MRS. PAT PERKINS – SHOW REPORT

IMPERIAL AC PERSIAN GR. CH. – MALE

IMPERIAL- AGUIARS GR. CH. BARLEYFIELDS MOON-RIVER – PER w 62 (12.8.14) Solid cobby Orange-eyed White boy. Broad mature head, small side set ears with lots of feathers, large round expressive rich orange eyes, broad nose with a strong break, open nostrils and wide leather, his chin firm, round cheeks. Lovely pristine white coat, beautifully prepared, frill framing his head, short wide full tail. Strong legs and big rounded paws, breadth to chest, well made body – a laid back boy so nice to handle.

IMPERIAL AC PERSIAN GR. CH. - FEMALE

IMPERIAL – SMITHS GR. CH. ZILVA ANGELICA PICKLES – PER ns 12 64 (25.1.10) Chinchilla lady well aware of her good looks today. Very full soft coat her tipping light and even, silvery white to her undercoat. Rounded top of head, small ears, well feathered, Big wide open eyes of a lovely aqua green , so expressive, outlined in black, short nose, good break brick leather outlined in black, firm chin and full cheeks. Solid build, compact build, thick short legs and tufted paws, wide short evenly tipped tail – a most impressive lass.

RES. PRIESTLEYS GR. CH. KRANEWITTERS CALYPSO – PER a (28.6.14) Another lovely lass, Blue, her coat a medium soft blue, slightly shady to roots on back, so very well presented. Frill framing her round head, small ears with lots of furnishings, short nose, strong break, nostrils open, chin firm and her cheeks rounded, large deep orange eyes. Cobby and compact, short little legs, and rounded paws, her tail short and wide – a quality girl with a gentle nature.

AOC SEMI-LH GR.PREMIER

GR. PR. BURGESS IMP. GR. CH & PR. COONARIA CHICAGO – MCO n 03 22 (27.11.13) Brown Tabby & White Maine Coon, lovely long lean boy with good bone, strong legs and big paws with undertufts. Well developed head, eyes hazel, square muzzle, his nose broad with a slight concave curve, firm chin and level bite. Nicely groomed coat, frontal ruff and a very long full tail to shoulders. White to chin, chest and paws, clear tabby to head, body stripes, rings to legs and tail, markings dark brown, the ground coat warm fawn – great boy to handle.

RES. SCOWCROFT PR. DIZZYPAWS MUSTARD – RAG n 04 (4.4.10) Seal Mitted Ragdoll boy, strong bone thick legs and paws large, well made especially in the tummy area. Mature head, flat plane to forehead, ears wide based with a slight forward tilt, firm chin, large slightly oblique set eyes of an even mid blue. Very thick soft coat, the body beige in colour shading lighter to tummy, dark seal to ears and face, full tail of a mid seal. White paws, chin, chest, legs and paws, just a spot of seal on right leg – such a laid back lad.

GRAHAMS CH & PR. MYDOLLS CHOCOLATE TRIUMPH – RAG b (3.12.11) Mature Chocolate Colourpointed Ragdoll. Well developed boy with good bone and substance, strong medium legs, paws firm and rounded, length to body. His head broad with a flat plane between his wide, slightly forward tilted ears, nose showing a gentle dip, firm chin. Eyes of a mid even blue set slightly oblique and wide apart. Nicely presented coat, the body a very pale ivory, slight shading to back, rich dark chocolate to mask and ears, little paler on limbs, his tail bushy, slightly tapered, a pale chocolate with some slight brindling - friendly fellow

WILLIS PR. RAGZNDREAMS MOSES – RAG d (26.6.14) Red Colourpointed Ragdoll another solid well made lad with strong bone and substance, thick strong legs and big paws, long body. Broad head, flat plane, his ears wide based, medium in size, nose, medium with slight dip, good chin. Large slightly oblique eyes of a lovely deep blue, the left pupil not quite as even as the right. Soft pale coat, rich red to ears and mask, tail a tad paler – gentle temperament.

AOV SEMI-LH GR. PREMIER – FEMALE

GR. PR. DAVIES PR. ANGLEZARK SUGARSPUN – MCO g 03 22 (16.12.12) Blue Tortie Tabby & White Maine Coon lady. Strong head with her ears set very high on head, wide based, long tips. Big expressive eyes, slightly oblique set the colour a good hazel, broad nose with a concave curve, muzzle firm and square, a nice overall balance. Length to body, she has study high legs and large feathered paws. Coat showing nice shades of mingled blue and cream, seasonally changing a fraction harsh on lower back, frontal ruff and long whiskers, white to V to face, paws white, tabby M to head, spectacles, body showing good blue tabby markings on a warm beige ground – grand girl to handle.

RES. WILLIS PR. RAGZNDREAMS SASSY – RAG g (26.6.14) Attractive Blue Tortie Colourpointed Ragdoll, she was rather upset by the British lads opposite who were causing mayhem! but we did finally manage to judge her. Soft well groomed coat, body showing shades of bluish white, greyish blue and pastel cream to ears, well developed mask and limbs, tail full long and slightly tapering ruff framing her head. Balanced broad head with medium slightly forward tilted ears, flat plane to forehead, medium length to nose which had a gentle dip, firm chin, her eyes bright a mid blue set well apart. Length to body and firm limbs, rounded paws – a very nice lass.

BENNERS PR. NOYNAROCK DOTTY CANDY MINT – NFO w 64 (25.3.15) Sweet Norwegian youngster, I really liked this girl she is not quite 12 months still a little adolescent, some filling out to do, long lean body and very high limbs, rounded paws, triangular shape to her head, straight profile, firm chin, her ears wide based and long tufted, bright eyes the colour a pale hazel. Pristine white coat, top coat has nice texture for her age, long well furnished tail past her shoulders – lovely natured a pleasure to handle.

AGUIARS CH. PERSILUS ZIPPORAH – PER w 62 (202.15) Cobby well balanced girl, strong legs and round tufted paws. Rounded top of head, her ears small and side set, well furnished, quite a short nose with strong break, open nostrils, firm chin and rounded cheeks, when we could get her to open her eyes the colour was a strong orange. Lovely well prepared coat, full frill framing her head, pristine white, balanced off with a short wide tail – laid back youngster.

PERSIAN BLUE COLOURPOINT – ADULT

1st. CC & BOB ADAMS PANTILE PRECIOUS PHOEBE per a 33 (10.5.15) Solid cobby lass with an apple shaped head, tiny feathered ears, firm chin, round cheeks, when she could be bothered to open her eyes they were large, round and a soft blue. Well developed blue mask and ears, limbs slightly paler, body coat almost white, very slight shading to lower back, bushy wide short blue tail. Sturdy body, short legs and nicely rounded paws – at 10 months a promising youngster.

PERSIAN BLACK KITTEN – MALE

1ST & BOB HIGGINS HEAHROSE BARRY WHITE – PER n (24.7.15) Lovely boy wearing a super coat, so long and soft lovely preparation, already has a good ruff framing his broad rounded head, small ears, long furnishings, short wide nose, good break, wide leather and open nostrils, firm chin, good bite, large round eyes the colour a promising muddy brown. Cobby and solid with thick short legs and big feathered paws. His tail wide, short and a good black, coat showing some shading at roots but head and legs a dense black – cracking youngster.

FEMALE

1st. NICHOLAS SUGARTUMP THRYSORI MYFANWY - PER a (26.6.15) Another very nice youngster, ran winner close. Solid and cobby in build, sturdy legs and rounded paws. Width to top of head, small well feathered ears, large eyes the colour is not yet sorted, rounded cheeks, chin firm, broad short nose, good break. Baby soft coat, ruff developing, overall a good black, a little shading to roots, short little well furnished tail – lovely natured girl.

PERSIAN TABBY COLOURPOINT – KITTEN

1ST & BOB ADAMS CUSHKA KALEESI – PER d 21 33 (3.7.15) Very pretty Red Tabby Colourpoint, sweet expression, good width to top of head, tiny ears, her nose short with an ample break, open nostrils, fully cheeks and good chin, large round eyes the colour developing from centre. Her coat very soft, well groomed, body a pale apricot white, rich red to ears, mask developing, darker over nose, spreading out to cheeks, limbs a pale red, M showing on head, spectacles round eyes, slight rings on legs, tail bushy a mid red, some slight rings. Solid cobby build, short thick limbs and round paws – happy youngster to handle.

RED, CREAM AND TORTIE POINT BIRMAN – KITTEN

1ST. & BOB HEFFERMANS PENDLESTAR RAPHAELLA – SBI g (22.6.15)g Attractive Blue Tortie Point youngster with good bone and substance, thick strong legs and rounded paws. Her head broadening, medium nose with a slight dip to profile, her ears medium and set well apart, cheeks rounding, lovely nearly round deep blue eyes. Soft blue and cream to ears, over nose, spreading to cheeks, nose leather blue and pink, limbs showing soft shades of blue and cream, as did her bushy balanced tail, body off white with light shading of blues and creams. Pristine white gloves covering her paws, back feet covered, one gauntlet tapered the other short but the under leg had to tortie shading – alert and friendly.

2ND. KINGS DALTEEMS BUTTON MOON – SBI f (14.9.15) Seal Tortie Point lass, just starting to go a little teenage in build. Strong skull , her nose medium with a slight profile dip, leather seal, medium ears held a little pricked at present, firm chin, eyes nearly round the colour a sound even blue, firm chin. Ears and mask showing intermingled seal brown and shades of red, spreading over cheeks, limbs just a little paler but well mingled, body fawn with tortie shadings. Gloves just covering paws, Socks pristine and covering feet, gauntlets rather difficult to see at present, some tortie colour to sides, tail fanning out and showing shades of brown and reds. Body has good bone, long with strong medium limbs and short rounded paws – very promising youngster.

AC SILVER BENGAL ASSESSMENT – ADULT

1ST BOB AND MERIT TO MORELANDS CH. KIABINDHI ICED SKYE – BEN ns 24 33 (8.5.13) Mature balanced lady with super eyes, bright and a lovely deep blue, nearly round in shape. Broad wedge shaped head, rounded high cheeks, gentle curve to nose, her ears wide based, she was so interested in what was going on that she held them quite high, but relaxed once in her pen. Dense glossy soft coat showing good black markings on a silvery ground, scarab to head, spectacles round her eyes, rings and spots. Body has spots and rosettes, strong limbs ringed and spotted, her rounded paws spotted, all balanced off with a medium ringed tail, slightly tapered and dark at tip – she was a happy alert lass.

AV. SEMI-LH BREEDERS ADULT -MALE

1ST. STAVELETS CH. BELKATRON KOSTYA – Massive Brown Tabby & White Siberian boy, mature strong head, lovely thick coat, strong bones and good substance.

2nd. LYNCH CH. MAGISRAGIS PIGGY MALONE – Striking Seal Bi-colour Ragdoll lad, super deep blue eye colour, good textured coat, pristine white to facial V and limbs.

3rd. HAWORTHS UK IMP. GR. CH. DIZZIPAWS BRUCE – Grand Seal Colourpointed Ragdoll gentleman nearly 10 years old and still in lovely condition.

AV SEMI-LH BREEDERS ADULT – FEMALE

1ST. HOPES GR. CH. REDSKY MARTHA MUFFIN – Seal Tabby Birman girl with really lovely deep blue eyes, and good clear tabby markings.

2nd. MLYNEK & HAYWARDS MLYWARD HEITEKI – Another lovely Birman lass, Seal with a pale soft well groomed coat, well developed seal mask and points, nearly round eyes of a sound blue.

3rd. CASEYS SPIRITZ GLITTER N'TRASH – Attractive Tortie Smoke and White Maine Coon, her coat showing good silvery contrasts and warm tortie colours, high wide based ears, firm chin.

A.V. SEMI-LH BREEDERS – NEUTER

1ST. YOUNGS THEODORIAN BARNABAS – Big Black Smoke and White Ragamuffin, super coat for texture, solid well made boy, strong limbs, mature head width to cheeks.

2ND KEEPINGS GR. CH. & GR. PR. BAYGAZER KHALESİ – Attractive Blue Birman lady, balanced and solid, good blue eyes, nicely set ears, soft well groomed coat.

3rd. WATKINS KRYSTALTOZE GIACOMO - Grand Red Birman boy, mature and well developed, good eye shape and colour, rich red to ears and mask.

A.C. BIRMAN – NEUTER

1ST. BROWNS GR. CH. DALTEEMA DIAMANTE DOLLY – Attractive Cream Point lady, lovely blue eyes, warm cream to mask, ears and points. Solid and balanced.

2nd. KEEPINGS GR. CH. & GR.PR. BAYGAZER KHALESİ

3RD. SPARKES SARMOYAH MOONBREAM - Cream Point young boy with lovely deep blue eyes, warm cream to mask and ears, soft coat.

x3rd.KAYS KLAWNIQUE RELIGHT MY-FIRE – Seal lady with good bone and substance.

1ST. BRADBURNS SUNSHIMMER REMINISCENCE – Blue-eyed Snow Bengal girl wearing a lovely well marked coat, soft blue eyes. Length and substance to body.

2nd. WHITMORES SUNSHIMMER VELA FLEUR LILIUM – Another nice Bengal girl, Brown Spotted with excellent markings on a warm golden ground.

AV. FOREIGN VISITORS – ADULT

1ST. PHILLIPS GR. CH. MELKELTER FORENCITONA – Russian Blue lady, lovely balance, soft even pale blue coat, bright eyes.

2nd. GOODGERS CH. JAYUZAR RUMOUR HAS IT – Blue-eyed Snow Bengal girl, excellent coat texture and markings, mid blue eyes.

3rd. DODDS GR. CH. POOSI EBONY NILO – Black Devon Rex lad wearing a sound black coat of a lovely texture.

A.V FOREIGN DEBUTANTE – KITTEN

1ST. QUINNS BUNDARA CRUSE – Brown Spotted Bengal youngster his coat showing excellent distinct marking on a warm ground.

2nd. ALMONDS PEDDADORA OLIVE – Lively chocolate Tortie Devon Rex girl, good coat, strong head for age, lovely to handle.

3rd. WATKINS MOWGRAINE TICKETY BOO – Snow Bengal lad, bright and alert, well marked coat.
