I had some excellent cats and they were, without exception, extremely well behaved. I had a very beautiful Colourpointed kitten in one of my classes, **ALEJANDRO TANZANITE**, who has the most superb pinky-toned lilac points and who was undoubtedly my best cat of the day, I was very pleased to see her go on to win Supreme kitten, many congratulations. I thought that the atmosphere was very good this year with lots of stalls selling a huge variety of things, but it was sad to see the reduced entry. The GCCF should have a flag ship event where the very best of what we breed is on display and I feel strongly that we should support it or we will lose it. I was lucky to have an exceptional team of stewards again this year, to Barbie my brilliant Chief Steward and keeper of the paperwork, I couldn't have managed without you, to Ross and Caroline who worked their socks off, (there were one or two large cats to carry), my sincere thanks and I hope you both enjoyed your day.

A.C. Silver or Non-Silver Tabby British IGCH (or 1 UK Grand) Male

UK GD – Darling's IGDCH COUNTRYSTYLE SILVER TRAVIS (BRI ns 22) M 07/06/12. A strong mature male of very good type. Strong masculine head with broad skull and smallish ears set well apart. Rounded brow, short broad nose, firm chin and level bite. Round eyes of hazel green colour. Short strong neck, well muscled body with excellent weight, short strong limbs and good tail. Jet black tabby pattern, distinct butterfly and three spine lines, though central one somewhat narrow in comparison with the others, large oysters, on pale silver ground. Changing his coat thus could be a little denser, but good for length and with a hint of crispness. Super temperament.

2nd – Williams' IGD CH CROWVALLEY CAPAIN JACK (BRI ns 22) M 01/09/11. Overall a very nice by for type, would just like a touch more masculine. Round head with full cheeks, broad skull and neat small ears nicely set. Round eyes of clear green. Rounded brow, short broad nose, tends to puff out his whisker pads, good chin and level bite. Cobby body which has good weight for size, limbs short and fairly strong boned, good tail. Very good tabby pattern, butterfly, even spine lines and matching oysters on pale silver ground. Changing coat but reasonably dense and crisp. Excellent to handle.

A.C. Silver or Non-Silver Tabby British IGCH (or 1 UK Grand) Female

UK GD – Darling's IGD CH GOSHEN SILVER JASMINE (BRI ns 22) F 26/03/11. An attractive female with quite a strong head for a girl with good broad skull, ears small and set well apart, full-ish cheeks and rounded muzzle, short nose firm chin and level bite. Round eyes, open in expression and pale green in colour. Cobby and compact body, low hindquarters, short legs, medium length tail with rounded tip. Well defined tabby pattern with some brindling to the silver ground. Good butterfly, 3 even spine lines and matching large oysters. Coat short and fairly dense. Handled well.

A.C. Silver or Non-Silver Tabby British Grand Champion

IMP – Adair’s GD CH SKIDOOSH MARLENE-DEITRICH (BRI ns 22) F 21/05/11. A compact and cobby lady of very good type. Well rounded head with full cheeks, small ears nicely set apart with good width to skull, gentle curve to forehead with short neat nose, firm chin and level bite, well rounded muzzle. Round eyes with hazel colour. Short neck with cobby body, deep chest and low hindquarters, short legs and quite short tail. Tabby pattern could be better defined but all key elements in place, butterfly, spine lines and oysters. Coat medium in length with a little density and crispness. Excellent to handle.

British Back Silver Tabby Champion

GD CC – Williams’ CH KHANCOBAN SILVER CILLA (BRI ns 22) F 04/07/14. A well developed girl for her age, of good type and substance. Well rounded head with full cheeks, ears small and well set apart, although she has a tendency to bonnet them at times. Round eyes, open in expression and hazel in colour. Short nose, firm chin, level bite, nicely rounded muzzle. Still a touch rangy in the body but weighty and substantial, short legs, medium length tail. Jet black tabby pattern on pale silver ground, very nice definition, butterfly finishes well beyond the shoulders, has her 3 spine lines and large oysters. Coat good for length and fairly dense. Super temperament.

British Black Silver Tabby Premier

GD PC – Hatton’s PR VINMAR SILVER BENJI (BRI ns 22) MN 10/07/13. A handsome lad with good size and type. Head well rounded, neat cheeks but broad skull, medium size ears set well apart. Innocent expression to eyes of paler green. Short nose, firm chin and level bite. Medium length body, fairly cobby with good substance, short legs and good tail. Jet black tabby pattern on mid silver ground which was quite brindled, butterfly and spine lines good, oysters not quite complete. Coat short and reasonably dense. Excellent to handle.

A.C. Silver or Non-Silver British IGDPR (or I UK GD)

UK GD PR – Hiron’s IGDPR HIRONSUAE GIVEMEGOLD (BRI n 24) MN 10/05/10. A big strong male neuter of very good type. Strong round head with full cheeks, broad skull and round muzzle. Neat small ears very well set. Round eyes of deep gold colour. Short nose, good chin with level bite. Strong really cobby body with excellent substance, stands low on short strong limbs, good tail. Jet black spots on rich warm ground with minimal linkage to lower sides only. Coat short dense and with a little crispness. Handled well.

A.O.C. British Spotted Pre-Premier

PC – Audland’s PORTEOUS JASON-ORANGE (BRI b 24) MN 29/08/14. A very nice boy and he has wonderful weight and substance. Nicely rounded head, has good width between his medium size ears. Round eyes of deep gold. Gently rounded brow, short nose, good chin and bite. Weighty adolescent body, excellent short strong boned limbs, good tail. Rich chocolate spotting on warm toffee-toned ground, some brindling to the ground and a little linkage of the spots on the sides. Very dense coat, a touch long but a little crisp in texture. Super temperament.

British Blue-Cream, Lilac Tortie or Fawn Tortie Kitten

1st & BOB – Hutchinson’s MAKRISSNIC TANGLED (BRI j) F 25/04/15. A well grown baby of very good type. Lovely full cheeks to rounded head, good width to skull, ears small and well set. Rounded forehead, short nose, nose leather a little small, firm chin and level bite. Expressive eyes, round and open with mid orange colour. Weighty body, cobby and compact, super short strong limbs, round paws, thick medium length tail. Dark lilac coat very well mingled throughout in mid cream, baby long and soft in texture but dense. Excellent temperament

2nd – Blagdon’s CLEYVIEW PEARL HART (BRI g) F 16/06/15. A nicely grown and solid baby of good type. Dear little rounded head with good cheeks, ears small and nicely set apart. Rounded forehead, short nose, firm chin and level bite. Compact baby body and short legs tail to balance. Round eyes, colour still developing and is a little muddy in tone at present. Pastel blue coat well mingled throughout in pale cream and sound. Baby long and soft in texture but quite dense. Excellent to handle.

British Blue Lilac or Fawn Tortie & White Kitten

1st & BOB – Conway’s FELINESQUE MISS MARBLES (BRI j 03) F 25/02/15. Almost adult and a good sized girl. Good head type round and with full cheeks and good breadth to skull, with small ears set well apart. Rounded forehead, short broad nose, good chin and bite. Eyes open in expression with mid orange colour. Cobby body with good substance, short legs and tail to balance. Just over the one third white in proportion to coloured patches, on the face chest and tummy, and some on all four limbs. Mid rather blue toned lilac and mid cream patches – well balanced between the two, cream marginally ghosted. Coat a little long but dense with a hint of crispness. Excellent temperament.

2nd – Sutton’s LEKATI SHE’S A DREAM (BRI g 03) F 23/06/15. A dear little person, promising for type. Nicely rounded head, small ears rounded at the tips and well set. Nose short with neat pink nose leather, firm chin and level bite. Very good open expression to eyes, still baby muddy in tone. Slightly rangy body at present, short limbs, medium length tail. Pale bluer and paler cream patches to coat, white to just under the half, on face, chest and down the tummy and on all four legs. Very soft fine baby coat at present. A sweet person, handled well.

3rd – Steele’s STEELAWAY SCOTSLASS (BRI g 03) F 20/05/15. A nice chunky baby, well grown and good for type. Round head, good cheeks, slight pinch to muzzle, small ears set well apart, well rounded forehead, short nose with nose leather a little reduced in size, firm chin and level bite. Eyes good for shape but would like a touch bolder and more open in expression, colour deep gold. Medium length compact body, short legs and tail. A nice balance between darker cream, blue and white patches. Inverted white “V” to face, down neck chest and tummy, all four limbs mostly white. Coat baby long and soft in texture. Excellent temperament.

British Golden Tipped Kitten

1st & BOB – Amarilli’s AMAZOLOU HULLABALLOO (BRI ay) M 21/05/15. A neat little chap of basically good type., would like a little bigger but he is nice and weighty. Neat rounded head with chubby cheeks and small ears set well apart, short nose firm chin, slight teething pinch to muzzle. Round eyes colour still developing but a nice green coming through. Medium length body with good substance, short legs

round paws, good tail. Attractive mid blue to the surface of the hair with warm golden oatmeal undercoat, slightly darker dorsal line at present – (ticked based). Coat quite good for length but needs to develop some density. A very dear boy who was excellent to handle.

British Colourpointed Kitten Male

1st – Baker's ALEJANDRO LONDON CALLING (BRI e 33) M 15/04/15. A well grown chunky boy of very good type. Round apple head, nice full cheeks, small ears with good width to skull, short nose, rounded forehead, fairly good chin and level bite. Expressive eyes, round and open with two tone blue colour. Cobby body, very good bone to short legs, medium length tail to balance. Mid cream points to mask and tail, minimal on front paws as yet. Completely clear coat that was promising for length and texture. Super to handle.

British Colourpointed Kitten Female

1st & BOB – Lacey-Cook's ALEJANDRO TANZANITE (BRI c 33) F 15/04/15. A super baby, lovely head, round with chubby cheeks and dear little round tipped ears set we apart. Short nose, gentle curve to brow, good chin and level bite with well rounded muzzle. Eyes round and open in expression with clear blue colour. Cobby body, short strong legs and medium length tail to balance. Pale pinkie-toned lilac points – lovely. Magnolia coat, unshaded, perhaps touch long but nice and dense with a hint or crispness. Excellent temperament.

2nd – Richards' ADIFTSH STARLIGHT ANGEL (BRI c 33) F 16/05/15. A well grown kitten of good type. Well rounded head with full cheeks, ears neat small and rounded at the tips with good width between. Round eyes with good depth of blue. Rounded brow, short nose, good chin and level bite. Weighty body compact and cobby, neat limbs and paws, tail to balance. Lilac points rather blue-toned and the coat although impressively clear of shading is more white than magnolia, but nice and dense with a hint of crispness, albeit a touch long. Lovely temperament.
