ORIGINAL FOREIGN SH CH ADULT MALE

GrCC Johnson's CH KORESHKA RUDI SNAFFLEOVSKI, (RUS a (16a)), M. 26.10.2013.

Medium sized Russian youngster with good overall conformation. Body long with good muscle tone, legs in proportion with neat oval paws. The tail is in balance with the body. Head has a short wedge, acceptable whisker pads for his age, firm chin and a level bite. Profile shows a slight dip from nose to brow, his "angle" well developed and he has a flat forehead. Ears rather wide set and a fraction smaller than I would like at this age. Eyes of good shape and set, green with a hit of hazel in colour. Mid blue with a slight overall silvery sheen. Coat short and soft with fair density. Very grumpy today but did handle OK.

RUSSIAN BLUE ADULT FEMALE

BoB Oakley's, GR CH KREMLINKATZ KATYA KALIKOVA, (RUS a (16a)), F. 26.06.2013.

A very attractive Russian girl. Long, firm body with proportionate legs and feet limbs, balanced tapering tail. Head shows good Russian expression. With a short wedge, well developed whisker pads strong chin and a level bite. Large ears, of good shape and set. Appealing almond shaped eyes, two-tones of green in colour. Coat soft and fine with good density, overall silvery sheen. A little worried but handled well.

CC Garratt & Edwards's ADURTSH MISS MOONSHINE, (RUS a (16a)), F. 16.04.2014.

Very much a juvenile and hopefully passing through that rather gangley phase where things are developing at different rates. Body has good length but needs a little more muscle for balance. Long legs with neat oval paws. Tail in proportion to the body with a gentle taper. Head has a short wedge, slight curve to the brow, very slight bump on the nose. Well grown whisker pads, a firm chin and a level bite. Pleasing Russian expression, good eye shape and set clear green in colour. Large Ears of good shape and very well set coat mid blue with a well developed silver sheen, short and fine but a little resilient in texture and could be denser. Handled well out of the pen.

Johnson's CH KORESHKA RUDI SNAFFLEOVSKI

Male RUSSIAN BLUE KITTEN MALE

1st BoB Oakley's KREMLINKATZ OLIGARCH BEAR, (RUS a (16a)), M. 20.10.2014.

Young kitten of good size and conformation for the breed. Long firm body with matching long legs. Tail balances the body for length tapering to the tip. Head has a short wedge with well developed whisker pads, a good depth of chin and a level bite. Profile has a gentle slope to the brow, a well formed angle, top of head is flattening. Large ears well spaced but set at just a very slight angle. Baby round eyes a muddy green in colour. Coat short and fine with good density for his age. Silver sheen developing. Handled well out of the pen.

2nd Barber's KREMLINKATZ KOT LERMONT, (RUS a (16a)), M. 20.10.2014.

Litter brother to the winner, again of good size and overall conformation. Good length to the muscular body. Legs in proportion with neat oval paws. Tapering tail of good length but a little narrow at the base. Head has a short wedge whisker pads quite well grown, firm chin, baby teeth level but untidy at present. Good profile, angle not quite as well developed as his brother's. Top of head is flattening and he has large well set ears. Again muddy green, baby round eyes. Coat sort and fine with some density silvery sheen on paws and nose. Another well behaved lad.

RUSSIAN BLUE KITTEN FEMALE

1st Johnson's KORESHKA KARINA RAINA, (RUS a (16a)), F. 07.10.2014.

Well grown Russian girl. Balanced long body, commensurate long legs with neat oval paws, balanced tapering tail. Head shows a short wedge, good profile with a developing angle, firm chin and a level bite. Baby round eyes a muddy green colour. Large well set ears. Coat still very kittenish mid blue currently showing banding. Happy to come out and show herself off.

2nd Holdsworth's INNESKA MYSTIC BEAU-SAF, (RUS a (16a)), F. 19.06.2014.

Older Russian girl. Medium body with a firm feel, long strong legs. Tail balances for length but I would like it a little broader at the base. Head shows a short wedge, whisker pads beginning to develop. Rather shallow chin and a level bite. Profile shows a shallow curve, angle developing, top of head is flattening. Large vertically held ears eyes still rather round, green in colour. Short coat with developing density. Mid blue with a silver sheen beginning to develop on the face and legs. Handled well out of the pen.

USUAL ABYSSINIAN KITTEN

1st & BoB Lockwood's KHUPHERA ELIANA, (ABY n (23)), F. 24.07.2014.

Pleasing Usual Abyssinian girl. Medium body with good muscle tone matching legs with neat oval paws. Tail of good length to match the body but needs more width at the base. Head is a moderate wedge with flowing contours. Large well set ears, rounded almond shaped eyes well set, greeny-hazel in colour. Profile shows a slight nose break, chin falls away a little but the bite is level. Distinct facial markings free of bars or necklets. Some white on chin and lips. Very well ticked in black on a rich groundcoat. Solid spine line, some black on the hocks and solid tail tip. Coat short and fine but needs more resilience in texture. A little nervous at first but settled quickly and handled well

SORREL ABYSSINIAN KITTEN

1st & BoB Lincoln's LINCZOZO CLEMENTINE, (ABY o (23a)), F. 08.06.2014.

Beautiful Sorrel Abyssinian girl. Good size with a strong muscular feel. Matching legs with neat oval paws. Tapering tail with a broad base in proportion to the body. Head is a very good Abyssinian expression, a moderate wedge with gentle curves. Strong top of head. Large well set ears. Expressive, rounded almond eyes in an oriental set. Very good profile with a distinct nose break. Chin a little shallow with a level bite. Distinct facial markings, free of bars or necklets. No white at all on the lips and chin. Dark chocolate spine line and solid tail tip, some chocolate on the hocks. Well ticked in chocolate on a rich apricot groundcoat. Relaxed and happy to come out and be judged.

AV Foreign Breeders Adult

1st Lincoln's GR CH LINCZOZO CAT'S PYJAMAS, (ABY n (23)), F. 28.09.2012.

A really super Usual female. Body medium length with an elegant gait and a firm feel. Matching legs and neat oval paws. Excellent stance making judging a pleasure. Tail in proportion to the body, tapering to the tip. Head shows a moderate wedge, with gentle flowing contours. Very good top of head with large ears following the line of the wedge. Rounded almond eyes, well set. Good profile, strong chin and a level bite. Clear facial markings, cream on lips, some white on chin and cream extending down the throat. Some ghost leg bars, no necklets, a black spine line with a solid tail tip, some black on the hocks. Coat short and fine, with a resilient texture. Well ticked in black on deep apricot groundcoat. Relaxed out of the pen and handled very well.

2nd Oakley, GR CH KREMLINKATZ KATYA KALIKOVA.

Russian Blue girl good overall conformation. Long firm body with balanced, long legs and neat paws. Tail in proportion to the body. Head shows a short wedge but a little narrow at the line of the cheeks. Large ears of good size and vertical set. Good profile, good angle, firm chin and a level bite. Well shaped almond eyes, colour two shades of green. Good soft, dense coat of mid blue colour. Handled well.

3rd Wilson & Mr M G Wilson, NIDORAN NIMUE, (DRX as (33a 36a)), F. 20.01.2014.

AV Foreign Non-Breeders Adult

1st Bryce's GR CH THICKTHORN CHIPPEWA , (OCI bs 24 (73bs)), M. 24.06.2011.

Well grown Ocicat boy. Very shy and largely judged in the pen but he made it easy to do. Long muscular body. Legs in proportion to the body with neat oval paws. Balanced tapering tail. The head has a modified wedge with gentle curves, with a slight dip in the profile. Firm chin and a level bite. Moderate whisker pinch, muzzle has breadth and squareness, strong whisker pads. Large ears set at 45° with good width between them. Full almond shaped eyes, a warm gold colour. Clear facial markings and mascara lines "M" on the forehead, broken necklaces and bracelets. Body covered in large clear chocolate spots on a creamy-silver agouti groundcoat. Bulls-eyes evident on both flanks. Chocolate tail rings and a solid chocolate tail tip. Coat short and close lying, with a satiny texture.

2nd Wildman's CH STANREX CRÈME BRULEE, (DRX f 33 (33a40 6)), F 10.10.2013.

An attractive Devon girl. Medium body with good underling bone structure with a firm feel. Matching slender legs and neat oval paws. Long slender tail in harmony with the body. Head is short, rounded wedge with strong cheekbones. Profile shows a very good stop, pleasing depth of chin and a level bite. Large oval eyes, well set. Large low set ears. Well covered with short soft fur, with very good rexing. A friendly girl who handled well.

3rd Holden's ZAWADI BUNDARA-KAMUI, (BEN n 24 33 (76b30)), M. 05.05.2014.

AV Foreign Maiden Adult

1st Bryce's THICKTHORN ANISETTE, (OCI as 24 (73as)), F. 07.04.2014.

A very worried Blue silver Ocicat girl, with very pleasing conformation. Good length to the elegant, muscular body, with matching legs and neat oval paws. Balanced tapering tail. Head is a modified wedge of pleasing proportions, good profile firm chin with a level bite, well developed whisker pads which with a little gentle coaxing she showed off giving squareness to the muzzle. Large well set ears, fully rounded almond shaped eyes. Well defined facial and leg markings, distinct blue spots on a clear silver groundcoat. Both flanks have bulls-eyes. Short, close-lying coat with a satiny feel. Handled well.

2nd Hammersley's SYRINX MOONLIGHT SERENADE, (ABY a (23c)), F. 03.02.2014.

Blue Abyssinian female good overall conformation and size. Firm medium body, matching legs and tail. Mead is a moderate wedge although the muzzle is just a little finer than I would prefer. Good top of head, large well set ears and eyes, which shade from green to hazel. Clear facial markings, no bars or necklets. Coat short and fine with a resilient feel. Well ticked in blue on a virtually white basecoat. Handled well out of the pen.

3rd Hibbs's CHRISJAY ARTIC STORM, (BEN n 22 33 (76b20)), F. 12.03.

AV Foreign Limit Adult

1st Bryce's, AMEEKA OSPREY, (OCI n 22 (73 41)), F. 29.06.2009.

Mature Ocicat Classic girl. Balanced overall conformation with a quite long body with strong underlying bone with a firm feel to it. Tail tapers to the tip but I would like a little more width at the base. Strong legs in balance with the body, with neat compact paws. Balanced Ocicat Classic head with a good wild look to it, a modified wedge with gently flowing contours, with a slight dip in the profile. A clear whisker pinch and a broad squared muzzle. Chin a little shallow but not weak, with a level bite. Large ears with small tufts, set at 45°, wide at the base and wide set. Eyes are full almond in shape, set at a slight angle good depth of yellow-hazel colour. Beautifully marked in a very dark brown on a tawny agouti basecoat. Distinct facial markings, with a well marked "M" on the forehead, unbroken necklaces and barring on both back and front legs. Good overall symmetry of pattern with well defined butterflies across the shoulders. Oysters on the flanks clearly marked, linked on the left hand side at the bottom and unlinked on the right hand, clear unbroken spine lines. Tail has multiple tail rings with a solid black tail tip. Short coat, fine and satiny with a lustrous sheen. Very nervous but happy to let me complete a full assessment in the pen.

2nd Whitmore's VELA RHO INDUS (BEN n 24 (76 30)), M. 27.01.2014.

Young Brown Spotted Bengal lad, still looking quite adolescent. Long muscular body, matching strong legs with large oval paws. Tail fairly thick in harmony with the body for length. Head has a broad wedge, slight dip in profile, but needs more strength to the muzzle. The chin has depth but falls away a little, even bite. Large eyes oval in shape. Medium ears, well set. Clear facial markings. Large clear rosettes and some arrowheads on a warm coppery-apricot basecoat. Well marked on legs, broken spine lines and a solid tail tip. Short coat, soft with good density. Handled well.

AV Foreign Senior Adult

1st Lincoln's, GR CH LINCZOZO CAT'S PYJAMAS.

2nd Read's ONAWAY BOLROSE ALLEYESONME, (DRX bs 21 (33a18b)), M.

Pleasing Devon male good overall size with a firm feel to the body, matching long legs with neat oval paws. Tail slender and balances the body for length. Head is a short rounded wedge, profile is more of a nose break than a stop quite good depth of chin and a level bite. Ears of good shape and set but rather small for balance. Large oval eyes. Well covered with even waves. Happy to come out and handled well.

AV Foreign Kitten (14wks-6mth)

1st Barlow's ADIFTSH LITTLENEL PRINCESS, (DRX fs 21 (33a 18e)), F. 27.10.2014.

A very attractive, if vocal female Devon kitten. Firm muscular body with long slender legs and oval paws. Head has a short rounded wedge with a real pixie look to her. Strong cheek bones profile shows a good stop, good depth of chin and a level bite. Large, low set tufted ears wide set with good width at the base, well set large oval eyes. Well covered coat soft and well rexed. Handled well if nosily.

2nd Dodd's POOLSIDE EBONY MILO, (DRX ns (33a36)), M. 17.05.2014.

Large well grown Devon boy. Very good overall conformation Strong medium body with good breadth and a firm feel. Matching long legs. Short rounded wedge forms the head good profile firm chin and a level bite. Ears of good shape and set but smaller than I would like. Large oval eyes well set. Well covered with soft waves, although they are flattened along the spine line. A relaxed and friendly lad who showed himself off well.

AV Foreign Radius Kitten

1st Barlow's ADIFTSH SLINKY THEPRINCESS, (DRX fs 21 (33a 18e)), F. 27.10.2014.

This young lady simply exuded arrogance. Good overall Devon conformation. Firm medium body, long slim legs with neat oval paws. Tail in harmony with the body. Head short rounded wedge with a really "pixie" look. Good profile fair depth of chin and a level bite. Large oval eyes, ears of good shape and set but could be larger. Evenly covered with soft waves. Stood very well to show herself off, a pleasure to judge.

AV Foreign with 1 or More Pc's Neuter

1st Robertson's ONATUREL APPENNINE STAR, (SPH n 03 (84 31)), MN. 01.05.2013.

A well developed Black and White Sphynx youngster. Head is a modified wedge with strong cheekbones and muzzle with prominent whisker pads. Fair depth of chin and a rather untidy bite. Large ears set at a slight angle with good width at the base. Lemon shaped eyes set at a slant. Good length to the body with a firm feel. Long slim legs with neat paws, long toes with deep paw pads. Slender balanced tail. Even Chamois like feel to her with heavy down on the nose up to the bottom of the eyes, wrinkles on neck shoulders and legs. A happy lad that was keen to come out and show himself off.
