My final 3 in reverse order were the SLH contender BURGESS'S OLYG IMP GR PR CASSARO KID, who really is a great favourite & has been one of my own choices for Overall Best in Show on a number of occasions, who I think is a truly wonderful example of his breed, with my Overall Runner-Up being a wonderful Oriental Chocolate Spotted who was so, so beautifully mature looking EDWARDS'S HEMLOCK ALFREDO FERRARI who looked incredibly good & finally my winner a superb Persian Tabby, to whom I had awarded a Best Persian Kitten at his first ever show last year, a Brown Tabby & White MURRAY'S CH CULLYKHAN HERCULES who was looking quite magnificent, a really beautiful exhibit.**

07-10-13. Red Silver Classic Tabby & White Maine Coon, not a bad way to get your day up & running. This lad is looking amazing with perfect grooming which makes the most of what he has to offer (which is actually a heck of a lot). His cheeks are high & well defined, with strong squared off muzzle, with the head length a little longer than wide, in profile he has the required gentle concave curve, beautifully strong chin which lines up to his nose, excellent dentition. Beautifully set ears which are tall & well pricked, tufted tips wide base with abundant furnishings, with the added bonus of being a good larger size. Good size, eyes, which are round & set slightly obliquely, light golden tone complementing his colour scheme. Muscular neck, with beautifully grown long rectangular shaped muscular body, he has lovely strong legs & large paws, the tail deserves a report on its own, to give it the credit it deserves, it was not only long but was beautifully full & flowing, he is obviously very aware of its effect & knows how to use it to fullest effect as he carries it so proudly with a gentle wave to make sure you are aware of it (not that you could pretend otherwise). He has good density to his coat though at only 16 months it has still to attain its full length, the preparation & presentation were both superb, he has a gleaming glossy sheen to the surface, some ruff just beginning to become apparent, full breeches, shaggy tummy. He has a clear silver undercoat, with uneven more subtle red Tabby Pattern which is starting to blur, leg barring quite faint, subtle overlay of red on his tail surface, he was looking extremely pristine & showy, with a poise way beyond his tender age. His condition was exemplary & he is all you could wish for in show cat possessing a wonderful air of confidence with a look no further attitude, he oozes class & has 'Oomph by the bucket load, a real showman in the true sense of the word, one of those rare examples which transcends breeds. Many congratulations on his Overall Best in Show win for the Gwynedd.

**RES IMP GR PR GREEN'S GR PR NOYNAROCK MAGNOR. NFO n 21. 24-02-12.**

Brown Tabby Norwegian Forest Cat, handsome who succeeded in doing a

wonderful impression of a Tortoise (you had to see it to understand). Head shows a pleasing triangular shape with almost equilateral proportions, his profile is very good, with a perfectly acceptable chin, & level bite. The ears are set with the outer line following almost vertically from the cheeks, tufted tips, good interior furnishings. His eyes are full oval shape & are oblique in set, green colour though not points for that element. Good neck, body has good size though I would ideally prefer him a little heavier for his size, he has strong legs & good size tufted paws, with long tail which could be slightly fuller ideally. He has a full coat, with a good degree of ruff, full knickerbockers, he has a good thick woolly undercoat, with thick weather-proof top coat, with harsher longer guard hairs along his back sides & tail to some degree. His condition was sound, temperament was very gentle, would benefit greatly with dose of self confidence but preferred to hide underneath his bed.

### **SLH Imperial Grand Premier, Female;**

**IMP GR PR QINNEY'S GR PR TUMBLERAG TOP N TAILS. RAG a 04 21. 08-09-11.** Blue Tabby Mitted Ragdoll, what a gorgeous face this lady has & her certificate was well deserved, plus she so beautifully prepared. Her head has good width across the cheeks, showing well developed muzzle, flat on the brow, with excellent profile showing slight dip to her nose & slightly retroussé tip, with a good chin & bite. Her ears are medium size, with hint of forward tilt, set well apart, well furnished interiors. Beautiful eyes, large & well open with a gentle obliqueness to the setting, showing a good depth of blue to their colour & such a sweet gentle expression. Body was excellent weight & development, with strong legs & good paws, bushy tail. The coat was superb, really beautifully prepared with not a hair out of place, it silken in texture with excellent density, full ruff & knickerbockers. Attractive Tabby facial markings, good leg bars, tail rings, evident on the underside, the body has a very slight hint of tonal shading to its otherwise glacial tone, white chin difficult to state accurately whether or not it extended all the way through her tummy (but it appeared to), with the her clean white mittens & back legs to the line of the body. Her condition was wonderful & her temperament was delightful. A most attractive lady.

**RES IMP GR PR Not Awarded. 2<sup>nd</sup> LLYOD'S GR PR MIGATOBONITA TRULY SCRUMPTIOUS. MCO g 03 22. 16-01-13.** Blue Tortie Tabby & White Maine Coon, this girl was very nervous & not doing herself any favours. Her head was a longer than wide, the cheeks looked quite prominent but due to her nervousness looked very pinched, good square muzzle, with prominent whisker pads, flat brow, good curve to profile at the eye line, chin was good, bite very untidy & slightly under. Her ears are large & have good interior furnishing, tufted tip & set tall. Her eyes are a good larger size, yellowish green tone, round shape but lacking a little in obliqueness which was possibly due to her nerves. Body long & rectangular in shape, with strong legs, tufted paws, her tail could be longer & was very sparse, which detracted. Coat was very soft & well prepared but lacked in length & density, requiring more undercoat & could also do with more ruff & fullness to her breeches. Her Pattern was rather diffused due to her colour combination where the cream tended to knock out the clarity, facial & leg markings much clearer, the tail was rather solid. White paws, chest, tummy & groin areas. Her condition was excellent, but incredibly worried & keeping herself as flat as possible.

### **AOV SLH Grand Premier, Male;**

**GR PR WHITTLE'S PR NORSPIRIT SILVER SHADOW. NFO ns 09 23. 14-01-14.** Black Silver Tabby & White Norwegian Forest Cat, this lad has an amazing amount of coat, he looked like a rug on legs. Large substantially boned lad, strong neck, well proportioned muscular body, deep chest, strong legs, good size paws with tufts emanation from between the toes, the tail could be longer Ideally & was rather sparse in comparison to the fullness of his coat. He has a strong broad triangular head shape, with balanced equilateral proportions, strong profile, he even has a good chin, bite level. His ears are large & have well furnished interiors, tufted tips, set high. He has beautiful eyes, full oval shape in a gentle oblique setting, green colour (not that it matters) the shape is enhanced by the inverted white & tear drop of Tabby markings on his face. The coat was long with a really excellent woolly undercoat which gave the top coat an impressive springy texture & density, it certainly looked like it could deal with the harshest of winters without any problems, longer harsher guard hairs aplenty along his back & sides, impressive very full ruff, & knickerbockers, but he really needs a little more attention to the area to the tummy area, particularly between his back legs (which almost cost him the certificate). He was a very composed lad & was in excellent condition. Interesting white tail tip.

**RES GR PR Not Awarded . 2<sup>nd</sup> LLYOD'S PR KASSARO GOODWOOD. MCO n 22. 29-04-13.** Brown Classic Tabby Maine Coon, this lad has underlying potential but has a way to go before he is in my opinion ready for higher level than he is currently at. At present he is very juvenile in head development, requiring more width to define his cheeks, which is emphasised by his good square muzzle, with curve at the eye line to his profile, chin has depth, bite good. Ears are set tall & are well tufted at the tips, well furnished interiors, good larger size. The eyes are in a gentle oblique setting, quite large, round shape, hazel green tone. Requires a more muscular neck, body rectangular & still to fill out more fully, with quite well boned legs, large paws, tail was a good length but could be fuller. His coat though still to achieve more length & it has still to acquire more obvious ruff, fair breeches, nevertheless it was well prepared with an excellent glossy top coat, but as yet lacked undercoat. His pattern elements are in the Main(e) very good, butterfly over the shoulders, some evidence of oyster on each side, excellent facials, good leg barring, some rings on the underside of the tail. Pattern is dense & the contrast to the warmer ground colour is very good. He was in excellent condition & he has a very affable nature.

### **AOV Grand Premier, Female;**

**HORTON'S PR APPLAUSE COTTONKANDI. RAG G 03. 07-03-11.** Blue Tortie Bi-Colour Ragdoll, this girl's amount of white was something of an issue & she clinched her certificate by being a complete & utter flirt, she really pulled out all the stops with her antics. Her type was very balanced & pleasing, with a lovely soft expression. Her head has excellent width across her cheeks, well developed on the muzzle, I would ideally prefer her brow a little flatter, gentle dip in profile with slightly retroussé effect to her nose, chin was good, level bite. Her ears are set well apart, with longer interior furnishings, medium size & slight hint of forward tilt. Her eyes are really lovely, with a deep bright blue colour, well open with slightly oblique setting, the expression further enhanced by the drop in the

corner where the inverted white 'V' crosses over the eyes, such a trusting gentle expression. Her body was beautifully firm & well proportioned with good legs & tufted paws, bushy tail could be a fraction longer. Her coat could ideally be a little fuller but generally well prepared, good knickerbockers, the ruff could be fuller. As stated she has an inverted white blaze on her face which extends through the chest, front & back legs & tummy, with large patches of blue & cream to the remainder of her mask, ears & tail, also the body shading, but there is a very much a borderline of potentially more than a third on her body & I confess I did give her the benefit of huge doubt on this & had I been able to locate within the SOP's more easily may well have withheld due to this (but it seems to have moved location!!) Her condition was superb, temperament exceptional, she truly was a pleasure to waste a little time with, she made bread & rolled cartwheels, talk about sucking up!. I would not be prepared to award higher due to the concern about the amount of white on her body.

### **AC Oriental Grand Premier Neuter,**

**HARDY'S PR PIPPASTRO CINNERSTER. OSH o. 14-02-13.** Cinnamon, a very elegant lad who though a little retiring is nevertheless very pleasing on the eye. He has a longer wedge, minimal pinch, very good profile, good depth chin, level bite. The ears are large & set beautifully wide apart, with wide flare to their base & balance his head strength well. His eyes are suitably oriental in shape & slant & are also a perfectly acceptable green colour. Lengthy firm well muscled body, with deceptively long legs & oval paws, the tail I would ideally prefer an inch or so longer & is a little thick at its base. His coat was close lying marginally longer than ideal but nothing excessive, with a good degree of sleekness to it. His colour was virtually sound & looked quite spicy with a gingernut biscuit warmth to it. He was in super condition, takes a little winning over but worth the effort, his temperament was excellent.

### **Persian Orange Eyed White Kitten;**

**NICHOLS'S GEMKIN PARAGON. 03-08-14.** What a beautifully prepared kitten who looked like fluffy candyfloss. Her head was beautifully rounded with good round cheeks, small rise on her brow as yet, excellent stop, short snub nose the nose leather itself a little small & her nostrils could be larger, strong chin, bite a little under & still to sort itself fully. Beautifully small neat well placed ears, low on her head, with longer interior furnishings, very tidy. Her eyes are well open & round, with a good degree of boldness for her young age, the colour still muddy & to settle. Beautifully cobby compact body shape, low on her sturdy legs, round paws, full bushy tail of balanced shorter length. Her coat was impressively full for her young age, soft fine texture beautifully prepared, showing a good degree of frill already. Clean bright white throughout. She has a delightful personality & was wonderfully confident, her condition was splendid.

### **Tabby or Tortie Tabby Point Birman Adult;**

**PORTSMOUTH'S JANDOUGLEN MUSCAR THEO. SIB a 21. 24-03-14.** Blue Tabby Point, what a wonderful temperament this youngster has. He has good width across his cheeks which are developing well, his muzzle is still a littler fine, round on skull, with slight dip in profile, his chin was a little narrow & could be a little deeper, bite good. Ears are medium size & set well apart. The eyes are a

near round shape, with a good clear bright blue colour. He was well grown & has excellent weight for his young age, medium length strong legs, short paws, balanced medium length bushy tail. The coat was a very good length overall though he has still to attain more fullness to his ruff, silken well prepared texture. He has good blue Tabby tracings on his mask & legs, with more subtle tail rings on the underside, all in pleasing soft blue, contrasting well against his cool virtually clear glacial body colour. His feet markings were clean & white with relatively even gloves & socks, slightly more ragged left gauntlet but well with the requirements. He was in superb condition & has a very outgoing temperament, very fussy young chap.

**Considered for & Awarded BOB. GARDINOR'S IMP GR CH SNOWWITCH ATAKAD ASHADOW. SIB a 21** 14-07-12. Blue Tabby Point, wonderfully mature & solid lad. He has excellent head type, width across his full cheeks & well developed muzzle, rounded skull, slight dip to the nose in profile, quite a good chin his bite scissored over slightly. His ears are set wide apart & are a good medium size. Lovely depth of blue to the eye colour, the eyes themselves near round in shape. Body was large & solid without any coarseness, with impressive substance, strong well boned legs, large paws, bushy tail of near balanced medium length. Beautiful full coat which was most beautifully prepared with excellent silken texture, full ruff & not a hair out of place, excellent density. He has a very slight amount of light tonal shading which in no way detracts from the contrast to his well defined Blue Tabby tracings, excellent cheek stripes, 'M' on the brow, spotted whisker pads, tail a little more solid. Pristine white feet markings, the gloves were even, slightly uneven socks, his gauntlets slightly low but tapered well. His condition was impeccable & his temperament very composed & dignified, a very handsome chap.

### **Sorrel Somali Adult;**

**1<sup>st</sup> CC & BOB. COONEY'S TAGHER MISTER DILLON.** 06-05-14. This chap has moderately wedge with gentle curves, his muzzle has reasonable rounding though marginally longer length & the smile could be a little more obvious, slight indent the cheek lines, slight rounding to his brow, with touch of break in profile at the bridge of his nose, his chin was good & the bite level. His ears were set well, moderately large, with good cupped baser & alert pricked appearance, some longer interior furnishings. His eyes were a pleasing wide almond shape, slanting gently, hazel colour. At only 9 months & day he has still to muscle up more fully as one would expect, but he is a good medium build, with slender limbs, small paws, bushy tail, which was of balanced length. The coat length was good & he has quite a good ruff for his young age, full breaches, soft texture & good density. His colour is rich bright deep coppery tone, though still with contrast, bar free, excellent heels solid coloured cinnamon tail tip. He has good facial markings, with cinnamon rims to the eyes & showing some lighter coloured spectacle area beneath, the ticking over his shoulders still to become more apparent but much more obvious on his lower sides & deepening a little along the spine line & tail, banding was also apparent. He was in super condition & he was a very good natured youngster.

**2<sup>nd</sup> LINCOLN'S ZARZUELA PICASSO (imp)** 11-03-14. This lad was lacking somewhat in the level of ticking to justify a certificate at this stage of his development, again still very young so not achieved his full potential. His head is

shorter but the contours not so gently refined, slightly more muzzle pinch than slight indent, with the muzzle looking a little blunt, brow slightly rounded & has slight break in profile, chin requires a little more depth, good bite. His ears were a reasonably larger size, with longer furnishings to their cupped base, pricked, with slight tufts at the tips. His eyes let him down a little as these were a little too acute in set which detracted from their full almond shape as they looked a little small & deep set, hazel colour. Medium length well proportioned body, good legs, tufted paws, marginally shorter length bushy tail. Very good amount of coat, it was a good density & the length was good, showing a good amount of ruff & breeches. His colour was very intense & looking more chestnut in tone which tended to wipe out the ticking over his body as a result with no obvious contrast, showing in the main good head tracings, with flash onto his brow, bar free, heel markings are good, deep cinnamon on the outer edges of his paws & tail tip. His condition was sound & he was a very gentle young chap.

### **Brown or Blue Tabby Series Maine Coon Adult, Male;**

**1<sup>st</sup> & CC PORTSMOUTH'S CASSIMOON SLY STALLONEY. MCO n 22.**

29-07-12. Brown Classic Tabby, I confess it was a very borderline award. His head is marginally long in relation to its width & he requires more defined cheek line & I would prefer more boxiness to his muzzle, in profile he needs a little more evidence of break to give a more obvious gentle curve, he has quite a good chin & level bite. His ears are reasonably large & pricked tall, tufted tips, some longer interior furnishings. His eyes are green & good size, round shape with slightly oblique setting. He has good neck, body has long rectangular shape, ideally I would prefer more depth to his chest, well proportioned limbs, good size paws, the tail I would prefer longer & it requires more fullness & flow. His coat was a good mid length though a little more undercoat would help & he requires a fuller ruff & breeches, shaggy on the tummy. He has a pleasing degree of warmth to his ground colour & this defines his pattern contrast well, showing butterfly across his shoulders, with oysters on the sides, excellent leg barring, vestigial tail rings on the underside, excellent facials. His condition was very good & he was a gentle if slightly retiring lad.

**2<sup>nd</sup> HARKER & ALMOND'S JULESCOON TREBOR. MCO n 22 23-04-14.**

Brown Classic Tabby, only 9.5 months & as yet very gangly & out of balance. He has quite good muzzle prominence, but his chin detracts as it is both narrow & also lacking in depth to give the required square appearance, cheeks still to define more fully, he does have a reasonable break at the eye line which gives a reasonable curve, his bite was good. Ears are quite large with well furnished interiors & tufted tips, but these are already starting to widen off a little. Green eyes which are slightly oblique, good larger size. Body is well grown & though still to muscle up more fully was proportionate to his age, strong legs, tufted paws, tail was a good length, needs to plume up a little more. His coat is at present still a little short but again not out of keeping with his age, requiring a little more undercoat & more in the way of show preparation to give a glossier top coat, he has still acquire fuller breeches & some ruff. His pattern elements could ideally be a little clearer & more distinct, the facials & leg barring a little better, his tail more solid, his overall colour requires more warmth. His condition was sound & he was a calm & composed young fella.

**Brown or Blue Tabby Series Maine Coon Adult, Female;**

**CC Not Awarded. KAYE'S ALISIKA BETTATHEDEVIL. MCO n. 19-04-13.**

Brown Classic Tabby, this girl was looking a little adolescent & still to mature more fully. Her head requires a little more width to give her the required balance, & would benefit with a little more definition to her cheeks, her muzzle was generally good & has a degree of prominence to her whisker pads, slightly shallower break in profile as opposed to slight concave curve in profile, her chin has excellent depth, bite good. Her ears are large & have good tufts on the tips, well furnished interiors, they are set tall & well pricked. Eyes large & good round shape, quite large, pleasing slightly oblique setting, green colour. Her body is at present still looking a little gawky & needs to fill out more fully, her legs are long & proportionate, tufted paws, tail very thin & the lack of full furnishing made it look quite sparse, it also has an irregularity about tow inches from the tip. Her coat has still acquire more density to give fullness & it looks a little untidy as a result, as the top coat requires a higher gloss, fair breeches needs more ruff. Her colour was rather cold with cooler toned ground, but this is one of the variables with Brown Tabbies, contrast was good, well marked facials, good leg barring, tail a little solid as was her lower back. She was a very gentle girl, sound condition.

**Also Considered for & Awarded BOB. BURGESS'S CH COONARIA CHICAGO**

**MCO n 03 22. 27-11-13.** Brown Classic Tabby & White, though undoubtedly the best in the class he was not without shortcomings, but he excelled in preparation & in that respect alone warranted his Bob. His head was a little longer than wide & he has good prominence to his whisker pads, which assisted by the white defines his muzzle, he has high cheeks, showing a slight curve in profile at the eye line, with good depth chin & level bite. His ears are large & have extremely well tufted tips & well furnished interiors but sadly they are too wide apart & he compounds the problems by bonneting them forward & as a result look incorrect for his breed. His eyes I would prefer larger & more rounded in shape & they are inclined to look a little too acute in the angle as opposed to slightly oblique. He has a beautifully muscular neck & well developed body, he has long legs but a little fine on the ankles for my taste & his paws could be larger, good flow to his tail but would benefit with a little more length. His coat was wonderful, beautifully prepared, with good density to the undercoat, glossy top coat, showing a well develop if not yet full ruff, excellent breeches, super presentation. He has lovely warmth of colour to this ground & this contrasts sharply contrasted by his well defined pattern with butterfly across his shoulders, showing some linkage to the oyster on his sides, excellent leg barring, tail rings on the underside, he has inverted white on his face with stripes at the cheeks, some thumbprints, , the white areas on his face, chest tummy & paws was beautifully clean & well prepared. He was in wonderful condition & he has gentle good natured temperament.

**Also Considered for BOB. LAKE'S CH SILVALAKE PLUM PUDDING. MCO n**

**22. 25-04-12.** Brown Classic Tabby, this girl was for BOB only, somewhat small for her age & lacking in the required weight & substance for her breed & age. Her head is a little short, the cheeks are defined, but her muzzle requires more strength & prominence to the pads, she has a gentle dip in profile as opposed to concave curve, very shallow chin & as such does not comply, bite good. I would prefer her ears larger & these are also a little wide in set, good interiors. Her

eyes were slightly oblique, shape rounded, hazel/green colour. Body small & requires more weight & substance overall, proportionate legs & paws, tail I would like fuller & longer ideally. Her coat requires a little more density to the undercoat, & she really needs more show preparation as the top coat is a little lack lustre. Her colour is generally warm & the pattern is good, & contrasts well but requires a little more sheen. Sweet nature, her condition appeared sound but I would like her much larger & showing more mature development considering her age.

### **AOC Maine Coon Adult, Female;**

**1<sup>st</sup> & CC CANNELL'S MABALAKAT NORTHERN LIGHTS. MCO f 03. 03-04-13.**

Black Tortie & White, generally a well balanced girl, with definition to her cheeks & square muzzle shape, it length longer than wide, profile shows the correct slight concave curve in profile, the chin has good depth but also a quite good width equally important, the bite level. Her ears are quite large & have beautifully tufted tips. Her eyes are a light golden colour & a good size, set slightly oblique. Body has quite good rectangular shape, good bone to the legs & paws, her tail could be a little fuller & longer ideally. Coat was a good length & density, she was showing some ruff & good breeches, shaggy tummy, good gloss to her top coat. Her colour was a good combination of black with patches of red, white patch over the right of her muzzle with white on the chest, tummy & paws also red chin. Condition & temperament both excellent.

**2<sup>nd</sup> LAKE'S SILVALAKE MYLITTLETEDEBEAR. MCO f. 04-12-13.** Black Tortie, still relatively young so will hopefully continue to develop more fully. Her head is marginally short, but shows quite well defined cheeks, her muzzle could be a little more prominent ideally, reasonable concave curve at the eye line, adequate chin, bite good. Her ears are set well, pricked high, well furnished works, tufts on the tips, & quite large. Her eyes were good larger size, & rounded shape with typical slight obliqueness to the setting, Her body is as yet a little on the rangy side & I would prefer her a little more substantial & heavier boned ideally in the legs & paws, reasonably full tail. Coat was well prepared, but requires a little more density & undercoat, glossy top coat, requires a fuller ruff, good breeches. Her colour is a combination of red & black which is mainly intermingled & the red could be a little brighter ideally. Sweet disposition & her condition was very good.

**3<sup>rd</sup> HARDWICK'S RUTTERKIN TREACLE TART. MCO f 03. 29-11-12.** Black Tortie & White, markings wise this girl was almost a mirror image of the class winner, above. Her head is a little on the shorter side in relation to its length, she does though have quite a pleasing squareness to the muzzle, quite a good profile with slight downward curve at the bridge of her nose, chin was good, bite very borderline, verging under. Her eyes were a good green colour & good size to their rounded shape but could be a little more oblique. Condition very good, her temperament was charming.

Body was medium size, with sturdy legs, short paws, full bushy tail. His coat was really beautiful it was full & groomed to perfection, showing full ruff, to frame his face, it was dense beautifully pristine looking where every effort had been made to make the most

Lovely type, head has excellent width across the cheeks for his young age, with pleasing muzzle strength, skull is round & he has slight dip in profile, with good depth of chin & level bite. Gorgeous eyes, almost round shape, & the colour was intense & bright, lovely depth of blue, alert & expressive. Body is showing pleasing development for his young age, strong legs, short paws, bushy tail of balanced length. His coat was an appropriate length for his age, beautifully prepared & superb texture, his ruff not as advanced as the older boy (only to be expected). It was clear & showed super contrast to the seal Tabby tracings, lovely cheek striations & clearly marker 'M' on the brow, spotted whisker pads, with thumb prints also on the ears, good leg barring & vestigial tail rings evident, Beautifully clean white feet markings which are all well matched, with even gloves & socks, slight lower tapered gauntlets at the back. He was in superb condition & was full of confidence & showed beautifully. Two really cracking young lads.

### **Tabby or Tortie Tabby Point Birman Kitten, Female;**

Medium size ears which are set wide apart. Gorgeous eyes, really intense deep blue colour, almost round shape, such a beautiful expression. Her body I would like a little better grown for her age but she was relatively weighty for her size, with proportionate legs & paws, bushy balanced medium length tail. Her coat was wonderful it was beautifully prepared, with lovely fine texture, her ruff still to develop fully. It was clear with a light hint of golden hue, superb contrast to her points which are a combination of Tabby overlaid with some red, the tracings are generally well defined, even some residual tail rings. Clean white feet markings, with even gloves & socks, she does appear to have a little red infringement to the gauntlets as the colour is deepening. He has good compact body shape, well proportioned limbs, good size paws, his tail was moderately heavy & a balanced medium length. His coat was excellent, it was short & dense, beautifully crisp where you could almost scrunch it & make fingerprints in it. Body colour was lightly shaded magnolia tone, with excellent contrast to his cooler lilac points. I would have preferred her eyes a little larger & they required a more fully rounded appearance, very good depth of orange which was bright & intense. Body has a degree of substance & carrying a little more weight than ideal, broad chest, strong well boned legs, large paws, tail quite heavy but on the short side. Her coat was dense & has a good shorter length, reasonable degree of crispness to it. Her blue is even, mid tone, with shades of cream, showing some patching on the sides. Her condition was excellent, temperament could be a little more ladylike.

**Considered for & Awarded BOB. CHANDLER'S UK OBIMP GR PR KOLINGA BLUEBELLE. BRI g.** 04-06-07. Blue, impressive mature lady of overall excellence. Head is beautifully rounded, with fully filled round cheeks, her brow rounds well, broad nose, her chin was firm, bite level. Compact body shape of excellent depth, with good substance, strong legs & round paws, well balanced tail which was moderately thick. Lovely coat density it was short & has a pleasing degree of crispness to it. The body colour has a warm creamy ivory tone with excellent contrast to her well broken points which were a combination of slightly cooler

Thick strong neck, massive muscular body, he is one huge lad with wonderful substance, wonderfully sturdy legs & substantial paws, large paws, tail was heavy & medium length. His coat was moderately short & incredibly dense, with a really wonderful degree of crispness. The body is shady in a cool blue tone, very even with excellent contrast to his dense marginally dark blue points which are even. His condition was wonderful, his temperament was just a pure delight & nothing would phase him, he appeared to be completely bomb proof, flopped on his back & purred his heart out, he was absolutely charming & I enjoyed our time.

His head is wide across the cheeks, & shows good fullness to the cheeks, with slightly rounded brow & gentle dip to his nose, he has a pleasing degree of prominence where his whisker pads give the rectangular shape visible beyond the cheek line, some curly whiskers & some more stubbly, his chin was good, as was the bite. His ears are medium size & small tufts at the tips, & some longer curly furnishing to the interiors, they are as little wide at the base. He has well open good size eyes which are round, hazel colour but no points for the colour element so only mentioned for description. He has a rectangular body shape & looks a little high on the legs this was made more obvious due to being between coats, tufted paws, medium length tail. He lacks ruff which makes him look a little sparse in this area, giving him the appearance of a long neck. His coat has some tighter areas & others are looser, but it is all completely unstructured, ideally it could be a little softer, the tail, has longer more plume like effect, overall the coat still stands away from the body. He was a very gentle lad & his condition was excellent & will look much improved once back in full coat.

**Also Considered for BOB. OAKDEN'S, PR MEWSOS COMEON EILEEN, SRS h 01-07-11.** Chocolate Tortie Shorthair, this girl had a very interesting look in the pen she looked like a grumpy old man. Her head has good width with a good degree of fullness to the cheeks, her muzzle not looking quite as prominent as I would wish, the whiskers mainly stubbly, she has round brow, the chin I would prefer a fraction deeper, bite level. The ears are medium size, with tighter curls to the interiors. She large eyes which are round & open & have a very starry almost startled grumpy expression. Her body could ideally be a little more rectangular, being a little more compact & akin to British, good legs & paws, marginally short tail. Her coat being short was dense & quite thick, it also possessed quite tight curls underneath in a very unstructured, with tighter curls, on the chest, tummy & tail areas. She was in

He has a moderate wedge, slightly fine muzzle, with small pinch & as opposed gentle indent to the cheeks, with slight curvature beneath, the brow rounds gently & he has a slight break at the eye line in profile, chin was reasonable, double upper canines which are causing some discomfort. His ears have cupped base & are well pricked. He has good full almond eye shape which have a gentle slant, most attractive golden tone. Body is firm with slender limbs, small paws, tapered tail with its thicker base. Coat has a good degree of resilience & is as such not overly soft, medium length & the density was good. Good facials with slightly paler area beneath the eyes, flash onto the brow from his eyes, body was showing good ticking with bands of colour beneath, darker heels. Warm undercoat, with more dull beige tone on the chest, tummy & inside the legs, his lilac colour rather dark & a little more taupe than pinky lilac, Charming nature, excellent temperament.

### **Blue Abyssinian Kitten;**

Head has moderate wedge with slightly rounded contours, showing slight indent to the cheek line which curve gently, slight rounding on the brow, slight break at the eye line, her chin was good, level bite. Body is lithe & though I would like her a little better grown she was a good tone, slender limbs, broad base to her gently tapered medium length tail. The coat texture was very good, with a good density to its medium length, not unduly soft. Warm beige spectacle area round the eyes, with slight flash from the eyes to the brow, with warm sandy tone to the throat, chest, tummy, inside the legs, but sadly her back was very dense & dark shade of blue in colour with no real ticking as such over most of it, the colour also penetrated quite a way down the hair shaft & was not banded, minimal amount of peppery tone towards the roots. Showing good heel markings, bar free. Her condition was sound & her temperament was excellent, the BOB was not awarded due to the lack of ticking.

### **AC Burmese Breeders Neuter;**

**1<sup>st</sup> TOWN'S IMP GR CH & PR TEAPOT TANYA. BUR n.** 23-02-05. Very mature neutered girl. Her type as her title indicated was very impressive. She has a short wide wedge, with good blunt muzzle, top well rounded & she has an excellent break, strong chin, some missing incisors. Her ears are medium size & have good width between, slight forward tilt, rounded tips. Well shaped eyes which were large, showing a little more of the greener range of chartreuse than yellow. Body was beautifully weighty & firm, showing excellent maturity, well proportioned limbs, oval paws, her tail was a little short for balance & has a definite deviation at its tip. Coat was short & very, very sleek & satiny, laying beautifully close. Deep rich brown colour with wonderfully glossy surface sheen. Her condition was excellent, despite her chagrin at being handled, it was all for effect & there was no malice.

Lilac Tortie, This girl was not carrying her age as well as the winner. I would prefer her wedge a little wider & as a result it looked slightly long in relation to its width, I would also prefer her muzzle a little more blunted, quite well rounded top, good break, chin okay, bite good. Her ears were medium in size, rounded tips with touch of tilt, could be a little wider apart ideally. Her eyes are well shaped, but are now faded to a more green tone. Firm body, good legs & paws, her tail a little on the shorter side, rounded tip. Coat I would prefer shorter & she was also inclined to fluff it a little & as a result it was a little open as opposed to sleek, soft texture. Her Colour was dark lilac & very hot cream with a very decided metallic lustre. Very sweet disposition & her condition was excellent.

### **AC Burmese Senior Neuter;**

**1<sup>st</sup> ROBINSON'S GR CH & UK BOIMP GR PR MOLYNMEUX GOLD DUST. BUR**

**e.** 23-12-08. Cream, this lad has beautiful type & is fine specimen of his breed, even if his colour is hotter than I would wish. Super head type, excellent width across his short wedge, strong blunt shape to his muzzle, he has a beautifully rounded top line in both directions, showing excellent break, firm chin, level bite. He has medium size, ears with rounded tips & these have excellent width between. Beautiful eyes, large, with curved lower line & gentle slanted top line, beautiful light yellowy chartreuse colour, very expressive. Body is muscular & firm with good breadth chest, straight back well proportioned limbs near balanced tail with rounded tip. His coat was splendid, short & fitting close & incredibly sleek, it was satin like has beautiful polished effect. The colour was as stated hotter & more intense than I would have wished but we can't get everything & colour apart his is pretty close. He has a wonderful gentle disposition & was in superb condition, a cat with a great deal to admire.

### **Siamese/Balinese Kitten Under 6 Months;**

**1<sup>st</sup> KEOGHAN'S ALDERSTAR BABYBEL SIA y.** 28.10.2014. Fawn Tortie Point, What beautifully balanced baby, quite lovely. Head has a very even equilateral wedge, profile pulling out well, chin was good & her bite level. Ears large & well flared base complementing the wedge beautifully, set wide & low but without obvious extremes, just beautifully balanced. Her eyes are typically oriental in both shape & slant, the colour was I confess difficult to ascertain but appears to be a bright deep blue & have such a gentle trusting expression. Firm little body with everything in the correct proportions in relation to her age, slim legs, small neat paws, fine tail. The coat was beautifully close & sleek, it was also a very good shorter length for her young age, attractive soft sheen. Clear coloured body with very delicate tone, despite her very soft toned points colour of soft rosy mushroom & warmer creams, her points all subtly broken there is still contrast. Her condition was wonderful & her temperament was absolutely delightful, a very promising young miss who was a real pleasure to meet up with I think she is very promising & will watch her progress with interest.

**2<sup>nd</sup> BALL'S COSITA LEN GOODMAN, SIA a 21** 22.09.2014. Blue Tabby Point, This lad was not looking his best & rather out of kilter. Narrow wedge, profile is good, chin narrow & requires a little more depth, bit good. His ears were a little small & lacked width at their base, tending to prick rather high. His eyes were small & deep set & he was also showing his haws, which made the colour difficult to assess fully. Body was lithe, slim legs & small paws, fluffing his tail which

made it appear rather short. His coat was a little long & he was also fluffing it which compounded the problem. His coat colour could be a little more glacial & good contrast to the darker blue tabby tracings with the tail rings more difficult to ascertain. He was a good natured lad but not looking 100%.
