OLYMPIAN CLASS for AV IMPERIAL GRAND PREMIER.

OLY. GR PC to CHANDLER'S UK & OBIGP KOLINGA BLUEBELLA. FN. (BRI g (28)) 7 yrs 8 mths. Handsome lady who knows her own value, with a broad rounded head, neat ears spaced widely, blending into the head's contours, large rounded almond shaped, gold toned eyes with a withering expression to them. Face rounded with full cheeks, whisker pads pouting daintily. Clear profile break from a curving forehead, straight short muzzle, strong, well aligned, rounded chin, incisors absent now. Strong, thick neck, sturdy cobby body with short limbs of substance and matching tapered tail of mid length.

Lovely crisp blue coat with well distributed breaks. Bestows her favours sparingly **2. RES OLY Withheld. CATTERICK'S CH & UK I GR PR GATTINI LA LUNA. FN. (BUR a (27a))** 5 yrs 4 mths. Pretty lady with quite a well conformed head, could be a little broader at the cheekbones for preference, fairly blunt muzzle, large slightly prominent eyes giving a surprised look, eau de nil shade in the hall light, ears spaced widely, broad based and tapering, flared on the skull. Neat profile break, straight muzzle of depth, chin aligned, rounded in outline, bite level. Lengthy body, quite heavy, just a little substantial compared with the neat head, slender limbs, dainty paws, tapering tail balances. Coat a little long, needing to lie sleeker for preference, mid blue shade, sound with a hint of ghost barring. Also considered. **KIDD'S GR CH & I GR PR.**

MAKEWAYFOR KRESTAAMELIA. FN. (BRI ns 24 (30s)). 9 yrs 4 mths. Senior lady with a rounded head, neat spaced ears, eyes of mid size, pale gold tone, face heart shaped, cheeks might be a little broader for preference. Profile shows a clear, if slightly shallow break, good depth of muzzle, firm chin, lower incisors marginally forward. Body powerful and firm rather than cobby, limbs and tail match; head needs a touch more mass to balance body. Coat on body longer than the winners, rather less crisp, darkly tabbied over a silver background that

could be brighter; good facial tracings, body spotting and tail rings, spine line just broken. Lovely grave temperament.

IMPERIAL CLASS. AC SIAMESE/BALINESE GR PR MALE.

IMP GR PC to WROE'S CH & GR PR COSITA BRUNO TONIOLI. MN. (SIA a 21 (32 2)). 1 yr 6 mths. Very vocal youth, auditioning for a place in 'The Voice'. Strongest and best proportioned head in the class, wedge even sided with very good breadth at the top, between large ears showing good flare. Deep blue oriental eyes, well inclined. Strong arched profile, very good strong deep muzzle, level chin and bite. Body medium sized, lithe and firm, limbs and tail proportionate. Tabby facials in a dull mid blue, eyes outlined in the contrasting background shade, bracelets and tail ringing, some blue shading on body, sufficient contrast. **RES IMP GR PC. To RYAN'S GR PR RIDESTAR SEVERN**

SUNRISE. MN. (BAL d 21 (61dt)) 2 yrs 8 mths. Large strong gentleman in magnificent coat. Lengthy wedge indented beneath the cheekbones, ears set in line, inclined eyes with depth to the blue. Profile shows a gentle dip with a tiny rise over the nose, chin slopes a bit, bite level. Body very lengthy and substantial, balanced limbs and tail. Coat has length, excellent texture and flow, wonderfully developed ruff, and furnished tail. Soft red coat, with facial tabbing, tail just showing ringing and faint limb bracelets. Also considered. **ELLIS'S GR PR STYPERSON CRACKERJACK. MN. (SIA m 21 (32 8))** 2 yrs 6 mths. Elegant gentleman with a long, slightly narrow, straight sided head, oriental eyes with depth of blue, set rather deep and straight, making them look marginally small, ears of good size, following the facial lines. Excellent straight profile, would like a little more depth of muzzle, chin slopes a little, bite level. Wonderful lengthy body with limbs and tail to match. Close coat, showing very beautiful soft lilac based caramel tabby points, super tail rings, bracelets just hinted at, very lovely pale body for super contrast.

IMPERIAL CLASS AC SIAMESE/BALINESE GR PR FEMALE.

IMP GR PC to JACKSON'S CH & GR PR ADZWOAM KINKY BOOTS. FN. (SIA m (24n)) 3 yrs 5 mths. Elegant dark lady whom I believe I have met at each level of her career. Since last time her head has gained breadth to balance its length and now shows a super even triangle with attractive breadth at its top between large ears showing modish flare. Inclined orientally shaped eyes of good blue; she tended to hold them rather closed, adding an air of mystery. Profile almost straight, just a tiny dent at the bridge, curving chin of depth, level bite. Body of mid size, sleek and elegant, balancing limbs and tail. Coat of

excellent short sleek qualities, dark, blue based caramel points with similar body shading now, but sufficient contrast.

SORREL SOMALI KITTEN.

1 BoB. TIPTON'S MI-ALMA THELMA LOUISE. F. (SOL o) (63La)) 7 mths 2 wks. Slender little lady with a surprised look. Head a moderate wedge, indents below the cheek bones linking gently to the still developing muzzle, ears held cupped and alertly upright, might be a little more spaced ideally. Eyes of almond shape, showing gentle oblique set, pale outlining beyond the dark surrounds, inner and outer pencillings in place. Profile could show a more defined rise from muzzle to brow, muzzle itself shows commendable depth with aligned chin and even bite. Lithe body, limbs to match, tail needs an inch. Coat has length and flow, texture still slightly dry, ticking evident over shoulder areas, minimal elsewhere meantime, so overall impression mainly that of the apricot base at the moment, apart from slightly darker spine line, tail tip and hocks that are virtually complete.

ORIENTAL CREAM OR APRICOT ADULT.

BoB. KEOGHAN'S I GR CH ALDERSTAR ANDRO. M. (OSH em (37h)) 2 yrs 3 wks. What a pleasure to meet this chap again. Very strong and exceedingly handsome yet without any exaggeration, he has the additional attribute of a wonderful show temperament. Head is a beautiful even equilateral with masculine strength to it, inclined almond shaped eyes of clear pale green, ears large and held in lovely alignment. Strong straight profile, chin might be just a little firmer for preference, irregular incisors meet. Body lengthy and firmly muscular, limbs and tail matching. Coat just marginally thick; beautifully even, typical dull apricot shade with commendably little barring.

FOREIGN WHITE KITTEN.

1. BoB. BAUERFEIND'S MICHANT MUSTAPHA. F. (SIA w 67 (35)) 5 mths 4 wks. Dear little girl with an even triangular head, sporting large ears held just slightly high, showing good spacing. Inclined oval eyes of good blue shade. Profile fairly straight, chin and bite level. Dainty body, matching limbs and tail. Coat slightly long, good clear white, chewed a little over the shoulders

ORIENTAL BLUE KITTEN.

1. BoB. LLOYD'S SEIDO SEAMAIDEN. F. (OSH a (37a)) 8 mths 2 wks. Dainty babe, good even wedge with breadth between the ears that are set well in

line, showing flare. Excellent green oriental eyes already, arching profile, deep strong muzzle, firm chin, level bite. Sturdy little body, limbs to match, balancing slightly bony tail. Coat slightly long, darkish blue shade, fairly even; paw pads slightly purplish in tone.

ORIENTAL BLACK NEUTER.

1 PC. BoB. ENIGMATIC HE'S SOVAIN. MN. (OSH n (37)) 11 mths 2 dys. Very elegant, slightly rude lad, perhaps living up to his name? Good triangular head, very slight pinch evident, oriental eyes of clear lime green, spaced ears flaring widely. Profile straight, good muzzle depth, bite meets. Lengthy slender body with limbs and tail matching, very streamlined. Excellent typical, close, gleaming, sound black coat.

BLUE POINT SIAMESE ADULT.

1 CC BoB. RATHEBONE'S TRABREN ISHIBEE HAMISH. M. (SIA a (24a)) 4 yrs 10 mths. Adorable lad, looking just a bit of a bruiser. Nice head, even lines, good blue shade to his oriental eyes, ears of balanced size, set in line. Profile virtually straight, firm chin, incisors gone apart from two large ones symmetrically placed just medial to each the lower canines; bite looks to have met. Large strong body with matching limbs and tail. Coat slightly open and presented just a little informally, looking out doorsy; something had been happening to the shoulder areas (? Too much grooming?), mid blue points, shaded body. Most engaging and pleasing temperament.

RED POINT SIAMESE NEUTER.

1. PC. BoB. CHANDLER'S JOHPAS PETITS BISOUS. MN. (SIA d (32a)) 9 mths 4 wks. Very handsome lad, beautiful even wedge head, super breadth at its top between excellent large ears showing becoming flare. Lovely oriental eyes, blue might be a little deeper for preference. Good straight profile, chin curves a little, level bite. Balanced body, limbs and tail. Attractive pale red points with excellent warm white body contrast.

AV SLH ADULT.

1. HACK'S UK & OBIGC SUPATOFT SONYA. F. (SOL n (63L)) 4 yrs 11 mths Usual Somali. Such a charmer; aloof and just a hint snooty to start with as usual, in no time at all she was flirting quite outrageously with her public; totally irresistible. Excellent head type, moderate wedge, super broad muzzle connected by gentle contours to the wide cheek bones, oval oblique set eyes

showing inner and outer pencillings, wickedly seductive expression, smile just slightly lascivious. Ears large, wide set, broad at their bases and held up, cupped and furnished. Profile rises from a straight muzzle to the brow line, chin curves a little, bite level. Mature body, firm musculature, balanced limbs and tail. Coat a little less splendid than when last seen, marginally less dense here and there at present and ruff slightly less full than then, though retains good tail furnishing. Rich apricot undercoat shade and ticking intact, black spine, tail tip and hocks. **2. BURGESS'S CH COONARIA CHICAGO. M. (MCO n 03 22 (64 41w))** 1 yrs 2 mths. Lovely large brown tabby and white Maine Coon gentleman. Huge head, well proportioned length to breadth, broad spacing between large ears, tapering and tufted, held a little flared with the tufts toppling. Large eyes with a solemn expression. Muzzle boning square, though soft tissues look a little rounded. Profile shows a clear curve from the brow to a tiny bump over the muzzle that has good depth, chin well aligned, level bite. Huge rectangular body, powerful limbs and tail of length. Striking brown tabby and white coat of good texture and length, ruff and breeches; back somewhat solid. **3. POOL'S I GR CH SARMOYAH PRINCESS AURORA. F. (SBI f (13c6))** 2 yrs 10 mths. Attractive Tortie Birman. **X3 BURNS' I GR CH SOMANTIKKS FURRERO ROCHER. M. (SOL b (63Lb))** 3yrs 11 mths. Chocolate Somali. .

AV SLH ADULT.

1. GRANT'S CH NOYNAROCK OUNA. F. (NFO n 03 21 (67 31t)) 1 yr 5 mths. Brown Tabby and White Norwegian, looking splendid. Very lovely, correct triangular head, with inclined oval eyes, pale green and calmly expressive. Ears set in good alignment, dead straight profile, chin curves away a little, bite level. Super firm body of mid size, tall on hind limbs with feathered paws and lengthy tail fully furnished. Coat shows excellent double texture with ruff and knickerbockers in place, attractive bright white to contrast with the brown tabby. **2. HAWORTH'S UK I GR CH DIZZIPAWS ZEMO. M. (RAG a 04)** 6 yrs 10 mths. This Blue Mitted Ragdoll boy has lots of presence. Substantial lad with a broad head, almost flat top between ears of mid size, attractively set, just tilting, rounded tips, large spaced eyes of good mid blue, just oblique. Profile curve brow to neat muzzle could be a little more strongly defined, chin curves a little but has depth, bite level. Body large and strong, powerful limb boning and matching length of tail. Excellent soft coat texture, full ruff and knickerbockers, tail could be a little more profuse, good blue points, excellent clear cool icy body for contrast, neat mittens, correct white on rear limbs to the hocks, (little blue blush above left hock) undercarriage white correct. **3.**

JAMIESON'S I GR CH HAVENHOUSE ELISE. F. (RAG a 21 (66at)) 3 yrs 9 mths. Very pretty little Blue Tabby Colourpointed Ragdoll girl. **X3 HUGHES CH FAVORIT DUMNY KOT*PL. M. (NFO ns 09 21 (67 31ts))** 2 yrs 10mths. Silver Tabby and White.

AV SLH VISITORS ADULT.

1. COONEY'S CH HARRY SOM DE KISMAYOU. M. (SOL n (63L)). 2 yrs 7 mths. Adorable Usual Somali youth, superbly high spirited, turning summersaults with excitement and couldn't wait to burst from his pen and take over the world. Looks and behaves younger than he actually is. Good moderate wedge head with well shaped muzzle that could be just a little broader, nicely conjoined by gentle contours to the cheek bones, eager and beaming expression . Ears medium large, held up well, tufted and cupped, oval just inclined eyes, pencilled and brightly expressive. Profile shows a defined curve brow to the nose, muzzle has depth, level chin and bite. Slender, firm body with balanced limbs and length of tail. Striking rich coppery brown appearing coat at present, clear black ticking over shoulders and spine line, dark tail tip and hocks, junior ruff and breeches. Such a lad. **2 BURNS' GR CH**

SOMANTIKKSJAZZMYN. F. (SOL a (63Lc)) 2 yrs 10 mths Very pretty blue Somali. Head has good shape with breadth of muzzle that needs just a little better defined by indents from under the cheek bones. Ears of good size, held upright and cupped showing furnishings. Lime green eyes of good shape and oblique incline. Profile shows a shallow curve brow to muzzle, chin aligned, lower incisors marginally forward. Lovely blue ticked coat of good texture, soft and flowing, with ruff and breeches in evidence and flowing tail, enhanced by the warm oatmeal of the background, making a very pleasing picture. A little grumbly in spite of a beatific expression. **3. MOTT'S CH JANDOUGLAN**

SAMBRADH. F. (SBI g (13c8)) 1 yr 10mths. Blue Tortie Birman.. **X3 PORTSMOUTH'S CASIENMOON SLY STALLONELY. (64 41)** 2 yrs 6 mths .Brown Tabby Maine Coon.

AV SLH VISITORS ADULT.

1. CANNELL'S I GR CH SPIRRITZ TARTAN TREMBLER. F. (MCO f 03 (64 22)) 2yrs Maine Coon. Wonderful lady with a balanced head length to breadth, well squared muzzle outline, tapering ears of size well set, eyes of good size, oblique in incline, greenish in tone. Profile curves correctly brow to nose, muzzle has depth, chin lines up, bite level. Award winning whiskers. Strong substantial rectangular body, balanced limbs and tail. Superb coat with

excellent ruff and breeches, super tail furnishing, excellent brown tortie and white. **2. GRANT'S NOYNAROCK JOELENE. F. (NFO ns 09 21 (67 31ts))** 10 mths 1 wk, Very smart Norwegian child, lovely triangular head, furnished ears set up well, eyes good for shape and incline, excellent straight profile, muzzle has fair depth, chin curves, bite just meets. Strong body of length, limbs of correct relative lengths, super long tail. Lovely double smooth textured silver tabby and white coat. **3. CH DIZZYPAWS MISS MAISY. F. (RAG a 03 (66 31a))** 1 yr 6 mths. Pretty Blue Bicoloured. **X3. ELMS' NOYNAROCK TALUA BELLE. F. (NFO g 09 (67 22a))** 1yr 7 mths Blue Tortie and white Norwegian.

AV SLH NEUTER MALE. What a Class !!!

1. BREWOOD'S I GR PR NOYNAROCK LARS-MORGAN. MN. (NFO n 09 21 (67 31t)) 4 yrs 10 mths. That superb individual on whom I have sung the superlatives on many occasions in the recent past. Nothing to add really; he looks handsome as ever and has a wonderful, masculine presence. **2. OSBORN'S UK & I GR PR LINGCOMB ENDYMION. (SBI n (13c1))** 13 yrs 9 mths. I have also reported extensively on this wonderful fellow who continues to wear his years very lightly; he glows becomingly both in and out of his pen and deserves the highest honours. **X2 BURGESS'S UK & OGI GR .PR KASSARO CISCOKID. AV SLH NEUTER FEMALE.

1. HORTON'S PR APPLAUSE COTTONKANDI. FN (RAG g 03 (66 31g)) 3 yrs 11 mths. Very attractive blue tortie bicolor ragdoll. Correct head, flat between round tipped ears set well apart and showing tilt, spaced eyes, large in size, just oblique, good blue. Good cheek development, rounded muzzle. Profile shows a gentle dip to the mid length muzzle, level chin and bite. Short strong neck, with a lengthy but substantial body, mid length strong limbs, round paws, tail balancing. Coat of mid length, silky yet with density. Good blue mask, correct white V, fore, hind limbs and underparts. Nice. **2. ARCHER'S FILENSIO PANDORA CHARM. FN (RGM ns 03 21 32 (60 27tswx))** 2 yrs 3 mths. Silver Tabby and White Ragamuffin, Tonkinese Colour Restriction. Lovely feminine girl. Good boning to the broad head, medium length to it, developed rounded cheeks, full whisker pads to give that soft expression. Large spaced eyes with the desired walnut shape and benign look. Neat spaced ears, tilting slightly

and rounded in outline. Profile shows a nose break, straight muzzle, firmly aligned chin and level bite. Strong body, thick limbs, tail of balanced length. Coat has excellent soft dense texture with resilience to it, featuring ruff and knickerbockers and well furnished tail, attractive Silver Tabby and White pattern. **3. QUINNEY'S GR PR TUMBLERAG TOP N TAIL. FN. (RAG a 04 21 (66atw))** 3 yrs 5 mths. .

AC ORIENTAL LIMIT ADULT

1. BRANSBY'S HEMLOCK NAMAQUA DAISY. F. (OSH n 24 (38)) 10 mths 1 dy. Comely lady of good type, excellent ears for set and flare, oriental eyes of green. Balanced body limbs and tail. Close coat shows spotted patterning on the flanks, broken spine line, all overlaid by quite prominent ticking.

AC ORIENTAL JUNIOR DULT.

1. LLOYD'S SEIDOO SKYFALL. F (OSH n (37)) 1 yr 11 mths. **2. ELLIOTT'S SERAPIS ALLTHATIAM. F. (OSH a 24 (38a)).**10 mths 2 wks Sound type, blue spotted pattern clear, colour almost to the roots, less ticking than **3. BRANSBY'S HEMLOCK NAMAQUA DAISY (OSH n 24 (38)).** 10 mths 1 dy.

ORIENTAL MAIDEN KITTEN.

1. DEBOWSKA'S JUANNRE JUST-JADORE F. (OSH c (29c)) 3 mths 3 wks. Attractive girl of sound type with excellent green oriental eyes, ears set in line, clear green oriental eyes. Profile shows a tiny forehead depression, shallow and should resolve with maturity. Graceful little body, balancing limbs and tail. Lovely close, soft, sound lilac coat. **2. BROCK'S KEVELS DIRTY DANCER. F. (OSH m (37n))** 4 mths 1 dy. Pleasing oriental caramel lass, presently showing some tabby ghosting **3. MASTERS ENIGMATIC PANDORAS BOX. F. (OSH h (37h))** 5 mths 2 wks.

AC ORIENTAL JUNIOR NEUTER.

1. EDWARDS' HEMLOCK ALFREDO FERRARI. MN. (OSH b 24 (38b)) 1 yr 1 mth. Chocolate spotted lad of lovely oriental type overall and excellent spotted pattern including a clearly broken spine line, some ticking evident.

AC ORIENTAL ADULT

1. KEOGHAN'S I GR CH ALDERSTAR ANDRO. M. (OSH em (37fn)) 2 yrs 3 wks.
2. BROWNRIGG'S UK I GR CH HEMLOCK BOBBI DAZZLER. (OSH d (37d)) 3 yrs 6 mths. Oriental red, excellent type, rich red with prominent tabby patterning.

AC SIAMESE/BALINESE SENIOR ADULT.

1. BROCK'S UK & OB IGR CH KARAMUSHI TUTI FRUITY f. (SIA f (32b1)) 7 yrs 6 mths. Gorgeous as ever. Continues to sweep all before her. **2. PALMER'S GR CH DRESTOTHRIL DEBUSSIE. M. (SIA n (24))** 5 yrs 11 mths. Very handsome and appears to improve every time one meets him. Terrific fangs, level bite. Tending to become hooded but not quite there yet, little pale area in the seal behind right jaw angle. **X2 HELM'S CH VELVETENA FAWNTOCAPTIVATE. F. (SIA p (24r))** 4 yrs 6 mths. Very very pretty girl, typy wedge head, good eye colour, stunning clear body contrasting with fawn points that are a little cool and lack the rosiness described in the standard.
