BURMESE SECTION

AC Burmese Grand Champion Female (Imp Gr Ch):

Imp Gr Ch & BOB: Patience's Gr Ch Girona Sweet Pickle (Bur j)

A really stunning lilac tortie of excellent type. Gently rounded dome between ears that are of good shape and set. Rounded brown, short nose, good nose break and firm level chin. Eyes are of good shape and set, chartreuse yellow in hue. Short wedge. Firm, muscular body with close lying coat that is a delightful mingling of shades. Dainty limbs and neat oval paws. Tail a fraction short for balance.

AC Burmese Grand Champion (Gr Ch) Male:

CNJ Patience's Ch Aureus Emer-Detour (Bur e)

Such a shame that this boy was too cross to handle. He looked lovely in the pen but we saw too much of his tonsils for safety.

AC Burmese Champion (Gr Ch) Female:

Gr Ch & BOB: Stewart's Ch Penelope Pitstop (Bur n)

A little restless and wriggly but judgeable. Lovely rounded dome between ears that are well shaped and set. Rounded brow, slightly long nose, good nose break and discernable wedge. Shallow chin. Eyes of good shape, when she settled back in the pen. Chartreuse green in hue. Firm body with close lying coat of warm brown hue. Tail of correct length for balance. Dainty limbs and neat oval paws.

AC Burmese Grand Premier (Imp Gr Pr) Male:

Imp Gr Pr & BOB: De Largy's Gr Pr Emer Alfredo (Bur b)

A handsome boy of very good type. Slightly rounded dome between ears that are well spaced and set. Rounded brow, good nose break, short nose, short blunt wedge, and firm, level chin. Short, wide wedge. Expressive eyes are well spaced apart and of good shape. Pale, chartreuse yellow in hue. Firm body with tail of good length for balance. Close lying coat of warm chocolate hue, rich and even in tone with richer dark chocolate mask and ears. Satiny in texture. Sturdy limbs and paws.

AC Burmese Grand Premier (Imp Gr Pr) Female:

Imp Gr Pr & BOB: De Largy's Gr Pr Emer Sapphire Blue (Bur a)

A sweet, gentle girl with a typical Burmese expression. Sister to the chocolate boy
Rounded dome between ears that are well shaped and set. Rounded brow, good nose
break, short wedge and level chin. Well set and shaped eyes, green chartreuse in hue.
Firm, muscular body with tail of medium length. Close lying pewter blue coat, silky in
texture and with lovely silvering. Dainty limbs and neat oval paws.

AC Burmese Premier Male (Gr Pr):

Gr Pr Hawthorne's Pr Emer Sundancer (Bur b)

Slightly flat dome between ears that are well set apart. Head is a shade long, good nose
break, firm, level chin. Eyes are well set apart, of good shape and chartreuse yellow in
hue. Wedge shade long. Firm, muscular body with clear, coat of rich, dark chocolate,
and a darker mask and ears. Tail balances. Sturdy limbs and oval paws.

Brown Burmese Adult Male:

CC: Patience's Girona Teddyboy (Bur n)

A nice looking boy. Slightly rounded dome between ears that he was holding a bit high
at first, but settled when back in the pen. Slightly flattish brow, nose rolls off a fraction
and has a slight bump. Level, shallow chin. Eyes are of good shape and set, greenish in
hue. Firm body with close-lying coat of rich dark brown hue, tail a fraction short for
balance. Sturdy limbs and oval paws.

Blue Burmese Adult Female:

CC & BOB: Hawthorne's Adburtbu Silver Mistletoe (Bur a)

A very laid back lady with a big purr. Gently rounded dome between ears that are well
shaped and set. Slightly rounded brow, good nose break, level, shallow chin. Good eye
shape and set, yellow chartreuse in hue. Firm, muscular body with tail that just balances.
Short, close lying coat, pewter blue in hue, satiny in texture and with lovely silvering.
Dainty limbs and neat oval paws.

AOC Tortie Burmese Adult:

CC: Patience's Girona Daisy-Mae (Bur j)

Stunning lilac tortie girl. Very good dome between ears that are well shaped and set.
Rounded brow, good nose break, short wedge. Level bite and firm chin. Short, close
lying glossy coat with a delightful mingling of hues. Tail of good length for balance.
Dainty limbs and neat oval paws. A very typical naughty tortie expression on her face!

Brown Burmese Kitten Female:

1st & BOB: Hawthorne's Adiftbu Boadiccea (Bur n)

A friendly girl who was enjoying her day out. Nicely rounded dome between ears that are
well shaped and set. Rounded brow, short nose, blunt wedge. Firm level chin. Eyes are
stunning. Well shaped and set, a lovely chartreuse yellow in hue. Firm muscular body
with short, close lying, clear coat that was mature for her age. Dainty limbs and neat oval
paws. Tail only just about the right length for balance.

HOUSEHOLD PET SECTION

AC Household Pedigree Pet Imperial Grand Master Cat Male:

Oly: Stewart's OG & IGMC Dawn Patrol

Huge cream self long hair five year old boy with an attractive, but masculine, face. His heavy body has a dense coat, well groomed. Long fluffy tail and gorgeous tufts on his (huge) paws.

AC Household Pedigree Pet Imperial Grand Master Cat Female:

Oly & BIC: Copes' IGMC Ally

A lovely mature girl, just over seven years old, with a stunning short, brown tabby and white short hair with a lovely tabby marked soft coat that was very well prepared. Tall ears and big eyes give her a slightly amazed expression! Long tail. Very well presented.

AC Household Non- Pedigree Pet Grand Master Cat Male:

Imp & BIC: Copes' GMC Pepper

A lovely tabby and white boy that was very laid back and enjoying himself. Firm, muscular body has a lovely coat, which was well prepared, close lying with a spotted tabby pattern. Long tail and sturdy paws.

AC Household Non-Pedigree Pet Master Cat Male:

Gr MC & BIC: Tennant's MC Maximus Quintus

A superb brown tabby boy with mesmerising vivid green eyes. Semi-long coat, of rich brown, has lovely markings. He has very attractive tufty ear furnishings and attractive tabby markings on his face. Very gentle and a delight to judge.

AC Household Non-Pedigree Pet Master Cat Female:

Gr MC: Watson's MC Patsy

Very pretty, somewhat small girl with bewitching green eyes in her pert, alert face. Perfectly proportioned body with a lovely soft, black and white longhair coat, silky to the touch. Long tail and dainty paws. Beautifully groomed.

Ginger SH/any pattern or AC Tortie or Tortie Tabby:

MC & BIC: Siribor's Paris

A very well prepared, attractive tortie tabby, shorthair girl She has a lovely personality and purred non-stop. Lovely marked face and (very) firm body. Long, dainty limbs and very elegant tail.

2nd Skelly's Khoshekh

A lovely tortie and white girl shorthair girl, who was a real 'calico' cat coat of dense black, rich ginger and sparkling white. I had a difficult choice here- she just missed the certificate by a whisker! I just wished I could have awarded it to both girls.
