My thanks to Ms C Titterington and the committee of the Lancashire Cat Club for their invitation to judge at their show this year. Always one of my favourite shows and good to see a nice entry and hall full of people, cats and stalls which made for a lovely day. My thanks to my good friend Tina Mullineaux for her assistance as my steward. As usual Tina handled the cats with care and consideration and kept me on track throughout the day.

CLASS 497 – Blue Point Siamese Adult

1CC BOB – 303 Gramm’s Adiftam Molly Skylar (SIA a) F 25/3/15 – Blue girl of good type. Head has just enough width and her large ears are just in line with her pinched wedge. Profile is straight and she has a firm chin with a level bite. Slender neck, long body, fine legs and neat oval feet. Her tail is long and tapered. Points are an almost matching slightly dark blue with the legs being slightly paler. Body is glacial white but shows extensive shading but still shows very clear contrast to her points. Paw pads are brownish purple which made me question her as a blue, but with no other evidence of her being a blue based caramel I accepted her as a blue today. Short coat, lies close to body and is fine in texture. Temperament and presentation both excellent.

CLASS 498 – Chocolate Point Siamese Adult

BOB – 304 Brock’s UK Imp Gr Ch Kevels Twice As Nice (SIA b) M 18/4/10 – Very good type to this mature chocolate boy. He has a broad head with large ears that are set in line with his even wedge. Small dip to profile at the brow, the rest of his profile is straight. He has a firm chin and a level bite with some incisors now missing. Bright blue eye colour with the shape and set both being oriental. He has a long neck and body, tall legs and neat oval feet. Tail is long and tapered. Feeling less substantial since our last meeting. Almost matching paler shade of chocolate, showing brindling to mask, legs a paler shade of chocolate to rest of points. Ivory body colour which is free from shading. Short coat that lies close to the body and is fine in texture. Excellent temperament and presentation.

CLASS 501 – Lilac Point Siamese Adult

1CC BOB – 305 Smeaton’s Torbarniks Silver-Shadow (SIA c) M 1/4/15 – Lilac boy of good type. Head shows good width between large ears that are set in line with his slightly pinched wedge. Slight depression above the brow to his otherwise straight profile. His chin is firm and he has a level bite. Oriental eye shape and set with the colour being a clear blue of good depth. Long neck, muscular body, tall legs and neat oval feet. His tail is tapered and of balancing length. Grey points colour with no evidence of the desire pinkish hue. Body is magnolia with some slight tonal shading. Short coat that lies close to the body and is fine in texture. Temperament and presentation both excellent.

Miscellaneous Classes

CLASS 747 – AC Oriental Adult

1st – 287 Keoghan’s Gr Ch Alderstar Harajuku Girl (OSH hs) F 15/2/14 – Very good type to this chocolate smoke girl. She has a broad head with large ears that are set in line with her even wedge. Almost straight profile with just a very small depression above the brow and a small nose bump. She has good depth to her chin and a scissor bite. Mid green eye colour and oriental shape and set. Her neck is long and slender and she has a long muscular body, tall legs and neat oval feet. Her tail is long and tapered. She has a cool toned chocolate that is broken with pale red tortie mingling. Near white undercoat extending half the length of the hair shaft. Short coat that lies close to the body and is fine in texture. Temperament and presentation both excellent.

2nd - 288 Devlin’s Ch Athelstan’s Heavenscent (OSH ns 03) F 27/4/14 – Attractive black silver bicolour girl of good type. She has reasonably good width between her large ears that are set in line with her even wedge. Straight profile with a firm chin and a level bite. Oriental eye shape and set with the colour being a pleasing deep shade of green. Nice big girl with long neck and body, tall legs and neat oval feet. Her tail is long and tapered. Ticked pattern with silver undercoat. Some

tarnishing to back. Inverted V to face with just a small splash of colour to nose. Chest is white and travels down underneath her front legs down to her abdomen in an unbroken thick white line. Complete collar of white that travel up from her front legs over the back of her neck. Back legs are virtually all white. A small patch of white on her back near the base of her tail. Combined this girl has forty percent white. Short coat that lies close to the body and is fine in texture. Presented well though not the most confident girls.

CLASS 761 – AC Oriental Breeders Kitten

1st – 296 Devlin’s Baroushka Bi-Design (OSH ns 03) M 22/7/15 – Good type to this high white black silver bicour boy. Broad head with large ears set in line with his even wedge. He has a straight profile and a chin that ideally could show more depth, his bite is level. Oriental eye shape and set with the colour being pale green. Long neck and slender body, very fine legs and neat oval feet. He has a tapered long tail. Where visible this boy has a ticked pattern to the surface of the coat with the lower half of the hair shaft being silver. This boy has extensive white easily reaching the breed standard requirement of over a third, he is in fact eighty percent white. He has two patches of colour to his head and two patches of colour to either side of his body, his tail shows colour and otherwise the rest of this boy is entirely white. Short coat that lies close to the body and is fine in texture. Excellent temperament and condition.

2nd- 295 Keoghan’s Alderstar Orions Belt (OSH bs) F 16/10/15 – Very attractive type to this chocolate smoke girl. Excellent width to head with large wide based ears set in line with her even wedge. Profile almost straight with just a slight dip below the brow, her chin shows good depth and her bite is level. Oriental eye shape and set with the colour being olive green. Well grown sturdy kitten with long neck, medium length muscular body, fine legs and neat oval feet. Tail is long and tapered. Coat colour is a cold chocolate. This girl has too much silver with three quarters silver to the base of the hair. Silver popping through around the neck, face and throat and unfortunately also showing the appearance of clear tabby markings to face and with spots to sides. Coat is short, close lying and is fine in texture. Excellent temperament and condition.

CLASS 762 – AC Oriental Kitten not bred by Exhibitor

1st – 294 Masters’ Amulet Esen Happy Jungle (OSH n 22) M 30/6/15 – Well grown brown classic boy of excellent type. He has a broad head with large ears that are set in line with his even wedge. Profile is straight and he has a firm chin with a level bite. Oriental eye shape and set with the colour being an attractive deep green. He has a long neck and body that is well toned, tall legs and neat oval feet. Tail is long and tapered. Neck shows three unbroken necklaces, Clear M to forehead, he has a well-defined butterfly to shoulders, three clearly separated lines running down the back from the butterfly to the tail. Both flanks show an oyster that is surrounded by one unbroken ring. Tabby markings are jet black and sound to the root, ground colour is a warm coppery brown. Presentation and temperament both excellent. Quality boy possessing excellent type, colour and pattern.

2nd- 293 McCormack’s Alderstar Supernova (OSH k) F 16/10/15 – Very stylish lilac based caramel tortie. Very broad head with large ears that are set in line with her slightly pinched wedge. Profile is straight and she has a firm chin with a level bite. Oriental eye shape and set with the colour being a clear bright vivid green. Well grown kitten with a long slender neck, medium length body, fine legs and neat oval feet. Her tail is long and tapered. Coat colour is a developing warm brownish grey and is sound to the root. Apricot tortie mingling to head, body, tail and all four legs. Coat is short, close lying and fine in texture. Temperament and presentation both excellent.

3rd – 290 – Ball’s Alderstar Andromeda (OSH c) F 16/10/15 - Very good type to this young lilac girl. Broad head with large ears that are set in line with her even wedge. Slight depression above the brow to her otherwise straight profile. She has a firm chin and a tidy bite. Oriental eye shape and set with the colour being clear, bright vivid green. Well grown girl with slender neck, lithe body, fine legs and neat oval feet. Her tail is long and tapers. Coat is a frosty grey sound to the root but in the available light it was difficult to see any pinkish tone. Coat is short, close lying and fine in texture.

Rather feisty girl which I put down to nerves, a few grumbles but no real malice. Presentation excellent. Very attractive girl just needs to settle down and relax at her next show.

4th - 291 Bauerfeind's Snowseal Starrgayzer (SIA w 67) M 8/7/15 – Foreign white boy of good type. Broad head with large ears that are set in line with his pinched wedge. Profile shows a slight dip below the brow and he also has a small nose bump. He has a firm chin and a level bite. Oriental eyes shape and set with the colour being a brilliant blue of acceptable depth. Slender boy with a long neck, lithe body, tall legs and neat oval feet. His tail is long and tapered and needs half an inch for balance. Coat is white but in the available leisure centre lighting showed a yellow overtone. Temperament excellent.

5th – 297 Bransby's Sensay Angelina Ballerina (OSH n 03 33) F 25/6/15 – Seal bicour girl. Head needs more width between her large ears that are set almost in line with her even wedge. Profile is almost straight and she has a firm chin and level bite. Oriental eye shape and set with the colour being a clear bright blue. Long neck and slender body with tall legs and neat oval feet. Her tail is long and tapered. Points colour is a matching dense seal brown. Body is cream and show some tonal shading. Small amount of white to mask, bottom of all four feet and a white chest that travels down under her front legs in a thin white down to her abdomen. In total this girl has no more than fifteen percent white and does not meet the requirement set out in the breed standard. Coat is short, close lying and fine in texture. Temperament and presentation both excellent.

CLASS 782 – AC Junior Neuter

1st – 298 Masters' Gr Pr Enigmatic Tangerine Dream (OSH d) MN 21/8/14 – Very good type to this red boy. Broad head with large ears that are set in line with his pinched wedge. Straight profile with firm chin and a level bite which is untidy. Olive green eye colour with the shape and set both being oriental. Well grown boy with a long neck, muscular body of good length, fine legs and neat oval feet. He has a tapered tail of balancing length. Rich warm red coat which is sound to the root, underlying spotted tabby pattern evident to body. Coat is short, fine in texture and lies close to the body. Temperament and presentation both excellent. Lovely boy.

CLASS 794 – AC Siamese/Balinese Adult

1st – 305 Smeaton's Torbarniks Silver-Shadow (SIA c) M 1/4/15 – see class 501

CLASS 826 – AC Siamese/Balinese Junior Neuter

1st – 314 Cook's Styperson Dreamboat (SIA b 21) MN 1/8/14 – Gorgeous type to this chocolate tabby boy. Very broad head with large ears that are set in line with his even wedge. Straight profile with a firm chin missing all incisors. Oriental eye shape and set with the colour being brilliant blue and of excellent depth. Large fine boned boy with a long neck and body, tall legs and neat oval feet. His tail is long and tapered. Clearly defined chocolate tabby markings with M to forehead, cheek ribbons, thumb prints to ears and bracelets to legs. Tail shows rings to half the length. Body is ivory in colour and shows some tonal shading. His coat is fine in texture, lies close to the body and is short. Flashy boy.

2nd – 316 Ryan's Ridestar Clawdius-Maximus (BAL d 21) MN d 21) MN 13/8/14 – Red tabby boy of good type. Broad head with large ears that are set in line with his pinched wedge. Slight depression above the brow and otherwise straight profile. He has a firm chin and level bite. His eye shape and set are both oriental with the colour being a brilliant blue that could show more depth. He has a long neck, muscular body, tall legs and large oval feet. His tail is long and tapered. He has clear bright reddish gold tabby points that ideally could show a richer tone. Clear M to forehead, cheek ribbons, thumb prints to ears, paler tones bracelets to legs and a well ringed tail. Some tonal shading to his warm white body. Coat is medium long and fine and silky in texture lying flat along the body. Tail shows good plumage and his feet are tufted. Super temperament and excellent presentation.

3rd – 315 Glaubitz's Gr Pr Loluja Dressedinlace (SIA m 21) FN 30/11/14 – Lilac based caramel tabby girl of good type. Head shows good width and she has large ears that are set in line with her even wedge. She has a straight profile and a firm chin with a level bite. Brilliant blue eye colour with fairly good depth. The eye shape and set are both oriental, today her eyes were red rimmed and looked rather deep set and sore. Long neck and body, fine legs and neat oval feet. Her tail is long and tapered. She has brownish grey tabby markings with some tonal shading to her off white body. Short coat which is fine in texture and lies close to the body. Temperament good today and easy to handle.

CLASS 827 – AC Siamese/Balinese Senior Neuter

1st – 317 Ryan's Gr Pr Ridestar Severn Sunrise (BAL d 21) MN 13/8/14 – Big red tabby boy of good type and colour. Broad head with large ears that are set in line with his pinched wedge. Slight depression above the brow and a very small nose bump. Firm chin and bite scissored over. Oriental eye shape and set that he does hold rather full when out of the pen, left to settle in the comfort of his pen they do settle down to a more pleasing shape. His eye colour is a brilliant blue of good depth. A huge boy with a long neck, firm muscular body, tall legs and large oval feet. His tail is tapered and needs an inch for balance. Attractive clear rich bright reddish gold colour to his tabby points with M to forehead, single cheek ribbons, bracelets to legs and his tail being well ringed. His body is a warm white colour showing extensive tonal shading but still showing clear contrast to his tabby markings. His coat is medium long, fine and silky in texture and lies flat along the body. He has a well plumed tail, ear furnishings and his feet are tufted. Slightly shy but a very friendly boy and easy enough to handle. Presentation first class.

CLASS 829 – AC Siamese/Balinese Visitors Neuter

1st – 316 Ryan's Ridestar Clawdius-Maximus (BAL d 21) MN d 21) MN 13/8/14 – see class 826

2nd – 313 Cook's Styperson Summer Song (SIA m) MN 1/8/14 – Lilac based caramel boy of good type. Broad head with large ears set in line with his even wedge. Profile is straight and he has a firm chin with a messy bit which appeared level. Oriental eye shape and set with the colour being brilliant blue of good depth. Eyes rather sore today with some gunk in the corners and red rimmed. Long neck, slender body, fine legs and neat oval feet. Tail is long and tapered. Points are almost matching brownish grey with the legs being slightly paler. Body is off white and shows some tonal shading. Coat is short, close lying and is fine in texture.

3rd – 315 Glaubitz's Gr Pr Loluja Dressedinlace (SIA m 21) FN 30/11/14 – see class 826
