With so many beautiful and well behaved cats to judge I had a fabulous time. Thanks you to all those lovely people who sat and stood to listen to me on the day, it was lovely to see all your appreciative faces listening to me wittering on about my favourite subject.

To top the day off in spectacular style I was given the honour of judging BOV Burmese Adult, a total joy! Superb exhibits and demanded a disciplined approach to judging to make my final decision; I awarded BOV adult to stunning IGRCH Aureus Audacious Angel, whom, I believe, also became a UK on the day and was shimmering with health and style. My reserve BOV went to the Adorable brown male; IGRCH Katchyn Nikko, such a joy to cuddle this good looking gentleman. Congratulations to both Owners and breeders.

Lilac Burmese Kitten- Male

1st Bloomers Braggadocio M 3.06.15 BUR c

Sweet shy boy, being rather shy today. Good width at his cheeks and rounded top, slightly long nose, fair break, good medium depth chin, slightly set back from level. Large spaced eyes of yellow chartreuse. Large kitten ears well set astride his head. Good sized boy for age, feeling lithe and fit. Slender elegant legs. Well shaped tail. Coat is silky sleek, lying and an even pale lilac in colour. Well presented.

Lilac Burmese Kitten - Female

1st & BOB Bloomers Broomsy Witch F 3.06.15 BUR c

Very sweet female, same age as her boy competitor. She has very good overall type. Fairly short wedge, slight muzzle pinch at present, but most likely to be teething. Profile shows rounding to brow, fair break to nose, level although shallow chin. Large well shaped eyes. Larger medium ears (to grow into). Good size and weight for her age. Elegant legs and tail. Super silky coat of pale lilac which lies sleekly. Very promising!

Chocolate Burmese Kitten -Female

1st & BOB Aureus Magnifique F 23.05.15 BUR b

Beautiful pale chocolate female kitten just 5 months old. Good size and weight for age. Lovely elegant stance and proportions which she was happy to show off. Short wide wedge, typical of the breed. Neatly defined profile; short straight nose, good depth to level chin. Large eyes, well shaped, full lower line to eye. Slightly fuller top line than ideal, although she had a lot to take in today! Large kitten ears. Pale chocolate coat, silky textured, medium short, just slightly darker mask. Elegant legs and proportional tail.

2nd Kymian Hestia F 29.01.15 BUR b

A grown up kitten of almost 9 months with a gentle nature. She has strong overall Burmese head type; good short wedge of good width, rounded top, and brow, well defined break, nose is almost straight, just a small rise and roll off in profile view. Good depth to chin which is just about level. Medium sized ears, well set. Her eyes are correctly shaped, chartreuse, and a good large size. For her age I felt she rather small, for the desired 'medium' size as per breed standard. Lovely rich chocolate coat colouring to her coat with lovely texture, medium length. Slight barring evident on her legs at present.

AOC Tortie Burmese Adult

1st UK & BOB IGRCH Aureus Audacious Angel F 2.05.09 BUR j

Beautiful lady of quality type. Excellent short wide wedge, short blunt muzzle, well defined neat profile, short straight nose, level medium depth chin. Large expressive, chartreuse eyes of typical burmese shape and set. Larger medium sized ears, very well set, accentuating her wedge shape. Lovely strong elegant body, slender legs, proportional tail. Super sleek-lying coat. Slightly dark lilac

and cream colouring then my ideal. Shown in tip top condition and behaving beautifully. Congratulations.

2nd IGRCH Bloomers Belchampe Brooke F 2.07.10 BUR h

Lovely mature chocolate tortie lady of very strong overall Burmese type. Head displays a short wedge of good width, tapering to a broad blunt finish. Ears are well set following up from her wedge and medium in size. In profile show shows a slight rounding to the top of her head, a fair break to reasonably short nose, which just rolls off slightly at the tip. Medium depth chin, just fractionally set back. Large well shaped eyes of very good Burmese shape and set, greeny-chartreuse in colour, with a gentle expression. Her coat has a good texture, medium short, warm mix of chocolates and reds. A gentle shy lady with impeccable manners!

1st Gr Cert CH Rotara Qweenofhearts F 3.10.11. BUR g

Mature, stylish lady of 4 years having very good overall Burmese type. She has excellent width to her wedge, with a rounded top and brow tapering to a broad blunt finish. Profile shows a straight nose good break, level chin of fair depth, large expressive eyes of excellent burmese shape and set, green-chartreuse in colour. She is an excellent overall medium size, well grown, very muscular and weightier than expected, as per the Burmese standard. Slender elegant limbs and tail. Short satin-like coat of soft blues and creams. Very talkative but handled well in the ring.

Chocolate Burmese Neuter-Male

1st (UK withheld) IGRPR Ameripage Ray of Light MN 23.12.11 BUR b

Mature chocolate lad of good overall burmese type. Fairly broad head, good width at his cheeks tapering to a broad blunt slightly long muzzle. Profile shows good break, slightly long nose, which has a slight gentle curve down to the leather. He has reasonably large eyes, pale chartreuse in colour. medium large ears well set astride his head. He is a darker chocolate, displaying some masking but otherwise fairly even. He is well grown and of an excellent size and weight. His legs and tail are proportional to his physique. He has a darling gentle nature, and i'm sure he's the perfect cat to snuggle with in bed!. Sorry to withhold this UK certificate today, but adorable though he is, for me his type is not quite up to the high standard demanded of this award.

Chocolate Burmese Neuter-Female

1st UK & BOB IGRPR Bloomers Barika Bambalina FN 2.07.10 BUR b

What a beautiful 5 year old neuter lady. In the prime of life I'd say. She has an excellent short wide wedge, good profile break, nose shows small roll off. Chin is level, medium depth. Correct bite. Superb lustrous large eyes with a wicked burmese expression. Chartreuse in colour. her ears are medium large, very well set to accentuate her wedge shape beautifully. She is a warm toned chocolate, with slightly darker mask. Proportional legs and tail. Rather shy in nature but very attractive with it. Congratulations on your award - it was a close fort battle.

2nd IGRCH & IGRPR Vintarn Whisper a Wish FN 22.03.06 BUR b

What a lovely, older lady, of quality. She has an excellent short wide wedge, super neat profile, short straight nose, level chin. A fabulous set of teeth (well done). Expressive, well shaped eyes of excellent Burmese expression. Very well set medium-large ears. She is a darker chocolate, with a pleasing degree of richness to its tone. Slightly plusher than ideal but understandable at 9 years. Slightly plump too, which can often go with the territory of maturity. good legs neat paws, tail slightly short. A super exhibit and unfortunate to meet with my winner today.

AOC Tortie Burmese Neuter

BOB awarded to UK OS IGRPR Papgena Nadia FN 23.07.98 BUR h

An amazing lady of 17 years, looking stunning despite her age. Huge expressive eyes, very short wedge of good width, marginally flat top of head, rounded brow, well defined break, short straight nose and level chin. Medium sized ears well set. (Very well described by the SOP!) She has a compact body, maintaining a very good weight and muscle tone. Slender elegant legs neat oval paws. Tail just balances. Her coat is slightly longer than would be 'perfect', but it lies beautifully when stroked down. Super girl congratulations.

1st & UK IGRPCH & IGRPR Minotosa Rhea FN 17.07.03 BUR h

A mature 12 year old lady of excellent strong, overall type, although not really happy today, but oddly happier out of the pen than in! Short wedge, very good breadth at her cheeks and across the top of her head. Medium sized ears, very well set. Defined break, nose slopes onwards, good strong chin; deep and level. Excellent overall depth to her head. She has fabulous eyes and

expression which flash a good degree of indignation! Very good size and weight, perhaps a little plump. Proportional slender legs, tail a fraction short. Sleek well lying coat of medium short length. An excellent example of the Burmese breed.

2nd IGRCH & IGRPR Kymian Roanna FN 26.07.07

A mature lady of excellent overall Burmese type. Good short wedge having excellent width at her cheeks. Good rounding over top of her head and brow. Large well shaped eyes. Profile shows a well defined break, her nose is almost straight, slightly rolling off at the tip. Well set medium sized ears. Good overall had depth and medium depth to chin. Short coat of good texture. She is a good size and weight for her age, with proportional legs and tail. She has a lovely, young at heart, temperament.

1st (IMP withheld) IGRCH & IGRPR Millgill Theatrics FN 14.03.06 BUR j

9 year old lady with a very sweet nature. She has what i'd describe as a reasonably short wedge, fair width at her cheeks, medium large ears with fair width between. I'd prefer more width and bluntness to her wedge to give the required impact at this award level. She has good overall size and a good degree of muscle for her age. Lovely slender elegant limbs and neat oval paws with a tail of correct length to balance her body. Her coat just slightly longer than ideal and could lie more sleekly. Sorry to withhold today, she a lovely lady but not quite at standard of Imperial in my opinion.

1st and GR PC Pr Mainman Kissingtonstar FN 12.06.14 BUR j

Young lady of 1 year and 4 months, still having time to reach her full potential at maturity. Neat short wide wedge, well rounded top and brow, tapering to a good blunt wedge. Correctly shaped eyes. Personally, I'd prefer them to have more yellow tones for perfection. Her profile shows a fair break followed by a very slight rise in an otherwise short straight nose. Her chin is marginally set back from level and of medium depth. She has medium-large ears, well set. A lovely svelte body, proportional legs and tail and neat oval paws. Young but with everything in the right place for her age, I look forward to see her blossom further as she matures.

2nd CH & Pr Janzanco Razzmatazz FN 7.05.13 BURj

Two and half years old, well grown very muscular girl. Head is composed of a wide wedge, muzzle is fairly short with good width. Larger medium sized ears, very well set astride her head. Super eyes for shape and expression with excellent distinction between top and lower line. Chin has good medium depth but is slight set back from level. Slender legs, proportional tail, neat oval paws. Coat is beautifully sleek lying, with a satin finish. A little timid but handled well. Lovely girl who lost out by a whisker today, as I just preferred the overall balance of the winners head.

Lilac Burmese Neuter -Male

1st (UK Cert withheld) IGRPR Papagena Yeslow Wolsey MN 1.09.08 BURc

A 7yr old neuter male, good overall burmese type. Good breadth to fairly short wedge tapering to a good blunt muzzle. Slightly flat top of head. His profile lacks a defined nose break, showing what I would describe as a gentle curve. Chin appears level but shallow. His eyes are a very good large size and have excellent shape and set. Medium sized ears, set wide to follow up from his wedge. Overall he is a good sized, well grown male, feeling weighty and muscular, with strong yet elegant legs, oval paws and proportional tail. Sorry to withhold today but I felt he didn't have the outstanding standard of Burmese type I required to award a UK certificate.

Lilac Burmese Neuter -Female

1st PC and BOB Harlyndon Angelica FN 22.01.15 BUR c

Only just adult, a lovely type lilac girl. Very good short wide wedge tapering to a blunt finish. Good rounding to top and brow. Loverly neatly defined profile, short straight nose, good break, level chin of good depth. Rather large ears which weren't helped by her mood as she kept holding them low and flat. Super large lustrous eyes, a lovely golden yellow coloured. Elegant, lender body, beautifully sleek coat, with excellent satin-like texture. Proportional legs and tail.

Red Burmese Neuter -Female

1st PC and BOB Pr - CH Kymian Winifred FN 4.03.13 BUR d

Lovely red girl of very good overall type having a short wide wedge, tapering to a good broad blunt muzzle. Profile shows a well defined break, very slight curve ti nose, level chin of reasonable depth. Medium sized ears which follow up from her wedge. Excellently shaped Burmese eyes,

large and lustrous chartreuse. Super short sleek coat even tangerine red. Faint broken necklace but otherwise clear coated. Slender elegant legs, neat paws, proportional tail. Very promising lady.
