I was also taken with a lovely colourpointed kitten bred by Jean Wolfe called Bumpkin Rameses.

BLACK NEUTER

CONSIDERED FOR AND BOB AWARDED TO: BOOTH'S GR CH & OLYBRONZE & IMP GR PR RAYANSHEL ACE OF SPADES. 5.5 YEARS. Huge masculine typy lad I loved his deep orange eye colour! Super crisp dense sound jet black coat too, Excellent boning. Looked very good today!

LILAC NEUTER

1ST PC & BOB BROWN'S CH LYNBRO DEXTER 2 YRS 2MTHS Another huge lad ! Excellent width across his top of head, just prefer smaller less wide based ears for perfection. Head rounds to a nice muzzle and good cheeks. His eyes are a good gold colour and nice and round. His nose is short and broad and straight. Bite is fine chin just a mite shallow. Excellent size and muscle tone to this chap, super bone to his fairly short legs. Tail broad at base and rounded at the tip. His coat is fairly dense, nice length but just lays a wee bit flat down the back, slightly soft in texture too. It's a cool frosty grey and is sound to the roots. Lovely temperament.

ASIAN TABBY (SPOTTED, CLASSIC, MACKEREL OR TICKED) KITTEN MALE

1ST & BOB DEWHURST'S KIMANI ROCK DJ (ASH n 25) 8mths One's first impression of him is that he is a very well grown lad of size and substance and is firm bodied yet still retains elegance and balance overall. He has a head that balances his body and shows very good width across the top between medium large broad based ears with rounded tips that continue the angle of the upper part of the face. The wedge has very nice width at the cheekbones and tapers to a blunt finish. In profile he shows a good depth of head, I'd just prefer the brow to be slightly more rounded, he shows a good break to his fairly short nose which very slightly rounds at the very tip, otherwise is quite straight. Bite is level chin firm just very very slightly recedes. Lovely large lustrous yellow chartreuse eyes with topline angled gently towards the nose and has a good full more rounded lower line. He has a lovely expression and face on is very handsome. Good rounding to chest and straight back with proportionate slender legs with oval paws and a well-shaped tail that balances. Super coat and markings! Short fine and close lying and shining with vitality. He has excellent black ticking that is beautifully even on a super warm brown ground with the ticking colour matching also on his head and legs and tail; He has a darker spine line, m to face and a broken necklace with spotting to his belly and barring to legs with correct darker hocks; he also has 4/5 rings around his tail. I was very impressed with his coat and ticking indeed!

ASIAN TABBY (SPOTTED, CLASSIC, MACKEREL OR TICKED) KITTEN FEMALE

1ST WILLIAMS-BANNING'S AMERIPAIGE VIVA SPARTACUS (ASH n 25 31) 7mths. I loved this girls type, she is a very alert youngster and purred a lot enjoying the attention. Her head has excellent width across the top between medium broad based ears with just slightly rounded tips set well apart and continue the line of the upper part of the face. The head tapers to a blunt finish just a mite pinched at the moment, showing excellent width at the jaw hinge. Neat profile; the brow rounds nicely to a

short straight nose with good break, correct bite and level chin that pales underneath but doesn't extend too far; good overall depth of head. Her expressive yellow chartreuse eyes have topline that gently slants to the nose, the lower being more fully rounded and are set well apart; Elegant medium sized body of good weight, with a rounded chest, slim limbs and neat oval paws. Tail balances. Her coat is a fraction long, lovely texture developing, shows a good healthy sheen and lays well. Slightly cool toned seal brown ticking is clearly evident on a light beige ground that just has some unevenness to the ground where the baby coat appears to be changing. Her markings are the same tone on her head and tail as the ticking and she has a vague necklace, well ringed tail, bars to legs and deep brown tip to her tail with spotting to her tummy. It will be interesting to see her again as her coat matures, I liked her type very much and she ran boy very close for the BOB.

2nd BARNES' DAYLIGHT RUMMY HOMEY (ASH bs 25 31) 4mths Diddy baby who was very relaxed and purred for England bless her! She has a short wedge with quite good width across the top of her head between large broad based ears that she tends to hold slightly upright at the moment. The head tapers to a blunt finish and has quite good width at the jaw hinge. In profile the brow very slightly rounds to a short nose with acceptable break on checking both sides to tip of the nose has a slight roll off. Level bite and chin with good overall depth of head. Her eyes are a good size, the topline is very slightly straight above the pupil, then slants to the nose, the lower line is fully rounded, golden yellow with chartreuse towards the outer in colour. Nice weight, firm bodied with very slender legs and dainty oval paws. Tail slightly short and fine. Her coat is short and fairly fine, lays well just has baby undercoat at the moment. I'd like to see the ticking which is cool toned chocolate, better defined and showing more silver to the ground as on the day I can see a creamy ground with no evidence of silver on any part of her undercoat at all, however as she is so young and Burmese colour restriction too, I decided to give her the benefit of doubt as to the expression of silver at the moment and would be interested in seeing her develop. There is a skull cap on her head, spectacles around the eyes and the nose is outlined, vague spots to her tummy and legs bars these all match the cool chocolate ticking and she also has numerous rings to the tail.

CHOCOLATE BURMESE ADULT

CONSIDERED FOR AND BOB AWARDED TO: WRIGGLESWORTH GR CH ROSSIKHAN MARIGOLD 1YR 5MTHS. I think I recall writing gorgeous on the results slip? She is a beauty, super short wide blunt wedge, gorgeous haughty look to her stunning eyes! Lovely coat, warm milky chocolate that fits her like a glove.

AOC TORTIE BURMESE ADULT

CONSIDERED FOR AND BOB AWARDED TO: WOODLEY'S IMP GR CH HONPUSS CARELESS WHISPA 9 YEARS 4MTHS. (BUR g) Blue Tortie who is a good size and mature and all balanced. Lovely wedge and expression with pretty mingling of blue and cream and she is in very good condition, handled well and enjoyed her cuddle.

BROWN BURMESE NEUTER

CONSIDERED FOR AND BOB AWARDED TO: WRIGGLESWORTH'S UK & IMP GR PR SYKRIS AKHENATEN YEARS 5MTHS. Lovely lad, excellent glossy brown coat, super tpy short blunt wedge.
