Novice Level:

Chelsea Edwards and BIG BOPPER, MN, tabby: EXCELLENT. Bop is a large, placid Norwegian Forest cat which had been shown in the Pedigree Pet Section; Chelsea handled him carefully and confidently. Considering she is at Novice Level, she knows a great deal about her cat, and has excellent knowledge of how a semi-longhair is prepared for showing, and about penning and health and safety at shows. Whilst she is quite a quiet girl, Chelsea’s knowledge of the show scene is very good and she shows appropriate confidence when encouraged to speak. She does need to speak up a little!

Intermediate Level:

Rose Parr and IMPGC & GP PARRADAZY POPSTAR, BRI j33, FN, EXCELLENT. Rose’s lilac tortie colourpointed British SH was quiet and gentle, confidently and effectively handled by Rose. Rose knows quite a lot about her cat and was excellent on type and coat texture, though she does need to remember that the body colour is magnolia! She explained the need for vetting in very well indeed, and had excellent knowledge of show preparation of British cats. Rose shows good potential; she is a pleasant young woman, a little shy, but very happy to talk about her cat. Aged 15, she is looking forward to stewarding in due course.
