AC PERSIAN GR CH ADULT MALE

IMP GR CH Vujasevic & Wharton's GR C Lafrebella Obama – Black

At just over two years of age, this is a very nice young cat. He has a good round head, with a broad topline and well set ears. His eyes are large, round and deep orange in colour. Short broad nose, with a full leather and good open nostrils, nicely rounded cheeks, firm chin and good bite. He has a short cobby body, and short thick, well boned legs, with his body shape balanced by a short full tail. His coat is medium length today, silky in texture and well prepared and quite sound for the time of year. Later went **Best in Show AOC Adult and Overall Best AOC Exhibit**.

AC PERSIAN GR CH ADULT FEMALE

IMP GR CH Roberts' GR CH Alaskan Blue Spice – Blue

A pretty, feminine girl with a round head, well placed small ears. She has round, expressive orange eyes, shortish nose, round cheeks, a good chin and slightly undershot bite. She has a good cobby body with good body weight, well boned legs and a short tail. Her coat had a lovely soft texture and had been very well prepared, sound and pale blue in tone.

AC PERSIAN GR PR NEUTER MALE

IMP GR PR Fairs' GR PR Lafrebella Ortez – Orange-eyed White

A superb cat, looking magnificent today. He has a very wide top of head, with neatest of ears set well down and into the contours of his head. Round, deep orange eyes, short broad nose, beautifully rounded cheeks, firm chin and fractionally undershot bite. Excellent, substantial cobby body, excellent boning to his legs and large feathered paws. Short full brush. Very long, full coat indeed, very well prepared. I can only marvel at the dedication of owners of a big white boy with such a wealth of coat. Lovely show presentation, well done on winning **Best in Show White Neuter**.

WHITE (BLUE-EYED) ADULT

BOB Roberts' CH Alaskan China Doll

Round head with nicely set ears. Large round eyes of good even blue. Shortish nose, round cheeks, good firm chin and slightly undershot bite. She has a very good cobby body shape, and short well boned legs and a full brush. Her coat today was shortish in length, pure white and very well prepared.

BLUE ADULT MALE

1st, CC WITHHELD Hawke's Zenith Virgil

Just a youngster at 13 months of age. He has a very nice round head, ears are quite neat and nicely set. Round orange eyes, short broad nose, nicely rounded cheeks, good chin and fractionally undershot bite. Cobby body shape and short tail. His coat today was too dark, being slate blue in tone, too short and had the appearance of having been scissored, so looked very patchy, shady and uneven – my reason for withholding the ticket today.

BOB Roberts' GR CH Alaskan Blue Spice – Female

AOC NON-SELF EXOTIC SH KITTEN

1st & BOB Pearman's Simcris Jezebel – Black & White Female

Just approaching 6 months of age, this pretty girl has a good round head, nicely placed ears, round eyes with the colour still developing, short broad nose, good full leather and open nostrils. Her pattern shows a white V to her face, a full white collar and she is nicely patched, the black areas are a little unsound at present, but the coat has a very nice length and density. Some attention needed to neatening the stray white hairs on the tips of her ears and edges of coloured patches (always a lot of show prep work with Bi-Colours). She has a nice firm cobby body, well boned legs and short thick tail.

WHITE (ORANGE-EYED) NEUTER

1st, PC & BOB Lovesey's IMP GR CH Persilus Mr Bigglesworth

A beautiful cat in fantastic condition. Round, masculine head, good broad top and good ear size and set. His eyes are large, round and deep orange in tone. Short broad nose, good full cheeks, nice firm chin, bite fractionally undershot. He has a substantial cobby body, that is firm and muscular, very well boned legs and a short full tail. His beautiful white coat had been prepared to the nth degree, it has fantastic length, and a very silky texture, so that it flowed and with every hair separated – so impressed with the great show prep on this boy!

AV HP IMPERIAL GRAND MASTER CAT MALE

OLY Brock's IGMC Alikat Paccino – LH Silver Tabby Pewter

Only one exhibit in this class, but a very worthy winner. This is a super boy with a lovely round, doll face and large, expressive green eyes. He has wonderful body condition with a strong, muscular frame and strong legs with large round paws. He has a medium length coat that is silver toned with shading and some tabby stripes. The texture is excellent, the preparation and presentation being first class. He is a laid back guy with a lovely temperament and handled very well.
