her careful handling of the cats and good company.

AC PERSIAN GR. CH. – MALE

IMPERIAL: COOKS GR. CH. KERUBIEL MERLIN – (13.6.11) Orange-eyed White shown to perfection. A mature solid boy, breadth to strong head, tiny ears, short wide nose with a good break, full cheeks and firm chin. When he could be persuaded to open them his eyes were round and a sound deep orange. Solid muscular build, short thick legs with well feathered paws, a short wide full tail to balance. Lovely coat long and soft, a pristine white, frill framing his head – quality lad.

RES. PRIESTLEYS GR. CH. GEMKIN ZEUS – (22.4.12) Another quality Orange-eyed White, (nice to see a line up of 5 whites) Broad head, his ears well furnished, just a touch open, broad short nose with a good break, pink leather with a spot of black pigment, strong chin and fullness to cheeks, big expressive round eyes of a sound mid orange, good bite. Thick short legs, rounded tufted paws, breadth to chest, cobby body, tail wide, flowing and short. Coat a clear white, frill framing his head, back starting to change texture at present – a very gentle lad.

Also considered **WALLACE GR. CH. VIVALDI BUGATTI BABY – (23.10.10)** Shaded Silver Exotic who was rather on edge to day. Strength of bone, big round head, small ears, large eyes, very full cheeks. Super coat for texture thick but soft, standing away very well, evenly shaded, thick tail with a rounded end, very well shown.

AC PERSIAN GR. CH. – FEMALE

A quality class of ladies all deserving of an award.

IMPERIAL PRIESTLYS GR. CH. PANDARUS CELESTE – (24.5.12) Lovely Blue/Cream wearing a super coat, soft pastel blue and cream intermingled on the body, small patches to face, all legs and feet two tone, excellently presented full and flowing, frill framing her pretty head. Mature cobby build, thick short legs, tufted feet, tail very bushy and short showing blue and cream intermingled. Rounded head, good width between small side set ears, nicely furnished, short nose with ample break, firm chin, width to cheeks, big round eyes of a deep sound copper giving her a bright alert expression – laid back lady a pleasure to handle.

RESERVE MORRIS GR. CH. PRINCESS IN RAGS – (16.10.12) Mature Tortie Silver Tabby, excellent bone and substance, cobby solid body, short thick legs and big paws. Well groomed coat thick but soft, just changing a touch on lower back, frill framing her strong head, well set feathered ears, firm chin, broad short nose with good break, level bite, big expressive eyes of a sound orange. Coat showing soft silver and tortie colours, tabby M to head, spectacles round eyes, tabby rings to legs, side markings, tail short and full showing rings – a quality lady.

Also considered – **PRIESTLEYS GR. CH. PICTUREBOOK GOINGFOR GOLD – (25.6.12)** Cream girl of good type, well groomed coat of a mid cream, soft and long, frill framing her head, short full tail to balance, quite shy.

WALLACE GR. CH. VIVALDI LADEBEE – (17.7.10) Solid compact Brown Tabby Exotic, round apple head, thick coat with good classic tabby markings showing some brindling, due to time of year, but good texture, thick short tail, rounded end – lovely temperament

AC SELF EXOTIC SHORT HAIR – ADULT

1ST. & BOB HARROPS SHAKIRA FIAMIFFERRO – (19.4.13) Red Self boy who was solid and well constructed, thick strong legs, big paws, breadth to chest and head, muscular body. Large rounded head with small side set ears, nose wide with a good break, firm chin, very full cheeks, round eyes of a good deep orange, would like them a touch larger. Super coat texture thick but soft standing away very well, he had quite a lot of tabby markings, but he is not yet 12 months old, his tail was thick and in balance to his length of body - lovely laid back nature.

AC BI-COLOUR RAGDOLL ADULT – MALE

1ST. & CC WILSONS PHATPAWS PILLOW TALK – (2.6.13) Blue Bi-colour although not yet 12 months has good boning and substance, length to body, strong limbs and paws. Broad head, his ears spaced well apart, medium length to nose with a slight dip to profile, flat plane to forehead, rounded cheeks, firm chin, large open eyes of a strong deep blue set slightly oblique, nice expression. Coat silky to touch medium length, inverted white triangle to forehead, covering nose, whisker pads, white to chin, tummy and back legs to body ears and mask greyish blue, paler to cheeks back legs to hock, long slightly tapered tail of a good greyish blue – gentle boy to handle.

FEMALE

BOB WILSONS CH. HUAUARAG ETERNAL DAISY – (12.9.11) Mature Blue Bi-colour in lovely condition, strength to limbs and long body. Soft bluish white body coat with a white patch on back, ears and mask an even bluish grey. Even white triangle to face, well set ears, slightly forward tilted, gentle dip to profile, large expressive deep blue eyes – an attractive lady.

1ST & CC. LANCOMBES RAGZNDREAMS TOTALLY DEVINE – (7.5.13) Pretty Seal Bi-colour youngster, very feminine expression, big round eyes of mid even blue, flat plane between medium slight forward tilted ears, nose with a gentle dip, firm chin. Rich seal to ears, slightly paler to face, white inverted even triangle to face, white to chin, chest, front limbs and tummy, back legs white to hock, a small spot of seal on right hock, mid seal to long full tail, body coat soft a pleasing light beige – very promising girl.

SEAL POINT BIRMAN KITTEN

1ST. & BOB WILCOXS REDSKY COCO CHANEL 13c1 (4.7.13) Well developed girl, good muscular development to body, strong limbs and rounded paws. Skull broadening with her ears set good width apart held just slightly pricked, nose a medium length with a slight dip to profile. Lovely almost round eyes of a rich deep blue so expressive, cheeks rounding, muzzle still a little narrow. Coat medium length, soft and silky to the touch, a pale beige to body slight shading to shoulders and lower back. Dark seal ears and mask which was almost complete, paler seal to legs and medium length bushy tail, balanced well with the body. Her gloves a pristine white, even and covering paws, socks again well covering the back feet, gauntlets tapered and an even length reaching 3/4 up the hock. – well shown youngster who was a little on edge, but handled alright.

AOC BI-COLOUR RAGDOLL KITTEN – MALE

1st. JONES GROOVICATS CRACKERKACK – Seal Bi-Colour developing good bone and body length. Flat plane between wide set ears, still held a little pricked, lovely deep dark blue eyes, slightly oblique in setting, medium nose with a gentle dip to profile, nice chin, still teething. Coat still baby soft a light beige, rich seal to ears and face covering cheeks, white chin, chest, tummy and limbs, even white inverted triangle to face, tail well furnished good length almost to shoulders. For his age he has good substance and strong limbs, body lengthening – a promising young chap.

2nd. WILSONS PHATPAWS THE PHAT DUCK – (27.9.13) Very shy Blue Bi-colour wearing a soft baby coat of a pale bluish white, ears and tail a bluish grey. Well set ears, oblique set to round eyes of medium soft blue, nose with a gentle dip but a very slight bump, good chin. White to chin, chest, tummy and front legs, white to hocks on back legs, even triangle to face. Good bone and substance, well padded for age, tail bushy and in proportion to body a soft greyish blue.

FEMALE

A nice class of promising young ladies.

1ST. & BOB SCONCROFTS DIZZYPAWS MISS DAISY – (25.7.13) Lovely Blue Bi-colour wearing a very soft coat of medium length, a pale bluish white, slight shading to neck, white to chin, chest, tummy and front legs, hocks white, the left has just a small spot of colour, soft greyish blue to ears and face, even white inverted triangle to face. Tail bushy, medium in length a light greyish blue. Well developed head, her ears set wide apart, slightly tilted, flat plane to forehead, very nice eye shape a deep blue in colour, good chin and rounded muzzle. Length to body, strong limbs and rounded tufted paws – good natured lass.

2nd. HASSETTS ADTHILO OPHELIA TUMBLERAG – (15.7.13) Pretty Blue-Bi-colour quite a wriggler, she was never still. Good balance to her head, ears set nicely apart, flat plane to forehead, round slightly oblique set eyes a warm even blue, medium length to nose which has a slight dip in profile, firm chin, muzzle still a touch narrow. Strength to limbs and paws, body long,

Balanced off with a long bushy tail. Good soft coat texture, the body bluish white, with slight shading to back, Soft greyish blue to ears and face, paler to limbs and tail, even inverted white triangle to face, chin chest and under parts white.

3rd. WILSONS MONTANTE ELIZA DOOLITTE – Seal Bi-colour the youngest of the class and at present all in balance. Pretty face her eyes a good even blue, set obliquely, ears wide based and set well apart, nice size in relation to head, medium nose with a slight dip in profile. Baby soft pale beige coat, warm seal to ears coming on over face and front legs, pristine white triangle to face, legs, chest tummy and chin white – delightful temperament.

4th. FOSTER & SMITHS BLUDIAMONDS LUCIELOCKET – (8.9.13) Blue Bi-Colour who is starting to through the teenage stage, length to body, high limbs. Her ears set wide apart still a touch pricked, round eyes of a mid blue, slight dip to profile, flat plane to forehead. Silky medium length coat of a bluish white, soft greyish blue to ears, paler to face and bushy long tail.

White triangle to face, chin, chest and tummy white, front legs white a couple of spots of colour on hocks – friendly youngster.

BROWN SPOTTED BENGAL ADULT

1ST. CC & BOB MITCHELLS PEARLDUST RAZZLEDAZZLE – (12.7.11) Very vocal but friendly girl, broad wedge shaped head, lovely large eyes of a bright green, broad nose with puffed leather, slight curve, firm chin, whisker pads developing, wide based ears rounded at tip, set slightly to the side. Lovely coat dense and soft, showing clear markings on a warm

agouti ground, M to forehead, scarab continuing over to neck, spectacles round eyes, clear eye lines, spots and rosettes to sides, back lines starting to break, tabby rings and spots to limbs and thick medium tail. Long body still a tad teenage but coming on nicely, strong legs and paws – promising youngster.

SINGAPURA KITTEN

1ST & BOB RATHBONES JANAMEL AMIR OSCAR – (12.8.13) Lovely boy well developed, lithe body, good limbs, neat rounded paws. Big expressive eyes of a nice hazel, ears wide based and set nicely, nose with a slight stop, salmon leather, good chin. Coat close and silky a warm ivory even sepia ticking. Pale ivory to tummy inner legs and chest, broken pale necklace, barring to inner front legs, just showing on back legs. Nose leather outlined in brown, cheetah lines from eyes, tail slender with a blunt end, dark tipped - a lively boy.

BROWN SPOTTED BENGAL NEUTER

2 grand boys not a lot between them

BOB ROBINSONS CHEYSULI SUNSET KISS – (23.5.12) Super boy, strong well made body and limbs. Good wedge with medium ears well set, big expressive eyes, surrounded by spectacles, nose broad the leather puffed, broad muzzle with pronounced whisker pads, firm chin. Glossy coat medium and dense, the markings distinct, M to head, scarab, whisker spots and eye lines. Rosettes and spots to back and sides, tummy a warm golden rufus colour well spotted, rings to legs and toe spots, tail quite thick, in balance to body, well ringed with a dark tip – quality lad with a good temperament.

Also considered – HUTCHINSONS GR. PR TOBYSDEN WILLIAM OFORANGE – (8.3.09)

Mature boy with a lovely temperament. Long and lean in body, good limbs and paws. Strong wedge, his ears wide based, large eyes of a good green, firm chin. Soft dense coat showing good markings, M and scarab, rosettes and spots to sides, back line a touch solid, tail well ringed with a dark tip – gentle to handle.

SINGAPURA NEUTER

BOB RATHBONES CH. & GR. PR. JAYSHELM TAMARISK – (27.7.10) Balanced girl so very friendly. Rounded skull, round eyes of a warm bright green surrounded by spectacles, large ears open at base, well cupped, blunt nose with a salmonleather, broad muzzle. Close silky coat, even ticked in a warm sepia brown, pale ivory to tummy, inner legs and chest. Markings to inner legs, tail slender blunt tip.

1st.& PC. RATHBONES KWANSAN MARAS MOJO – (14.4.12) Shy gentle girl wearing a short silky coat with even sepia ticking, warm ivory to chest, tummy and inner legs, markings to inner back legs. Good head development for her age, ears large open based, nicely cupped. Large bright eyes of a hazel green, dark spectacles, salmon leather with a dark outline, Medium balanced body with strength to legs and small oval paws, tail slender, blunt at tip.

3RD. EMERYS NOYNAROCK JOSHUA-SKOGVENNS – Brown Tabby Norwegian lad another with a good coat for texture.
