It was an exceptionally heavy book & I sincerely hope that exhibitors were not too disappointed re the judge change (& I am sure some were), though it is impossible to avoid such things.

This is likely to be my longest ever show report, be warned.....before you start. My apologies that some may be out of order but this was due to the additional classes on the day, welcome to my version of 'War & Peace'. Exhibitors have a little sympathy for the poor judge who has to go home when the show is finished & then do their homework in the form of a report on the exhibits judged. The actual judging is the fun part; the reports are a bit onerous & much less enjoyable.

Olympian Adult, Female;

OLY PROUT'S OB IMP GR CH FERGAN GOODNIGHT KISS. BRI f. 10-10-10.

Black Tortie British, though alone in the class, this girl was well worthy of her certificate. Her type is excellent, having round head shape & well developed fullness to her cheeks, round in the brow, broad nose, good chin & bite. The ears are placed well apart & look neat & tidy. Eyes are well open & round, the colour a pleasing deep bright orange. Body is chunky & square in shape, very compact, with strong legs & round paws, medium length tail. Her coat was short & dense, minimally soft but considering her gender & time of year was well within what I considered acceptable. Beautiful rich vibrant colour with lots of bright red in the black. Her condition was splendid & her temperament was beautifully relaxed & composed, warranting her award

Persian Imperial Grand Champion, Male;

IMP GR CH Not Awarded. 1st MORRIS'S GR CH & INT CH SHEERBLISS

FABIO. EXO d 24. 31-03-12. Red Spotted Tabby Exotic, not the largest of males which was made more evident by being out of coat. Head is round, with rounded cheeks, round on the skull, well defined stop, snub nose, well formed nose leather, chin was both broad & good depth, his bite was almost level. The ears small & placed wide & low on his head. Large eyes well open & round shape, with a good degree of boldness, vibrant coppery orange colour. His body was looking rather narrow this was compounded as he was also rather high on the legs, requiring a little more substance overall. He will hopefully look much improved when back in full coat, as his is currently very loose & shedding heavily & as such lacking in density & the required full of life quality. I would ideally prefer his colour more vibrant, & he possibly left his spots at home as he was not wearing them today, typically paler muzzle area, the facial tracings could

also be a little more defined, slightly better leg bars, fair tail bands but the contrast lacked distinction. His condition was sound & the temperament was excellent.

Non-Self Persian Grand Champion, Male;

GR CH CRAIG & BELL'S CH SUNLIT GEORGIE (imp). PER es 12. 15-10-13. Red Silver Tipped Cameo, Beautifully boned lad of excellent substance overall. Head is broad & he has full well developed cheeks, slightly heavy brow to his round broad skull, excellent stop, short snub nose, full well shaped nose leather & large nostrils, good depth chin, his bite a little under but nothing excessive. The ears are quite small & set wide apart, neat appearance. His eyes are well open & fully round shape, good degree of boldness, deep bright orange colour. His body was short, with good breadth to his chest, low on the sturdy well boned legs, large paws, balanced short busy tail. His coat was well prepared & the length was good, full frill, it was lively & stood well away from the body. He had excellent silver undercoat, with generally light tipping though a little heavier on the top of his head, shoulders & flanks to some degree, clean silver frill, chest, tummy & beneath his tail, completely free of barring. His condition excellent & such a composed good natured chap.

Persian Imperial Grand Premier, Female;

IMP GR PR EMPEY & JOHNSTON'S GR PR SHEERBLISS TOUCH OF CLASS. PER ns 03 11. 07-12-10. Black Shaded Cameo & White Persian, this girl was not in full coat & will look much improved when it is back to its fuller length. Her head was well rounded Her cheeks nicely rounded, round skull, well defined stop, her chin firm, bite marginal undershot. The ears were small & neat, set well apart, some longer furnishings to the interiors. Eyes were a well rounded shape & larger size, with a good degree of boldness, the colour a deep copper tone. Not the largest of girls but generally all in proportion, her body is cobby, low on her legs, round paws, tail moderately short though not as bushy as I would ideally prefer. Her coat I would prefer longer & the undercoat needs a little more fullness to give lift, texture was soft & fine, would also benefit with more frill to create more frame around her face. The shading was impressively even with the exception of some tarnish on her left shoulder, a clear silver undercoat, this contrasted well against her clean white areas. Her condition was excellent & she had such a sweet disposition.

RES IMP GR PR Not Awarded. 2nd EMPEY & JOHNSTON'S GR PR

SHEERBLISS ROZANNE. EXO d 03 22. 31-01-11. Red Classic & White Exotic, rather small girl who required more weight & substance, the body lacking little in depth & I would like her heavier boned in the legs & paws, her tail was also somewhat fine. Her head was round & her cheeks well filled, round skull, deep stop, her nose short but the nose leather small & narrow, with tiny nostrils, chin good, bite undershot. Not in the best of coats, it was short & very loose lacking in density to give it plushness & lively quality it requires particularly at this level. She is also in my opinion not Classic pattern with her body pattern in spite of the lack of contrast consisting of a combination of linked spots & bars as opposed to classic tram lines & oysters, the white was clean & had good contrast as a result, the white evident on her face, chest, tummy & paws. Her condition & temperament were both excellent.

Non-Self Persian Grand Champion Female;

GR CH Not Awarded. 1st CRAIG & BELL'S CH PETOVIA TAISSHA (imp) PER fs. 20-05-10. Black Tortie Smoke (or should be) but in my opinion is Black Tortie Shaded Cameo. Excellent head type, fully round, well filled cheeks, skull rounded, excellent stop, short nose, her nose leather a good size & well formed nostrils, strong chin but quite badly undershot & constantly tipping her tongue as a result. Her ears are set wide apart & low on her head & are small & neat in appearance, light ear furnishings. Eyes are large & bold well open shape, deep coppery orange colour. Body was beautifully developed, broad chest, low on her strong legs, quite a full bushy tail. Her coat was beautifully prepared, pleasing soft texture & with a good amount of frill. The colour was NOT typical of a smoke, the undercoat was reasonably clear with what was a more shaded top coat towards the surface of the coat, with deepening colour to her mask & tail, lighter frill as was her chest & tummy, she has lots of red present, particularly over her shoulder & mid back area, the reds for a silver series cat less muted than usual, deeper colour on her hocks. Her condition was splendid as was her temperament, her mouth & colour problems either being sufficient on their own to justify the withholding I'm afraid.

AC Exotic Grand Champion, Female;

GR CH CRAIG & BELL'S SHEERBLISS MIRACLEOF JOY. EXO ns 24. 18-05-12. Black Silver Spotted Tabby Exotic, though with some seasonal coat issues I felt there was sufficient to justify her award. Head shows very pleasing type, it was round, the cheeks well filled, round skull, excellent stop, short nose, I would prefer her nose leather & nostrils a little larger chin has good depth & breadth, her bite very slightly under but not excessively. The ears were small, still to widen a little more ideally but when her new coat comes in this may look much improved. Body was well proportioned overall, with good legs & paws, balanced moderately short tail. Her coat though not at its best showing some seasonal looseness, she was generally still showing quite good pattern elements, it could ideally have a little more plushness to give better stand away quality. Ideally her silver ground colour could be a little clearer, that said the pattern was still good, with well defined facial markings & good leg bars, tail bands are also good with quite well defined spotted pattern on the body. Temperament was excellent & her condition was sound.

Persian Imperial Grand Premier, Male;

IMP GR PR EMPEY & JOHNSTON'S GR PR SHEERBLISS NUKIDONTHEBLOCK. PER ds 11. 10-06-12. Red Shaded Cameo, I thought this lad looked quite impressive & was my vote for Best Persian. He was looking in fine form & has excellent substance & bone overall, his body was compact & well muscled, excellent weight, short strong legs large round paws, bushy moderately short balanced tail. Head is masculine & broad with rounded full cheeks, broad round skull, excellent stop, his nose leather was well formed & he has large nostrils, good depth chin, he was reluctant to have his bite examined though it is minimally under, albeit nothing excessive. Ears are small with well furnished interiors, could ideally be a little wider in set perhaps. His eyes are beautifully bold being well open & round & a good larger size, intense deep copper colour &

very expressive. The coat was full & well prepared & stood well away from the body, full frill soft silken texture. His coat was showing a good mantle of red colour over his silver ground colour, with clear silver on the chest, tummy & beneath the tail, with silver white ear furnishings & frill showing through. The actual colour was a pleasing muted red very light leg barring. He was in wonderful condition & his temperament was superb.

AC Exotic Grand Premier, Female;

GR PR GUILFOYE'S PR SHEERBLISS ADALINA. EXO fs 22. 20-04-12. Black Tortie Silver Classic Tabby, Excellent type, head is beautifully rounded, the cheeks full & well developed, round on the skull, excellent stop, her nose leather adequate, with good nostrils, chin was good & her bite virtually meets. The ears were small & placed wide apart & low on the head, neat & tidy. Her eyes are large & round with well open shape creating a bold appearance, the colour really intense, beautifully expressive. Body was well developed, quite cobby & compact, good legs & paws, balance quite short tail. Still some old coat present & there was still some seasonal looseness, but there was still a lively quality about it & a reasonable degree of stand away from the body. Her facial tracings are good, broad legs bars & wide tail bands, body pattern a little more diffused due to the red present. She has a slight amount of Tarnish (not red) present, but enough to diminish overall, I would prefer the silver ground colour a little clearer ideally, showing a reasonable amount of red, black up her heels. Her condition was excellent & her temperament also.

RES GR PR Not Awarded. 2nd GUILFOYLE'S GR PR SHEERBLISS PRECIOUS MEMORY. EXO fs. 18-02-13. Black Tortie Smoke, this girl had most impressive type. She is beautifully rounded & has full round cheeks, broad round skull, deep stop, short nose, strong chin & sadly badly undershot exacerbated by tipping her tongue constantly. Her ears were small set wide & low, fitting into the head contours. Her eyes are large & well open with wonderfully bold appearance deep intense copper orange colour. Her body was cobby & compact, legs are short & strong, very good balanced tail. Her coat was standing quite well away from the body, it was soft & was still showing a reasonable degree of liveliness. Though I would have preferred more obvious clear silver undercoat to give more defined contrast to Tortie top coat which was a combination of black with varying shades of more muted red. Her condition & temperament both excellent.

AOV SLH Grand Champion, Male;

GR CH GUGGENHEIM & LENNOX'S CH KIRSTEGEMS TEDWARDO ED RAG d 04. 20-02-10. Red Mitted Ragdoll, this lad was truly beautifully prepared & a dream to handle even though he was a little worried about the experience. He has excellent width across the cheeks, well developed cheeks, good flat brow, his profile requires more evidence of gentle downward curve & retroussé tip to the nose, chin was good, level bite with chipped upper canine. His ears were medium size, hint of forward tilt, medium size, with good internal furnishings, set well apart. His eyes were a pleasing larger well open shape, in a gentle oblique setting, the left was a little watery, beautiful deep bright blue colour. His body was well developed, & has good muscularity, deep chest, well proportioned legs & paws, bushy medium length tail. The coat was a good length, the presentation quite splendid, it was beautifully prepared, excellent density & soft

fine texture. Showing some ruff & full knickerbockers,. He has a lovely warm tonal glow to his body colour, which does not in any way detract from his points colour of bright coppery red, slightly paler stockings on the front as is often the case, difficult to ascertain his white chin, white mittens & to the line of the body on the back legs. He was in lovely condition & in spite of his reserve he was such a gentle good natured lad.

AV Foreign Imperial Grand Premier, Male;

IMP GR PR SCOTT'S GR PR TYPHAST QUICKFLIP. BEN n 24. 11-07-08.

Brown Spotted Bengal, very pleasing lad overall & much more impressive out of the pen. His head was typically marginally smaller in relation to his body size. His head was showing good width, with his cheeks well defined, puffed whisker pads, gentle rounding to his head with slight break in profile, firm chin bite level. I would ideally prefer his ears a little small & he carries them a little higher than I would have preferred. His eyes are large & full oval shape, good green to the colour. Good neckline, body is well muscled, & showing excellent development & weight, strong legs & large paws, his tail moderately thick though it could be a tad shorter ideally. The coat was medium length & excellent density, with a lovely soft texture. He has an excellent pattern elements, which show as a combination spots & rosettes, his facial markings were quite dramatic, well defined stripes on the cheeks, spotted whisker pads, complicated scarab on the brow, excellent leg bracelets & tail bands, black heels & tail tip, paler spectacle area beneath the eyes, the contrast to his deep ruddy ground colour with rich apricot undercoat was excellent & he also had a very good amount glitter evident also. His condition excellent, just a tiny bit temperamental.

AOV Grand Premier, Female;

GR PR CLARKE'S PR CRYSTAL TEMPLE NEYTIRI. BEN n 24. 20-03-13.

Brown Spotted Bengal, Extremely attractive girl & was the main contender for BOB in the actual breed class though she was a somewhat less than keen on being handled. Excellent body she was long & beautifully firm, possessing good depth overall, her legs were strong, round paws, her tail was moderately thick & a medium length,. Head was showing good rounded shape, with high cheeks, quite broad muzzle with prominent whisker pads, her brow is rounded there is a slight break in profile, her chin was firm, difficult to check her bite, achieved after the third attempt & it was level. The ears are medium size & are well set with width between. Her eyes are fuller rounded oval shape & are an excellent green colour. Lovely coat, it was a sleek short dense medium length, texture beautifully soft. She has deep ruffus ground colour with bright apricot undercoat, excellent facial markings, spotted whisker pads, well marked cheek ribbons, good 'M' & scarab on the brow, her body was showing mainly rosettes with some complex elongated barring on the shoulders, clear leg bracelets & clear tail bands, all beautifully contrasted, black heels, black eye rims. Somewhat feisty temperament, her condition was wonderful.

Persian Red Self Neuter, Male;

1st PC & BOB. EMERY & JOHNSTON'S SHEERBLISS RED ADMIRAL. 01-07-13.

Handsome chap with lovely brightness his colour. Head shows excellent round shape with his cheeks filing out well, skull is broad & well rounded, showing

excellent stop, short snub nose, the nose leather is well shaped & he has well formed nostrils, the chin is both broad & deep, his bite a little undershot but nothing excessive. His ears are set well apart, they are proportionately small, with good interior furnishings evident, tidy in appearance. His eyes are large & fully round in shape, set well apart & have an excellent deep intense coppery colour, all of which enhance their bold appearance. His body is compact & show good depth, pleasing short appearance, low on his sturdy legs good size tufted paws, bushy tail. Coat was good length & well prepared, it flows well & stands well away from the body, showing a good degree of frill, with full breeches. His colour is rich & bright it was also impressively sound & virtually devoid of pattern. He was in excellent condition & he was very self assured & relaxed.

AC Colourpointed or Mitted Ragdoll Kitten; Not sure what happened the exhibits appear to have become mixed up but I actually think it was the details as opposed to the actual exhibits as none of the information tallied with the exhibit concerned, I think this exhibit was actually the adult Female Neuter & the name is more in keeping with a boy & the exhibit was in my book as a M/N & the exhibit exchanged with no. 33 who was actually a Seal Mitted young Male Neuter, but was down also as Blue Tortie with a more feminine name, particularly as the Female Neuter was also down as Blue Tortie, all very odd, as a result the I will report on both.

1st & BOB. MONTGOMERY'S ADIFTON PRINCE DEXTER. RAG g 04.

09-02-15. Blue Tortie, after the change, I genuinely do not think this was the kitten, nor was she a male neuter, but can only assess what is available. Her type with the exception of her profile was very pleasing. Her head has quite good width across the cheeks, muzzle well developed, she has a flat brow, her profile is almost straight & lacks evidence of downward curve to create the required slightly retroussé effect to her nose (but this is not a withholding fault, at Kitten, CC or PC level), chin & bite both good. Ears medium size, well placed. Her eyes were in a gently oblique setting, well open & a pleasing even bright blue colour. Body was typically feminine in development but more in keeping with a year old as opposed to 7 months, good legs & paws, medium length bushy tail. Her coat was a good length with overall good preparation, short ruff as yet, good knickerbockers, silken texture. Body was showing some shading, but there is still abundant contrast to her points which show both colours, the blue is rather dark & the cream a little hot, difficult to state with accuracy as to whether she conformed on the white but I couldn't state she did not. Her condition was excellent & she was a very gentle miss.

The young male who was initially in the pen & changed as being incorrectly penned was a most impressive in his development (assuming he was 7 months) but was let down quite badly by his eye colour. He has excellent type overall showing width across his cheeks which are filling & rounding, good muzzle, his brow was reasonably flat downward curve to his nose, firm chin, level bite. The ears are placed well apart & a good medium size with slight touch of forward tilt. Eyes are well open slightly oblique but rather pale in colour & this is further exacerbated by having a large amount of green wash over a large portion of the eye. Excellent body which was firm & good weight if 7 months, strong legs, tufted paws, balanced bushy tail. Coat was a good length & was beautifully

prepared, the ruff developing well excellent knickerbockers, silken texture. His body was virtually clear, with excellent contrast to the points, he has a white chin which appears to extend through his throat, chest & tummy, white mittens, white to the level of the hocks but with a small patch of seal on the right. Wonderful condition & super temperament. If adult small but if 7 months well developed.

Lilac or Chocolate Birman Neuter,

PC & BOB Not Awarded, 1st MULLALLY & HAMILL'S TULLYPAWS

PRINSTON. SBI b. 04-03-13. Chocolate Point, handsome lad & generally beautifully prepared with the exception of a major knot under his left armpit which was very tight & lumpy as a result. His head was showing mature development, with good width across the rounded cheeks, well developed muzzle, round skull, slight dip to his nose, chin tapers slightly, bite good. He has medium size ears which were placed well apart. The eyes were almost round in shape, quite a good depth of blue. Solid weighty chap with good muscularity, broad chest, strong bone to his medium length legs short paws, medium length tail could have a little more bushy appearance. His coat was a very good length & was soft & fine, with a good degree of density, some ruff, with the exception of the know mentioned & spot of something I could not ascertain on one of his back socks, the preparation was very good. He has warm hue to his light clear ivory coat, excellent contrast to the points, good sock & reasonably well matched socks, his gauntlets a little irregular & appear to have a runner up into the thigh area for the left. He was in lovely condition, handles well but for a short period only.

Thai Blue Point or Lilac Neuter;

1st PC & BOB. JEFFERS'S SERRENOL LOVING MIST TAI c. 12-09-13. Lilac, this chap was beautiful soft colour. Ideally the head could show more heart shaped appearance which is due to lacking a little in width, the muzzle is good. Flat forehead, slight downward dip to the nose, excellent chin & bite. The ears are moderately large & set quite high, sparse interior furnishing. I would prefer the eyes to be larger to create a greater degree of dominance, lovely green colour. Body is medium in build, reasonable semi-cobby appearance, slim legs, small oval paws, broad base to the tail tapering to a slightly more pointed tip & correct medium length. His coat was single & lays well, just breaking a little on the lower back, soft texture. The colour was beautifully even & very subtle & soft, the tone was verging towards fawn, there was some silvery sheen just evident. Condition & temperament both excellent.

AC Ocicat Neuter;

1st PC & BOB. WHITE'S ALLSPOTS ELEANOR RIGBY. OCI bs 24. 20-02-14.

Chocolate Silver Spotted, well grown mature looking girl with the typical wild appearance which is desired. Head shows a moderate wedge being a little longer than wide, with gentle curve from the broad muzzle (which has quite a good squarer appearance) to the cheeks, she has a slight rise at the bridge of the nose with a very slight dip in profile, her chin was firm & her bite level. Quite large ears, which are set at angle though possibly not 45 degrees, slight rounding to the tips. Her eyes have a gentle slant to their full wider almond shape, most attractive golden colour. Body is beautifully grown with lithe & athletic

appearance, she is long but her weight may require watching, well muscled legs & oval paws, quite a good length tail with a very slight taper. Her coat was again quite a reasonable shorter length & close, pleasing satin like texture. Well marked facial tracings with paler spectacle area round the eyes & also paler muzzle area, line break over her back, broken spine line, the body spotting consisting of mainly thumbprint shaped spots along the body with better bulls eye formation on one side (can't remember which & I forgot to note), the spotting was a little more blurred than I would have wished, more clarity to her leg barring, tail rings better towards the tip which is solid chocolate, with deep chocolate heels, she has chocolate coloured eye rims & paw pads, slight amount of tarnish but nothing excessive. Super condition & a gentle temperament.

Brown Spotted Neuter, Male;

1st PC & BOB. O'LOAN'S ZAWADI DUSK. 09-07-13. This male looked remarkably impressive but was not the most co-operative & I had to go back a number of times to fully evaluate him. He has excellent masculine head type showing a rounded wedge, high cheeks, good puffed whisker pads to his muzzle, strong chin, not particularly keen on having his bite looked at (hence the number of visits to check), though it was actually level. The ears were smaller medium size, set well apart, rounded tips. His eyes are large near round full oval shape, with dark rims & excellent green colour. He has a strong neck, hard muscular body of excellent length, well boned strong legs, round paws, his tail is moderately thick with slight taper to the tip, medium length. Wonderful coat, short & with excellent density, beautifully soft texture. Lovely facial tracings, with paler spectacle area around the eyes, spotted whisker pads, multi cheek ribbons which almost meet beneath the chin, excellent 'M' & scarab on the brow, broken spine line his body pattern consists of numerous rosettes & spots along the length of his body, excellent leg barring & multi tail bands. These are all sharply contrasted against the rich golden tawny ground colour with a most impressive amount of glitter enhancing the colour further. He was in super condition, though his temperament could be better, but an impressive exhibit nonetheless.

2nd CLARKE'S CRYSTAL TEMPLE THORIN. 15-10-14. Very young & as a result somewhat outgunned by the maturity of the competition & he has a good deal of head development to achieve before he catches up. Head as yet still somewhat kittenish, he is presently a little long & he has still to widen a little more in the cheeks, his muzzle though has a good degree of prominence having puffed whisker pads, he requires slightly more rounded brow, slight break evident, his chin firm the bite good & he has widely set canines. His ears are a little tall as yet, still to widen more fully (in keeping with his young age to some degree), I would prefer them a little smaller. He has large wide oval shaped eyes, with a pleasing green colour,. His body is beautifully developed & already has excellent weight & muscle, with well proportioned legs & good size round paws, his tail is a little longer than I would wish & could be thicker, He has beautiful ultra soft coat texture, it was short & dense & an impressive feature. He has an excellent warm ruddy ground colour, with intense rich apricot undercoat, showing excellent pattern contrast, with some linkage over the shoulders, some rosettes with triple colour present, well broken spine line, gorgeous leg barring & tail bands, black well up his hocks, & also the tail tip, his facial markings are

very defined, spotted whisker pads & strong cheek flashes almost linking up to form a chin strap, complicated scarab on the brow. He was also showing some glitter when the light caught his coat, He was in splendid condition, but not terribly keen on other cats.

Brown/Blue Tabby Series Maine Coon Adult, Male;

1st CC & BOB Not Awarded. 2nd HAWTHORNE'S ANAMCARAMAINE JARVIS.

MCO n 22 03. 16-06-14. Brown Tabby & White, it gave me no pleasure to withhold the 1st on this lad, sadly his complete lack of presentation did him no justice at all, I would have liked to see the exhibitor to explain this but due to my extremely heavy book & time schedule there was no opportunity. His head is a little longer than wide, reasonably cheek development, his muzzle had a reasonable degree of prominence, with an impressive set of whiskers & eyebrows also, slightly heavy brow but the profile shows slight concave curve at the bridge of his nose, his chin was quite deep though it could be wider, his bite was splayed & a little overshot. His ears were large with good longer furnishings at their wide base, set tall with tufted tips. His body is as yet rather narrow & rangy looking long & lean as opposed to rectangular, still to deepen & broaden more fully, strong legs, tufted paws, good length tail but requires fuller furnishing. The coat length was generally good but the lack of proper presentation was a major concern & he was covered in knots & tangles particularly on his tummy where there were lots of matting which will possibly require cutting out. He has white on his muzzle, chest, tummy & paws which could be more pristine. He was a gentle lad but in my opinion not in show condition.

Her colour is quite a dark sound blue & lacked the required silvery sheen which may yet develop hopefully. Her condition was excellent & though a little worried she was very gentle.

Head looks much better out than he did in the pen, head is round & the cheeks are quite well filled, round in his brow, broad nose, his chin was firm (like the boy above I did not examine his bite, for the same reasons). His ears were small & neat, set well apart fitting into his head shape. His body was looking a little narrow, & he could be a little

broader in the chest, legs & paws both good, moderately thick tail of medium length. His coat was laying a little flat & required a greater degree of density, it was also a little softer than I would have preferred. His ears are moderately large & set tall & pricked, lightly furnished interiors. Eyes were a fuller shape slightly more leaning to oval than almond an excellent green colour. He is somewhat lanky at present, but he is firm & developing well, with good length, long legs, oval paws, broad base to his gently tapering tail of good length. His coat requires more evidence of double coat quality as though very soft top coat, it required a little more density to the undercoat. He was a rather dark blue colour which was even, though still to acquire more evidence of silvery sheen. He was in super condition & his temperament was excellent.

Beautifully round head shape, well developed cheeks, round on the brow, short broad nose, good chin & bite. Her ears were well placed & quite small fitting well into her head shape. Large round well open eye shape, green colour, slightly irritated expression. She is a little over her best weight (okay quite a lot), cobby & square, low on the strong legs, round paws, tail a little short to balance. Her coat was very dense & has a good degree of crispness to it, but very loose & a little dry at present, it was also rather scurvy with lots of dandruff present on the surface. Her pattern was excellent but was rather grey as opposed to black & the silver ground colour could be clearer to give sharper crispness. Very good facial tracings. Her condition was excellent, likes the last word or bop as the case may be.

His ears are medium in size, these could perhaps be a little wider in set, rounded tips. His eyes were large, I would ideally prefer a little more depth of curve to the lower line, the colour has faded a little to a greener phase of chartreuse. Body firm medium length, slim legs oval paws, slightly shorter length tail with rounded tip. Beautiful coat, it was incredibly close & beautifully sleek & also a good shorter length. It was beautifully glossy & an attractive rich chocolate & with very little contrast to the extremities. Super condition & a lovely composed temperament.

1st PATIENCE'S GIRONA LONESOME. SIA n. 24-04-15. Seal Tabby Point Siamese, balanced even young miss who looked very even without undue flash. Her head is medium length wedge, which possessed virtually even lines, near straight profile, she is teething quite badly at the moment, her chin good. The ears are moderately large & set well though I would prefer a little more flare to their base ideally to give a greater degree of impact. Her eye have a gentle oriental slant, marginally wide, excellent depth of blue to their colour. Her body was firm & in keeping with her young age & development, with proportionate slender limbs, neat paws, well balanced length tail. Her coat was close lying & a good shorter length, with sleek well prepared finish. The body was a light beige tone, with generally good Tabby tracings, tail rings could be a little more defined, with some brindling in this area. The Seal could ideally be a touch warmer. Lovely condition & her temperament was confident & alert.

The eyes are showing a somewhat wider shape with pleasing slant & a good depth of green to the colour. Firm body which was well toned, slender limbs, small neat paws, her tail is quite fine & near balanced length. The coat was a good shorter length & was beautifully sleek & close lying. She was a beautifully dense jet black & was sound to the roots, with an excellent glossy sheen. Her condition & temperament were both excellent in spite of being a little reserved.
2nd SHORTHALL'S SIAWYE HAPY. OSH n. 05-04-15. Black, litter sister to the above, but a little smaller. Head was showing a slightly shorter wedge with small pinch, her profile has a slight break, chin & bite good, appears to be teething still.

I would like her ears larger & she is a little inclined to prick them a mite high, she also requires more width to their base. Slightly fuller eye shape which require more evidence of slant, the colour still in the process of change to true green. Body smaller than her sibling but still firm, with proportionate legs & paws, her tail fine but needs a little more length. Coat was a little long but nevertheless close lying though it required a little more sleekness. The Black was not as glossy as her sibling, but was dense, I detected 3 white hairs in groin area which she needs to lose. She was a little panicky out of the pen, excellent condition.
