**AV SLH GR CH ADULT MALE; IMP GR CC; Aggett GR CH ISADORYOU DEAR DARLIN** brown classic tabby and white Maine coon of almost two years old. A very large lad with good bone and substance. Rectangular body shape. Ears are large and set quite high with a good width apart and long tufts. High set cheek bones with the cheeks fairly full. Square muzzle. Slight concave curve at the nasal bridge. Level bite. Eyes with a slightly oblique aperture and set and green in colour. Nice breadth and depth to the chin. Lovely sheen to the coat with a good butterfly to the shoulders and oyster markings on the flanks. Small ruff to frame the face. Large tufted paws. White to the paws, chest and legs and some to the under parts. Excellent warm copper ground colour and very clear black markings. Spine line and lines across the cheeks from the corner of the eyes. Well marked m to the forehead. Tail well furnished and balancing with the body. Excellent clear pattern. Wonderful temperament.

**NORWEGIAN FOREST ADULT; 1 CC & BOB; Brewood NOYNAROCK CHLOE** blue tortie smoke of just over eleven months old. Nicely built female for her age standing taller on the hind legs. Tail balances with the body and is rather sparse today. Head of a reasonable triangular shape just a trifle short to be equilateral. Ears are of a medium size and set high and wide at the base with small tufts. Eyes are oval in shape and green in colour. She tends to puff her whisker pads. Straight profile and a level bite. Chin is fairly strong. Her head is still developing. Medium length coat lacking in undercoat today. Coarse texture can be felt near to the base of the tail and a little softer along her spine, most probably still some kitten coat present. The blue is very dark and a good cream colour, contrasts can be seen.

**NORWEGIAN FOREST KITTEN MALE; 1 Richardson NOYNAROCK GUNNARSSON** silver classic tabby and white of five months old. Well developed for his age and with the Norwegian stance. Lovely bone structure. A long tail which is still a little sparse. Head is a little short in length at present with the triangular shape still developing. Ears are of a good size and well set with nice width at the base with very good furnishings and tiny tufts. Eyes are large and well opened and amber in colour. A straight profile and a level bite. Chin almost in line with the end of the nose. Coat is still developing. White to the paws, chest and tummy with a white chevron to the face. Well marked m to the forehead and lines across the cheeks from the corner of the eyes. Tabby to the legs and a few markings to his back. Coat has some guard hairs present and the coarse texture to develop fully. Well presented.

2 Richardson NOYNAROCK SIR BEOWOLF red classic tabby and white of five months old. Nice length to the body and stands taller on his back legs. Tail balances with the body and is nicely furnished. Head has reasonable triangular shape and still developing. Medium sized

ears which are set quite high and wide at the base, no tufts as yet and fairly well feathered. Oval shaped eyes and just looking a little hooded over the eyes and this was the only reason for the placing. Amber eye colour. A shallow dip in the profile and a pink nose leather. Level bite. Lovely strength to the chin. Head still developing. Coat yet to develop the coarse texture and has limited undercoat. Several lines running over the top of the head with oysters on his flanks. Nicely marked m to the forehead and a good red colour. Paws, chest and a small area of the tummy are white. Nicely groomed.

**NORWEGIAN FOREST KITTEN FEMALE; 1 & BOB; Benner NOYNAROCK DOTTY CANDY MINT** green eyed white of five months old. Lovely bone and well built. Standing taller on her back legs. Tail reaching the shoulder blades and is quite bushy. Head of a good triangular shape. Medium sized ears which fit well into the line of the head. Small tufts to the top of the ears and nice furnishings. Eyes are oval in shape and slightly obliquely set and green in colour. Straight profile. Level bite. Chin not quite in a vertical plane with the end of the nose. Lovely balance to the head. Coat showing a nice undercoat already developing. A coarse texture can be felt along her back. Clean and white coat, pristine, excellent show grooming. An absolute pleasure to handle. I was delighted to see she went on to get best of variety SLH.

2 Benner NOYNAROCK DITZYDAISY BLUE blue eyed white of five months old and absolutely full of mischief. Lovely bone structure and nice length to the body with a Norwegian stance. Tail reaching the shoulder blades and is a little sparse. Head is reasonably triangular shape still a little short in length. Ears are well placed and set quite high with nice tufts and lovely furnishings. Oval shaped eyes which are showing a nice blue colour but I would prefer the eyes larger in size. Straight profile and a level bite. Chin a little weak. Head balanced is still developing. A small amount of undercoat. Coarse texture just along the flanks. Clean white coat which was well presented. A small black marking on the top of her head. Full of mischief and great to handle.

**RED SERIES BIRMAN NEUTER; BOB; Watkins GR PR KRYSTALTOZE GIACOMO.** Just over three years old and a lovely looking exhibit, unfortunately he was not very happy today we managed to have him out of the pen just long enough to check him over. Very good bone structure and substance. Medium sized ears which are well placed. Cheeks are quite full and the muzzle is well formed. Eyes with almost a round shape and lovely blue colouring. Slight dip in the profile. Level bite. Gloves are nicely matched. Socks even. Gauntlets broad and even in length. Lovely preparation to the coat which has very minimal shading and a good undercoat. Soft in texture. Rich red to the points which are all very well matched. Tail balances with the body and is lightly covered.

**NORWEGIAN FOREST NEUTER MALE; 1 PC Murray NOYNAROCK WINTER VALENTINE** brown mackerel tabby of just over nine months old. Very well developed for his age with lovely bone and substance and standing taller on his back legs. Tail reaching the shoulder blades and quite bushy. Head has a nice triangular shape. Ears are of a medium size and he tends to hold them down, long tufts and lovely furnishings. Oval shaped eyes which are green in colour. Straight profile and a level bite. Chin a little weak. Good balance to the head. Semi long haired coat with a small shirt front. Knickerbockers are

present and a fairly full ruff. Very good mackerel pattern to his sides. Lines across the cheeks from the corner of the eyes and a nice m to the forehead. Coat is coarse in texture along the spine and with some undercoat present. Lovely black markings on a fairly warm copper ground. Well groomed coat.

2 Murray NOYNAROCK SCOMBRINI brown classic tabby and white of nine months old. Well built and nice length to the body with a Norwegian stance. Tail balances with the body length and is quite bushy. Head is a fairly good triangular shape but he was not very happy and did not show himself off at all. Medium sized ears which are set quite high and with nice tufts. Eyes are large and well opened with a slightly oblique set and green in colour. Medium length nose with a straight profile. Level bite. Chin is not quite in line with the end of the nose. Fairly good head balance. Tends to puff out his whisker pads. Coarse texture towards the flanks. Warmth to the undercoat and nice black markings. Butterfly marking to the shoulders.

BOB; Brewood CH & IGR PR NOYNAROCK HARALD silver tabby and white of just over four years old. A large and well built lad with nice length to the body, a substantial lad and I would not want him any fatter. Standing tall on the back legs. Tail reaching the shoulder blades and bushy. Head has equilateral triangular shape. Ears are medium in size and set nice and high with a good width at the base and fitting well in to the line of the head. Small tufts to the tips of the ears. Oval shaped eyes which are green in colour. Straight profile and a level bite. Chin just falling away a little. Head has good balance. Coat showing a nice woolly undercoat and semi longhair length. Some gloss evident to the coat. Coarse texture can be felt. Shirt front and small ruff, knickerbockers are present. White to the paws, chest and tummy. Silver evident to the coat and nice black markings which are diffused on his back.

**NORWEGIAN FOREST NEUTER FEMALE; 1 PC; Benner NOYNAROCK VIOLET**

PIXIEDUST tortie and white girl of seventeen months old. Very well built girl and another exhibit whom I would not like to see gain any more weight. Standing taller on her back legs. Tail fairly long and quite bushy. Nice triangular head shape which is almost equilateral. Ears are a medium size and fitting well into the line of the head with tufts and furnishings. Eyes are oval in shape and green in colour. Straight profile. Level bite. Chin not quite level with the end of the nose. Fairly good head balance. Puffs her whisker pads. Pink nose leather. Very good patching to her coat with a vibrant red and a jet black in colour. A small amount of undercoat present.

**AOC TORTIE BURMESE KITTEN; 1 & BOB; Beaumont IOCOSA COCO**

MAIDEMOISELLE BUR h (27h) FN 15.1.15. Chocolate Tortie. Her head is in proportion with her body and she has a medium wedge which is wide at the cheek bones. Blunt finish at the muzzle. Just rounded between the ears and I would like a little more depth from the top of the skull to the lower jaw. Her brow is a little flat. Distinct nose break and a slight roll off at the tip to the nose. Chin is not quite in a vertical plane with the end of the nose. Medium sized ears which are rounded at the tip and slightly tilt forward. Fairly large eyes with a very nice rounded lower line and the top line showing a slant towards the nose, a lovely golden yellow colour. At eight months old she was well developed and medium

in size having a straight back from the shoulder to the rump. Slender legs and neat oval paws. Tail is a touch short in length and tapering to a rounded tip. A thick coat at present. I did discuss her coat colour with a breeder judge as she was a very pale cream and the chocolate was a creamy chocolate which tends to predominate. She has small areas of pale tangerine on close inspection. A warmer stronger in colour chocolate and tangerine on her face, ears and legs. At the moment she is showing quite a contrast between her mask, ears and body.

**ORIENTAL BLACK KITTEN; 1 & BOB; Cassar-Simmonds FIORDILISO JAYJAY'S JEWELS** black. Super lad who is six months old and a lovely size for his age. Svelte body with a lovely length. Slender legs and small oval paws. Body, legs and feet all in proportion. Tail is quite long and tapering to the tip. Well proportioned head with good width between the ears. A fine muzzle. Straight profile and a level bite. Chin almost in a vertical plane with the end of the nose. Ears are large and wide at the base and set as to follow the lines of the wedge. Oriental shaped eyes which are medium green in colouring. Very short coat which has a superb gloss and is very well presented. Jet black coat colour which is the same colour down to the roots. Just one or two white hairs but never the less groomed to perfection.

**ORIENTAL SPOTTED TABBY KITTEN; 1 & BOB; Brownrigg HEMLOCK HUDSON MOHAWK OSH n 24 (38) M 21.2.15.** Brown spotted. Well grown for six months old. Body, legs and feet all in proportion. Long svelte body. Slender legs. Small oval paws. Tail long and tapering to the tip. Head is well proportioned with nice width between the ears, just a touch more width at the base so as to follow the lines of the wedge. Ears are large in size. Fine muzzle and a straight profile. Level bite. Chin not quite in a vertical plane with the end of the nose. Oriental shaped eyes and green in colour which could be deeper for perfection. Short coat and fine texture which is close lying. Broken m to the forehead. Lines across the cheeks from the corner of the eyes. Spotted whisker pads. Scarab marking running over the back of the head. Broken spine line. The warm ground colour is beginning to form along his spine but yet to show to his sides. Spots to his sides with minimal agouti invasion and a nice black colour which is sound to the roots. One broken necklace and the other is starting to break. Tabby markings to the tops of his legs. Spotted tummy. Tail ringed with the tip of the tail solid in colour.

**ORIENTAL BI COLOUR KITTEN; 1 & BOB; Brownrigg HEMLOCK ALLABOUT-THAT-BASS** brown spotted tabby and white of six months old and well developed for her age. Body, legs and feet are all in proportion. Slim legs with small oval paws. Tail is tapering to the tip and a good length. Head is nicely balanced with a good width between the ears. Fine muzzle and a small dip in the profile. Just a tiny pinch in the muzzle. Level bite. Large ears which are well placed and with a good width at the base and not quite set as to follow the lines of the wedge. Oriental eye shape and a medium green in colour. Short coat of a fine texture. Colour to the back of the back right leg with the back left having colour to the front and back. Front legs are all white. White to her nose, cheeks and forehead. Ringed tail. White up her flanks and also up her shoulders. Most of the spots in her pattern are broken. White tips to her ears. I think she was in the region of 50/50 colour to white.

**ORIENTAL BI COLOUR NEUTER; BOB; Webster IGR CH & IGR PR FIORDILISO NANPEMA-NUAGE** seal point and white of nearly three and a half years old. Medium sized female whose body, legs and feet are all in proportion. Tail is medium in length and tapering to the tip. Head is quite well proportioned with nice width between the ears. Fine muzzle. Straight profile. Fairly strong chin. Level bite with the teeth quite untidy. Ears are large and with a fair width at the base. Eyes slanting towards the nose and nice blue eye colouring. White on her cheeks and forehead. Patch of colour adjacent to her nose. White to the front legs and small patches of white to the back legs. White on her shoulders and not quite a full white collar. White up her flanks. I would consider her to be around 60% colour to 40% white.

**TABBY POINT SIAMESE ADULT; CC Withheld 1; Tonkinson TENAJ SKY LANTERN** seal tabby of just over two years old and I was sorry to have to withhold but for me she was too small in size and this was my reason. Body, legs and feet are all in proportion. Svelte body. Small oval shaped paws. Tail balances with the body and is tapering to the tip. Some width between the ears and a fine muzzle. Straight profile. Chin just falling away slightly. Level bite. Ears are quite large in size and I would have preferred a little more width at the base. Oriental shaped eyes and a brilliant blue colour. Short coat which is fine in texture. Close lying to the body. Spotted whisker pads, lightly marked m to the forehead and some rings to the tail. A very minimal amount of shading to the body coat. Seal to the markings of a medium warm colour.

**CARAMEL TABBY POINT SIAMESE NEUTER; 1 PC & BOB; Glaubitz LOLUJA DRESSEDINLACE** caramel tabby point of just over nine months old. Not too happy today and had her out just long enough to check her over. Well developed and medium in size. Body, legs and feet all in proportion. Slender legs with neat oval shaped paws. Tail balances with the body length and tapering to the tip. Nice width between the ears. Straight profile. Chin just falling away a little. Level bite. Ears are quite large and with a fair width at the base, not quite set as to follow the lines of the wedge. Eyes of an oriental shape and brilliant intense blue colour. Short coat and fairly close lying. Ringed tail. Lightly marked m and lines across the cheeks. Some tabby markings to the legs.

**RED POINT SIAMESE NEUTER; 1 PC & BOB; Thorpe JOHPAS THE RED BARON** seventeen month old and with a long body and just a little rounded in the tummy, medium in size and well balanced body, legs and feet. Slender legs and neat paws. Tail is of a medium length and tapering to the tip. Head is nicely proportioned with good width between the ears and narrowing to straight lines to the muzzle. Fine muzzle. Elegant neck and a level bite. Ears are large and wide at the base, set as to follow the lines of the wedge. Short coat of a fine texture and a some gloss is evident. Reddish gold to the ears, mask and tail with the limbs just a touch lighter in colour. Minimal shading to the body coat and well presented.

**AC PERSIAN LIMIT KITTEN; 1 Hacking BALOOBOO BOND JAMES BOND** brown tabby and white of four months old. Fabulous type and huge eyes of a very good copper. Tabby markings evident. Tummy a little curly.

**AV SLH MAIDEN NEUTER;** 1 Thomas DARKTOWER ARCHIMEDES brown classic tabby and white Maine Coon. A huge lad at seventeen months old. Excellent coat pattern. Lovely cheeks and a shallow concave curve at the nasal bridge.

2 Murray NOYNAROCK WINTER VALENTINE brown mackerel tabby Norwegian.

3 Lincoln ASTROKINI ECHO-SPRING sorrel silver Somali.

**AV SLH NOVICE NEUTER;** 1 Lincoln ASTROKINI ECHO-SPRING sorrel silver Somali. Amber eyes, lovely colour and ticking to the coat, profile a touch shallow.

2 Fairbanks WENLOCKEDGE CLAUDIO seal point ragdoll. Heavy weight lad with a tiny pinch in the muzzle. Lovely eye colour and slightly oblique shape.

3 Thomas DARKTOWER MADAM MIM tortie classic tabby and white Maine coon.

**AV SLH LIMIT NEUTER;** 1 Tunstall CARLESSWHISKERS OLLIE blue colourpoint ragdoll, large lad with minimal shading to the coat. A small amount of undercoat. Some shading to the muzzle which gives the impression of a pinch, which it is not.

2 Willis RAGZNDREAMS SASSY blue tortie point Ragdoll. Lovely cheeks and a well formed muzzle. Nice type and very gentle dip in profile. Bad temper!

**AV FOREIGN KITTEN;** 1 Eames ABYDREAMES SPECSAPPEAL Blue Abyssinian only six months old but already showing lovely rounded contours. Large expressive eyes, very good mushroom to the base hair.

2 Phillips MELKELTER MYRTHUS MITRODORA Russian Blue of seven months old. A short wedge with a shallow concave curve to the profile. A good dense coat for a kitten.

3 Keen LESJAROKEE CRYSTAL CREEK brown marbled Australian mist.

4 Cross BEXBENGALS MOCKINGJAY brown spotted Bengal.

**AV FOREIGN DEBUTANTE KITTEN;** 1 Birkby BUNDARA ZUBENELGEN brown spotted Bengal with a gentle curve to the profile. Large oval eyes which are green in colour. Rich colour to the coat and very good pattern.

2 Sutton XZIBIT MISS-MATILDA Sphynx with the down to the body not yet developed. Medium wedge and large ears.

3 Lee SITHEE LEMONNEY SNICKET Russian.

**AC BURMESE NON BREEDERS KITTEN;** 1 Beaumont IOCOSA COCO MAIDEMOISELLE BUR h (27h) FN 15.1.15. Chocolate Tortie.

**AC BURMESE DEBUTANTE KITTEN;** 1 Boardman AMABILE BLUE MOTY BUR a (27a) F 29.5.15. Blue. Three months old and head in proportion to the body. Short wedge which is wide at the cheek bones. Blunt finish at the muzzle. Rounded between the ears and a fair depth from the top of the skull to the lower jaw. Slightly rounded brow and a definite nose break showing a straight nose which just rounds at the tip. Chin almost in a vertical plane with the end of the nose. Medium size ears which are rounded at the tip and slightly tilt forward. Eyes are a nice size for the head with the top line slanting towards the nose and a well rounded lower line. Chartreuse eye colour. I would have liked her a touch larger in size at this age and she has a straight back from her shoulder to her rump. Slender legs bearing neat oval shaped paws. Medium length tail which is rounded at the tip. Coat a touch long in length and clear coated. A very even tone and also a very even colour. Soft blue

grey to the mask, legs, body and tail. Some silvering around her ears. Very nice colouring for such a young baby. Coat just a little open in places.

**AC ORIENTAL KITTEN;** 1 Cassar-Simmonds FIORDILISO JAYJAY'S JEWELS black.

2 Brownrigg HEMLOCK HUDSON HAWK OSH n 24 (38) M 21.2.15. Brown Spotted Tabby.

3 Roberts METAXA DESIREE OSH q (37m) F 30.5.15. Cinnamon Tortie. Just over three months old and I would have preferred her a touch larger in size at this age with a little more length to the body. Her body, legs and feet are all in proportion. I would have liked a little more length to the head. Svelte body. Slim legs. Paws are neat and oval in shape. Tail of a medium length and tapering to the tip. Head is showing a fair width between the ears. Her muzzle is fine. Straight profile. Chin not in a vertical plane with the end of the nose. Level bite. Ears could be larger and wider at the base, not set as to follow the lines of the wedge. Eyes slanting towards the nose and a medium green in colour. Fine textured coat which is short in length. A very nice warm cinnamon brown with a good dark red to the coat. Unfortunately the coat is not sound to the roots today. Showing a mingled coat pattern. All the limbs are broken with both colours.

**AC ORIENTAL BREEDERS KITTEN;** 1 Cassar-Simmonds FIORDILISO JAYJAY'S JEWELS black.

2 Brownrigg HEMLOCK HUDSON HAWK OSH n 24 (38) M 21.2.15. Brown Spotted Tabby.

3 Davies WICCANWAYS KHALEESI OSH f (37e) F 26.3.15. Tortie. Five months old and very nicely grown for her age. Body, legs and feet are all in proportion. Nice length to the body which is svelte. Slender legs bearing neat oval shaped paws. Tail of a medium length and tapering to the tip. A nice width between the ears and a fine muzzle. Her profile has a slight dip and she has a small bump to the nose. Chin is strong. Bite is undershot. Ears large in size with a good width at the base and almost set as to follow the lines of the wedge. Oriental shaped eyes which she tends to open fully and the shape can be seen much better when she is relaxed. Coat a touch long and fine in texture. All feet are broken with both colours and the back left has minimal breakage. Jet black and good red to the coat which is the same colour down to the roots. Lovely patched coat. Nice temperament.

**AC ORIENTAL MAIDEN ADULT;** 1 Tonkinson TENAJ TIGERLILLY OSH b 11 (43b) FN 21.11.12. Chocolate Shaded. Nearly three years old and medium in size with the body, legs and feet all in proportion. Svelte body and long in length. Slender legs with neat oval shaped paws. Tail of a medium length and tapering to the tip. A nice width between the ears. Fine muzzle. Slight dip in the profile and a small bump to the nose. Chin falls away slightly. Elegant neck. Teeth are untidy. Ears are large and with a fair width at the base, almost set as to follow the lines of the wedge. Oriental eye shape and the green colouring could be deeper. Short coat which is of a fine texture and close lying. Heavy agouti invasion, numerous spots to her sides, far too much pattern. Solid dorsal line. She was not a shaded in my opinion.

**AC SIAMESE/BALINESE VETERAN ADULT;** 1 Brock UK & OSI GR CH KARAMUSHI TUTI FRUITY seal tortie point with lovely type. Some slight shading to the coat and a very friendly temperament.

**AC BALINESE NEUTER; 1 Webb PR PIPPASTRO OSAMU MURAMATSU BAL b 21 MN**

25.3.14. Chocolate Tabby Point Balinese. Medium in size and with his body, legs and feet all in proportion. Svelte body with a long length. Slim legs and small oval paws. Tail balances with the body and is tapering to the tip with a very small plume. Head is quite well proportioned with good width between the ears and narrowing to straight lines to the muzzle. Fine muzzle and a straight profile. Chin just falling away slightly. Level bite with untidy teeth. Ears are quite large and with a nice width at the base and almost follow the lines of the wedge and with small tufts. Oriental shaped eyes and a nice blue colour. Fine and silky texture to the coat and just a little short in length, lying flat along the body. Very small frill around the chin. Some lightly marked stripes to the tops of the legs. Nicely marked m to the forehead, spotted whisker pads and lines running from the corner of the eyes across the cheeks. The tabby markings are a fairly copper tone in colour. Some shading to the body which is in tone with the points colour, ivory to the chest and tummy.
