The winning Neuter boy has wonderful type for the breed and showed himself off superbly. My overall best for the Semi's was the Seal Point Birman Kitten MLYWARD XANDER. Congratulations to all.

MAINE COON BROWN/BLUE TABBY (INC-BICOLOUR) KITTEN MALE class 183a

2<sup>nd</sup> CLOWES COONFLAKES LINUS PELT (MCO n 22 (64 41) (27,05,2015) Brown Classic Tabby, this six and a half months old kitten has quite a broad head with lovely large sized ears which are very well furnished and long tufts, set high on his head giving the impression of a real hunter, head of medium length, currently developing breadth with cheeks filling out, I feel his head still needs to broaden a little more for true balance. Nice eyes large and expressive set slightly obliquely light gold in colour. Nose has a shallow concave curve present, muzzle is forming squareness and chin has a good depth but, on close inspection his bite does not line up in fact quite undershot, confirmed by the duty vet, which is the reason for withholding 1<sup>st</sup>. A large well structured kitten of good weight and proportions a long rectangular body with sturdy legs and large furry paws. Lovely well groomed glossy coat which has a rich brown classic tabby pattern very well marked including tramlines and oysters the black markings on a warm coppery agouti base, with some ruff developing around his neck, tail of balanced length, sweet boy to handle.

MAINE COON BROWN/BLUE TABBY (INC-BICOLOUR) KITTEN FEMALE class 183b

1<sup>st</sup> & BOB GILLMANS NAVARRI MARTHAS VINYARD (MCO n 03 22 (64 41w) (27.05.2015) Brown Classic Tabby & White girl of good size and bone for her age but feeling a little light in weight. Head of reasonable width with large ears well feathered and tufted, held high on her head with good width between. Round golden eyes widely spaced of a slightly oblique aperture ad set. Nose of uniform width with a very shallow concave to the profile, high set cheek bones, level bite. Her muzzle is square but rather fine not helped by teething at present, chin is deep but needs more width. Glossy kitten coat soft in texture just beginning to develop length of fur to the flanks, tummy and breeches. The tabby markings showing a clear 'M' on the forehead with lines running from the corners of the eyes, and nice spotted whisker pads, a more blotched pattern along her back, white tummy, chest and legs with a sweet splotch of white on her nose. Long and rectangular body shape with proportionate limbs, flowing brown tail showing some rings which tapers towards the tip. Although a little tense she handled well.

AC RAGAMUFFIN KITTEN class 191

1<sup>st</sup> & BOB CANNIS CHEHAM FREE SPIRIT (RGM as 03 21 31(60 27 atsw) (05.08.2015) Blue Silver Tabby & White (Burmese pattern) Charming kitten who was more than ready to come out of his pen for a cuddle so we duly obliged. Lovely little chap just 4 months old with the sweetest expression and wonderful temperament. Nice wide top of head, with a moderately rounded forehead, ears are a little obvious at present but well furnished and in pleasing proportion to his head. Large walnut shaped eyes pale clear blue in colour, excellent break at the nasal bridge which gives the profile it's gentle contours, slightly tapered chin, good bite, slight muzzle pinch, his head has a nicely rounded appearance and shows good balance. Lengthy body and well matched tail, hind legs just fractionally longer than fronts which gives the body a slight rise towards the hind quarters which is well muscled, overall his body is of good weight and condition. Lovely body fur coming together and of good length and texture and shows a good predominantly white coat of about two thirds which covers virtually all the lower half of the body with a silver base to his pastel blue tabby pattern which starts from just below his eyes over the head and ears along the back and tail, soft textured and becoming more plush as he develops, promising boy.

BLUE POINT BIRMAN NEUTER class 204

BOB EAST-PATERSONS GR PR DAUROSE LEVI (SBI a (13c2) (24.08.2013) Lovely Birman boy coming up to two and half with lovely balanced type, broad well formed head, super eye shape and colour, medium length nose having a gentle dip which gives a pleasing profile, firm chin strong muzzle. Pale soft silky coat well presented contrasting so beautifully to his light blue points colour which is even on his good full mask, ears, legs and tail. Feet markings neat and tidy gloves really well matched, long level gauntlets, the left just fractionally narrower and all snowy white and sparkling, what a joy to handle such a relaxed individual.

AC COLOURPOINTED OR MITTED RAGDOLL NEUTER class 218

PC & BOB GODFREYS PARTYPALACE PERCEUS (RAG n 04 (66w) (20.01.2014) Lovely Seal Mitted boy just under 2 years old already well grown with a developed mask covering his entire face and in great overall condition. Full and well formed head with a clearly visible flat plane and good width between his neat well set ears which show long furnishings, lovely deep blue eyes almost round in shape and set slightly oblique, cheeks quite full and a firm muzzle plus a good depth of chin balance up his features nicely. Quite a masculine body, long and strong of good weight, long bushy tail which has a slight taper towards the tip. Coat of good length and texture showing some slight shading but the overall effect is very dramatic from his deep velvet seal points, neat white mittens to his front feet with white on his hind legs, a white chin, chest and tummy and not forgetting his handsome long white whiskers and eyebrows sprouting from his handsome seal face, a charming boy and so sweet to handle.

GOODCHILDS PR CHEGAYAN WARREN (RAG e (66f) (01.05.2014) Solid well built Cream Point boy 19 months old of very good type and profile, broad head with well placed ears neatly rounded at their tips, lovely eye shape and colour, firm muzzle and chin and level bite. Really big lad solid quite a heavyweight, good length to body and tail. Coat is of good length showing a warmth from his cream points colour which in fact shows a very subtle contrasts but there is some to be seen, good ruff and breeches in place, lovely temperament.

## AC PERSIAN NON-SELF MAIDEN ADULT class 670

1<sup>st</sup> DOBSONS LADYGEM FLEUR-DE-LIS What a sweetheart this young Tortie & White is, just into the adult classes, so over the top with her affections, striking and pretty facially. Pleasing width to head it does feel a little bumpy at present, neat ears well furnished widely set, short broad nose, with small pink leather, well formed eyes large and bright orange in colour, bite is marginally undershot, full chin well developed muzzle her cheeks have ample width. Lovely body shape quite low and square with well boned legs. Her coat is truly wonderful the patching is very desirable the pristine white accounts for about one third of the coat the shiny dense black patched with rich glossy red, she has black to one side of her face with red to the other side with a white muzzle and nose area. White to underparts and legs with black and red patched over her back and tail, what an amazing tapestry of colours, all patching free of any white hairs, faultless grooming.

2<sup>nd</sup> SMITHS AMORAMIST MILKYWAY Chocolate Tortie Colourpoint girl of almost 3 and a half years of age, dear face and lovely temperament but lacking in presentation. Round head with fairly neat ears having good furnishings, bold and round crystal blue eyes, very short broad nose, nice width to cheeks, good chin, bite is undershot, slightly off centre and she is very snuffly. Her ivory coat colour has some length with a ruff forming around her head giving reasonable contrast to the points colouring but needs more show preparation to bring the best out of it, points colour is disappointing the warm chocolate base does show some tortie elements to her head ears legs and tail but it is cold in tone with no hint of the required shades of red. Such a dear sweet gentle soul, so friendly.

## AC PERSIAN VISITORS NEUTER class 705

1<sup>st</sup> FLINTS IGR PR RIASCATZ CHAMPAGNE ON ICE Cream & White boy who is stunning, the presentation on his profuse coat leaves nothing wanting he is a joy to behold. Beautiful open type strong bold head with neat ears which sit well to the sides edged with long furnishings, well opened round eyes, short broad nose with a good stop, full and ample cheeks, deep chin, bite not quite level but acceptable. Substantial solid body square in shape sitting low on chunky legs ending in large furry paws. Full and very bushy tail matches the body for length. His gorgeous coat is about two thirds white to a light sound cream, having a white saddle across his back which breaks up the cream, tummy legs and chest pristine white with a small amount of white to a mainly cream face, a full cream tail. Handsome, gentle boy who was a pleasure to handle and judge.

2<sup>nd</sup> ELLIOTS GR PR PARMEL ALBERT EINSTEIN A very nice Blue self boy just over 3 and a half years old well developed and in lovely overall condition. Having a broad top of head his ears are well placed just a tad open at their base very well furnished, very short broad nose with a small blue leather, large well rounded and quite bold deep orange eyes, good depth to chin firm muzzle bite is marginally undershot but acceptable, plenty of width to cheeks gives his head the balance required. Well groomed coat which has come on since last I saw him a full frill frames his handsome face. Coat beautifully soft and silky in texture, medium blue in colour showing good soundness throughout right down to his short and bushy tail. Solid and strong body square and low on sturdy legs. Very well shown and lovely temperament.

## AV SLH MAIDEN NEUTER class 740

1<sup>st</sup> GRANTS CH VANAHEIM KOORA (NFO g 09 21 (67 31 gt) FN Delightful Blue Tortie Tabby & White Norwegian Forest this mature female has the most gorgeous NFC expression she really looks down her long straight nose at you as a Norwegian should. Lovely triangular head shape with large ears which are in line with the outline of the head, really nice eye shape and colour in an excellent oblique setting, good straight nasal profile, level bite. Chin quite firm and of nice depth. Long body, very well muscled, solid boning to legs the back legs clearly longer than the fronts to give the body the all important rise at lower back, nicely furnished bushy tail more than reaching the shoulders. Coat is a good length with a ruff around the neck, good dense undercoat the topcoat glossy and rich in a tortie and tabby pattern. This elegant and stylish female left nothing wanting, groomed and shown beautifully.

2<sup>nd</sup> GASCOIGNES ISADORYOU TA DAH (MCO f 03 22 (64 41 ew) FN Tortie Classic Tabby & White of 16 months, beautifully placed large ears, well furnished with tufts at their tips, sitting high on the head, about one ears width apart. Medium length to her head, cheeks still filling out with breadth developing. Large and expressive pale green eyes set slightly obliquely, lovely shallow concave curve to the nose, muzzle is square but needs a little more time to fully develop, level bite. Long body rectangular in shape, well boned limbs. Tail easily reaches her shoulders and is well covered and flows nicely. A very attractive coat on this youngster which has been very well prepared, a rich combination of red and black tortie colours with an overlay of a well defined tabby pattern which can be seen on the head along her body and down the tail, her sparkling white accounts for about half the body fur and covers the chest, tummy legs and feet. Well presented with perfect manners.

3<sup>rd</sup> BACHELORS CHEHAM XCARALISA (RGM g 03 32 (60 27 gwx) Blue Tortie & White Ragamuffin. Very well developed female of just over 2 and a half, who is something of a heavyweight, but everything is in proportion her large head goes with the large body so the overall look is all in balance, she has nicely rounded contours giving the head that typically chubby look of the breed, large walnut shaped green eyes, medium length nose with an excellent profile line, firm in the muzzle and a strong chin. Her coat has a lovely feel to it thick and dense, the tortie pattern of light creams on a blue base patched on her head with one blue ear and one cream ear and along her back and tail, the white starts with an inverted 'V' to her face and follows through on all her underparts legs and feet, sweet female a little nervy but handled beautifully.

## AV SEMI-LONGHAIR ADULT, KITTEN OR NEUTER class 931

1<sup>st</sup> BURNS OSIGC SUPATOFT SOMANTIX TYGALILY (SOL n (631) Usual Somali girl, coming up to six years of age and don't she wear it well. Lovely feminine type with an alert expression her head shows a moderate wedge with gentle contours and a strong deep chin, ears are set wide apart broad at base and well furnished, expressive eyes a lovely shade of green that more than tell a story, almond in shape slightly obliquely set and beautifully outlined in black, ears set well apart moderately large, a shallow indent forms her muzzle giving the all important Somali smile. Firm lithe body quite muscular with a long flowing tail showing a slight taper which balances with body for length, long legs ending in oval paws with black tufts between her toes. Soft fine coat which lays flat along the spine, the length gaining as winter approaches a ruff and breeches are evident, the apricot base hair with well defined ticking which shows a heavier line along her spine and down the tail and tail tip, very good black heels, in lovely condition shown beautifully with an excellent temperament.
