Persian Bi-Coloured Neuter Male; BOB FLINT'S PR RIASCATZ CRÈME DE LA CRÈME (PER e 03, 20/3/14). This Cream & White lad has the most wonderful 'pretty' expression and gorgeous type. Lovely top of head with neat ears. Expressive large deep orange eyes of excellent size & shape. Very short broad nose. Lovely width to his cheeks. Level bite & firm chin. Coat expertly prepared and of lovely length. Clear white to his body and legs, with mid cream to tail and head. White patch to face. Lovely cobby body shape. Short full tail to balance.

Also considered for BOB only;

FLINT'S IGR PR RIASCATZ CHAMPAGNE ON ICE (PER e 03, 9/8/11). ). Just wonderful Cream and White boy! Excellent broad masculine head with good width to top of head and tiny neat ears, set low. Copper eyes of good size & shape. Very short broad nose. Full cheeks and firm chin. Level bite. Superb full coat which was expertly prepared. Pristine white to around 50% of his coat with pale cream patches. Very cobby body. Short full tail to balance. Lovely friendly show temperament. So hard to choose between him and his stable-mate for the BOB. He just has the slightly heavier brow which gave the other boy the edge for me – but they are both superb.

CORCORAN'S PR LOMORAS MANDELA (PER d 03, 19/5/12). Red & White lad who is of good type, just slightly out-classed today by the stunning Cream & White lads. Good top of head with neat ears. Orange eyes of good size & shape. Very short broad nose. Good width to his cheeks. Bite slightly undershot. Good chin. Coat of good length & well prepared. Good rich red, but slightly shady. Clear white patches. To head and body. White to legs and underneath. Cobby body. Short full tail.

British Black, Chocolate or Cinnamon Tortie & White Kitten; 1 BOB WAIT'S HINDERSLYNE LADY OF CAMELOT (BRI h 03, 5/8/15). Pretty Chocolate Tortie & White girl of very good type. Rounded head with neat ears that are set well. Eyes of good size & shape – currently a deep sludgy colour that promises a lovely deep copper colour as she matures. Short broad nose. Well developed cheeks. Level bite. Good strength & depth to her chin. Her coat was well prepared and the density is developing nicely. Dark rich chocolate to around 50% of her coat, nicely broken with shades of mid red. White to her legs – with red patches to her front legs. White inverted 'V' to her face. White to her chin and bib and underneath her body. Cute tiny patch of chocolate to her chin. The red is showing just slight tabby markings at present. Well grown cobby

body. Short strong legs with well rounded paws. Tail of good length to balance. Lovely show temperament. A super lass presented in excellent condition.

British Blue Lilac or Fawn Tortie & White Kitten; 1 BOB ASHTON'S LORASTON RUBY-TUESDAY (BRI g 03, 29/6/15). Gorgeous Blue Tortie & White girl of super type. Rounded head with neat ears that are well set. Deep copper eyes of good size & shape. Short broad nose. Excellent width to her cheeks. Level bite. Good strength & depth to her chin. Excellent coat that was prepared beautifully and showing excellent density and lovely crisp texture. Just a tiny touch of staining to her eyes at present. Lovely clearly defined patches of mid cream and blue to her back, head and tail. White to her whisker pads and legs, and underneath her body. Small white patches to her shoulders and flanks. Excellent cobby body of good size. Strong legs with well rounded paws. Tail of good length to balance. A really super girl.
