Foreign Imperial Grand Premier, Male; I genuinely struggled between the two certificate winners for some time & both would have justified the award, it was actually quite painful choice to make.

IMP GR PR JACKSON'S GR PR TROIKA GRAYMALKIN. RUS a. 23-05-11.

Russian Blue, this lad was so, so composed & relaxed & this as much as anything just swayed the result his way. His wedge is short from the eyes down, with the required prominence to his whisker pads to give squareness, he has a pleasing gentle angle in profile created by the gentle concave curve, his chin good, level bite. His ears I would like possibly just a little taller in set, but are well pricked & pointed effect to their tips, lightly furnished, good larger size. His eyes once he deigns to wake are perhaps just slightly deeper in set at the inner corner, wide almond in shape, very good definite green colour, sleepy expression. Body lithe & firm with good length, slender limbs, tail thicker at its base with a gentle taper to its very good length. Excellent coat showing the double qualities of his breed requirement well, dense undercoat with medium length soft fine top coat, well prepared. He has mid blue colour with a good deal of silvery sheen which is created by the translucence at the hair tips, the silvering is particularly evident on the shorter areas, he was in excellent condition & had such a wonderfully gentle nature, just completely at ease with the world in general.

RES IMP GR PR BROOK'S GR PR JANAMEL DEWA AIM SIN. 19-07-11.

Singapura, this was a very impressive exhibit & I did genuinely feel torn between the two. He has a moderate wedge with gentle curves, slight whisker break beneath his cheeks with gentle curvature, his muzzle broad & slightly blunt on the nose, rounded skull, with slight break, his chin firm & his bite level. I would prefer his ears a little larger but that said they are well cupped at the base with a pricked & alert appearance, set well with hint of tilt forward. Beautiful eyes which when fully alert & large rounded shape which are quite dominant, the colour a clear pale green. Body is beautifully firm medium size, well proportioned limbs, small neat paws, the tail is slender & requires a little more length to balance. Coat is short & fine, laying close with a soft lustrous sheen evident. The body colour is typically old ivory & as such the ticking is well contrasted, this deepens off on his spine line & along the tail to the solid sepia coloured tip, as were his heels & outer edges of the paws, he has some slight allowable barring on the inside of his front legs, no knee smudges, darker salmon coloured nose leather with darker outline, some cheetah lines from the eyes, spurs could be a little more definite, darker sepia coloured eyes rims. warmer ivory tone on his chin throat, chest & tummy. He was not demonstrating the same degree of confidence as the Russian lad preferring the comfort of his pen, his condition was wonderful, this is a position I could so easily reverse.

Foreign Imperial Grand Premier, Female

IMP GR PR BRYNES'S IMP GR CH & GR PR ONATUREL GIFT WRAPPED. SPH w 63. 18-01-12. Beautifully pristine looking girl who looked moist impressive, Head is a little longer than wide, very well defined high cheeks, good whisker break & some prominence to her muzzle, her profile shows slight break at the eye line, quite a reasonable chin, her bite level. The ears are large wider at the base & have a pleasing angular setting with only a very light amount of covering on the outside. Gorgeous eye, beautifully large full lemon shape, wonderfully open & expressive. Body though not overly large was beautifully firm, good breadth of chest, muscular flanks, well proportioned limbs & stands on thickly cushioned paw pad, long toes, long fine tail she can curl against her body. The body was covered in the finest of chamois effect, with extremely fine amount of covering on the outer edges of the paws & a little more on her muzzle, with the exception of a very small scratch below her right eye she was otherwise blemish free & was in absolutely superb condition, she really looked so pristine & clean, wonderful temperament.

RES IMP GR PR BANDY'S IMP GR CH & GR PR TROIKA VASILISA. RUS a.

17-09-08. Russian Blue, I like this girl very much & she would have been well worthy of the certificate in her own right. Her wedge is short & the muzzle showing good prominence, good flat plane between her ears & showing slight curve at the eye line to give the required angle, firm chin, level bite. Her ears are set well & she holds them in a fixed tall position, good larger size, light interior furnishings & pointed effect at the tips. Her eyes are marginally deep set, pleasing wide almond, very good green colour & expression. Her body was firm & well proportioned, with slender limbs, oval paws, tail was good length, broader base & gentle taper. Coat was showing double qualities with good undercoat & soft fine top coat. Mid even blur colour with lots of translucence to create silvery sheen present. Condition was excellent & her temperament was charming.

AOC SLH Grand Champion, Female;

GR CH JAMIESON'S CH PHATPAWS DELICIOUS. RAG a 03. 27-09-13. Blue Bi-coloured Ragdoll, this girl had excellent size & substance. Her head has good width across her well developed cheeks, good muzzle, quite a good flat plane with a gentle dip in profile, her nose shows the required slight retroussé effect at its tip, her chin good & the bite level. Her ears are set well apart & are a good medium size, touch of forward tilt. Her eyes are well open with gentle oblique setting, showing a good depth of blue & such a gentle expression. Body was firm & has good depth, her legs are medium length & well boned, round paws with tufts between the toes, bushy tail could perhaps be a little longer. Her coat was showing good length & density, the texture soft & fine, well prepared, some ruff, full knickerbockers. She has inverted white blaze & clean white chin, chest, tummy & legs, the remainder of the mask, ears & tail a mid blue, body was showing tonal blue shading but there was plenty of contrast. Condition & temperament both excellent.

AC Sphynx Grand Champion, Male;

GR Not Awarded. 1st HICKS'S CH BEVLIN MYSTICAL MERLIN. SPH b 32.

27-06-14. Regardless of what his breed number indicated if not completely wrong it was nevertheless way out even making allowance for the fact that he was Sphynx, he had distinctly blue eyes, which indicated he was Colourpointed not Darker points, he was also definitely Tabby & White so his GEMS code indication is more likely to be SPH b 21 03. However all that said somewhat irrelevant as there are no points for Colour, pattern or eye colour. Head ideally requires a little more width at the cheeks, these are high & well defined, quite good prominence to the muzzle, in profile he requires a little more obvious break at the eye line, chin was adequate his bite level. The ears were large & the angle perfectly acceptable, they had an almost full covering of hair on them. His eyes were large but a little more oval than lemon shape requiring a little more evidence of drop in the corner, the blue colour is extremely attractive even if there are no points as such. Body is firm & well muscled with good strong muscular thighs/flanks, well proportioned limbs, cushioned paws with long toes, tail is long & fine with extremely small knobbly tip. He was unfortunately showing far too much evidence of hair, this was on his muzzle, which was perfectly acceptable, but also came up his back paws, & was also showing on his lower back & thighs, though only residual it was still very evident & as a result could be felt. He was in super condition & has a wonderful disposition.

Siamese/Balinese Grand Champion, Male;

GR CH RICHARD'S CH MAFDET DEBIKAT-MASERATI. SIA d. 26-05-14. Red Point Siamese, though in my opinion this lad still has a degree of maturing still to achieve he is nevertheless handsome & has a very pleasing overall look & balance. Head shows even lines to his balanced medium wedge, he has a very minimal break to his otherwise very good profile, chin & bite good. His ears are large & placed well apart, the wide flare at their base which is very complementary, excellent top line, His eyes are marginally deeper set than ideal the shape is beautiful & they have a good depth if blue with a lovely expression. His body still to fully mature & deepen off, but nevertheless well muscled, slim legs & oval paws, fine well balanced tail. The coat was close lying & a reasonable shorter length, it was well prepared & sleek. He has very slight amount of tonal shading which gave a warm tone, his points were a pleasing red, typically paler on the front stockings. His condition was excellent & he has such a gentle nature.

Siamese/Balinese Grand Champion, Female;

GR CH Not Awarded. 1st TOBIAS'S CH FLUTTERBY FIRST LOVE. SIA c.

08-10-14. Lilac Point, still looking rather immature was not exactly a happy bunny which tended to exacerbate her problems. Wedge is good length but a little narrow & was showing quite a defined pinch which emphasised her fineness of muzzle, very good profile, chin was quite firm but a little narrow, slightly overshot. The ears are a good larger size, but she was not holding them particularly well, requiring more flare to their base & with a tendency to bonnet forward. The eyes were rather small & deep set, set slightly straight, the colour was a very intense blue colour, rather angry expression. Her body was lithe though well toned, slim legs, neat paws, fine tail, hint of something minor at its extremity. Her coat though a little long, was close lying & has a pleasing sleek

texture. Body was clear slightly cool magnolia colour excellent contrast to the points but these were somewhat bluey in tone which required more evidence of pink tone to give the required softness to the colour. Her condition appeared excellent but she was rather tense & less than co-operative.

Tonkinese Adult, Female; Some lovely girls to consider for BOB which was hotly contested.

CC Not Awarded. 1st SINGLETON'S TONKYWAY TSEEN SHE TOS a 21 32.

04-12-14. Blue Tabby, rather unbalanced young girl looking more kitten than cat & not yet made the transition between the two, which at a year I would have expected. Head shows a moderate wedge but the whisker pinch though a requirement is deeper than ideal & her muzzle is somewhat fine, very flat brow, very shallow break, chin & bite both good. Her ears are medium size, taller than wide with oval tips, set back on the head & a little angular. Eyes large almond shape, showing a gentle slant, green with a hint of blue just evident. Her body is still quite small & fine boned, with proportionate limbs, small paws, tapering medium length tail. Her coat was reasonably short & was close lying, with a soft texture & lustrous soft sheen. Good Tabby facials, as were the leg barring & tail rings, her body pattern was showing quite heavily spotted & as a result she does tend to lose out on the subtle merge of colour. Her colour overall appeared to be more Carmel than blue with the more brownish tinges evident on the ears, back, legs & tail in particular. Her condition & temperament were both excellent.

Considered for & Awarded BOB. MACEY'S IMP GR CH FEHELDEE

DAISYMAY TOS k 32. 01-12-06. Caramel Tortie, oldest in the class but looking very good & with excellent tone, body has firm muscular built to its medium length, well proportioned legs & small oval paws, her tail is perhaps marginally fine & could be a fraction longer. Head has a moderate medium wedge, with some whisker pinch, muzzle has slight rounding, her brow is slightly rounded, & she has small break in profile, with good chin but showing a little acne, level bite & she has long upper canines. The ears are medium size, width at their base & are taller than wide, with oval tips. Lovely eyes fuller wide almond shape with gentle slant, excellent Tonkinese colour of blue wash over green, gentle expression. Her coat was short & close lying with a very pleasing sleekness to the texture which for age is especially good. Colour appears to be lilac based caramel with the typical taupe colouration with varying shades of hot sandy apricot present, which deepened almost imperceptibly to the darker extremities creating the required gentle merge of colour. Her temperament beautifully composed, the acne almost cost her the BOB.

Also Considered for BOB. MCNALLY-ROBERTS'S GR CH TONKYWAY IO.

OTOS a 32 01-04-12. Blue, This girl was overall quite pleasing but was let down a little by her coat. Head has moderate wedge, showing good whisker break & gently rounding on her muzzle, slight flatter on her brow, with slight break in profile, chin was adequate & her bite good. Ears are well placed the outer line continuing the lines of her wedge, could be a little wider at their base, taller than wide, with oval tips & medium in size. Lovely eyes, attractive bluish green tone, good larger size & pleasing expression. Body has good length & is well balanced & proportionate in the limbs, oval paws, slight taper to her tail which is balanced in length. Her coat was rather long, but that said was sleek & very close, soft & fine. The blue was showing the required merge of colour to the slightly deeper

colour on the extremities & possesses a lustrous sheen. Condition was sound & her temperament was excellent.

Also Considered for BOB. MILLWARD'S UK & OB IMP GR CH YOKOTA LUCIE LOCKETT. TOS c 32. 03-02-07. Lilac, main contender for the BOB. Head has a moderate wedge, definite but not excessive whisker pinch, muzzle rounds gently, her brow round very slightly & shows a gentle break, chin & bite both good. Her ears are well placed taller than wide, oval tips & the outer line following her wedge. Eyes are large fuller almond shape, the colour ideally need to show a little more evidence of blue to the green. Her body is perhaps a little over her best weight, but then she is 8 years of age, so taken into account, slim legs, oval paws, her tail is a little short & thick. The coat was a fraction long & slightly thicker in texture as opposed to sleek & short. Her colour was a reasonable shade of lilac which deepened off to the extremities a little viewed from a slight distance though I would have preferred it a little more lustrous. Her condition was excellent & her temperament beautifully composed.

Also Considered for BOB. RICHARDS'S CH TONKAHOLICS DONTFORGETME. TOS g 32 24-06-09. Blue Tortie, older girl. Head is a little long in relation to its width & the muzzle a little sharp, some whisker pinch, slight break at the eye line in profile, her chin could be deeper, bite good. Ears medium size, oval tips pricks a little high. Her eyes are quite large, fuller rounded almond shape, just the slightest evidence of blue to the otherwise green colour. Body was very firm & perhaps just a little over her optimum weight, slender limbs, oval paws, her tail was quite fine & somewhat short for balance. Coat very, very soft with a slightly more almost fluffy appearance & not short & close as required, it was also showing heavy scurf. Blue/Cream which did possess the required gentle merge of colour when viewed from a slight distance. Her physical condition was excellent but her coat required more work, temperament excellent.

AC Colourpointed Tonkinese Kitten;

1st & BOB. RICHARDS'S TONKAHOLICS DOTTIE LOTTIE. TOS h 33.

24-03-15. Chocolate Tortie Pointed, what a beautiful type kitten. Head has moderate wedge, showing good whisker break, slight rounding to the muzzle, slight rounding on the brow, slight break at the eye line, firm chin, level bite. Her ears are medium in size, good width at the base, taller than wide & pleasing oval at the tips, with slight hint of forward tilt to their slightly angled setting. The eyes are wide almond shape with gentle slant, there does appear to be slight infringement of green to the outer edge to the lighter blue colour which detracts. Beautifully firm body, well proportioned limbs & oval paws, balanced medium length tail. Beautiful coat, it was sleek & short with a lustrous soft sheen to it, beautifully prepared. The body is light magnolia with excellent contrast to her darker chocolate Tortie Points, her left back heel has slight amount of red so conforms the chocolate is colder toned than I would wish. Her condition was wonderful & her temperament was splendid, I did deliberate due to the eye colour but decided her type was superior & gave her the benefit of some doubt as a result.

Tonkinese Neuter, Female;

1st PC & BOB. MACEY'S FECHELDEE CORLENA. TOS em 32. 10-02-13.

Apricot, attractive girl. Her head is a little longer than I would ideally wish & her

whisker could be a little more obvious, muzzle rounds gently, her profile could show a little more rounding, very good slight break, her chin is firm, bite level. Her ears are a good medium size, taller than wide, slightly angular, oval on their tips. The eyes are large, full almond with slight slant, mere hint of blue evident to the greener coloured eyes, lovely expression. Her body was beautifully firm longer medium length, her legs slender with oval paws, tail is balanced length slightest taper. Gorgeous coat it was beautifully short & very close lying, well prepared satin like texture. Rich apricot with deeper colour to the mask ears & tail merging towards the body where it shows merge between the two. Immaculate condition & such a gentle demeanour.

Also Considered for BOB. BORMAN'S GR PR LILYPUT SHERBERT

FOUNTAIN. TOS m 32. 26-05-14. Caramel, this lad has an excellent body but his head lets him down a little, being a little long in relation to its width requiring a little more gentle rounding to the muzzle & more obvious whisker pinch, somewhat flatter brow, his profile is virtually straight, chin & bite both good. His ears are taller than wide with oval tips, medium size. His eyes are large full almond shape, slight slant, blue washed green colour typically Tonkinese. Longer medium length hard well muscled body, slender limbs, oval paws, well balanced tail. Beautiful coat, it was short & very close with a lovely sleek satin like finish. Lustrous sheen the blue with slightly deeper extremities creating the required gentle merge required. He was in excellent condition & gentle temperament.

Abyssinian Adult, Assessment;

1st, Merit & BOB. MUSPRATT'S ESSENCE FLAMEOFMADEBA ABY d.

27-10-13. Red, attractive girl who looks like an Abyssinian, she has a small well healed tear on her left ear. Moderate wedge with gentle contours, slight muzzle indent, shallow break in profile, the chin & bite both good. Her ears are large & well cupped, open base, pricked & alert. Her eyes are a little wide & the pupils are dilated, green colour. Quite dainty fine boned girl, slender limbs, small paws, she could be a little heavier, her tail is well balanced with slight taper. Her coat is a little long but there is some resilience & overall has the feel of gentle resistance to it. Good rich red colour & her ticking was evident, pales to the undercoat a little at the base, slight muzzle paling, slightly heavier well broken necklet. Very shy gentle girl in excellent condition. Overall pleasing & conforms well, I would like her tail tip a little more solid, with more confidence she could look much improved. She justified her Merit & BOB.

2nd Merit BARRETT'S HIGHLIGHT MATILDA. ABY fs. 01-02-15. Usual Tortie Silver, attractive girl who is well Tortied with lots of cream (which should actually read as red). Moderate wedge, with slight contours, gentle indent beneath the cheeks, her chin okay if a little narrow, bite okay. I'd like bigger ears & more cupping to their base. Her eyes are golden yellow, the shape better when she relaxed. She is not big but is firm with well proportioned slender legs & oval paws, her tail is marginally thicker but has the required gentle taper. Her coat is good length, typically softer texture created by the Silver colour as a result not as resilient to the touch. Beautifully ticked throughout, deepening on her dorsal line & along the tail with solid tip, excellent silver undercoat. She was very nervous but not difficult, wonderful condition. The Tortie was well in evidence more tarnish than ideal, some rather heavier but well broken necklet, she has a

little Bindi red spot on her brow. My apologies as I kept referring to her as Blue Tortie Silver.

Sorrel Abyssinian Kitten;

1st & BOB. BARKER'S COPPICE PRICILLA. 01-08-15. Generally well balance girl. Head has moderate medium wedge, slight indent to the cheeks with slightly rounded muzzle, her brow could show a little more evidence of rounding & her profile a little too straight, chin is good, level bite. The ears are moderately large, cupped base & pricked appearance, set well. Her eyes are the required fuller almond shape, hazel/green colour & pleasing gentle slant. Body is firm & though she is just over 4 months, pleasing medium length, slender length, slender limbs, small neat paws, tail a little thicker at its base, medium length. Her coat was a good density & medium length, not unduly soft. Her ticking was well defined, could possibly be a little richer undercoat, to give greater coppery effect, dark chocolate ticking/banding & tail tip, heels could be a little higher, good colour muzzle & chin, slightly heavier colour in the necklet area. Condition & temperament both excellent.

Abyssinian Kitten, Assessment; Two litter brothers, both very similar with superb temperaments.

1st Merit & BOB BARRETT'S FLAMSTONE CARACTACUS. ABY es. 20-05-15. Cream Silver, he complies well for his breed & is very attractive. Gentle curves to his medium length moderate wedge, slight indent at the muzzle, slight rounded brow, shallow break, excellent chin, bite scissored. His eyes large almond shape, amber colour. Body was excellent, lovely & firm, slender legs & neat paws, tapered tail of medium length, thicker base. His coat was tight fitting & close with good density & not unduly soft having slight amount of resilience of his breed. Dark Cream well ticked, the colour deeper towards the tail tip, the ticking is excellent, hint of residual necklet & barring, wonderful condition & temperament. Much to recommend & admire he has an extremely tiny & I mean tiny cartilage issue at his tail tip. He was a charming young chap. I appear to have omitted his ears, I assure you he had two, both quite large & well pricked with cupped base.

2nd Merit. ANDREW'S FLAMSTONE GALILEOGALILEI. ABY ds. 20-05-15. Red Silver, well grown youngster, who looks typical of his breed. Gentle curves to his moderate wedge, good muzzle indent, small nose bump, gentle break, chin & bite good. Large well cupped pricked ears, Amber, fuller almond shape eyes. Body beautifully firm, stands well on slender limbs, oval paws all in proportion. Tail has thicker base & medium length. Coat could be shorter but is Silver & as such very soft but with a pleasing density overall. Colour is rich Red, his Silver undercoat has still to clear, but the ticking very evident, showing some slight residual barring & hint of broken necklet. Temperament & condition, gorgeous for both. He is a fine piece of work in progress, his tail tip could be a little more solid.

AC Sphynx Kitten;

1st EDWARDS'S HAYANA GALLETA (imp) SPH w 61. 10-04-15. Blue Eyed White, this kitten looked truly pristine & was extremely attractive. Her head was a little longer than wide, showing excellent width & high defined cheeks, ,

with good whisker break, the muzzle firm & with prominent whisker pads, profile ideally needs a little more evidence of break, her chin was perfectly acceptable & her bite good. The ears were large, slightly angular setting, wide at their base, very light covering. Beautiful eyes, alert & bright clear blue colour, full lemon shape with slight slant to the setting. She has a beautifully firm body with excellent weight for size, showing muscular hardness throughout, well proportioned limbs, her paws were well cushioned & the toes long. Body had the required almost imperceptible chamois effect to create resistance & was free of excess hair with the exception of the permitted areas showing a little on her muzzle & ears, minimal on the paws. She was amazingly clean & looked very pristine immaculately prepared. Her condition was superb & her temperament was charm personified, she was a real delight.

2nd EDWARD'S THOR OF ANKH AMULET (imp) SPH a 21 32. 18-05-15. Blue Tabby Tonkinese CR this lad was undoubtedly handsome & has the best chin I have seem to date on a Sphynx, sadly there was a but!. Has a strong head with a pleasing degree of masculinity for his young age. The proportions in relation to width & length are good, high cheeks, good muzzle, profile like so many requires a little more obvious break, wonderful firm chin (not protruding or excessive), with good depth, sadly he is undershot & this will undoubtedly impact on his show career. Beautifully set, large ears rounding to the tips, open base & gently angled setting. His eyes are a striking feature being large & well shaped, drop to the corner which enhanced their lemon shape, bright clear colour. Muscular well developed body, with some wrinkling round his head & neck which pull out as he moves, he stands on well proportioned legs, with well muscled thighs, lovely cushioned pads, with long finger like toes, his tail was long & fine. Very fine down covering on the body, creating the effect of chamois, free of excess coat with only a little present on the allowed areas. His condition was wonderful & he has such a gentle nature, a great pity about his bite.

AV SLH Junior Adult;

1st CANLIN'S GR CH GROOVICATS IVNAHOE. RAG n 03. 22-07-14. Seal Bi-Coloured Ragdoll, despite his young age & still with a degree of finish to achieve, he is a well developed lad with a number of fine qualities. Very good head type, showing width across the cheeks, well developed muzzle, good flat brow, gentle dip to his nose with its slightly retroussé tip, chin okay, bite good. His ears are medium in size, set well apart, slight forward tilt, some longer internal furnishings. His eyes are well open, slightly oblique, with an excellent depth of blue. Body good muscle tone & firm weight, medium proportions as yet, proportionate legs & paws, bushy tail. His coat has good length & shows some ruff, soft, fine texture. Inverted white on his mask, white chin, chest, front legs, tummy & back to the line so his body which extends up the flanks, white collar, the remainder of his mask, ears & tail seal, some beige body shading which does not detract. Condition & temperament both excellent.

2nd TIPLER'S HAPPYTYME ALEXIS -BT RAG n 03-06-14. Seal Point Ragdoll, very feminine & most attractive young miss. Pleasing head shape, wide across the cheeks which are well filled, her muzzle has good development, flat brow, excellent downward curve to profile, chin tapers a little, bite level. Her ears are set well apart & have good medium size, well furnished. Excellent deep blue eye colour, well open shape & set slightly obliquely & are very expressive. She is

perhaps a little smaller than I would wish at present but she is all in proportion & has good legs & paws, bushy tail which is a little short. Her coat length is very good & she is well prepared, excellent amount of ruff, full knickerbockers, soft texture. 1st WOLFE'S BUMPKIN RAMESES. BRI n 33. 09-08-15. Seal Colourpointed, very typy little chap, beautifully round apple head shape with excellent rounding to his cheeks, round brow, well developed muzzle, good depth chin, teething badly with swollen gums. His ears are beautifully small in size & as a result very neat & tidy, being set well apart also. The eyes are well open & round, colour still to settle fully with slightly incomplete blue tone to the outer rim as yet. Lovely cobby little body, wonderfully compact for his young age, low on his sturdy legs, good size paws, medium length tail which was quite heavy. His coat is already showing a pleasing degree of density & has some crispness present, shorter length. His points are a rather cold seal & he is shady whether this has yet to clear or still developing is yet to become more evident, but time will no doubt tell. He has a wonderful temperament & in super condition, quite a little character.

2nd SPENDER'S HARLEME ANGEL EYES. BRI c 33. 15-04-15. Lilac Colourpointed, at 8 months this girl has a number of problems which may well hold her back as she goes into adult classes. Body is good, with chunky firm build, her legs have good bone, round paws, balanced tail. Head though still to round more fully & fill out at the cheeks more, is in keeping with her development, good muzzle, round on the brow, chin & bite both good. Her ears are smaller medium size, slightly wide base as yet. Her eyes are large & well open, round shape but sadly the colour would be difficult to call blue, looking more like an extremely pale greenish tone, which was further compounded as it had hazel flacks diverging on the outer rim also. Her coat was reasonably dense but a little flat lying & could be a little crisper. Cool toned magnolia body colour with excellent contrast to the points which are slightly more blue in tone requiring a little more pinky hue to give the required warmth for lilac, some tail rings which is not unusual for her colour. Head requires a little more width across & between the eyes to create a more heart shaped appearance, muzzle neither pointed nor too square in appearance, flat forehead, needs more evidence of slight stop, with small bump on the nose, chin & bite both good. I would prefer larger ears & though these are well & set high they require more flare to their base. Her eyes are at present a little acute in set & smaller than I would wish, reasonable blue tone. Body small as yet but in keeping with her age, good legs & paws, shorter medium length tail, slightly pointed tip. Single coat, still slightly wispier soft longer baby coat. Cool toned

Beautifully even head lines, well balanced wedge, excellent profile, good chin, teething badly with double canines. Large ears, wide flared base, very complementary, most beautifully set in a fixed wide position, gutter the top line. Her eyes are beautiful, deep intense blue the shape & set both essentially oriental, gorgeous expression. Lovely short close lying coat, which fits her perfectly well with a sleek well prepared satin like finish. She has within the region of 50% white to colour so complies with what is required having a clean white tummy line also, the points colour where present a darker Seal & brighter red, with patches of both light beige & pale red shading present on her body, the white areas clean & bright. Superb temperament & condition.

Extremely promising young lady.

2nd ALEFOUNDER'S SISAR PRIMAVERA. SIA b. 27-06-15. Chocolate Point Siamese, Beautiful kitten, excellent type, her wedge has the merest hint of pinch & is of very good length, excellent profile, firm chin, bite good. Her ears were both large & set well apart, with the wide flare at their base creating complementary effect to her wedge, wide on the top line. Her eyes are a typical oriental shape & slant, very good depth of blue & expression. Elegant neckline, lithe body the length is developing well, slim legs & small oval paws, fine tail. Coat was beautifully prepared, short & close lying, with a pleasing sleekness to it. Her body colour was warm magnolia & the contrast to her points was excellent, but these sadly were darker than I would like to see & ideally required a little more warmth (had this not been the case the choice between the two would have been far more difficult) & was very much a deciding factor. His eyes were an excellent shape & set, the colour a deep vivid shade of blue & are very expressive. Long neckline, with long taut well muscled body, long slim legs & oval paws, long fine tail. His coat though well prepared was a little long, & it could be sleeker, slightly coarse on the lower back. The body colour is a clear delicate ivory tone & affords excellent contrast to his points which are undeniably darker than ideal but with just sufficient warmth to it, typically paler stocking & his mask has still to fully complete. His condition was splendid & he was an extremely gentle chap.

Slight wrinkling over her neck & shoulders in relaxed mode which she can pull out easily when she moves, slight amount of coat on her muzzle, otherwise dappled effect with smaller spots of darker colour evident on her skin, free of excess coat. Apart from the haws her condition was excellent & she was beautifully relaxed.
