AC GRAND PREMIER BIRMAN NEUTER FEMALE.

GR SCOTT'S CH & PR AREZZA TRULY SCRUPulous.

(SB1a) (13c1) (FN) 22.2.09. A mature six year old four month old Sealpoint Lass of a good size and weight. Nice length to the body well boned, the quite bushy tail balanced the body. Broad head with medium sized ears. Ears well apart. Almost round eyes of a good blue colour. Slight dip to the nose profile. Her well developed cheeks scissor bite and firm chin. Head well balanced. Coat of a nice length well prepared. Silky texture. Pale coat, slightly shady, there was a nice Seal brown colour to all the points. Her seal mask to the face, slight bridling to the tail. Green white gloves and socks to the feet. The white gauntlets were of a nice length, tapered and matched well. She was a little huffy today.

ADV JH GRAND PREMIER NEUTER MALE.

GR - WATTS'S PR EMANAN BEN JAMMIN-SUNNY.

(50Lc) (632d) (MN) 14.12.13. A well grown eighteen month old Libe Somali Lad just verging on plump. Firm like muscular body, legs in proportion to the body with oval feet lifted between the toes the slightly tapering nose

furnished tail balanced the body. Moderate wedge to the head, proportionately large ears, picked and well cupped, set wide apart and in a good position. Large almond shaped eyes set slightly obliquely and well apart, of a good amber colour, slight break to the nose profile. A shallow indent formed the muzzle, level bite, firm chin. Excellent head balance. Coat of a good length well prepared, fine and soft in texture, the undercoat was of a mushroom colour nicely ticked with blue giving the coat a warm dove grey appearance. A lovely lad, good temperament.

RESER - EMERY'S CH & PR NOYNAROCK GANDOR.

(NFO 2521) (GT. 18P) (MN) 8.3.11 A four year and three month old Cream Silver tabby Norwegian forest lad of a very good size and weight. Long body well boned and muscled standing tall on the back legs. The tapering gait well furnished tail balanced the body. Triangular shape to the head with nice sized ears, held high and open and fitting into the lines of the head. Nice sized greenish yellow eyes set slightly obliquely, long straight nose in profile, just slightly bulbs to the sides, level bite, quite strong chin. Head nicely balanced. Coat of a good length well prepared showing a reasonable weather undercoat covered by a good shiny coarse textured top coat; lovely temperament.

POTTS'S CH & PR ISADORAION FIRED UP NEGADY.

(MCO 0322) (GT. 41EW) (MN) 7.4.13 A two year and two month old red classic tabby and white Maine

Coon had of a good size and weight. Long body well boned and muscled, the well finished tapering tail balanced the body. Broad head with large ears well feathered and tufted, held high on the head. Nice sized round golden eyes of a slightly oblique aperture and set. A very shallow concave curve to the nose and showing a uniform width. Cheek bones high. Square muzzle level bite, chin of reasonable width and depth, very slightly recessed. Head quite well balanced. Coat of a reasonable length well prepared, shaggy belly and breeches, not real classic tabby pattern or an apricot ground colour. Classic pattern fairly clear. The pristine white over to the muzzle, bib, tummy and legs. Good temperament.

JCC & BOB - HOLDEN-RITCHIE'S YAHESKA PANGUR BAN

(MCO 464) (64.14c) (M) 13.8.14. A lovely young ten month old green eyed white head of a nice size and weight. Long body well boned and muscled, the well finished tapering tail balanced the body. Broad head with large ears well feathered and tufted held high on the head. Nice sized round yellow green eyes of a slightly oblique aperture and set. nose of a very shallow concave curve and uniform width. Cheek bones high. broad square muzzle. level bite, good width and depth to the chin. Very good head balance. Coat of a reasonable length well prepared, soft texture, fairly substantial top coat, belly and breeches shaggy. the coat was pristine white. well presented, good temperament.

2nd. HOLDEN'S NAVARRI NOBBY NOMATES

(MCO d0322) (64.41dw) (M) 17.7.14 A young eleven and a half month old real classic tabby and white head of a reasonable size and weight looking a little rangy and adolescent at present, needing to fill out; the quite well furnished tapered tail balanced the body; broad head with large ears well feathered and tufted and held quite high, nice sized round golden eyes of a slightly oblique aperture and set. The nose displayed a VERY shallow concave curve to the profile with a uniform width. cheek bones high. square muzzle, level bite, fair width and depth to the chin, near level. Head balance still needing to come together. Coat of a fair length well prepared, soft texture, belly and breeches shaggy, looking a little undercoat and substance, glossy top coat: rich red tabby pattern on an apricot ground color. Good classic tabby pattern, the patches white areas were to the chin, bib, tummy and all feet: Good temperament.

AOC MAINE COON ADULT FEMALE1st / CCWH SMITH'S WIZARKIT POPPY

(MCO d22) (64.41d) (F) 29.6.13. A two year old real classic tabby lass of a medium size, but lacking weight and muscle tone, back bone a little prominent the quite well furnished tail tapered and balanced the body. fair breadth to the head with large ears well feathered and tufted, held high on the head, nice sized round golden eyes of a slightly oblique aperture and set. The nose showed a slightly exaggerated curve to the profile, of a uniform width, cheek bones high, the muzzle

was square but a little narrow level bite, good width and depth to the chin, not quite level. Head needs more balance. The coat was out of condition, looking sorry, reasonably shaggy belly and breeches, lacking undercoat and substance; Rich red tabby pattern on an apricot ground colour, the coat displayed a fair classic tabby pattern, Good temperament.

MAINE COON SILVER TABBY SERIES NEUTER FEMALE.

PC & BOB - RABBY'S COONFLAKES PENNY-LANE

(MCO FS 03 23) (64 44 esw) (FN) 1.8.14. A young eleven month old silver tortie mackerel tabby and white. Less of a good size and weight. nice length to the back were boned and muscled, the tapering were finished tail balanced the body. Broad head with large ears were feathered and tufted, held high on the head. large round yellow eyes of a slightly oblique aperture and set. nose of a shallow concave curve and uniform width. cheek bones high. broad square muzzle, level bite, nice width and depth to the level chin. The head showed good balance. Coat of a nice length very well prepared, soft texture, nice silver ground colour showing off a dense black tabby pattern which in turn was nicely overlaid with tortie coloring. The coat to the sides & flanks displayed a clear mackerel tabby pattern. Some lines not so clear down the back, tabby markings to the face, ringed tail. The pristine white areas were to the muzzle, chin, bib, tummy and legs. A lovely girl quite well behaved.

(NFO a 09) (67.31a) (MN) 24.7.14. A young eleven month old blue and white head of a good size and weight. Long body well boned and muscled, standing tail on the back legs, the tapering quite well finished tail balanced the body. Triangular shape to the head with nice sized ears held high and open and fitting into the lines of the head. Nice sized hazel eyes set slightly obliquely. Long nose fairly straight in profile. Level bite and quite firm chin. Head quite well balanced. Coat of a reasonable length needing more show preparation, classy and knobby to the underside, woolly underneath, glossy coarse textured top coat, Good temperament

2nd. EMERY'S SKOGVENNS SMOKIE JOE.

(NFO AS 09) (67.31s) (MN) 24.7.14. An eleven month old black smoke and white head of a good size and weight. Nice length to the body well boned and muscled, standing tail on the back legs, the tapering quite well finished tail balanced the body. Triangular shape to the head with nice sized ears held high and open and fitting into the lines of the head. Nice sized hazel eyes of a slightly oblique set. Long nice straight nose. Slight pinch to the muzzle, level bite, fairly firm chin. Head quite nicely balanced. Coat of a reasonable length in need of more show preparation. Tatty in appearance fairly woolly underneath and a quite nice coarse textured top coat. He was slightly nervous today..

Quite nice length to the body well boned and muscled, standing tall on the back legs, the tapering well finished tail balanced the body. Mangular shape to the head, with nice sized ears, held high and open and fitting into the lines of the head. Nice sized green eyes of a slightly oblique set, nose straight in profile. Level bite, quite strong chin. Head well balanced. Coat of a nice length well prepared, showing a good woolly undercoat and a glossy coarse textured top coat. lovely temperament.

(SIB n 03 21) (82.31c) (FN) 22.7.08 A stunning mature six year and eleven month old Brown tabby and white loss of - very good size and weight. Rectangular body well boned and muscled, broad chest, short neck, well boned legs with rounded well tufted paws. the slightly tapering well finished tail balanced the body; short broad wedge to the head with medium sized ears, well finished and set well apart. Large hazel slightly oval eyes showing a slightly rounded lower line, slight concave curve to the nose profile. excellent wide low set cheek bones adding to the gently rounded contours, level bite, fine chin,

Excellent head balance. Coat of a good length very well prepared, showing a dense soft undercoat and a coarse textured top coat. The coat displayed a nice brown tabby pattern and the white areas pristine. Super girl, lovely temperament.

1st LIEWELLYN'S CH BENDILAYN TOODLE PIP.

(SBI/A)(13c1)(F) 1.1.13. A two and a half year old Seal point Birman lass of a medium size and weight. Her bushy tail balanced the body. Broad head, medium sized ears set well. Almost round eyes of a good blue colour. Slight dip to the nose, well developed cheeks, level bite, firm chin. Head well balanced. Coat of a nice length well prepared, silky texture, pale coat, golden hue. Nice seal points. Firm musk. Even white gloves and socks. Nice length gauntlets tapered and matched well. Good temperament.

2nd BROWN'S NANDINAKATT'S LADY EDITH

(NFO 95 09 23)(67.44g 52)(F) 2.2.13 A two year and five month old blue tortois silver mackerel tabby and white Norwegian forest lass of a medium size and weight. Reasonable length to the body, standing tall on the back legs. The tapering nicely furnished tail could have been a fraction longer. Triangular head, nice sized ears, head high and open. Nice sized green eyes set well straighter parallel to the nose, level bite, firm chin. Head nicely balanced. Coat of a reasonable length quite well prepared, reasonable undercoat and a coarse glossy top coat. Good temperament.

1st FINNEY'S NANDINAKATT'S NEWHORN CHEESECAKE

(NFO 109 23)(67.442)(M/F) 11.10.14 An eight month and three weeks old brown mackerel tabby and white

Norwegian forest head of - good size and weight - long body standing tall on the back legs, the quite well furnished tail balanced the body. Triangular shape to the head, nice sized ears, held high and open. Nice sized hazel eyes set well, straight nose, level bite, chin could have been a little firmer. Head quite well balanced. Coat just needed a fraction more finish to the underside and behind ears, woolly underneath with the cause for coat developing. Good temperament.

(PER 03)(12/1)(FN) 17.509 A stunning mature six year old dominant tortie and white girl. Good size and weight. Cobby stature. Short full tail. Broad rounded head, excellent type and balance, large bold round eyes of a near orange colour. Small nose. Bite excellent, full cheeks. Firm chin. Full coat excellently prepared, soft and free flowing, super red and black patches very well defined, the white areas pristine. Red and black to the face and tail. A beautiful girl, lovely temperament.
