Exotic SH Tabby or Tabby & White Kitten

1st & BOB – Palmer's Rosalyn Rhapsody in Red (EXO d 22) DOB: 29/8/15.

A very sweet little girl with a nicely rounded head shape. She has a good width between well placed rounded ears which are just a 'tad' large for balance at the moment. She has full fat little cheeks with well set round eyes of a good deep orange colour developing from the centres. She has a short broad 'brick red' nose leather with a stop, her bite is a little undershot and she has a strong chin.

Her body is a good size and weight for her age of nearly 15 weeks of age and she is well balanced, with a short thick neck, depth to her body standing on short thick little legs with rounded paws.

Her tail is short in length and in proportion to her body but I would like it thicker for perfection.

Her tabby pattern I would like richer in colour but she has a good contrast to her ground colour with clear facial liner with a 'M' marking on her forehead, 3 clear spine lines, a large oyster pattern on her sides showing 'bull's eyes' in the centres, she has very distinct unbroken bracelets on her legs but her necklace around her neck is just a little paler in colour in comparison. Her tail shows very rich red rings. She has an excellent plush coat for her age which is soft in texture and stands out from her body. A lovely young lady with plenty of character.

Blue, Lilac or Fawn Tortie & White Adult

BOB – Macoy & Pearson's Ch Mibelomo Mayzee May (BRI g 03)

Well matured girl with lovely patches of blue and cream. Her coat is nice and short and dense. Very heavy in weight. Just a little unhappy today.

Tipped Adult

BOB – McEwen's Ch Greendale Adele (BRI ns 12)

Very pretty girl of lovely type. She has an excellent well rounded head, balanced cheeks, large round eyes 'to die for' in a stunning green colour with attractive liner around the edges. Short brick coloured nose leather, edged with liner. Level bite and a firm chin. She is not overly large in size but very compact. Short thickset legs and rounded paws. Tail in proportion. Excellent even black tipping on a coat of brilliant contrast, just a tad long in length but the texture is very crisp to touch. I can only fault her on being just a 'tad' heavy browed which covered those beautiful eyes.

Black Silver Tabby Kitten

William's Crowvalley Kitty La Tois (BRI ns 22)

Very pretty young lady, but I would like her larger and heavier for her age of just over 5 months. A little fine boned. Her head shape tends to be rather triangular and her ears are out of balance at present. Excellent large round eyes which are rather strong in colour although there is a green rim in the centres, so there is hope! Short straight black coloured nose, her bite just needs to be watched as she develops, as it is a little untidy at the moment as she has her adult set of teeth coming through.

Attractive facial liner, on a jet black pattern consisting of clear spine lines, oysters muddy but match on both sides, her butterfly on her shoulder matches on both shoulders, she has clear necklaces and bracelets with attractive spotted toes. Tail of correct length showing clear black rings. Her contrast is pale silver, apart from her chest and front paws which at the moment are rather cream in colour. Coat short in length but I would like it denser.

Ticked Tabby Kitten

Miles' Porteous Play-the-Game (BRI n 25)

Super boy with a great character. He has a very alert expression on his face with a lovely round head and full cheeks. Lovely facial tabby markings with well set ears, just a 'tad' large at present for balance. Round eyes of deep gold, short broad 'brick' coloured nose, level bite and a firm chin. His body is of good weight with short thick legs and rounded paws. Tail of correct length showing rings towards the tip. Clear even ticking showing three bands with a good copper contrast underneath. His lips and chin are just a little paler in colour. His coat is short in length and has good density. Very promising young man with an excellent temperament.

AC Colourpointed Kitten Male

1st & BOB – Wolfe's Bumpkin Rameses (BRI n 33)

Oh what a chocolate box kitten he is!!! A real little butterball. A lovely true 'applehead' with neat tiny tiny ears, lovely chubby cheeks, a lovely short broad nose, level bite and a firm chin. Round eyes of good blue colour coming in from the centres. Cobby little body with short fat hairy legs!! And huge round paws. He has a lovely clear mask, points on his legs and tail match, all of a good seal brown colour. His coat contrast is of a warm fawn but very shaded at present, but very short in length and very dense, just a tad soft in texture. A really gorgeous little kitten.

AC Colourpointed kitten Female

1st W/H - Spender's Harleme Angel Eyes (BRI c33)

A very mature girl for her age with a fairly well shaped head, ears a tad large at present. Nicely balanced cheeks with well rounded expressive eyes which lack a good blue colour, she has a cream colour bordering the edges and unfortunately I had to call the vet as I had diagnosed that she had *Mystagmus* which was verified by the vet, hence the withholding of first place. She has a short straight nose, level bite but rather a shallow chin. Heavy mature body for her age with good strong

legs and paws. Tail in proportion. She has an attractive clear lilac mask with matching ears, her points on her legs and paws are of a paler lilac and her tail also shows faint ghost rings. Coat contrast of clear magnolia on a crisp coat which is a 'tad' long in length.

Black, Chocolate or Cinnamon Tortie Neuter

BOB – Hemming's IGR CH & GR PR Hinderslyne Hecate (BRI f)

What a lovely large tortie with a lovely expression. Lovely patches of colour but her coat was rather 'open' today and she was moulting quite badly.

Blue-Cream, Lilac or Fawn Tortie Neuter

BOB – Hopgood's SUP OBIGP Pinemarten Tina Sparkle (BRI j)

What a beautiful girl she is. She has excellent type, an excellent head shape with large deep orange eyes. Super mingling of lilac and cream on a very short dense coats. She definitely knows how beautiful she is.
