IMPERIAL CLASS – AC SIAMESE/BALINESE GR CH ADULT MALE

1 & IGC Pummell's GC SISAR FIGARO (SIA d) 10/6/14 Flashy young red man – yes ideally I would like him larger (although he is firm and muscled) but some good things come in little packages! Long even wedge with complimentary ear size and flare, super eyes for shape, set and depth of colour, straight strong profile, chin could have more depth to it but bite level, minimal pinch, firmly muscled body, fine and elegant legs and neat oval paws. Points of a pale red – seal based obviously – but even and matched, nice bright unshaded white body, coat short and close fitting.

IMPERIAL CLASS – AC SIAMESE/BALINESE GR CH ADULT FEMALE

1 & IGC Martin's GC FLOWERDEW AGNETHA (SIA n) 1/8/13 Beautifully grown but elegant seal Lady, strong medium wedge with large open based ears set with good width between, small pinch, deep set eyes of a good depth of blue, haws up fractionally. Strong profile with a nice firm depth of chin line and level bite, long neck and extra-long body of a lovely muscle tone, long fine whip tail and elegant legs. Warm even seal brown points, some brindling around the eyes and along dorsal line of tail, warm fawn and cream coat gives excellent contrast. Coat is a tad long but of good texture. Very relaxed and shows well.

AC ORIENTAL LONGHAIR ADULT MALE

Considered for, and awarded, BOB:

Brown's GC FIROUSI FUDGE-BROWNIE (OLH b) 8/10/13 Strong but elegant choc lad, even wedge with pleasing top line, oriental eyes of a bright mid green, almost straight profile, chin slopes back slightly but bit is level, strong long body and balancing length to tail. Coat of a dark toned choc and does show some slight 'rusting' in lower sides and along tail. Few scattered short white hairs buried over his shoulders. Coat is of a good length, lovely full plume and toe and ear fronds. Handled well.

HAVANA NEUTER FEMALE

Considered for, and awarded, BOB:

Miller's IGC & PR PASHTAN RHAPSODY (OSH b) FN 5/8/12 Lovely style to this Lady, Long even wedge with minimal pinch large ears that for my personal taste need a touch more width between but that said they manage to balance to her lines and length of head. Oriental eyes of a reasonable depth of green, strong firm chin, bite untidy with missing teeth. Long neck and body, firm feel to her, long whip. Excellent coat texture of a warm chestnut tone and almost sound to roots. Few scattered short white hairs over her shoulder/back.

ORIENTAL SPOTTED TABBY NEUTER MALE

Considered for, and awarded, BOB:

Drummond's GP HEMLOCK RISKY BIZZNESS MN (OSH n 24) 28/3/14

Extremely handsome with a beautifully balanced strong wedge head and large widely flared ears. Strong profile, small pinch, deep firm chin, level bite, expressive dark green oriental eyes (lovely 'eyeliner'!) Long muscular body, long slender legs and a long fine whip tail. Distinct black tabby markings on his head, legs and tail. The lines over his head break into small 'measle' spots on his shoulders and continue in a broken spine line., 2 Broken necklaces. Spots on his flanks are mainly separate – some linkage on lower sides, which is not that unusual. Slightly cold copper brown ground with a little agouti in evidence, coat beautifully short and sleek. Lovely temperament and presentation.

ORIENTAL TICKED TABBY NEUTER FEMALE

Considered for, and awarded, BOB:

Drummond's PR KAMIK BLILLY JEAN FN (OSH f 25) 29/7/14 Nicely grown young neutered female of good type, one who looked better once relaxed. Medium, slightly sharp to muzzle, wedge with very good top of head. Profile almost straight, level bite, chin could be deeper. Oriental eyes of vivid green. Large ears, well set. Long fairly heavy body, slender limbs with tail of balancing length. Very short fine coat with black ticking broken with lots of red patching – very attractive. Clear bracelets to legs and ringed tail. Excellent condition, presentation and temperament.

CHOCOLATE POINT SIAMESE KITTEN FEMALE

1 & BOB Alefounder's SISAR LA PRIMAVERA (SIA b) 27/6/15 Choc Miss of lovely type and style and oh so confident.....Long wedge with nice wide set open based ears, eyes are slightly straight in set but of a good depth of blue, small pinch, tiny bump to nose, good chin and level bite. Fine long neck and body development in line with age, stands tall on elegant legs with neat 'spoon' paws. Long fine whip tail. Points dark in tone and although they have a modicum of warmth I would not want to see them become any darker. Body colour also requires a little more warmth to it. Short fine coat.

RED POINT SIAMESE NEUTER MALE

Considered for, and awarded, BOB:

Emmens' IGP SPICESIAME COOLHAND LUKE MN (SIA d) 31/5/13 Lengthy (and weighty!) red lad of overall very good type and style. Strong wedge with small pinch evident, wide set open based ears giving a pleasing triangle when viewed front on. Oriental eyes of a bright blue – ideally I would like a touch more intensity, straight profile, firm depth to chin and level bite, long neck he uses well and long muscular strong body, whip tail – just needing another inch to balance lines completely, strong legs and quite large 'boots'! Points of a rich intense red – well matched – and minimal shading. Coat a little long but well prepared and laid close. Slightly 'on his toes' but handled ok.

AV ORIENTAL ADULT – NOT BRED BY EXHIBITOR

1 Freeman's DELAMON DELUXE XENON M (OSH a 03) 24/2/15 Huge strong young bicolour lad. Strong short wedge with small bump to nose, large ears he does tend to bonnet, eyes of a good shape and set and of a bright medium green, chin ebbs back very slightly but bite is ok, strong well

nourished body, tail a touch heavy but of good length, slightly heavy legs and large paws! Lovely soft blue – some bleeding through the white which is approx. 50%, loved those shell pink tipped ears!

2 Ludwig's KIMELPHA PEARLSASINGER F (OSH f) 31/1/15 Choc tortie of lovely type and superb rich choc and red colouring, unfortunately has a fixed xiphy sternum. Medium wedge with large ears just held slightly forward, eyes of a rather yellow tone, straight profile, small pinch, firm chin and level bite. Well-nourished body and fine whip tail.

ORIENTAL KITTEN NOT BRED BY EXHIBITOR

1 Allen's FIROUSI VONTEEZ IF YOU PLEEZ F (OSH h 03 24) 4/9/15 What a little poppet and just loved the rich red tortie mingling evident to her rich choc base. Short, as yet, little wedge with ears wide set – ideally would like them, at this age, to be larger as I feel she could grow through them, minimal pinch, firm little profile and good chin and bite. Firm little body and long tail to balance. Spotting a little indistinct to lower sides, super tail rings evident, clear facial tracings. White evident through tummy line and on legs and mask - a fraction over of the required one third in total.

2 Davies' SHIMILEETA HOLLY BERRY F (OSH b) 27/4/15 Havana girl of fair type and with colour problems today. Long wedge with marked pinch, ears of good size but set close and held high. Oriental eyes of a pale green, bump over brow in profile, slightly fine and dainty for her age, long whip. Coat of a warm tone but very patchy and unsound.

AC SIAMESE/BALINESE VISITORS ADULT

1 Miller's IGC MAFDET QUICKSILVER M (SIA n 21) 15/9/13 Rather rangy in build and stature this seal tabby chap. Long wedge lightly sharp to muzzle and shows quite a pinch today, wide based large ears – he was tending to bonnet today – oriental eyes of a good expressive deep blue, firm profile, chin and bite ok. Long fine whip tail and stands tall on elegant legs. Warm seal brown points, tabby facial tracing well defined with clear thumbprints, lovely whisker spots, clear M to forehead and double ribbons, broken leg bracelets, tail ringed for 2/3 of length. Excellent coat qualities.

2 Tobias' CH FLUTTERBY FIRST-LOVE (SIA c) 8/10/14 Very worried lilac Lady who looks rather immature as yet. Long wedge with a marked pinch evident – not helped as she was puffing whisker pads in her fear! Eyes small and deep set but appeared of a very good depth of blue, ears of a good size and set – could ideally be a little more open to the base to fix the setting to the lines, almost straight profile, good depth of chin and level bite, long fine neck and body, balancing whip tail. Points rather blue in tone and her coat also a touch 'cold' toned. Beautiful condition to her, shame she was not enjoying the day.
