**WESSEX:**

**AC BRITISH PREMIER NEUTER**

GR PC IMP GR CH & PR HINDERSLYNE HECATE (BRI F) Lovely lass almost 7 years old and in very good condition looks younger! Lovely overall look to her, the head is broad across the top, to nit pick I'd like a more rounded muzzle line, excellent width between neat ears. Good fullness to cheeks. Her eyes are lovely and rounded, pale orange in this light, expressive too. Short straight nose and good bite. Close coupled cobby body of excellent muscle tone and development supported ably by short thick legs and a lovely British tail. Super short dense crisp coat of lovely bright reds and blacks both sound to roots. Just the 1 solid paw of pale red otherwise the others show both colours. Excellent condition!

**LILAC ADULT**

1<sup>ST</sup> CC & BOB NOT AWARDED ACTON'S IDELBECK TARARA BOOM DEAY F 10 MTHS 2 WEEKS. Rather needs more time for me to develop a british head as today she looks quite wedge headed when you look at the underlying bone structure. Very broad top of head that tapers to a narrow muzzle with jowls rather than cheeks. Medium ears set well apart but a trifle wide at base. Deep golden eyes a wee bit straight across the top, nice expression and set well apart. At the moment her head is out of balance with a very long body, supported by tall legs that are quite well boned. Good substance. Her coat today is uneven in lengths too, rather long and flat lying and lengthens down the back too so its possibly changing. Almost a sound almost fawn toned lilac in the lighting which has natural daylight so it will be interesting to see how the colour develops. I do hope she comes together as she matures.

**BLUE ADULT MALE**

1<sup>ST</sup> CC NOT AWARDED JOYCE & GARDNER'S XZIBIT DUTCH-COURAGE 1YR 8MTHS. A cobby lad of good size and lovely type with excellent eye colour almost copper orange eyes and fat cheeks complimenting his lovely round head. Excellent top of head too and fairly neat ears. Good build and very nice bone. Sadly, his coat is far too silvered and is too long as it lays flat and is very soft. Such a pity as the coat is totally incorrect at the moment.

**BLUE ADULT FEMALE**

1<sup>ST</sup> CC & BOB BLAGDON'S REVODNA ANABELLA 9MTHS A nice looking lass a trifle long bodied ably supported by well boned medium length legs at the moment, needing to fill her frame. Round head just tapering a wee bit at the muzzle, full cheeks not jowls. Eyes are rounded and set well apart and of a promising deep orange. Short broad nose, good bite and chin. Very short crisp nicely toned shade of mid blue coat with minor silvering just at the tips, good density and texture. Rings to her short thick tail.

### **BLUE NEUTER**

CONSIDERED FOR BOB AND AWARDED TO: ALLEN'S GR PR JOCOCA CREDIT CRUNCH MN 4YEARS. Big strapping masculine broad face lad of lovely type, bone and substance. Excellent copper eyes too. Just a mite soft coated but nice and dense and short.

### **BLACK SILVER TABBY NEUTER**

CONSIDERED FOR BOB AND AWARDED TO: BRASSINGTON'S GR PR TIGATAILS SILVER DONALD MN 2YRS 2 MTHS. Slightly greyish black pattern at the moment, possibly seasonal. Nice clean contrast of pattern to the ground though. Light green eyes and pleasing type.

### **BLACK CHOCOLATE OR CINNAMON TORTIE NEUTER**

CONSIDERED FOR BOB AND AWARDED TO:HEMMING'S IMP GR CH & PR HINDERSLYNE HECATE- See above report.

### **BLUE- CREAM, LILAC OR FAWN TORTIE NEUTER**

CONSIDERED FOR BOB AND AWARDED TO: HOPGOOD'S SUP IMP GR PR PINEMARTIN TINA SPARKLE Beautiful lilac tortie sadly getting very tetchy nowadays, need a rest I feel from the show bench.

### **SELKIRK REX NEUTER MALE**

CONSIDERED FOR BOB AND AWARDED TO: MINSHALL'S PR ACOZNI AUNTIELEAONIE (SRL d 33 ) Lovely balanced Selkirk with correct muzzle and superb tight waves to her coat. Nice doming to the head too.

### **RED BURMESE NEUTER FEMALE**

CONSIDERED FOR BOB AND AWARDED TO; BELL'S UK IMP GR VH & PR HOBBERDY MEDORAS GOLDBERRY (BUR d) Lovely lass who has super vibrant red tines to her sleek coat.

CONSIDERED FOR BOB: SMITH'S UK IMP GR PR JANZANCO ZINFANDELLE Nice type but not quite as vibrant tones to her coat today.

### **SH AOC OR PATTERN CAT MALE**
