Imperial Class for Cornish Rex /Devon Rex/ La Perm Grand Premier Female

IMP /Lovell's GrPr Calonlan Honey (LPL b, 21/32) 29/04/07

Mature girl of eight yrs plus.,a real honey one of the sweetest exhibits you could hope to meet "slightly short " modified wedged head with strong blunt muzzle and good whisker break, expressive eye line, cupped ears set well with good width between. Good body confirmation, balanced limbs and tail. Medium length coat"soft " springy texture.What a delightful lady

Grand Class for Devon Rex Premiers Male

Gr/Pr/ Puckrin's Pr Assiya Cyber Esper (DRX bs 21)19/10/12

Solid boy.Strong head with good width across cheeks, short wedge with well defined whisker break, fair stop,level bite /good chin, typical Devon expression. Large wide at base well set ears. Firm powerful body with high limbs and thick based tapering tail in balance. Well covered in soft evenly rexed coat.Handled well,lost weight since last we met, looking good

CornishRex Untitled Adult Female

C/c/ Robbie's Pixiepurrr China In Your Hand (CRX n,03/33) 09/06/14

What a delightful name for this girl she certainly was, ears large and set well on head of good length and width, "slight "bump on profile (nose end). Expressive eyes of good set,shape and size. chin sloping a little but her bite's level. Slender elegant body lines,tall limbs,nicely textured rippled fully covering coat. Not the biggest but all in proportion and weighty for her size, delicate girl with lovely nature

Exhibition with Critique only Female

Brown's Boonlands Iris. (IMP) (DRXf 21) 18/08/14

Basically of good Devon type, lovely tufted ears of good size /set and shape. Fair stop in profile short wedged wide cheeked head with good whisker break. Firm chin, bite level.Typical expressive Devon eye line. Firm muscled strong boned body, slender neck, large feet. Good length to thick based tapering tail.Long shaggy coat, albeit rexing is apparent it's a little rough/harsh in texture, suede on stomach. Excellent temperament, good condition, handled very well. Good all over Devon type could contribute to the breed but would have to eliminate the coat problems

Devon Rex Kitten Under 6 mths Female

1st Chalmers Peppadora Harbour (DRX gs 21)02/04/14

Sweet girl who handled well and seemed to enjoying her day out. Her ears are of good size and shape, would just like her to hold them a little lower, wide cheeks /short wedge and good whisker break,slight stop in profile, firm chin and level bite, typical Devon expression to well set and nicely shaped eye line. good body development for age and in balance with high limbs and thick based tapered tail. Her coat on body needing to develop rexing, albeit her paws nicely covered. very well presented exhibit, just needs to drop her ears

Devon Rex Kitten 6-- 9 mths Male

1st BoB Linton -Sinclair's Edemlen X-clusive(IMP) (DRX d 02) 01/12/14

Super natured boy so easy to judge. Large wide based ears set well with good width between,fair stop in profile. chin slopes just a little / level bite, short wedged wide cheeked head, strong whisker break, expressive eyes set well, just eight months old, of good size and he has firm muscle, good bone, proportionate limbs and tail. his coat fully covered with well defined even rexing

Devon Rex Kitten 6-9 mths Female

1st Watson's Cherek Brownie Points (DRX n, 32) 31/01/15

Lovely natured girl with firm body lines. large ears of good shape and size, she has a tendency to hold them a little high but there is good width between. Very expressive wicked eye line. Would like just a little more defined stop in profile. wide cheeks and short wedge, good whisker break, firm chin, Level bite. Coat fully covered, needs to develop more rexing and there is evidence of guard hairs

La Perm Untitled/ Neuter BoB only

Bob Lovell's Gr/Pr Cloudborn Barb Dwyer (LPL b 25) mn 13/05/13

Elegant lad with large well placed ears, expressive eye line, very well set and of good shape and size. gentle profile and chin has good depth, head just "slightly " long in wedge. Nice body limbs and tail confirmation . Coat soft and springy, loosely curled with plumed tail.

Also considered Lovell's Gr/Pr Canlonlan Honey / the boy just edged it on coat
