### **910b NON-SELF ORIENTAL SH OR AC ORIENTAL LH IMPERIAL GRAND CHAMPION (or cat with 1 UK GR)**

UK, BOB – ENTWISTLE'S IGRCH GABLME LAWAN KANIKA – Chocolate Tortie female

26/03/13 She is muscular but feminine and elegant and stands well on long slim legs with neat paws. Her tail is long and tapered. Lovely wedge with super set and shape to her ears. Oriental green eyes are well set and have a lovely expression. Straight profile, level bite, chin just steps back a fraction. Short fine close-lying coat has a sheen to it. There is plenty of mingling and patching of rich warm chestnut brown and shades of red. She has an attractive blaze which sets off her face. Lovely condition and temperament – but with a bit of feistiness!

### **910a NON-SELF ORIENTAL SH OR AC ORIENTAL LH IMPERIAL GRAND CHAMPION (or cat with 1 UK GR)**

UK, BOB – BROWN'S IGRCH HEMLOCK SPOTTY MULDOON – Brown Spotted Tabby male

28/03/14 He is a massive and striking boy but he still maintains good balance and elegance to his muscular body, long legs and tail. Good wedge with fairly large ears which are set to follow the lines – they are of correct shape. When he relaxes, his green eyes are of lovely Oriental shape and set – he tended to round them a bit when he was stressed but I gather he had a bruised foot, poor boy, so I hope he is now back on top form. Slight dip to his nose when viewed in profile. Level bite and firm chin. Short fine coat lies close to his body. The ground is rather cool toned due to a lot of brindling, rather than the warm coppery brown, but he has a super jet black spotted pattern, clearly visible, even down to the broken spine line. A sweet boy.

### **911a NON-SELF ORIENTAL SH OR AC ORIENTAL LH GRAND CHAMPION**

IMP, BOB – DEVLIN'S GR CH ATHELSTAN PANDAMONIUM – Black & White Bicolour male

22/12/13 A large muscular weighty boy with good body shape and balance. He has a broad triangular wedge (just noted that I wrote 'rectangular' on his report.....what was I thinking of?!!) and large ears which are of correct size to balance. He was rather nervous and he tended to hold his ears rather low at times, which just detracted from the overall look when he did it. Oriental shaped eyes are green – again he tended to stare a bit when he was anxious so they sometimes seemed rather full. Slight dip to his nose in profile, acceptable bite – a slight scissor bite with the top incisors ahead of the lower ones but they meet. He has a slight whisker pinch and his chin could be a bit

firmer. Lovely short fine close lying coat – the colour to white is balanced at about 50/50. The jet black areas are glossy and sound – he just has scattered white hairs in places. There is plenty of clean white on his head, neck and chest, running uninterrupted to his abdomen. He has a full white collar and there is white on his legs and paws. I would like to see him more relaxed!

**911b NON-SELF ORIENTAL SH OR AC ORIENTAL LH GRAND CHAMPION**

IMP – BROWNRIGG'S GR CH IDEAL CAT ZEBRA – Black & White Bicolour female

17/07/12 She is a dainty feminine female but she has good weight and muscle tone and she stands well. Balanced triangular wedge is topped by ears which are wide at the bases and rounded at the tips – correct size to balance – but she just tended to prick them forward a little so that they did not follow the lines of the wedge. She was also quite tense today so her eyes appeared a little full in shape – the colour is correct green. Her nose has a slight bump when viewed in profile, level bite and chin could be firmer. Her coat is fine but slightly long and as she was anxious she tended to fluff it up slightly giving it a more open appearance rather than lying close to her body. Correct proportions of jet black and clean white with white showing on her face and down around her neck and along her tummy to her abdomen. She has white on all four legs and paws. Tail is fully coloured. Sweet natured.

**917 AOC SELF ORIENTAL GRAND PREMIER**

IMP, BOB – MILLER'S IGRCH GRPR PASHTAN RHAPSODY – Havana female

05/08/12 A well grown muscular elegant female who has a firm body standing on long slim legs with neat oval paws. Tail tapers and is of good length. Excellent wedge with super ear set – adding to a perfectly balanced triangular look. Oriental shaped eyes are pale green in colour. Good profile. She has some teeth missing and the bite is a bit messy but it is level. Firm chin. Lovely glossy fine coat lies close to her body. The colour is sound and even and it is lovely to see an example of the warm chestnut brown, rather than some of the darker colder ones around. She is an excellent example with a super temperament.

**930 ORIENTAL BLACK PRE-PREMIER**

PC, BOB – BROOKES' DERRYLEON TEAZAS-DARKNIGHT – male

29/08/14 A large muscular weighty boy who has a good body shape, is in proportion and he stands well. Triangular shaped wedge with large well set ears following the lines. He was a bit anxious so his eyes seemed a fraction full in shape but they are well set and of good green. Fairly straight profile – he just has a slight tilt upwards where it meets the nose leather- not unattractive! Level bite and firm chin. The coat is fairly short and lies close to his body – the jet black is sound and glossy, in lovely condition. A sweet shy boy, well shown.

### **964 ORIENTAL RED PREMIER**

GPC, BOB – WELLS-McCULLOCH'S PR BUURAPHA SOLDEMIVIDA – male

28/05/14 Large, well grown elegant muscular boy – he is of good shape and balance and stands well; his tail is just a fraction short for his size but the shape is right. Good triangular wedge with large ears, well set, wide at the bases and rounded at the tips. Oriental shaped eyes slant towards his nose – a bit hard to tell the colour and they might be slightly hazel rather than green. Nose has a bit of a bump at the bridge between his eyes. Level bite and firm chin. Short fine coat is in good condition and it lies close to his body. Down his centre back it is deep sound red but it fades a bit on his flanks and shows some ghost markings. A sweet boy.

### **987 ORIENTAL TICKED TABBY PRE-CHAMPION**

CC, BOB – HELM'S VELVETENA TZARINALIBET – Brown Ticked Tabby female

16/01/15 Just an adult and she is lovely – well developed and muscular and elegant with it. Balanced triangular wedge is topped by super large ears, wide at the bases, which perfectly follow the lines of her head. She has a lovely gentle expression to her Oriental shaped green eyes. Fairly straight profile, level bite and firm chin. Super short fine close lying coat – the ground colour is fairly warm and it contrasts well with the ticking which is a fraction cool toned but really good – double and treble ticking in various areas. Impressive! She has pleasing facial markings and a clear scarab. Tail is ringed and legs show barring. Her body is already clear of any ghost markings and she has the darker dorsal shading. Very promising and I hope she does well.

### **996 ORIENTAL SMOKE CHAMPION**

GCC, BOB – CARTER'S CH ATHELSTAN ARKHAMKNIGHT – Black Smoke male

04/10/14 What a lovely boy – he has excellent type and elegance to his muscular body. His legs are long and slim, ending in neat paws and he has a super long tapering tail. Excellent triangular wedge with ears set to follow the lines perfectly. Lovely green Oriental shaped eyes. Straight profile and level bite, chin is firm. Super short fine coat lies close to his body and it is in excellent condition. Fantastic Smoke effect – the undercoat is near-white, really shouting the contrast with the black colour at the surface of the coat. The pleasing things are: wonderful contrast, no ghost markings and no loss of density to the top colour. He is a super example – no wonder he is doing so well - and sweet with it. A contender in my BOV line-up.
