A rather worried young man of overall good balance and an acceptable size and maturity for his age. Rounded top of head, well developed cheeks, level bite. good chin. Well set ears of reasonable size. Hazel eyes of good shape, set a size. Broad chest to cobby body that needs to fill out limbs and tail to balance. Short, dense coat of soft texture, moulting heavily good contrasts considering the between black markings and silver ground colour. Spine line broken, some linkage on flanks. Two necklets, one broken.

BSH BLACK SILVER TABBY - MALE

This was not an easy decision as both boys had a lot going for them.

Well balanced boy of good size for his tender age. Rounded top of head, cheeks filling out well, level bite, good chin. Well set ears still a little oversized. Green eyes of good shape, set and size. Broad chest to cobby body that needs to mature, limbs and tail to balance. Short, dense coat of silky texture still. lovely contrasts between black markings and silver ground, classic head markings good butterfly, spine lines, tail rings, fairly even ossicles, spotty mane, mild tarnishing on muzzle.

LEWIN'S - ALUMOR I AM SPARTACUS

A rather tense boy who was not too happy to be handled. Good size and balance to this mature boy, rounded top, reasonable cheek development, level bite, shallow chin, a little snipey on the muzzle. Neat, well set ears. Green eyes of good shape, set & size. Broad chest to muscular body that is a little heavy at present, limbs and tail to balance. Mouthing badly so not as dense as it could be, a little over length, crisp

texture, reasonable contrasts between black markings and lighter ground colour. 1 unbroken necklet, classic head markings, butterfly and spindlines, fairly even oysters, spotty fun.

Good size and balance for her age, well rounded head, chubby cheeks, level bite, good chin. Neat, well set ears.

Orange eyes of good shape, set and size. Broad chest, cobby body with good limbs and tail to balance. Short dense coat still rather soft but with a crisp tone developing in some areas. Very pleasing evenness to the distribution of the colours, pale cream, pale blue and clear white areas. Very friendly. My choice for Best BSH Adult.

Blue eyes of good shape, set and size. Good rectangular muzzle. Short coupled body but needs to fill out. Loose flowing coat showing random wiriness throughout.

Young gentleman who was a little overawed by it all but handled well. Size and balanced appropriate for his age. Rounded top to head of reasonable breadth, cheeks filling out, wet bite good chin, rectangular appearance to muzzle. Medium sized ears but a little high in set. Eyes of good shape set and size, when he could be persuaded to open them! Good body shape with hump to balance. Tail of good length has a suspicion of a tail defect. Coat of good length with random loose curls. As I did not want to pull his tail around I gave her the benefit of doubt today.

recedes a little. Eyes of good shape set
& size when relaxed. Large wide based
ears. Elegant neck to muscular body
with long limbs and tail to balance. Coat
covers and flows gently where sufficient
depth.

eyes. Elegant muscular body with
limbs and tail to balance. Med blue
coat that is a little harsh in texture
and lacking in density.

a little grumpy but handled well.
