PEWTER/BLUE PEWTER KITTEN

1 & BOB PEARSON'S REMILAKAT BAILEY A gorgeous 6 month old girl who loved being handled. She was well grown for her age and of a good weight and bone. Excellent width between her well placed furnished ears, short nose with stop, brick nose leather outlined, full cheeks, acceptable bite and a firm chin. Lovely round bold orange eyes. Cobby body with short sturdy legs, large paws and a medium length tail in proportion to her body. Well prepared soft silky coat showing fairly even black tipping on a silvery white undercoat. Some slight barring to legs. Excellent temperament and condition.

AC BI-COLOURED RAGDOLL KITTEN

1 & BOB CANLIN'S RAGNDREAMS CHANCENCOUNTER A blue bi colour lad coming up for 7 months old and of a good size weight and bone for age. Good width and a flat plane between well placed furnished blue ears, touch open at base, nose of a medium length showing a dip in profile, full cheeks, level bite and a firm chin. Muscular body with sturdy legs and a full blue tail of a medium length in proportion to her body. Well prepared soft silky pale beige coat with her legs all white. Blue to top of face broken by white coming from a small inverted v on his forehead covering his nose whisker pads, chin chest and tummy. Excellent temperament and condition.

BLUE-CREAM/LILAC FAWN TORTIE KITTEN

1 & BOB ABIDIN'S CWTCH MADEMOISELLE A lovely blue cream girl who is just over 7 months old. She was of an excellent size weight and bone for her age. Good round head with well placed nice small ears set in the rounded contours of her head. They were rounded at the tip. Short nose of a uniform width and showing a break. Lovely full cheeks, a level bite and firm chin. Well placed round eyes, colour changing, muddy today. When the colour is fully developed to orange that will be the making of her. Quite a cobby body with fairly short sturdy legs and a tail of a medium length which balanced with her body. Her coat was great, lovely and crisp and dense. It was well prepared. and showed a good distribution of blue and cream well intermingled. All her feet were broken. Shown in excellent condition and had a lovely laid back temperament.

2 ARNOLD'S ADIFTSH'S ZITA LA-VITA A lovely lilac tortie whose colouring was stunning, a chocolate box babe. Round head with small well placed ears, rounded at the tip and set in the rounded contours of her head. She had a shot nose with a break, fairly

full cheeks, bite almost level, teething and a fairly firm chin. Well placed almost round eyes, colour developing muddy today. Her body was of a good size weight and bone for her age, fairly cobby with short legs and a medium length tail which balanced with her body. Her tail was broader at the base tapering towards a rounded tip. Well prepared soft dense kitten coat showing a good distribution of lilac and cream. Her coat was lovely and pale. When I first saw her little face peeping over her white nest I was smitten. So unlucky to have been against a more mature girl who had a lovely crisp coat and better facial balance. Excellent temperament and condition. Your day will come.

AOC SILVER SPOTTED KITTEN

1 & BOB SUTTON'S FARODELL TRUST AND HONOUR A lilac silver spotted girl coming up for 5 months old. Lovely round head with a good width between well placed ears, more medium than small, rounded at the tip and set in the rounded contours of her head. Short nose with a break and of uniform width, fairly full cheeks, level bite but needs a touch more chin to give the vertical line from tip of nose to chin. Round well placed eyes, orange colour still developing. Cobby body with short sturdy stocky legs and a medium length tail which balances with her body. Her tail was broader at the base tapering towards a rounded tip. Well prepared coat, quite dense, still soft kitten coat. Good lilac markings on a silver background. Broken m to forehead, spectacles around eyes, broken facial lines and spotted whisker pads. Necklaces are not broken yet but you can see where the spots will be. Her body shows lots of spots, some lines are still breaking. Spots to her tummy. Tail not yet broken. Excellent temperament and condition.
