Thanks to them for their invitation and also to my splendid Show team, Joanne Geddes, Lilian Saxon and Tina Mullineaux, who kept me busy with the exhibits and correct in the paper work; congratulation and thanks also to the Ring Team headed by Gillian who all did a wonderful job as usual at keeping the ring up to time, the paperwork immaculate and also managed to run as usual not just three, but six Best of Variety events in the ring in the afternoon; unsung heroes all.

### **CHOCOLATE, LILAC, CARAMEL, CINNAMON, FAWN POINT SIAMESE UK & I GR CH.**

**UK GR CC & BoB to BRUNO-GRIEVE'S I GR CH FLUTTERBY CONQUISTADOR. M. (SIA b) 12.06.09.** I was delighted to see this wonderful mature male after a very long interval. He was looking splendid with a strong head, showing the tiniest pinch that gives him an innocent and youthful look, large ears, well spaced and showing well aligned flare, eyes of good blue tone, oriental shape and an appealing lively look. Superb profile, with an aristocratic curve to it, excellent masculine depth of muzzle, firm chin and irregular incisors that are basically level. Strong, lengthy body with long strong limbs and balancing tail. Coat has good close lying texture, showing wonderful points colour rich milky chocolate with dazzling contrast from his clear ivory body that in spite of his maturity remains virtually unshaded, so stunning in this breed.

Also considered for BoB. **BROCK'S I GR CH KEVELS TWICE AS NICE. M. (SIA b) 18.04.10.** I was privileged to meet and handle a second superb chocolate point male in this splendid fellow, who was somewhat bored by proceedings today, preferring to snooze rather than to star. He has a very strong equilateral head with spaced ears of good size that he tended to bonnet a little; well inclined oriental eyes with depth to the blue. Profile has two straight planes with a tiny angle at the brow, good depth of muzzle, level chin and bite. Lengthy muscular body, limbs and tail in keeping. Coat condition excellent, matched soft chocolate points, body showing some gentle matching shading, but plenty of contrast.

Only a whisker separated these two magnificent cats for the BoB. I preferred Twice as Nice's head full face, in fact, but the profile and truly splendid colour, that attracts so many points in the Siamese, shaded it for Conquistador. I do hope that these fellows' genes are being well spread around; the chocolate point world certainly needs them.

### **CHOCOLATE POINT SIAMESE PRE-CHAMPION.**

**CC to VEAL & SMITH'S LAOKIND THE WOLVERINE. M. (SIA b) 12.01.15.** Handsome youth, just adult and with youthful enthusiasm. Lengthy wedge sporting very large flaring ears spaced quite well; dreamy oriental inclined eyes of smoky blue. Profile shows a tiny angle at the brow, muzzle is

developing depth, very good even bite. Long adolescent body with muscular strength, lengthy limbs and tail in proportion. Points a bitter chocolate shade with good clear contrasting ivory body.

#### **CHOCOLATE POINT SIAMESE PREMIER.**

**1. GPC & BoB to GRAY & JOHNSON'S GR CH & PR TSAICHIN GORGIOUS GEORGE. MN. (SIA b)** 28.06.13. Lovely lad though just a touch cheeky. Elegant type with a lengthy wedge head, oriental eyes of blue that he persisted in holding slightly closed. Gentle brow angle to the profile, straight above and below. Super lengthy firm body with long limbs and tail to match. Coat close and sleek, mid chocolate points matching well. Superb clear ivory body contrast. Decided that he liked us eventually.

#### **CHOCOLATE POINT SIAMESE PREMIER Female.**

**GR PC to GURNEY-TAYLOR'S PR TINKERTAYLOR BIZZY LIZZY. FN. (SIA b)** 07.09.1. Pretty young lady with a long, even head, perhaps marginally narrow, ears of good size aligned in keeping, inclined eyes of good blue. Profile shows a tiny dent at the bridge, level bite. Slender, lengthy neck with long lithe body, proportionate limbs and tail. Sleek coat showing dark chocolate points with wonderful pale unshaded ivory body for good contrast, making a pleasing overall picture.

#### **CHOCOLATE, LILAC, CARAMEL, CINNAMON, FAWN POINT SIAMESE I GR PR or 1 UK GR PC.**

**UK GR PC & BoB to MARTIN'S I GR PC ABICASA THE ARTFUL DODGER. MN. (SIA c)** 19.01.12. Lengthy lad, solemn today who took a little while to decide that we were friends. Lovely broad top to his even wedge, with widely spaced large flaring ears, inclined eyes with depth to their blue. Profile virtually straight, level chin and bite. Slender neck, body lengthy and unexpectedly heavy; neat paws, long limbs and tail with the tiniest invisible curve to the terminal vertebra. Coat of lovely soft texture, lying close with even, mid lilac points with a very attractive pale magnolia body that shows hardly any shading. A beautiful fellow and the only entrant of this lovely colour, all too rare on today's Show benches, which made me a little wistful.

#### **TABBY POINT SIAMESE KITTEN. Male.**

**1. BoB to HUTCHINGS' WHALLEYBUSH STARGAZER. M. (SIA a 21)** 06.06.25. Blue Tabby Point. My first exhibit of the day, as we look at the kittens first so that they are ready to go off to their fun classes in good time. And what a great way to start the Supreme with a true cracker! Stunning young man with a beautiful triangular head sporting widely spaced and flaring large ears. Dreamy inclined oriental almond shaped eyes of deep blue. Strong, masculine profile with wonderful depth of muzzle, level chin and bite. Firm, well-grown-for-age body, balanced limbs, tail might be just a little longer for preference, but there is time. Clear tabby markings on his points, the hall lighting dulling blue shades, pleasing body contrast in a coat that still has a touch of kittenish length to it. Lay happily in my arms waving his paws at us. Later Best Siamese Kitten. Only just managed to resist pocketing him.

#### **TABBY POINT SIAMESE KITTEN Female.**

**1. CALLOWAY'S SIAMAZING SORINNA. F. (SIA n 21)** 19.02.15. Seal Tabby Point. Lengthy well grown girl of very good overall type. Triangular head showing a tiny pinch, lovely large widely flaring ears; excellent shape to her inclined eyes of good blue shade. Profile shows a tiny dip at present, chin aligned, bite meets. Very good long, lithe body with lengthy very active limbs and tapering tail to match. Coat shows well defined seal tracery on mask, with thumb prints, tail rings and leg bars; body shows a little shading but contrast sufficient.

### **RED POINT SIAMESE KITTEN.**

**1 BoB, to SHELDON & PEARSON'S JOHPAS HARIKANE. M. (SIA d)** 14.03.15. Lovely development to this handsome youngster – long and elegant. Triangular head shows a tiny kitten pinch as yet, lovely spacing between large ears that seem well set though he holds them a little up when agitated (which he was on the day). Eyes of good shape, blue seemed of good depth. Profile nearly straight, tiny rise over the muzzle at the moment. Superb length of body, firmly muscled, limbs and tail matching. Coat texture good. Super soft red points with dazzlingly clear pale warm white body contrast. Just a bit of a 'lad' at present.

### **TORTIE POINT SIAMESE KITTEN.**

**1. BoB to LAWRENCE'S JACKIQUE KISSI KISS. F. (SIA g)** 10.06.15. Blue Tortie Point. Very lively baby of very pleasing type. Even triangular head, excellent profile with depth of muzzle, level chin and bite. Spaced ears of good size, set in line. Lovely oriental eyes of good blue, inclined nicely. Dainty, very wriggly body, balancing limbs and lengthy tail. Soft baby coat shows points of a slightly dull shade in the Hall light, well broken by creams that are generally pale but show hints of warmth over ears and tail; pigmented areas of pads are dark maroon at present.

### **BALINESE PRE-PREMIER.**

**1 PC & BoB to BROWN'S WILLOWSILK SNOWDRIFT. MN. (BAL m)** 14.11.14. Caramel Point. Strapping youth with a delightful temperament. Medium length wedge, even, ears set nicely and are well spaced, eyes a little open in the pen with all the excitement but came down out of it, mid blue shade. Good straight profile, muzzle and chin could be a little deeper for preference, splendid teeth, even bite. Body substantial and strong, likes his porridge I suspect. Limbs strong, rounded paws, balancing tail. Delightful silken texture to his coat, a little short at present, needing a little more flow ideally, but he is probably growing his winter one. Lovely pale body to contrast with the soft, lilac based points.

I was delighted by the line up for the Best of Variety Siamese Adult which was of considerable quality; I had no hesitation in selecting as Best Adult **BROCK'S UK & OG IGRCH KARAMUSHI TUTI FRUITY F. (SIA f)** 04.08.07. This glorious lady retains terrific head type with a strong wedge, widely spaced, large ears, wonderful oriental eyes, pools of deep blue with an expression of calmness and confidence that is totally justified; she has a superb deep strong muzzle, firmly aligned chin and level bite. In spite of her seniority her body remains firm with balancing limbs and length of tail. She has balance and poise in spadefuls. Her tortie points might show just a little more depth of red to the breaks if one has to nit pick but there is warmth there on some on the head and tail. She has wonderful presence to her and I was pleased to see that she went on to be selected as Best Overall Adult, a suitable crown to her very distinguished career; congratulations to her and her owner. My runner up was an exquisite little Apricot Point, **COX'S GR CH EIREACHDAIL FHURAN. F. (SIA em)** 26.05.14, who was hard pressed by a lovely Chocolate Tabby Point, **MULLINEAUX'S CH RIOBELLE MAID FOR MULLSI. F. (SIA b 21)** 26.01.13. Each BoB winner in the lineup had great qualities and it was hard to exclude any from the ultimate awards; they, their breeders and owners should all be congratulated.
