BRITISH BLUE ADULT MALE.

BOB. HUTCHINSON'S GR. CH. MAKRISSNIC LORDOF THERINGS. 16. M. 20.8.11.

A very solid and mature looking Blue boy of one and a half years showing good British type for his young age.

Round head with good breadth and depth; ears just stand a little tall; good round cheeks to behind a slightly square muzzle; level bite, firm chin, short broad nose; round golden eyes giving him an alert expression. A solid cobby body of good weight and muscular tone; broad chest; short well-boned legs, neat paws; balanced tail. A very good coat of mid-blue with good density, short and beautifully sound to the roots. He was easy to handle and enjoyed his time with us.

1. CC. FIGGINS' HYSSOPUSS HIGHLANDER. 16. M. 20.3.11.

Quite a nervous lad at first. However, once he had settled down he was easy to handle.

A Blue boy of 2yr. showing good British type. Round head; ears still standing a little tall; good round cheeks to muzzle; firm chin, level bite, short broad nose; round eyes of a very good copper shade. Good size and weight to his cobby body; broad chest developing well; short well-boned legs, neat paws; balanced tail. Coat short, dense, and firm, of mid-blue, almost sound to the roots. He was happy to go back to his pen. He was a gentle boy who was shown in good condition.

BRITISH BLUE ADULT FEMALE.

1. CC. MORRIS' MABELLABRITZ LUNA LADY. 16. F. 9.5.12.

A 10-month-old Blue girl showing good size for her age and British type. Round head; neat ears with good space between; cheeks gently rounded to muzzle; good firm chin, level bite, short broad nose; round expressive eyes of gold. Good size and weight to her cobby body; broad chest developing well; short well-boned legs, neat paws; balanced tail. She has a good coat of mid-blue, dense and firm, just lying a little flat on her spine line; sound to the roots. A lovely girl who handled well and was shown in good condition.

2. HOWARD'S AIRLIEBIRD MINI HAHA. 16. F. 13.5.12.

A young girl of 10 months showing good British type. Round head; ears standing tall; cheeks rounded to muzzle line; firm chin, level bite, short broad nose; round eyes of gold. Good size cobby body; short well-boned legs, neat paws; balanced tail. Coat, a little soft in texture, was short, of good density; of mid-blue; paling to the roots; she still has some banding on her hindquarters. A gentle girl who handled well.

3. HARRISON'S CHARMODEN IAMBERTHA. 16. F. 4.5.12.

A Blue girl who is well grown for her age of 10 months, and showing good British type.

Round head; medium size ears; round cheeks to muzzle; firm chin, level bite, short broad nose; round eyes of gold. Good size cobby body; short well-boned legs, neat paws; balanced tail. Her coat of mid-blue was soft and a little long, especially on her back – unfortunately it pales rather a lot to the roots. She handled well and was shown in good condition.

CHOCOLATE ADULT FEMALE.

1. CC. & BOB withheld. HUTCHINSON'S MALSONE ZITA. 15b. F. 16.4.12.

A Chocolate girl of nearly 1yr. showing good British type.

Round head; neat ears; cheeks developing well to firm chin, level bite, short broad nose; round expressive eyes of a good golden colour. Good weight and size to her cobby body; chest developing; short well-boned legs, neat paws; balanced tail.

Her coat of a darker shade of chocolate was short, of good density, paling to the roots; ghost tabby markings are still visible, and her coat is quite brindled on her hindquarters; her coat was my reason for withholding the CC & BOB today. I was very pleased to be able to speak to her owners after judging, and hopefully, as she gets older and has a moult, her coat will improve.

2. BROWN'S CHARMODEN IAMHILDA. 15b. F. 16.4.12.

Still quite a kitten look to this chocolate girl of 11 months, she just needs more time to mature.

Round head; ears standing tall; cheeks needing to develop more shape; firm chin, bite very slightly undershot – hopefully as she matures the bite will settle; short broad nose; round eyes of gold. Still a young cobby body; short well-boned legs, neat paws; balanced tail. Her chocolate coat is short, soft, and needing more density; chocolate shade pales to the roots. A gentle friendly girl who handled well.

LILAC ADULT MALE.

1. CC. HOSKER'S ADZWOSH KATOSKA CAPTAINJACK. 15c. M. 18.5.12.

A balanced Lilac boy of 10 months showing good British type.

Round head; ears are just a fraction tall; round cheeks developing to behind the muzzle; firm chin, level bite; round eyes of gold. Good size developing cobby body; broad chest; short well-boned legs, neat paws; balanced tail. Coat of a darker shade of lilac, short with good density; evidence of a slight stud tail. A gentle lad who handled well.

LILAC ADULT FEMALE.

1. CC. & BOB. JAY'S JANSTAN JUSTLILIBET. 15c. F. 29.4.12.

A lovely well-grown Lilac girl of almost 1yr. year showing good British type.

Good round head with good breadth and depth developing well; neat ears with good space between; balanced round cheeks to muzzle; good firm chin, level bite, short broad nose; good round eyes of copper giving her an alert and interested expression.

A solid weight and size to her cobby body; broad chest; short well-boned legs, neat paws; balanced tail. Her coat of lilac, with a pinkish hue visible, has good density, firm, and just pales slightly to the roots. A bright and lovely girl who handled well and was shown in good condition.

BLUE/LILAC/ FAWN TORTIE ADULT.

1. CC. & BOB. KIRK AND JAHASZ'S SENI SEVIYORUN VICTORIA. 21c. F. 14.4.12.

What a super size and weight to this Lilac Tortie girl of almost 1yr. and she shows good British type.

Good round head; neat ears fitting well into her head shape; good round cheeks to muzzle line; firm chin, level bite, short broad nose; round eyes of a good copper shade. Good size and weight to her cobby body; really short well-boned legs, neat paws; balanced tail. Very good coat, short, dense, and firm; beautifully mingled lilac and cream; all four feet broken with colour. I really love this girl! She handled well and was shown in good condition.

2. ASHTON'S HYSOPOUSS HONEY-BLOSSOM. 28. F. 13.5.12.

It was a pity this Blue Cream girl of 10 months came up against the winner today. She shows good British type.

Apple-shaped head; neat ears; cheeks developing to muzzle; firm chin, level bite, short broad nose; round eyes of copper. Good weight to her developing cobby body; short well-boned legs, neat paws; balanced tail. Very good coat, short, dense, and firm; pale blue mingled with cream, sound to the roots; cream on the right side of neck; all four feet were mingled with colour. A delightful little girl who handled well and who was shown in good condition.

BI-COLOURED ADULT MALE.

1. CC. HAYES' SHEEPHOUSE CREAMY COOKIE. 31f. M. 17.5.12.

A young Cream Bi-Coloured boy of almost 11 months showing good British type.

Round head; neat ears; cheeks developing well to muzzle; firm chin, level bite, short broad nose; round eyes of a good deep golden shade. Cobby body and chest developing well; short well-boned legs, neat paws; balanced tail. His coat was short, dense, and firm; pale cream with minimal ghost tabby markings was sound to roots; cream on his head, back, and legs; white of one-third with good demarcation; white blaze; white on his chest and legs, with a lovely white collar. A friendly lad who was shown in very good condition.

BI-COLOURED ADULT FEMALE.

1. CC. & BOB. HOWARD'S PAMPURRED HEARTBREAKE. 31a. F. 23.7.11.

A super-size Blue Bi-Coloured girl of over one and a half years showing good British type.

Round head; really neat ears with good space between; cheeks well rounded to muzzle line; firm chin, level bite, short broad nose; round eyes of copper. Good size and weight to her cobby body; short well-boned legs, neat paws; balanced tail.

An excellent coat, short, of good density, and firm; mid-blue, sound to the roots on her head, sides of body, and legs; white of a good one-third on her chest, abdomen legs and neck; with a lovely white blaze on her nose. She was shown in very good condition, and handled very well. It was lovely to see such a particularly good coat.

2. WRIGHT'S REVODNA AMAZING-GRACE. 31a. F. 9.4.12.

Still a young Blue & White Bi-Coloured girl of almost 1yr. showing good British type.

Round head; neat ears; cheeks developing to muzzle line; level bite, firm chin, short broad nose; round eyes of gold. Her cobby body needs to develop more weight; broad chest developing; she appears to stand tall on her well-boned legs and neat paws; balanced tail. Her coat of blue is a little on the long side, and soft, especially on the spine line; white of one-third on her head, chest, abdomen, and legs; a white blaze. She is a nice little girl who just needs more time to mature.

AC COLOURPOINTED & WHITE ADULT (INTERMEDIATE).

1. IC. & BOB. HAYES' MAWBRTZ LUNE ECLIPSE. 40 8w. F. 19.3.12.

A well-grown Blue Cream Colourpointed and White girl of 1yr. showing good British type.

Round head; neat ears spaced well apart on her head; rounded cheeks to muzzle; firm chin, level bite, and short broad nose; round expressive eyes of blue. Very good weight and size to her cobby body; broad chest; well-boned legs, neat paws; balanced tail. Her coat was short, dense, and firm; blue mixed with red and cream clearly seen on her ears, mask, and body; her body was glacial white with shadings of blue and cream; her bib, chest, and underbody are white; her legs and paws are white; she has a white inverted 'V' on her forehead extending down and covering her nose and whisker pads. She was altogether a lovely girl shown in good condition and easy to handle.

BLUE/LILAC/FAWN TORTIE KITTEN.

1. BOB. ASTON'S HYSSOPUSS JUST-PAWSOME. 28. F. 21.8.12.

A real little pet! A Blue Cream kitten of 7 months showing good British type. Apple-shaped head; neat ears with good space between; cheeks rounding well to muzzle line; firm chin, level bite, short broad nose; round bright and alert eyes of a muddy gold. Cobby shaped body; broad chest developing; short well-boned legs, neat paws; balanced tail. A super dense, and firm coat of mid-blue well mingled with cream, and sound to roots; a small cream patch under her chin; all feet were mingled with colour. A delightful girl who handled well and who was shown in good condition.

BLUE/LILAC/FAWN TORTIE NEUTER.

BOB. CHANDLER'S UK. & IGR. KOLINGA BLUEBELLA. 28. FN. 4.6.07.

A very good size and type to this Blue Cream girl of 6yr. Good broad round head; neat ears; cheeks well rounded to muzzle line; firm chin, level bite, short broad nose; round eyes of gold. A good size cobby body – I think she likes her food! Broad chest; short well-boned legs, neat paws; balanced tail. Coat of good density and well mingled with blue and cream; all four feet mingled with colours. I loved the cream tip to her tail!
