AC EXOTIC TABBY OR TABBY & WHITE ADULT BOB HARROP'S GRCH SHAKIRAH NIGELLA CLAWSON

A very pretty spotted tortie tabby 1y 9 m old. Round head, neat ears, large round expressive orange eyes. Plush coat well broken with shades of red and her spots were just visible when viewed from a distance. Cobby build and a good weight. She was very easy to handle and well shown.

GRAY'S GRCH ONNYDALE BEAUJANGLES

A very handsome male, lovely balanced type. Today something must have spooked him as he wasn't very happy to be handled, such a pity, hope he is soon back to normal.

ORIENTAL SECTION

IMPERIAL CLASS AC GRCH ORIENTAL MALE IMP JONES' GRCH SARAMESE SUMMER SENSATION

Handsome 20 month old blue spotted male. An old friend judged him many times so I was pleased to award him this high award. Well balanced head, moderately long wedge, almost straight profile. Well positioned large flared ears. Expressive green oriental eyes, correct bite and reasonable chin. He did look far better in his pen as he has developed rather a shy disposition so not too happy out of his pen. Strong physique, elegant body, slender legs and a tapering ringed tail. Dark blue coat, back was a little solid, good facial marking, his spots were sound but showing some linkage with just a touch of agouti. Well shown and in lovely show condition.

2ND TASKER'S GRCH LORICHA BUNDOOK BOY

A mature black silver shaded LH male just over 5 years old. Pleasing type if a little feminine. Short wedge, slight dip to profile, moderately large ears. Good bright green oriental eyes, correct bite, chin does fall away a little. Unfortunately his coat was showing lots of tarnishing to his face, along his spine and to his feet. So I had no alternative to withhold his certificate. He handled well and shown in good condition.

IMPERIAL AC GRCH ORIENTAL FEMALE IMP WEBB'S GRCH CHANTEUR SHADY LADY

An attractive shaded tortie LH really 2.5 years old. I have had the pleasure of judging her several times, I was so pleased to award her the qualifying certificate, my congratulations to owner & breeder. Very stylish head type, even wedge, good profile, plenty of width between well furnished, large flared ears. Very expressive bright green eyes, level bite and fair chin. Not a long coat but well prepared and good texture. Shading just about visible with top coat showing lovely tortie colours. Elegant build, a little shy but handled okay.

RES IMP HELM'S GRCH VELVETENA FAWNYKACHON

A very attractive ,fawn female 2y8m old. She was such a friendly cat, showing off and so easy to handle. Well balanced head, even wedge, broad nose, almost straight profile, very slight pinch to muzzle. Plenty of width to top of head between large flared ears. Bright green, expressive oriental eyes, level bite with chin just falling away a touch Even mushroom coloured coat, sound to roots and lying close over body. Elegant build, long lean body, slender legs and good length tapering tail. Well shown in super condition

HAVANA ADULT MALE

1ST CC BOB HIRST'S TOGAR YANKEE DOODLE DANDY

A very young male only days over 9 months old. He was a strong chap well grown for age. Good balanced head, even wedge, slight dip to profile. Wide top of head between large flared ears which complemented the length of his wedge. Bright green oriental eyes, slightly deep set. Correct bite with chin falling away slightly. Rich dark brown coat, it was sound to roots with a healthy shine. Strong elegant build, a confident young male , easy to handle and he did show himself off well.

FEMALE

1ST CC ROBERTS' ENIGMATIC KISSESOFFIRE

Pretty female just over 11 months old. She was rather nervous, looked far better when she was settled in her pen. Moderately long wedge, slight dip to profile, flared ears which were quite well positioned (when she relaxed) and they did balance the length of her wedge. Green oriental eyes, level bite with a little more strength needed to chin. Sound dark brown coat lying close to body and it was in good condition. Elegant feminine build, lean body, slender legs and a good length tail. Rather a wriggly female.

2ND JONES' MESBELLES MADEMOISELE COCO

A young female of 10 months. She was a little over awed by the occasion, much happier in her pen peeping out from under her blanket. Even wedge , almost straight profile, she did hold her ears very high, I did leave her for a little but they wouldn't come down. Bright green eyes with a very worried expression, rather full but again this was down to nerves, hopefully she will realise we mean she no harm, grow in confidence and show herself better. Elegant shape, rich dark brown coat it was sound and had a good shine to it.

HAVANA NEUTER

1ST PC BOB EDWARD'S HEMLOCK AVANTADOR

Very friendly young male just a month over a year old. Medium wedge, broad nose, with some fur missing, he had been in the wars, it did rather spoil the overall appearance. Large flared ears, following the lines of his wedge. Bright very oriental eyes slightly deep set.. Level bite with chin falling away just a fraction .Lovely shiny dark brown coat, short and sound to roots. Strong elegant physique, lean body, slender legs and a long tapering tail.

SIAMESE SECTION

IMPERIAL CLASS AC SIAMESE/BALINESE GRCH

IMP PALMER'S GRCH DRESTOTHRIL DEBUSSIE

The only one in the class but a worthy winner. A mature seal point male nearly 6 years old. Stylish masculine head, long wedge, strong profile. Plenty of width between his large flared ears which balanced the length of his wedge. Bright blue oriental shaped and set eyes. Missing teeth but bite looked level with quite a firm chin. Strong male, elegant build and shown in good condition. Dark seal points and his coat was quite shaded but still a fraction of contrast. He was a very friendly chap plenty of confidence showing himself off very well.

CHOCOLATE POINT SIAMESE ADULT
1ST CC BOB JOHNSON'S MERRYTAIL MISS SOPHIA

Pretty chocolate point female just over a year old. Moderately long wedge, slight dip to profile. Fair width to top of head, quite well positioned large flared ears. Mid blue eyes, oriental in shape and set. Correct bite beautiful strong white teeth, chin a fraction weak. Warm dark chocolate points, a little surface shading to short body coat. Elegant build, very well shown and so easy to handle.

RED POINT SIAMESE ADULT
BOB TOTTEN'S CH GELCUNE TOUCH OF GOLD

Handsome 1y 8m old red point male. Masculine head, broad nose, slight dip to profile, fair width to top of head between moderately large flared ears. Oriental mid blue eyes, level bite with chin falling away just a little. Pale red points, body coat could have been slightly shorter but it did lie close to body. Strong build and he handled very well.

TORTIE POINT SIAMESE ADULT
BOB BROCK'S UK OBIGC KARAMUSHI TUTI FRUITY

I judged her a couple of weeks ago at the Scottish show and she is still looking very attractive and shows herself off very well. My choice for Best Siamese adult a worthy winner.

STOKES UK OBIGC LITTLEFEAT POWDERFINGER

Another beautiful seal tortie a little younger at nearly 5 years old. Very much down to personal preference as they were quite evenly matched both with very impressive titles. Would have liked the red in her coat to be a warmer shade, as a tortie breeder/owner I do like to see a lot of bright red in a tortie's coat.

CHOCOLATE POINT SIAMESE KITTEN
1ST BOB GURNEY TAYLOR TINKERTAYLOR BIZZY LIZZY

Very pretty chocolate point female kitten just 5 months old. Short even wedge, almost straight profile, wide top between quite large flared ears. Mid bright blue oriental eye. Scissor bite but she may have been in the process of cutting back teeth, chin was a little weak. Quite well developed points of warm chocolate, virtually clear body coat.

GRAND CLASS AC SIAMESE/ BALINESE PREMIER
GRPC GREEN'S PR BELROO MONTALBANO

A handsome fawn point male 1y5m old he is such a wimp, I just wish he believed in himself and gained a little confidence. Strong medium length wedge, slight dip to profile. Good width between balancing large flared ears. Bright blue oriental eyes, correct bite chin just falls away very slightly. Well prepared coat, matching mushroom/fawn points, virtually clear short coat. Good physique, long lean body, slim legs and a long tapering tail. I believe this was his final ticket my congratulations to his owners.

RES ROBINSON'S PR BEWYCHEN PRINCELING MING

An attractive 20 months old seal point male. Stylish head, even wedge, slight dip to profile and a small pinch to muzzle. Bright deep blue eyes oriental in shape just held a little full. Wide top of head between large flared ears which balanced the length of his wedge. Warm seal points, slight pigment loss to mask, perhaps an old injury. Some toning shading to his short close lying coat. Strong physique, elegant neck carriage, long body, slender legs and a long tapering tail. A confident exhibit well shown and easy to handle.

TABBY POINT SIAMESE NEUTER

BOB JOHNSON'S GRPR SULALAYA ICEWARRIOR

Very stylish lilac based caramel tabby point male nearly 3.5 years old. Good head type, lovely bright blue Oriental eyes. Well marked points with very slight shading to his well prepared coat. Very good build, well toned body. Long and lean. Well prepared for the show. Judged him a few months ago but today he was more relaxed and very good to handle.

GRCC ENTWISTLE'S CH GABLME LAWAN KANIKA

What a fuss pot, beautiful chocolate tortie, nearly 2 years old. She was such a friendly cat just wanted to be stroked and petted. Even wedge, wide top of head with nicely positioned large flared ears. Bright green oriental eyes, level bite and fair chin. Lovely coat, short and sound, warm chocolate well broken through out with various shades of red with an attractive pale red blaze to face. Elegant build well shown.

1 ST CC BRANSBY HEMLOCK NAMAQUA DAISY

An attractive 10 m old brown spotted female. Stylish head, even balanced wedge, good profile, plenty of width between large flared ears which complemented the length of her wedge. Expressive green oriental eyes. Level bite and fair chin. Black marking on a

warm brown ground. Clear facial markings, necklaces, spine was broken,. A little linkage on one side ,spots sound just a little agouti. Bracelets to legs and a nicely ringed tail. Well made young lady, elegant long body, slim legs and a ringed tapering tail.

2ND ELLIOTT'S SERAPIS ALLTHATIAM

Another young female ,a pretty 10 month old blue spotted tabby. Short even wedge, almost straight profile, tiny pinch to muzzle. Fair width to top of head between balancing flared ears, which she did hold a little close. Bright green oriental eyes, a fraction full. Short well prepared coat, dark blue marking with a mid beige ground. Clear facial marking and necklaces, spine lines starting to break. Spots were reasonably sound just a little linkage , nicely ringed tapering tail. Well build female, elegant shape. She was very confident and showed herself off very well.

3RD BAUERFEIND SHIMILEETA BLAMEITONTHRAIN

The oldest in the class , a attractive brown spotted female nearly a year old. Short wedge, slight dip to profile, large flared ears. Bright expressive oriental eyes, correct bite chin falls away a little. Short coat, black markings against a fairly warm ground . Plenty of spots reasonably sound just a little agouti, broken spine lines, well defined bracelets and necklaces and a nicely ringed tail. Petite female and a little slender today perhaps she had been calling. Well shown and a little nervous but no malice.
