I also had the great pleasure in judging Best in Show Persian kitten with fifteen beautiful babies to choose from. I chose an outstanding cream boy **HERRAFARESIH DOC HOLIDAY**, super type and balance for one so young with an amazing sound pale cream coat and my reserve best kitten was **OWLETTS FANCY SCHMANCY**, an extremely pretty and well typed chinchilla female. I shall follow both kitten's show careers with interest. Congratulations to both owner/breeders.

COLOURPOINT PERSIAN IMPERIAL GRAND CHAMPION

UK NEALE'S IMP GR CH CONFETICAT LADYMAKEBELEIVE (PER g 33) F 26.2.10

A blue cream colourpoint female fast approaching her sixth birthday. Lovely rounded head shape with smooth skull and good depth to forehead. Excellent width to top of head with small ears set wide and low into the contours. Bold round expressive eyes of an even mid blue shade. Short wide nose with excellent depth to break. Smaller sized but fully shaped two tone pink and blue nose leather with good width to nostrils. Full rounded cheeks and good breadth to muzzle. Bite a fraction undershot with firm deep chin to balance. Very short cobby body standing low on short thick legs with excellent definition to her bone structure for a female. Large round fully tufted paws with pink and blue paw pads. Short lightly furnished tail in proportion. She is of an excellent weight and well covered. Expertly prepared and presented coat that is predominantly soft in texture, just a little coarser along her spine line and flanks. Although she has a mid length coat her new seasons coat growth is still coming in and the few guard hairs that remain are not ready to pull in these areas. Evenly matched points to her full mask, ears, legs and tail of mid blue all broken with shades of cream. Creamy white body coat is free from any shading. Super temperament on this beautiful female and she could purr for England.

COLOURPOINT PERSIAN GRAND CHAMPION

IMP MARNOS GR CH ST JUDE TIFFANY (IMP) (PER d 33) M 1.6.12

A well developed red colourpoint boy aged just over three years. Masculine in appearance with broad, smooth and well rounded skull. Good width between neat well furnished ears, set wide and low. Large round eyes of an even pale blue shade with corneal abrasion to left eye. Short broad nose with good

depth to break and large well formed deep pink leather with wide open nostrils. Nicely rounded cheeks and good width to muzzle. Slightly undershot bite with untidy incisors. Firm chin to balance. Extremely well built boy with a strong muscular and nicely rounded cobby body that stands low on short thick legs with excellent definition to their bone structure. Large rounded paws with short toe tufts. Short furnished tail in proportion. His expertly prepared and presented coat is soft and silky in texture. Apricot white body coat is beautifully clear from any surface shading and tones with his points colour. Rich red points to his ears and tail. Paler red points to his legs and mask which extends outwards from the bridge of his nose up to his forehead, across his cheeks and down to his muzzle and chin. Very friendly boy with super temperament.

TABBY COLOURPOINT CHAMPION MALE

GR BOB NEALE'S CH BLUE POEM'S SUGAR (IMP) (PER d 21 33) M 27.3.14

A young red tabby colourpoint wearing his summer outfit today. Broad skull that is smooth and well rounded with good depth to forehead. Good width between neat ears that are well positioned. Bold round eyes of a good shade of medium blue. Short broad nose with good depth to break and fully formed pink leather with wide open nostrils. Full rounded cheeks and ample breadth to muzzle. Near level bite and deep firm chin to balance. He looks like he will be a very large boy when fully matured. Super definition to his bone structure with very well boned short thick legs and huge rounded paws. Cobby in stature with medium length to his body and tail. His short coat has been well presented and is very soft in texture. His body coat is clear apricot white with no evidence of any shading. He has rich red points that are evenly matched. Clear M to forehead, spectacle markings and spots to whisker pads. His mask already extends over his forehead, out from the bridge of his nose, across his cheeks and down to his chin. Thumbprints evident to tops of his ears. Clear barring to his front legs and lighter barring to the inside upper of his hind legs. His lightly furnished tail shows clear rings. Rather a wriggler when handled and not the most confident of boys today.

TABBY COLOURPOINT CHAMPION FEMALE

GR SMITH'S CH ALILEW DARLING BUDS OFMAY (PER n 21 33) F 20.7.14

Seal tabby colourpoint female aged fifteen months. Smooth rounded skull with good width between well furnished medium sized ears. Bold round eyes of a pale but even blue. Broad nose with break and fully formed nose leather. Fair width to cheeks but I would prefer more strength to muzzle for balance. near level bite with concave top incisors and top canines set back a little. Firm chin. Medium length to body of cobby stature with tail in proportion. Standing quite low on strong thick legs with well defined bone structure. Rounded paws with short toe tufts. She is of an excellent size and weight for a female. Her well prepared coat is predominantly soft in texture. Clearly defined seal brown tabby markings on a pale brown agouti background to all her points. She wears a full mask, even at this young age, that covers her face, whisker pads and chin. Clear M to forehead, beautiful spectacle markings and heavy pencil markings to her cheeks. Clearly spotted whisker pads and well defined thumbprints to the backs of her ears. Broken rings to her front legs and clear barring to upper hind legs with seal brown to hocks. Fully ringed tail. Her body coat is rather shady at present but the new coat growth at the roots is a clear

creamy white when the coat is parted. A little more attention to the finer details is required on her underside. Rather a difficult cat to handle as she wriggled so much when out of the pen but she may just have been overcome by ring judging today.

CHINCHILLA OR SILVER SHADED CHAMPION (INC BLUE) MALE

GR COHEN-RANDALL'S CH TASHIAMOUR JOYFUL-DREAMER (PER ns 11 64) M 22.8.14

A shaded silver male aged fourteen months, who is very well developed for his age. Good width to top of head with smooth rounded skull. Well positioned and furnished ears of medium size. Bold round eyes with a good green shade to the centres but much paler outer edges, having clear black mascara outlining them. Broad open type with gentle break to nose. Clear black outline to his fully formed brick red nose leather. Rounded cheeks and good width to muzzle. Near level bite with concave top incisors. Good depth to firm chin. He is cobby in stature and stands low on short thick legs which end in fully tufted paws. He has super bone structure for a silver, which is lovely to see. He wears a well prepared soft textured coat of medium length. He has light tipping to his face, under his eyes and to the bridge of his nose and to the top of his head and ears. Even black tipping which is approximately one third the length of the hair shaft to his spine line and top of tail. He is more lightly tipped to his sides and flanks. He has some shading around all his paw pads and light shading to his hocks. Clear white undercoat to his chest, stomach and underside of tail. He does have light ghost barring to his front legs, although not to the roots, this really must fade as he matures to obtain higher awards on the show bench. A very gentle natured boy who handled with ease.

CHINCHILLA OR SILVER SHADED CHAMPION (INC BLUE) FEMALE

GR FISHER'S CH CHIPPENDALES KAYLA KISSES (IMP) (PER ns 12 64) F 13.5.11

A chinchilla female aged four and a half years. Nicely rounded and smooth skull with good width between well furnished medium sized ears and also having an abundance of furnishings to the top of her head. Large, bold and round expressive eyes of a super emerald shade that turn even deeper the longer she is handled. Super black mascara to outline them. Mid length nose with break and fully formed pale brick leather with black outline. Rounded cheeks and good width to muzzle. Near level bite with very untidy incisors. Firm chin. She is not the largest of girls but quite cobby with a mid length body and tail in proportion. Medium size to the bone structure of her legs with dainty rounded paws. She is of a very good weight for her petite size and nicely covered and rounded. Not currently in full coat but it is of a medium length and has been well presented, retaining a soft texture. She shows minimal tipping to the top of her head, lower spine and top of tail. Her chin, chest, underside of tail and tummy are pure white. Rather a feisty lady with lots to say for herself but she meant no malice, it was all words.

CHINCHILLA OR SILVER SHADED PRE CHAMPION (INC BLUE)

CC BOB ATTERBURY'S OWLETT'S ANNA PAVLOVA (PER ns 12 64) F 22.5.12

A pretty chinchilla female aged just over three years. Smooth rounded skull with good width to top of head. Well positioned and furnished medium sized ears. Bold round eyes of a super emerald colour, just

a fraction paler at the outer edges and outlined in black. Snub nose with pale brick leather, fully shaped and with light black outline. Rounded cheeks and muzzle. Near level bite with untidy incisors. Firm chin. Short cobby body of a super weight. Good definition to her bone structure. Short legs with neat rounded paws. Short wide and fully furnished tail to balance. She wears a full coat that is quite well prepared and is soft and silky in texture, just needing a little more attention to detail on the underside. Full ruff around her pretty face and deep frill to her chest. Her light black tipping is evenly distributed to the top of her head, along her spine line and to the top of her tail giving her a true chinchilla silver appearance. Her chin, chest and stomach are pure white. minimal shading around her paw pads. A sweet tempered girl who was just a little nervous on the day.

CHINCHILLA, SHADED SILVER,GOLDEN, SMOKE, CAMEO, PEWTER GR CH MALE

IMP BOB FAIRS'S GR CH FILOSELLE FORTUNATE SON (PER es 11) M 30.1.14

A very well grown cream shaded cameo boy of gargantuan proportions, aged twenty one months. Masculine head with smooth rounded skull and excellent width between small, well furnished ears set wide and low. Bold round orange eyes. Short broad nose with excellent depth to break and fully formed large pink leather having wide open nostrils. Excellent full rounded cheeks and super breadth to muzzle. Slightly undershot bite with concave top incisors. Firm deep chin. Strong well muscled boy with a deep broad chest and rounded rump. Short and cobby in stature with short wide fully furnished tail in proportion. Excellent definition to bone structure with short thick legs ending in large fully tufted and rounded paws. Expertly prepared and presented full and flowing soft and silky coat. He shows minimal even cream tipping to the top of his head, under his eyes and to his legs. On his body and tail the tipping extends approximately one third of the hair shaft with deeper intensity along his spine line where the colour is fifty/fifty to pure white undercoat. Rather a nervous boy when handled and a little shy in the pen. Lovely to see a cameo with the correct colour distribution on the show bench.

CHINCHILLA, SHADED SILVER,GOLDEN, SMOKE, CAMEO, PEWTER GR CH FEMALE

IMP BOB COHEN-RANDALL'S GR CH TASHIAMOUR GOLD CLEMENTINA (PER ny 12 64) F 23.7.14

A young golden female aged fifteen months. Smooth rounded skull with good width between neat well furnished ears. Bold round eyes of a super emerald shade, just a fraction paler at the outer edges and having a clear black outline. Medium length to nose with gentle break. Medium sized fully formed brick leather outlined in black. Rounded cheeks and good width to muzzle. Slightly undershot bite with concave top incisors. Good depth to chin. Medium length to her body with tail in proportion. Although not a large girl she is of a very good weight for her size and well developed for her age. She stands quite low on thick legs with good definition to bone structure. Fully tufted round paws with black pads. She has a well prepared coat of medium length which is soft and silky in texture. She has a warm rich apricot ground colour deepening to gold. Even black tipping to her head, body and top of tail. Paler golden colour to her lower sides with light apricot chin, throat and underside of body. Ghost barring to her front legs at present but she is still very young. Even tempered female when handled.

RED, CREAM OR AC TORTIE TABBY PERSIAN KITTEN

1 BOB ATTERBURY'S ADIFTON PROMETEY (EXO d 22 V) M 1.6.15

A young red tabby boy aged almost five months. Smooth well rounded skull with good width between well positioned and furnished neat ears. Round eyes of a good deep brown shade at present which bodes well for the future. Short wide nose with good depth to break and well shaped deep pink nose leather. Full rounded cheeks and good width to muzzle. Undershot bite that I would not like to see develop any further as he matures. Strong chin. He is of a good size and weight for his age. Short and cobby body that stands low on well boned legs with short furnished tail in proportion. He wears a mid length coat with fuller ruff and bib which are rather curly today. He is rich red in tone with some lighter apricot agouti ground colour evident to his lower sides. His markings are a deeper mahogany red and he would appear to be mackerel rather than classic patterned. He has an obvious spine central spine line with broken parallel lines and vertical lines running down his shoulders. The remainder of his body pattern is diffused at present. His tail is fully ringed. He shows a clear M to his forehead and some facial pencil markings. His legs are all clearly barred and he has evidence of broken necklaces to his chest. Super temperament when handled and it will be interesting to watch his coat pattern development as he matures.

BLUE CREAM PERSIAN KITTEN

1 BOB STORRIE'S ANNASHIRBELLA MELITA (PER g) F 26.5.15

A pretty blue cream female aged five months. Near rounded skull with good width to top of head. Neat well furnished ears set wide. Lovely bold round eyes already showing a super copper colour. Short wide nose with good depth to break. Two tone pink and blue leather which is a little narrow with well formed nostrils. Nicely rounded cheeks and good width to muzzle. Near level bite with wide bottom jaw and two sets of top canines at present. Firm chin to balance. Not a huge girl but of a super weight for her size and nicely covered. Medium length to body with tail in proportion. Well formed bone structure to her short thick legs that end in nicely rounded paws with pink and blue pads. Mid length coat that is well prepared to the top side and soft in texture. More attention to detail required to the underside and inside of her back legs which are rather curly today. She is of a sound medium blue with warm cream shades evenly distributed and intermingled throughout her coat, broken to all extremities. It is difficult to assess her true colour in the NEC hall lighting and I expect she is probably much paler in daylight.

AC TABBY, SMOKE, CAMEO & WHITE PERSIAN KITTEN

1 BOB WHITE'S HELLO SWEETY WOLVERINE (IMP) (EXO a 03 22) M28.5.15

A very appealing blue tabby and white male, almost too pretty to be a boy. Extremely well grown for five months old. Lovely broad and smooth well rounded skull with very good depth to forehead. Excellent width between tiny well furnished ears set very wide and low into the contours. Round eyes of medium size with a good copper colour developing. Short wide nose with excellent depth to break and large blue nose leather although it is a fraction narrow, he has good size to his nostrils. Full round apple cheeks and good breadth to muzzle. Slightly overshot bite at present but still retaining good depth and strength to his chin. He has a lovely short cobby body and stands low on short thick legs with excellent definition to

their bone structure. He has very large rounded paws and is sure to be a very large lad when he matures. Short wide well furnished tail to balance. Expertly prepared and presented soft and silky textured coat that has been separated to the very last hair. It is full and flowing with a full ruff to surround his face and a deep frill to his chest. Full white collar, white and colour to all his legs, white to underside of his body. Large white chevron to his lower face with colour spot under his nose. Remainder of his body, head and tail are a medium shade of blue. He shows some light beige agouti ground colour overlaid with mid blue tabby pattern to his face, legs and lower sides although at present his back is rather solid as is to be expected of a dilute tabby at this stage of his development. Lovely lad and so friendly, a pleasure to handle.

AC TABBY, SMOKE, CAMEO & WHITE PERSIAN I GR PR

UK BOB TONK'S IMP GR PR ZENDIQUE ZEBEDEE (EXO d 03 22) MN 15.10.13

A well grown red tabby and white boy who has just celebrated his second birthday. Masculine head with smooth rounded skull and good width between small well furnished ears set wide and low. Super bold round expressive copper eyes. Short broad nose with excellent depth to break and having a fully formed large pink leather with wide open nostrils. Full rounded cheeks and ample breadth to muzzle. Near level bite and good depth to chin. He has lovely Persian type and excellent facial balance. A heavy and well built boy with a short cobby body standing very low on short thick legs that end in large rounded paws with toe tufts. He shows excellent definition to his bone structure. Short wide well furnished tail in proportion to his body size. He wears a full coat that is well prepared and soft and silky in texture. Red face with minimum expression of white under his nose and a thin line along the top of his upper lips. White and colour to chin. Half white collar and bib. White to underside with colour and white to all legs. M to forehead with spectacle markings leading from the outer edges of his eyes. Tram lines to top of head which lead to a hint of a butterfly across his shoulders. Light oyster pattern to both flanks and matching pattern to his lower sides. Barring to all legs in the colour spots. His tail shows some broken rings. He has darker markings on an extremely rich vibrant red coat, the intensity of which makes it harder to see the classic pattern. His white areas sparkle. A real showman who was very easy and happy to be handled.

2ND CASE'S GR CH & IMP GR PR GEMKIN CUPIDS BEAU (PER a 03 21) MN 10.8.11

A well grown mature blue tabby and white boy aged just over four years. Very large and masculine rounded head shape with excellent flat Persian profile. Smooth rounded skull with good depth to forehead. Excellent width between small ears positioned very wide and low into the contours. Bold round orange eyes. Short wide nose with well shaped pink and blue leather, nostrils a fraction small. Full round apple cheeks and excellent width to muzzle. Acceptable bite but a little overshot, still having good depth to chin. Short cobby body of excellent weight and substance. He stands low on short thick legs with good definition to bone structure, ending in large rounded paws. Short wide fully furnished tail to balance. Expertly prepared and presented full and flowing coat with every last hair separated. Predominantly pristine sparkling white body coat with a small patch of colour to his right side, fully coloured and ringed tail, colour and white to back left leg and a small colour spot to his chest and upper

left leg. His face is mostly white with a colour patch to the left of his muzzle below his nose that shows spots to the whisker pad. Small colour patch to right side top of head with larger colour patch to left side top of head and ear that travels down the outside edge of his face. Evidence of beige agouti background in this area with mid blue tabby facial markings leading from the outer edge of his eye. Super boy with very laid back temperament and unlucky to meet the winner today.

AOC PERSIAN IMP GR PREMIER

Four very lovely boys in this class and such a difficult choice to make.

UK FLINT'S IMP GR PR RIASCATZ CHAMPAGNE ON ICE (IMP) (PER e 03) MN 9.8.11

A huge mature cream and white bi coloured boy of just over four years. Well developed masculine head. Broad well rounded skull with excellent width between neat well furnished ears set wide and low into the contours. Large eyes of a good copper shade that he does not open to their full potential today. Short broad nose with good depth to break and large fully formed pink nose leather with wide open nostrils. Full rounded cheeks and excellent width to muzzle. Near level bite with concave top incisors. Good depth to chin. Massive boy of super size and weight, being extremely heavy with excellent definition to bone structure. Cobby in stature and short in the body with a super wide and short fully furnished tail to balance. He stands low on short thick legs with large rounded paws that have short toe tufts. He wears a wealth of extremely well prepared pristine white and near sound pastel cream coat. It is full and flowing, soft and silky in texture. He has a white face with a cream chin and colour splashes to his muzzle. Cream to the side of his right eye, above his left eye and to the top of his head. Patching to the back of his neck and shoulders with colour to his rump and a fully coloured tail. Cream patching to one leg with the remainder of his body and legs being pristine white. Super temperament on this gentle giant who just adores being handled.

2ND GORE'S IMP GR PR POPUP FREDDIE MERCURY (PER n 03) MN 18.8.09

A black and white bi coloured boy who has just celebrated his sixth birthday. Lovely rounded head for shape and balance. Smooth broad skull with good depth to forehead. Small well furnished ears set wide and low giving him very good width to the top of his head. Super bold round eyes of a good orange shade. Very short broad nose with deep break and fully shaped large black nose leather. Round apple cheeks and good width to muzzle. Near level bite and good depth to chin. He stands four square and cobby. Very low on short thick legs that end in rounded paws with short toe tufts. Short wide well furnished tail to balance. Excellent body weight being very heavy and perhaps a little rotund. Expert preparation to a fully and flowing silky textured coat with every last hair separated. He is mainly pristine sparkling white with black and white random colouring to his face. Two black spots to body on his right side. White and colour to all legs with fully coloured black tail and a black spot to his underside. His black areas are dense, glossy and sound. Super temperament on this lovely boy who was so unlucky to meet the winner today.

3RD BOYES'S GR CH & IMP GR PR VIVALDI TEDDY-BOYES (PER d 03) MN 17.9.13

A mature looking red and white boy who has just had his second birthday. Masculine in appearance with a lovely facial expression and super Persian profile. Smooth well rounded skull with very good width between small ears set wide and low. Super bold round eyes of pale copper. Short broad nose with good depth to break and having a fully formed pink leather with wide open nostrils. Rounded cheeks and good width to muzzle. Bite a little undershot with top canines set back a fraction. Firm deep chin. Super weight and bone conformation for his medium body size and well covered. He is short and cobby with a broad deep chest and stands low on short thick well boned legs that end in large rounded paws. Short wide and well furnished tail that he holds in tension when handled. Excellent preparation to a full and flowing rich vibrant red coat with minimum shading evident to his lower sides. Little white chevron to his lower face. Half white collar with a small white spot to his central back. White and colour to all legs. Small amount of white to his underside. Fully coloured tail. All his white areas are pristine and sparkling, looking particularly bright against the lovely red shade of his remaining coat. A very placid boy with a lovely disposition and easy to handle.

4TH PETTIT'S IMP GR PR RIASCATZ BLACKBERRY BLISS (PER n 03) MN 6.7.12

A black and white bi coloured boy aged just over three years. Smooth rounded skull with good width between small ears set wide and low. Bold round orange eyes. Short wide nose with good depth to break and fully shaped medium sized black nose leather. Full rounded cheeks and good width to muzzle. Undershot bite and firm deep chin. Short cobby body of very good weight and substance, although he is not a massive boy. He stands low on very short legs with excellent definition to bone structure and has round tufted paws. Short wide fully furnished tail to balance. Well prepared full and flowing coat with full ruff around his face and deep frill to his chest. Predominantly soft and silky in texture, just a little harsher to his rump. Mainly white face with large patch of colour to the top of his head that travels over his right eye and ends in a teardrop to the left of his nose. Large colour patch to rump and fully coloured black tail. Black spot to rear right leg. Remainder of coat is a clean creamy white shade. His black areas are dense and sound to the roots. Rather a wriggly boy when handled today.

BI COLOUR PERSIAN PREMIER

GR BOB FLINT'S PR RIASCATZ CRÈME DE LA CRÈME (PER e 03) MN 2.3.14

An outstanding cream and white bi coloured boy who steals the show. Just nineteen months old and he has everything for me. Super head for type and balance. Smooth and rounded from all angles, his broad skull has excellent width between tiny well furnished ears set wide and low into the contours. Bold round expressive deep copper eyes. Short wide nose with good depth to break and excellent leather formation with open nostrils. Full rounded cheeks and good width to muzzle. Near level bite and good depth to firm chin. Not yet a massive, mature masculine head but very well developed for his months. Sweet facial expression and almost too pretty to be a boy. Short, cobby and boxy with super size to his bone structure and excellent body weight. He stands very low on short thick legs which are fully feathered to the front and to his trousers. Large rounded paws again with ample feathering. Short wide fully furnished tail of the palest pastel cream colour. Not a hair out of place on this super boy. He is dripping in the fullest of pristine sparkling white coat that has been prepared and presented to the very

highest of standards. It is very full and flowing, extremely soft and silky in texture. He has two pastel cream patches to the top of his head that extend down to his forehead and above his eyes. They are divided by white from the bridge of his nose to the top of his head. My take home cat of the day, who not surprisingly later became Best in Show Persian Neuter. Congratulations to both his devoted owner and his breeder.
