

## **Short Haired Cat Club 2015 - Judge: Ms.K.Wilson**

### **AV Burmese Champion Male**

**1st & GRCC - Marshall's Ch Millgill Kungfu Khat (BUR b) M 28/04/14**

I deliberated for a long while on awarding this certificate as this young lad was rather immature for this level of award. Just as you'd expect as he was only 11 and half months, and really not into his manhood yet. I do believe he has the quality of type to make this level so I gave in to his pleading expression!

Head; well shaped Burmese wedge, reasonably short in the muzzle, reasonable width across the top of his head and cheeks tapering to a fairly broad blunt muzzle.

Profile; gently rounded top to head between ears, rounding over brow, well defined nose break, fairly short nose, curves slightly rolling off at the end. His chin is strong, having good depth and , ending level with his nose.

Ears; medium Large, broad at their base, rounded tips and set so as to follow up from his wedge.

Eyes are good although, ideally I'd prefer them to be larger to give a more striking expression. They are however, well shaped, set well apart and a pleasing golden-yellow in colour.

Lovely firm body of good weight for his age, yet to fill fully out with maturity. Rounded chest and straight back. Strong, elegant legs, tail has a thick base tapering slightly to rounded tip and just balances.

Coat; slightly long, and a little plush, possibly due to outdoor living, so not lying as sleekly as ideal. A lovely warm chocolate colour with a darker mask.

Excellent relaxed temperament

### **Brown Tortoiseshell Burmese Adult**

**1st, CC & BOB - Tegg's Bloomers Bossy Britches (BUR f) F 22/04/14**

An 11 months, 3 weeks old, sappy girl, with an exceptional temperament. Another youngster, who will continue to improve as she matures.

Head; fairly short wedge of reasonable width. I'd like to see more width for increased impact but that may well develop with maturity as she is still just under a year old. Slight rounding over the top of her head and brow.

Profile; good overall head depth, well defined nose break, reasonably short nose which rolls off at its tip. Level bite and fair depth of chin which could be a little stronger.

Ears which are pleasingly medium in size, are well set with rounded tips and a slight forward tilt when viewed in profile.

Eyes; large eyes, of typical Burmese shape having a gentle curve to the top line and fuller rounding to the lower line. Lustrous golden yellow colouring.

Body; medium sized girl with good weight for her age. Slender elegant legs, neat oval paws, and proportional tail of good shape.

Coat; fine in texture, lying sleekly and medium in length. Rich seal brown splashed with pale tangerine red, no noticeable bars.

### **AC Pedigree-Pet Master Cat Male**

**GMC Thompson's MC Ferguson (Chocolate Point Longhair) MN 2yrs.**

Gorgeous young man with penetrating sapphire blue eyes which are very striking. Strong muscular body, beautifully prepared luxury silken semi long coat. Starch white mittens and socks over soft warm chocolate points with creamy coat. Fabulous condition and a total gent. Congratulations.

### **SH Self Pedigree Pet with or without white Male**

**BOC - Lowell's Imp IGMC Just Willyum (PPS) 8years**

Superb, absolutely huge oriental styled lad, so completely relaxed, gentle and very appreciative of all attention. Walks out onto the trolley to meet us, which was much appreciated given his size! Sleek, short impeccable coat of rich rosey-toffee colour. Lovely expressive eyes, I can just imagine waking up to them in bed, what a hunk!

## **Blue Abyssinian Neuter**

### **1st & PC - Goodyear's Abydreams Edward (ABY a) MN 07/04/14**

A pleasing blue male neuter.

Head inc Ears; he has a moderate wedge, gently contoured with fair width across the top of his head and cheeks. Good rounding over his head flowing over his cheeks and into the slight indentations which precedes his gently rounded muzzle, which is just slightly narrow at present. His profile shows a slight nose break. His chin could be firmer and deeper. Level bite.

Large ears, with furry inner edges, sitting cupped and pricked with a good degree of width between them.

Eyes; his amber eyes are large, rounded-almond in shape, with an oriental set delivering an excellent Abyssinian expression.

Body; he is a lovely overall size, medium length body, lithe and muscular, correct foreign conformation. Elegant proportional legs, feet and tail.

Coat & Pattern; well defined facials, pale lips and chin, pale apricot throat and neck 2 residual broken necklaces. Slightly darker spine line of soft blue, continues down his tail to a solid blue tail tip. Well coloured hocks. His coat has density but could have more of a resilient feel to it.

Well ticked in blue over a off white undercoat.

He has a fabulous temperament, very easy to handle, a calm and collected gent.

## **AOC Abyssinian Adult Assessment, Male**

### **1st Merit & BOB - Barrett's Flamstone Sunnyhill Boy (ABY d) M 29/02/12**

Red male of 3 years 1 month and how lovely to see a red of such good overall Abyssinian type.

Head inc Ears; He has a moderate wedge, gently contoured with good width and rounding over his head and cheeks. Slight indentation precedes his gently rounded muzzle. His Profile shows clear nose break, a hint of a bump, firm chin and he has a level bite. Moderately large ears, with furry inner edges. He was a little nervous today so tending to hold them a little on the flared side, but settled into a good set once he had fully aquatinted himself with us.

Eyes; his eyes are rounded almond in shape, with an oriental set, which ideally could be slightly larger.

Body; he is a good overall size, medium length body, slightly lean over his haunches, (working lad), elegantly proportioned finished with small feet,( kneading gently). His tail is a good length and shape.

Coat; he has a defined darker red spine line, and clearly defined facials. Pale cream coloured lips and chin, leading to rich ground coloured throat and neck. 2 residual well broken necklets to the sides of his neck. The dark red ticking colour extends halfway up his hocks. His coat has an excellent texture, resilient, dense and medium short in length. Displays impressive ticking, with a bright red base colour, and dark red ticking.

## Midland Cat Club 2015 Judge : Ms.K.Wilson

### Asian Smoke or Burmilla Adult

**1st, CC & BOB - McRae & Gabb's Cagaran Julie-Jo (ASH hs 31) F 03/07/14**

Only just eligible for this adult class at 9 months and 1 week, she is a just wee poppet of a cat, and extremely cute with it. I did have some deliberating to do over her award today.

Head; Very short wide wedge, which tends toward too short so as to loosing the typical wedge shape desired. Broad blunt muzzle Slight rounding between the ears and over her brow, and good overall depth of head.

Profile; A distinct deep nose break short straight nose medium depth to level chin . correct bite Medium sized ears wide at their base and rounded tips, furry inside - practically streamers!

Her eyes are large very full, set on a slight slant, and set well apart. Green hazel in colour.

Body; She is a smaller compact girl, with a shorter body than ideal, and slightly short in the leg. I'd prefer to see a more elegantly foreign conformation for this breed. Her tail is fractionally short and has a stiff tip although no deviation.

Coat & Pattern; She has pretty tabby facial markings in chocolate and light red, with fetching chocolate eyeliner, and dark edging to the back of her ears, creating the thumbprint effect.

Her coat is fine in texture, but really needs to be shorter and sleeker. I suspect she is a long haired carrier. Lightly shaded with BCR chocolate and red tipping, over a clear warm toned silver ground.

She has faint tabby leg bars and rings down her tail

Temp; a totally adorable temperament!

### Asian Tabby Adult Male

**1st & CC – Crow & Goss' Kagura Achilles (ASH b 25 31 ) M 16/06/14**

Young lad only just adult at 9 months 4 wks. BCR Chocolate Tick Tabby

Head; Excellent overall head type having a short wedge with excellent width and broad blunt muzzle. Gentle rounding across the top of his head and rounded brow. Excellent overall head depth.

Profile; Well defined nose break, followed by s short straight nose, and good depth to level chin. Correct bite.

Ears; medium sized ears, broad at their base and with rounded tips, Well set so that their outline continues up from his wedge

Eyes; his eyes are large and hazel with a true Burmese expression.

Body ;he is a good size and weight for his age, lithe and muscular. String rounded chest and straight back. Slender elegant legs and well shaped tail.

Coat; fine textured coat, pale chocolate ticking over a warm creamy base colour, slightly longer and plusher than ideal. Chocolate spine line is defined, continuing down tail to solid choc tip, Chocolate rings down his tail. Typical tabby facial markings in pale chocolate. A promising young lad, a little nervous but well mannered.

### Asian Tabby Adult Female

**1st & CC – Dewhurst's Kimani Tinie Temptress (ASH f 24 31) F 13/03/14**

1 yr old female, BCR brown torte ticked tabby, what a wriggler and very vocal in her comments on proceedings. Clearly a girl is used to getting her own way at home!

Head; short wedge good width across top and at her cheeks, gentle rounding to top and brow. I'd prefer more overall head depth.

Profile; neatly defined, defined break, short straight nose level chin of fair depth. Correct bite.

Ears; medium large with excellent set.

Eyes; lovely expressive face with large golden coloured, lustrous eyes which have a gently curved top line, with the desired slanted towards the nose and full rounded lower line.

Body; she a smaller medium sized slender young girl, very strong and muscular though!

Coat & Pattern; she has predominantly seal brown spotting over a beige ground, some soft reds visible as a testament to her tortiness. The pattern could be better defined, and have more clarity, Spots visible over sides, quite a bit of linkage particularly on one side, the spine line is more of a broad diffuse band, brown tail tip, soft brown coloured bars on legs and rings on tail. Seal scarab on her forehead, cheek lines and eyeliner. Lovely and sleek, with a satin like texture and a good shorter length.

**BOB – Crow & Goss' Ch Karakoram Kagura Pearldust (ASH m 24 31) F 30/10/11**

Head; with excellent overall Asian type this mature female has a well balanced short wedge with good width, tapering to abroad blunt muzzle. Gentle rounding and width between her ears and rounded brow.

Profile; good break, short, straight nose. Bite level although untidy. Good overall depth of head, with good chin depth which lines up level with nose. She has Medium sized ears which follow up the outer-line of her wedge shape.

Eyes; lovely sweet expression to her large chartreuse eyes. Well shaped with a gentle slanting top line, and full rounding to the lower line.

Body; she is a very good size and weight, with elegant foreign conformation, proportional, slender, legs and oval paws. Well shaped tail, just about balances. Coat & Pattern; Super silky textured coat that lies well, although slightly longer than ideal.

Coat & pattern; She is a BCR caramel spotty-tabby, with toffee coloured caramel spots over a beige ground. Distinctive metallic sheen evident, particularly on her head and her tail, and hocks. She has typical tabby facial markings, 'M' pattern, dark caramel eye liner with beige spectacles, etc. A spotty tummy, full rings down her tail, bracelets across her legs and an unbroken necklace and some broken necklet. Although she is clearly a spotty tabby, the spotting could be better defined with less spot linkage, a challenge for the breeder!

**Also considered for BOB**

**Crow & Goss' Ch Kagura Aleppo (ASH b 25) M 22/06/12**

Mature male of 2 years 9 months.

Head; well typed male, with a short wide wedge, Good head depth.

Profile; well defined nose break, reasonably short nose, nice and straight to the tip. medium depth level chin, untidy but acceptable bite.

Ears; medium large well set astride his head so as to follow his outer wedge line.

Eyes; large, lustrous, set well apart and hazel coloured. They have a good shape with well rounded lower line and an acutely curved top line.

Body; long, powerful and muscular 'foreign' physique. Elegant legs and proportional tail

Coat & Pattern; Fine textured coat, sleek lying and a good shortish length. Overall rich vibrant chocolate appearance, with rich apricot base coat, pales to a cooler darker colour at the roots and ticked with warm chocolate. Chocolate spine line, and tabby facial markings,

Temp; Shy lad.

**Crow & Goss' Ch Kagura Eliechlo Mowgli (ASH n 25 31) M 05/08/13**

1 year and 8 months of age

Head; strong overall head type having a short wedge with excellent width, tapering to a short muzzle with a broad blunt finish. Slight rounding to head top and over brow. Good overall depth of head.

Profile; he has a well defined nose break, a short, straight nose, shallow depth to a level chin, and correct bite.

Ears; medium sized, very well set so as to follow up from the outline of his wedge.

Eyes; large, green, with the correct typical shape having a well rounded lower line and straighter top line slanted towards his nose.

Body; he is a good sized lad feeling firm and fit. Proportional legs and tail.

Coat; fine textured coat, but appearing rather fluffy giving him an unkempt look. He also has a very sparse patch over his shoulders, perhaps due to an over amorous house mate?

Temp; unfortunately he was not a happy lad, and very nervous. I felt he was not in tip top show condition today.

**Chocolate/Lilac Abyssinian Kitten Male**

**1st & BOB – Lincoln's Legend Cesare. (ABY b). M 20/07/14**

At 8 months 3 weeks, what a delightful male kitten.

Head inc Ears; he has flowing contours to his moderate wedge with good width and rounding between his ears. Slight indentations are evident either side of his gently rounded muzzle.

His profile displays a slight nose break and a good deep, firm chin. Level bite.

His large ears, with furry inner edges, sitting cupped and pricked, finished with tufts are typical of the breed. They are well set to follow his wedge shape and with good width between them.

His eyes are very expressive, large, rounded-almond in shape, with an oriental set and hazel in colour.

Body; he is a good size for his 8 months, lithe and elegant, proportionals legs and tail.

Coat & Pattern; well defined facials, pale apricot lips and chin, apricot throat and neck free from necklets and bars. Chocolate spine line which continues down his tail to a solid choc tail tip. Short chocolate hocks. His coat, is medium short, has density and a resilient feel to it. well defined chocolate ticking over an apricot base.

Temp; confident and playful character who shows a great deal of promise. Congratulations!

### **Blue Burmese Adult Female**

#### **BOB - Grey's Ch Rossikhan Fancy-Piece (BUR a) F 15/03/12**

A very stylish looking exhibit.

Head; Strong overall burmese type, well balanced short wedge, good width, short, broad, blunt effect, muzzle

Profile; well defined neat profile, good break, short straight nose and level chin of medium depth.

Ears are rather large and tend to dominate her face, but very well set to accentuate the shape of her wedge.

Eyes; large and very expressive with that sultry burmese look, having excellent shape . They are green-chartreuse in colour.

Body; a good sized girl, lovely elegant conformation, slender elegant legs, and neat oval paws and proportional tail.

Coat; very sleek and close lying, giving that very desirable sprayed on look. Medium blue, just a little fawing evident. Clearly in excellent condition and very even tempered.

#### **Also considered for BOB**

#### **Marshall's Ch Millgill Kirkbride Kin (BUR a) F 28/04/14**

A lovely young miss, just not having the same degree of finish as the BOB winner, but given she is a year younger, she has all to play for in the future.

Head; pleasing, short wedge, with good width at cheeks and across the top of her head, tapering to a short blunted muzzle.

Profile; neatly defined profile, good break, straight nose and level chin, of fair depth.

Ears; larger medium sized ears, well set.

Eyes; well defined by their Burmese shape to impart a typical expression.

Body; is a smaller medium size, good weight, feeling firm and lithe.

Coat; sleek and close lying, lovely soft mid blue with desired silvering

Temp; very pleasant character.

### **Red Burmese Neuter Female**

#### **BOB - Smith's UK IGrPr Janzanco Zinfandelle (BUR d) FN 18/04/11**

Head; the lovely breadth and rounding to the top of the head , tapering to a blunt muzzle gives this lady a strong Burmese look.

Profile; shows a gently rounded brow, a good break, straight nose and good depth to level chin.

Ears; are very well set ears, astride her broad head.

Eyes; very attractive, large with well rounded lower line and gentle curve to top line. Lustrous yellow tones complete her expression

Body; a very good medium sized girl, weighty, muscular and elegant in conformation. Proportional legs and tail.

Coat; is an excellent short length, sleek and silky in texture, and a pleasing bright tangerine colour in colour, clear from bars and necklets.

Temp; Gentle girl who handles well.
