**NORWEGIAN FOREST CAT ADULT**

**I, CC & BOB CANDLER'S KATTJEWELS ROXY MUSIC (NFO g 09 21) F 19.02.15**

Triangular head with a straight profile, large beautifully tufted ears set vertically so that the outer line of the ears follows the line of the head to the chin, eyes set obliquely but are perhaps a touch full, level bite and firm chin. Feminine long-backed body of good size for her age standing tall on the legs and complemented by a long full tail. Her coat is developing the coarser guard hairs over the woolly undercoat.

**AC RAGAMUFFIN ADULT**

**1, CC & BOB CANNS' CHEHAM M'LADY-HAS ATTITUDE (RGM n 03 21) F 25.02.15**

Broad head of moderate length with rounded contours, medium sized well-set ears, walnut-shaped eyes of good size, nose break in profile, level bite, puffy whisker pads and with a lovely expression, and slightly tapered chin. Rectangular body of good size and bone for her age standing on strong legs with nicely tufted feet and balanced by a well feathered tail. Only just adult but already looking impressive dressed in an immaculately presented dense coat of good length which is attractively marked brown tabby and white. Superb temperament and no hint of 'attitude'. One to watch.

**AC PERSIAN JUNIOR ADULT**

**TURMER-RUSSELL'S BENESTAR GOLDENRUSH (PER ny 12 64) M 23.08.14** Broad top of head between widely separated neat well-furnished ears, large round green eyes, snub nose, undershot bite, firm chin and full cheeks. Close-coupled body standing low on the legs and balanced by a short full brush. Full golden coat very very lightly tipped in black; black hocks and front feet, paler tummy.

**AC PERSIAN VISITORS ADULT**

**1 RUBERY'S AROURA TOUESSROK (PER w 62) M 01.06.13** A very impressively presented orange-eyed white attired in a cloud of immaculately separated coat. Rounded head with neat well set ears, round copper eyes, snub nose, firm chin and apple cheeks. Cobby body standing low and complemented by a short full brush. An object lesson in how to present a Persian.

**2 TURNER-RUSSELL'S OWLETT'S GOLDIE HAWN (EXO ny 12 64) F 22.09.14** Cheeky chappie with much to recommend him but still looking very much the adolescent that he is. Nicely

balanced head carrying neat widely separated ears, round green eyes, short nose, marginally undershot bite, firm chin and well filled cheeks. Short-backed body standing low and complemented by a short tail. Coat of good texture and length standing out well from the body, golden colour rather muted by the grey of the new coat coming through and an obvious spotted tabby pattern that will hopefully clear with the first change of coat.

#### **AV SLH KITTEN BRED BY EXHIBITOR**

**1 WOOD'S RAGADEE CLEOME (RAG a) F 06.04.15** A lovely youngster with medium sized forward tilted ears separated by a flat plane, gentle dip in profile, level bite and rounded muzzle. Well-developed feminine body carried on medium length legs with a long well feathered tail to balance. Excellent coat texture with mid-blue points contrasting well with the clear body coat.

**2 GILLMAN'S NAVARRI MARTHAS VINEYARD (MCO n 03 22) F 27.05.15** Large lynx-tipped ears set vertically and well apart, round eyes with oblique aperture and set, gentle concave curve in profile, level bite, square muzzle and good depth of chin. Long-backed body standing tall on the legs and balanced by a long full tail. Silky coat with rather a pale agouti ground at present; classic pattern dense black but a touch solid down the back, white bib, tummy and on the legs.

**3 BEATSON'S ADIFTLO YORSTRULLY HATTY (RAG n 04 21) F 02.04.15** A kitten with much to recommend her.

#### **AV SLH NEUTER NOT BRED BY EXHIBITOR**

**1 COLE'S UK OBIGP & SUP K ISADORYOU MR BOJANGLES (MCO n 03 22) MN 25.03.11** I just love this boy and will always point him out as for me he has the ideal MC type. Nicely balanced head carrying large lynx-tipped ears set vertically and well apart, large round eyes with oblique aperture and set, gentle concave curve to the proportionate length nose, high set cheekbones, level bite, firm chin and strong square muzzle. Long-backed muscular body just reaching its prime carried on long legs standing on large tufted feet and balanced by a long feathered tail. Beautifully presented coat that may not yet be at its best after the moult but is of lovely texture.

**2 EAST-PATERSON'S GRPR DAUROSE LEVI (SBI a) MN 24.08.13** Masculine head carrying medium sized ears that are a touch open at the base but set well apart, nearly round deep blue eyes, proportionate length nose with a dip in the profile, level bite and tapered chin. Heavy muscular body carried on medium length legs and balanced by a well feathered tail. Dense blue points with excellent pristine white gloves and gauntlets.

## **AC BURMESE DEBUTANTE KITTEN**

**1 CHODNICKI'S BURMAROSA HEARTSEASE (BUR b) F 04.08.15** Short wedge with gently rounded top and tapering to a blunt muzzle, well set round-tipped and broad-based ears into which she should grow, chartreuse coloured eyes with a top line that slopes towards the nose and a fuller lower line, good nose break, level bite and good depth of chin. Heavy body supported by slender legs and complemented by a proportionate length round-tipped tail. Short close fine coat with warm chocolate colour developing.
