

**Many thanks to Carol and Ron for the kind invitation to judge. It looks as though there were plenty of exhibitors and a good gate, I hope the show was a success for the Club.**

**AV FOREIGN GR CH ADULT MALE:** IMP GR CC MUSPRATT'S GR CH FLAMSTONE JASPURR (ABY n). A handsome lad. Gentle rounding to top of head between large ears of good shape and set, wide at base. Good shape to hazel eyes with good expression having an oriental slant and good width between. Indentation to muzzle with a slight nose break to profile and a level chin, could be deeper. Boy of good size and weight with good length to body, slim legs and oval paws. Pale golden brown colour to coat which has well defined black ticking, slightly darker spine line. Coat has a very good apricot colour to base and is of very nice texture. Black tip to well shaped tail of good length. Good nature to this happy, very nice lad.

RES IMP GR CC EYRE-BROOK'S GR CH WOTHORPE GENIUS (BEN n 24). Slight rounding to top of head between ears of good shape and set. Large green eyes of good shape and expression, set well apart with uniform width to nose. Profile shows a slight contour to nose line, level chin which could be deeper, good definition to muzzle. A very well developed lad for age at just 18 months, body is firm and of good muscle, well shaped legs and paws. Coat is dense, showing good definition of dark brown and mid brown markings and spots including arrowheads and rosetting. Lovely white tummy with spots. Tail is well marked, would ideally like a little shorter.

**AV FOREIGN GR CH ADULT FEMALE:** IMP GR CC CHERKAS' GR CH JUSARKA DIVINE DREAM MAKER (TAI a 33). Alert set to medium sized ears with rounding to tips and of good shape. Large blue luminous eyes are of good shape and set well apart. Flattening to forehead, slight downward curve to nose which shows a slight stop, level chin of medium depth. Medium sized body, semi-cobby and of good weight, with proportionate medium boned legs and neat oval paws. Very nice texture to off-white coat with blue shading on back and sides, silvery tipping to ears and mask. Medium length to tail which tapers to end. A little grumbly and reticent at first but handled well, her grumbles accentuated her expression.

RES IMP GR CC ALGER-STREET'S GR CH TYPHAS KINDERELLA (BEN n 24). Gentle rounding to top of head between ears of good set and shape. Green eyes are of good shape and set well apart. Gentle contour to profile with good chin, good definition to muzzle. Very good texture to golden brown coat which has density and shows good definition of marking and spots including rosetting and arrowheads. A very weighty girl of good size, legs and paws of good shape. Tail is well marked, would like thicker in shape.

**USUAL ABYSSINIAN ADULT MALE:** BOB MUSPRATT'S GR CH FLAMSTONE JASPURR.

**USUAL ABYSSINIAN ADULT FEMALE:** 1CC ANDREWS' MARAFIKI AMELIA. Sweet, gentle girl. Slight rounding to top of head between large ears which are well cupped and wide at base. Hazel eyes are set well apart and have a slight oriental slant. Slight nose break to profile, small bump to nose, level chin which could be deeper, slight indentation to muzzle. Slim, medium sized body of good weight with slim shape to legs and neat oval paws. Warm tone to golden brown coat which is well ticked and shows a darker spine line, lies well. Good apricot colour to base, some black on lower hocks. Black tip to medium length tail of good shape.

**ASIAN SMOKE/BURMILLA ADULT FEMALE:** 1CC & BOB PETERS' ELLIECHLO PIXIE-TRIXIE (ASH m 11 31). A very pretty, gentle girl of just over 11 months. Gentle rounding to top of head between moderately large ears of good shape and set. Yellow colour to eyes of good shape and size. Balanced wedge with an acceptable nose break to profile and level chin which could have more depth. Good weight and feel to body of good size, slim legs and oval paws. Very good texture to fine, close lying coat which is evenly shaded. Tail tapers to end but needs more length to reach shoulder. In fine condition.

2. BARNES' DAYLIGHT GOT THE GIGGLES (ASH ns 11). Another pretty girl. Moderately large ears held slightly high, slight flattening to top of head between. Large green eyes of good set with lovely "mascara" outline. Balanced wedge with blunt muzzle, acceptable nose break, chin just slightly set back and a needs a little more depth. A young girl of just 10 months, of good weight and size with slim legs and oval paws. Coat is a little long but lies well, evenly shaded with good silver undercoat. Tail tapers to end, would like more length to reach shoulder. A gentle, slightly apprehensive girl in good condition.

**ASIAN TICKED TABBY MALE:** BOB PETERS' CH KAGURA ELLIECHLO MOWGLI (ASH n 25 31). Rounding to top of head between medium sized ears of good set and shape. Profile shows a nose break, level chin. Blunt muzzle

to wedge with large green eyes of good shape. Good weight and feel to body with well shaped legs and paws. Coat a little dense, of good texture with definite brown ticking. Tail is of medium length. A gentle lad. Also considered: WOODLEY'S GR CH KAGURA PRINCE CASPIAN (ASH n 22 31). Rounding to top of head between slightly large ears, held a little low, but probably due to his timidity. Short blunt wedge, showing jowls, is very broad at eye level, large pale green yellow eyes. Well defined classic brown tabby markings on a beige ground. A medium sized young lad with slim body of good weight for size, slim legs and oval paws. Coat is soft, a little long but lies well. Tail slightly thick in shape, short in length. A gentle boy.

**TONKINESE COLOURPOINTED PATTERN ADULT FEMALE:** 1CC & BOB Young female just 9 months of age. Slight rounding to top of head between large ears held a little high but better set when relaxed. Lovely blue colour to eyes of good shape and set. Pinch to muzzle, slight nose break to profile, bump to nose, would like more depth to chin. Very good size and weight with slim legs and neat oval paws. Fine coat lies well and of very nice texture, off white in colour with bluish grey matching points. Medium length to tail. In lovely condition, happier in her pen. A pretty, gentle girl.

**USUAL ABYSSINIAN NEUTER MALE:** BOB BARKER'S IGR PR COPPICE VIA REGGIO. Mature well grown lad. Slight rounding to top of head of good breadth between large ears which are wide at base and have slight tufts. Hazel colour to eyes which are set well apart and have a slight oriental slant giving a good expression. Indentation to muzzle, slight nose break to profile with a bump to nose, would like the chin a little firmer and deeper, gappy teeth now. Golden brown colour to coat with good black ticking, feint broken necklace, slightly darker spine line and lovely apricot base. Lovely sized boy of good bone with slim legs and oval paws, some black colour on hocks. Black tip to tail of medium length. A chatty lad wanting attention and a joy to judge.

**ASIAN TIFFANIE NEUTER FEMALE:** BOB BELL'S IMP GR PR CHINATREE KRISTINA TIANA (ALH ns 31). Rounding to top of head with furnishings to medium sized ears which are set well apart. Large greeny yellow eyes of good shape and size. Blunt muzzle to wedge with acceptable nose break, would like a firmer chin. Good weight and size. Medium length coat of soft texture, silver base. Good plume to tail. Not an overly happy lass.

**BENGAL BROWN SPOTTED NEUTER FEMALE:** BOB Slightly large ears of good shape, slight rounding to top of head between. Green eyes of good shape and set well apart. Defined whisker pads with a gentle contour to nose in profile, chin could be firmer. A good sized girl with good length to body, well shaped legs and paws. Golden brown dense coat shows well defined black markings and spots including arrowheads, broken and unbroken necklaces and spotted belly. Tail is of good length and well marked. Not happy to come out but presents well in pen where she was much happier.

**MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES: AV SEMI L/HAIR ADULT NOT BRED BY EXHIBITOR:** 1. CANNELL'S IGR CH SPIRRITZ TARTAN TREMBLER (MCO f 03) female. A very attractive brown tortie and white female, whom I liked very much. Large tall ears with tufts and good feathering. Large eyes are spaced wide apart, green in colour and having an oblique set, uniform width to nose. Fairly full cheeks with high cheek bones. Muzzle is strong and square, long whiskers. Profile shows a concave curve with a good chin. Large body of good balance and weight with substantial bone to legs and large round paws with toe tufts. Waterproof texture to top coat of good length showing attractive black and red tortie pattern and has a gloss, good ruff. Long fur to tail which is of good length.

2. BURNS' OSIGC SUPATOFT SOMANTIX TYGALILY (SOL n) female. Another very nice girl, who chatted away and poses well. Gentle rounding to top of head between ears which are set well apart, slightly large in shape with tufts and wide at base. Large green eyes are set well apart and have a slight oblique set. Slight indentation to muzzle. Profile shows a slight nose break, bump to nose, level chin, untidy teeth. Coat has density and of good length with a good ruff and lies well. Definition to black ticking, coat is soft in texture and of a rich golden brown colour, apricot colour to base. Well furnished tail. A well behaved girl.

3. CANN'S CHEHAM M'LADY-HAS ATTITUDE (RGM n 03 21) female. This young girl certainly doesn't have attitude, a joy to handle and developing well, just into adulthood. Very nice girl.

**AC VETERAN BURMESE ADULT:** 1. WOODLEY'S IGR CH HONPUSS CARELESS WISKPA (BUR g). Good breadth to top of head between medium sized ears of good shape and set. Large yellow chartreuse eyes of good shape. Balanced wedge with nose break to profile, level chin of medium depth. Medium sized body of

good weight with slim legs and oval paws. Attractive blue and cream mingling to coat which lies well. Tail tapers to end and is of medium length. A sweet lass.

**AV FOREIGN DEBUTANTE KITTEN:** 1. BARRETT'S FLAMSTONE CARACTACUS (ABY es) male. How lovely to see a cream silver, so rarely do we get a chance to see this colour, and a lovely lad he is to. Slight rounding to top of head between very large ears which are wide at base and have tufts, does hold a little high some of the time but when relaxed were set well. Golden amber colour to eyes which are large and rounded almond in shape, slight oriental slant and set well apart. Indentation to muzzle, slight nose break to profile with a medium depth level chin. Nice weight and length to body of good muscle and very good size for age, slim legs and oval paws. Good ticking to warm toned cream coat, silver base, of good texture and close lying. Lovely tail for shape and length. An alert lad who was interested in all around. Super temperament.

2. MOIR'S GENIEMAU SHEFRU (MAU n 24) male. Slight rounding to top of head between moderately large ears of good set and shape. Amber cast at present to eyes of good size and set, green inner rim evident. Slight contour to nose in profile, chin could be firmer. Very good weight and size for age, slim legs and oval paws. Bronze coat has a lovely shine and lies well, showing well defined spots and markings and a warm undercoat, spotted tummy. Tail is well marked and of good shape, medium in length. In fine condition. Sadly not a happy boy.

Extra 2. ANDREWS' FLAMSTONE GALILEOGALILEI (ABY ds) male. Litter brother to the winner and another nice lad and once again, lovely to see a red silver, so rarely seen. Slight rounding to top of head between large ears which are well cupped and set well. Oriental slant to amber eyes which have good width between, rounded almond in shape. Indentation to muzzle with a slight nose break to profile, small bump to nose, chin could be firmer. Very nice weight and feel to body of good size, well developed for age, slim legs and oval paws. Silver to undercoat with definite ticking to red coat which lies well, a very faint broken necklaces and a couple of smudges. Tail is of good shape and length. Another nice lad with lovely temperament.

3. JACKSON'S TROIKA TAMORA (RUS a) female.

Extra 3. BARNES' DAYLIGHT RUMMY HOMEY (ASH bs 25 31).

**AV FOREIGN MAIDEN KITTEN:** 1. GRIGG'S MAURICO PERSONA GRATO (SPH a 03) male. Flattening to top of head between large ears which are wide at base and of good set and shape. Lemon shaped eyes of good expression. Prominence to cheekbones and whisker pads, good muzzle showing a definite indentation. Very nice weight and size to muscular body. Slim legs with long toes. Fine tail of good length.

**AV FOREIGN ADOLESCENT NEUTER:** 1. MCCARTEN'S AGAPIMOU THE ENIGMA (ASH n) male. Gentle rounding to top of head of good breadth, large ears held a little low. Good shape to large golden coloured eyes and of good set. Acceptable nose break to profile, chin could be firmer. Very well developed lad of 14 months, firm and muscular, with slim legs and oval paws. Good shine to black coat which is coloured to roots and close lying. Tail tapers to end, needs more length to reach shoulder. A gentle, slightly timid lad in lovely condition.
