

KENTISH CAT SOCIETY SHOW 21ST OCTOBER 2017
REPORT FROM ALISON LYALL

Many thanks to Helen and her team for the invitation and to my steward Brian Gregory. We had a great day together with some lovely cats to handle.

IMPERIAL CLASS – AV SLH GR PR NEUTER FEMALE.

IMP.CAMILLERI'S GR PR CHEHAM CHANTILLY LACE RGM n 03 21 32 FN – 24.4.16. A quality brown tabby and white Ragamuffin lass with darker points, of only eighteen months but nicely developed for her age and well deserving of the award. I later nominated her for BIS SLH. Her head was very broad with widely spaced medium ears showing rounded tips and generous furnishings and a slight forward tilt. The wide cheeks were rounded as were the puffy whisker pads and the bite was level and chin gently rounded. The rounded forehead flowed down to an obvious nose break and a medium length clear profile. Large pale green walnut shaped eyes were set wide with a sweet gentle expression. The body was basically rectangular in shape, of excellent substance with a deep chest and broad shoulders and the medium length legs were heavily boned with large tufted paws. The tail was well furnished and just about balanced the body. The plush medium length coat was soft and dense and very well presented with longer fur forming a ruff around the head and on the chest and the tabby pattern was beautifully defined.

GRAND CLASS – AC BIRMAN CHAMPION ADULT FEMALE.

GCC.SIMMONDS' CH GAYEMAUDI BLUJASMINE SBI a F – 31.7.13. A mature blue point Birman female of pleasing type and medium size with the most soulful expression. Her head was rounded with full broad cheeks and a well developed muzzle with a level bite and a firm chin. The medium ears were well spaced and the deep sapphire blue eyes were almost round. The medium nose showed a slight dip at the bridge with a gentle convex curve in profile. She looked well balanced with a long body of reasonable substance, proportionate limbs and short strong paws. The bushy tail balanced the body. Her silken coat had a glacial tone and was well presented with a ruff to frame her head. The white gloves were symmetrically scooped, the socks were level and the well matched broad gauntlets tapered to an even point a third of the distance down from the hocks. She was a delightful cat who was very alert and sweet natured.

RES GPC. FLUCK OFFORD'S CH RAGIDAN CHOCOLATE-BISCUIT SBI h F – 15.4.14. A sturdy chocolate tortie point Birman female. The skull was broad and rounded though appeared slightly small in proportion to the body. Cheeks were full and the muzzle well

developed with a level bite and firm chin. The eyes were not very well opened and in this light were a dull blue and paler in colour around the edges. The nose was medium with a slight dip at the bridge and a slightly Roman profile and pink and chocolate nose leather. The body was long and heavy with well boned limbs and a bushy tail just to balance. The coat was full with a silken texture and a ruff to frame the head and all points were marked with all colours with an attractive blaze on the nose. The white gloves were symmetrical although the gauntlets were of uneven length, with the left reaching almost to the hock and the right considerably shorter.

AC TURKISH VAN OR VANKEDISI ADULT.

CC & BOB.McLEOD & McLEOD'S KAZDEE KAZ TUV d 63 F – 27.11.16.A stunning young odd eyed Turkish Van of less than eleven months with a wonderful temperament – she was talkative and affectionate and made puddings all the time we were with her. Strongly grown with a strong wedge shaped head and high set and well feathered moderately large ears. The profile was of medium length and almost straight with pink nose leather and the bite was level and chin firm. The large eyes were oval, most expressive and of exceptional depth of colour, with the right blue and the left amber. The body was long and muscular and of good heft, the limbs were well boned and the neat paws round and tufted. The brush was pale auburn with darker auburn rings and of balanced length. The butterfly marking on the head was nicely balanced, just coming a little lower towards the top of the eye on the left and separated by a narrow white blaze. The coat was chalk white and of silky texture, well presented and developing length. She was a delightful young cat and a pleasure to handle.

RED, CREAM, TORTIE TABBY OR TABBY AND WHITE MAINE COON.

Both for BOB only.

BOB.HOLDEN'S CH KASSARO BLUBERRY-SWIRL MCO g F – 1.8.15.A well grown blue tortie female with a well mingled coat. Broad head with well separated large ears showing glamorous tufts. When relaxed they tend to spread but can be held erect with encouragement. High broad cheek bones, large round luminous yellow green eyes with a slight oblique aperture and a good profile line. The muzzle is square with a level bite and a deep, slightly narrow chin. The long and hefty body is almost rectangular and the legs are strongly boned with large tufted paws. Long bushy tail to balance. Well presented coat, a relaxed female who was gentle and easy to handle.

ALLEN'S CH EMPURRER CARNIVAL QUEEN MCO f 03 F – 30.6.16. A strikingly marked young tortie bi-colour female who was unfortunately rather shy and tense and thus did not show herself to full advantage. She was well grown with good substance and bone and a lovely long sweep of tail. Her ears were large and very mobile, the cheekbones were high and the muzzle fairly square with a level bite and strong chin. Her body was long and hefty and she had a lovely gloss to her top coat but not much softer undercoat today. I thought she was very much at a transitional stage of development but promising if she can relax.

AC COLOURPOINTED OR MITTED RAGDOLL ADULT MALE.

CC.BAILEY & BAILEY'S RAGADEE COLBY OFKORAG RAG c M – 28.4.16. An adolescent lilac colourpointed lad who was very well grown. A flat plane separated his ears which still appeared a little large, an impression that was accentuated by his tendency to bonnet them. The cheeks were broad and the muzzle had gently rounded contours with a level bite and a firm chin although a little more breadth would have been ideal. The large sky blue eyes were well separated and there was a gentle dip at the bridge of the nose. The body was long and hefty with a short strong neck, limbs were well boned with large tufted paws and the tail was long, though rather sparsely furnished today, and his soft dense coat was also on the short side. A large shy lad at an in-between stage with a very sweet nature.

BOB.BOOOTH & PHILBRICK'S CH STARTOPCAT DANS DELIGHT JNR RAG a M – 28.6.16. A large sixteen month old blue colourpointed lad, in the peak of condition and beautifully presented. He had very good Ragdoll type with a broad flat plane between the ears and super breadth to the cheeks and muzzle and gently rounded head contours. Beautifully shaped large deep blue eyes were wide and slightly obliquely set with the ideal fuller lower line and the medium nose showed a gentle dip at the bridge and a retrouse profile. Excellent bone and substance to the long body and long bushy tail, and a soft dense coat which was well presented with a full ruff and knickerbockers.

Considered for BOB. GLADWIN'S GR CH GLADTIDINGS DRAGONFLY RAG a M – 4.10.15. A blue colourpointed male with a super dense, soft and plushy coat, a profuse ruff and generous knickerbockers. He was very well built and strongly boned but his tail was rather a disappointment, being short and sparsely furnished. Handsome head with large forget-me-not blue eyes and a slightly retrouse profile.

AC COLOURPOINTED OR MITTED RAGDOLL ADULT FEMALE.
CC. BOOTH & PHILBRICK'S STARTOPCAT HOT-CHOCOLATE
RAG b F – 13.3.12. A sweet mature chocolate colourpointed female with excellent deep eye colour. Her head was broad with a flat plane between medium forward tilted ears and her cheeks and muzzle were well developed with gently curving contours. Her bite was level though slightly scissored and she had a firm chin. The eyes were really lovely, large and well shaped, set wide and slightly oblique and of a luminous deep sapphire blue in colour and the medium nose showed a gentle dip at the bridge and a slightly retrousse profile. The long body had heft and substance, limbs were well boned and the bushy tail balanced the body. A most attractive and sweet natured lass.

2ND. ADAMS' RAGADEE MOONSTONE RAG b F – 6.2.14. A gentle mature chocolate colourpointed female whose coat was not in the best of condition today, feeling rather coarse and dry to the touch. Her ears were rather large and held erect, separated by a flat plane, and although her cheeks were broad, the muzzle was rather narrow with a level bite. The eyes were mid blue but not particularly large and she looked rather heavy browed. She was well grown with strong bone and a long body which had good substance, but there was a bald patch on the points of both hocks and I did feel she was not in show condition.

Considered for BOB. ADAMS' CH RAGADEE AMETRINE RAG c F – 21.5.16. A sweet and gentle young lilac colourpointed girl with a quality coat having a lovely soft, dense and plushy texture. Good substance and bone, broad gently contoured skull and large mid blue eyes.

AC BI-COLOUR RAGDOLL ADULT.

CC & BOB. BAXTER'S SARAGGS WILLY WONKA RAG n 03 M – 6.9.16. A lively and affectionate seal bi-colour lad who was still looking quite kittenish for his age and very much at an in-between stage of development. In spite of this, the building blocks are there and the head conformation is good, with gently rounded contours and showing breadth of flat plane between medium forward tilting ears, broad cheeks and a well developed muzzle with a level bite and a firm chin. The eyes are large and wide set, cobalt blue in colour and with a slight oblique aperture and the medium nose shows a gentle dip at the bridge and a slight retrousse profile. The body is fairly long although I would ideally prefer a little more substance, limbs are well boned and the tail is long although sparsely furnished. The white conforms to the standard although the inverted V marking on the head was broken and was more like a maple leaf than a V. His show presentation needed more attention as his paws and chin were rather stained.

SEAL POINT BIRMAN KITTEN.

1ST & BOB.BALDOCK'S TIKABOO MYSTICAL MIMI SBI n F – 1.5.17. Lovely seal point Birman kitten of just over five months, very well grown for her age and sex and most promising. The head is round and strong with width between the ears which are still a little erect and bonneted. The cheeks and muzzle are well developed and the bite is level and chin firm. Exquisite deep sapphire eyes are almost round and sweetly expressive and there is a slight dip at the bridge of the medium nose. The body has good length and substance, limbs are thickly boned and the bushy brindled tail balances the body. The white gloves are symmetrically scalloped and the gauntlets are beautifully shaped and taper evenly to a point just below the hocks. Inevitably, the mask is not yet fully developed with the central area showing deep seal and the rest brindled and the fluffy kitten coat is a very pale beige in colour. A delightful lass.

BLUE POINT BIRMAN KITTEN.

1ST & BOB.FINCH'S ATAKAD SNOWWITCH AVALON SBI a M – 19.4.17. A purring blue point kitten of six months who was strongly grown. Good strong rounded head with breadth at the cheeks and promising muzzle development, level bite and firm chin. The ears are still held erect and tend to dominate the head and the eyes are almost round and a stunning deep even blue in colour with a gentle loving expression. The medium nose has a slight dip at the bridge and a slightly Roman profile. He was a very sturdy lad, strongly boned and with a long substantial body and a balanced bushy tail. The full kitten coat was soft and a little shady on top but with glacial white coming through at the base. Well matched gloves and gauntlets. A super young lad.

SEAL POINT BIRMAN NEUTER.

PC & BOB.SIMMONDS' GR CH GAYEMAUDI MARIA SBI n FN – 12.5.07. A sweet mature seal point Birman of ten and a half in lovely condition. She had a lovely broad head with the medium ears set wide, full round cheeks and a well developed muzzle with a level bite. Her expressive eyes were almost round, a little faded but still a strong two tone blue and her nose had a slight dip at the bridge and a beautiful profile line. Her body was long and most substantial, the medium length legs were thickly boned and the tail was bushy to balance. She had a profuse, rather shaggy coat with a soft texture and a full ruff to frame her head, a little shady on top but clear below. Strong and extremely furry

paws had white symmetrical gloves and reasonable gauntlets at the rear. Loving temperament.

NORWEGIAN FOREST NEUTER MALE.

PC.COMER'S ZEALANDONII BANOFFEE PIE NFO as MN – 25.6.15. A delightful blue smoke Norwegian lad. His skull formed a strong equilateral triangle and the large ears, which were extravagantly furnished, extended the lateral lines of the head. His pale green eyes were obliquely set, well opened and almond shaped with a lovely gentle expression and his long nose had a basically straight profile with just a slight bump. Level bite and firm chin. His body was long, muscular and most substantial, long limbs were strongly boned and stood taller at the rear and his bushy tail just balanced his body. He had a full coat with deep woolly undercoat with some firm top overlying it, a full shirtfront and generous knickerbockers. He had a most endearing temperament.

NORWEGIAN FOREST NEUTER FEMALE.

BOB.COMER'S PR ZEALANDONII BLUEBERRY PIE NFO a FN – 25.6.15. Blue litter sister to the previous lad, I thought she had the edge on him today because she was so balanced and elegant and had the typical Norwegian Forest stance – also, her top coat was better with a good firm texture for a blue. She had a defined equilateral triangular head extended by large ears with tiny tufts at the tips to give a pointed appearance, a long profile (also with a very slight bump), a level bite and a firm chin. The eyes were well shaped, large, green, obliquely set and well opened. Her torso was long, muscular and elegant and her strongly boned legs had large tufted paws and stood taller at the rear. A long bushy tail balanced the body. The coat was double and well presented with a gleaming firm top and a deep woolly undercoat, with a shirtfront and generous knickerbockers. A confident and most attractive female.

SIBERIAN NEUTER.

PC & BOB.PHILLIPS' MUSRAFY POLYARNY SIB n 03 84 MN – 12.9.16. A very well grown spotted tabby and white bi-colour lad. He had a short broad wedge shaped head with good rounded contours, well spaced medium ears, broad low cheekbones and generous whisker pads and firm chin with a level bite. Large pale green eyes are well shaped with the fuller lower line and wide and slightly obliquely set. The nose was of medium length and uniform width with a good profile line from the slightly domed forehead via the slight concave curve at the bridge. Substantial and hefty rectangular body, very strongly boned medium limbs with huge tufted paws and a balanced length of bushy tail. Full coat

of good quality with a firm top and a dense springy undercoat and plentiful ruff. A super lad.

2ND.FLUCK OFFORD'S RAGIDAN THISTLEDOWN SBI c 21 F –
17.5.17.A real pocket kitten, this lilac tabby point Birman baby showed excellent type and such a loving temperament. Her head was rounded with good breadth at the cheeks and muzzle and a level bite. Exquisite forget-me-not blue eyes were almost round and she had a slight dip at the

nasal bridge and a clear profile line. Her bone and substance was age appropriate and she had a soft pale kitten coat with faint tabby markings visible on the head and minimally on the forelimbs and tail. Gloves and gauntlets appeared well matched.

3RD.BOOTH & PHILBRICK'S STARTOPCAT MY-GOD-ZEUS RAG a M – 19.5.17.A strongly grown blue colourpointed Ragdoll lad of five months. He had good head conformation with promising breadth at the cheeks and muzzle and a flat plane. The large eyes were a very pale blue as yet and there was a gentle dip at the bridge of the nose but no retrouse. Strong long torso and thickly boned limbs with a promising coat texture. A sweet little chap.

AV SLH BREEDERS KITTEN b.

1ST.CANN & CANN'S JOMANEI CARACTACUS POTTS RGM n 03 23 M – 17.6.17.A lovely purring Ragamuffin kitten with excellent head conformation, showing super breadth at the cheeks and muzzle and an ideal profile line. Very strongly boned limbs and hefty sturdy body and soft fluffy kitten coat. An adorable little lad.

2ND.CANDLER'S KATTJEWELS SHINY EEVEE NFO as 23 F – 30.6.17.A most affectionate young Norwegian Forest baby. She currently has a very long narrow triangular skull and her large ears are very erect and close together and her olive green eyes set very oblique. Long straight profile. Her body is proportionately long, with well boned long legs and a long tail, all covered in a soft fluffy kitten coat with a spectacular mackerel pattern.

3RD.DEAN & DEAN'S ANGELRAGS BOBBYS GIRL RAG a 04 F – 6.3.17.A very solid blue mitted Ragdoll female showing good head lines and large forget-me-not blue eyes set wide and slightly oblique and with the desirable fuller lower line. Well boned limbs, strong long body and a lovely dense plushy coat which was well presented. Sweet and gentle temperament.
