SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS:

The show is held under the Rules of the Governing Council of the Cat Fancy and is open to all. As a copy of the Rules is NOT included with this schedule, all exhibitors are reminded that they should read Section 4 of the Show Rules, as they will be strictly applied. Ignorance will not be accepted as an excuse for a breach of the Rules. (Copies of the Rules may be obtained from the GCCF Offices, 5 King's Castle Business Park, The Drove, Bridgwater, Somerset. TA6 4AG)

REGISTRATION

No Cat or Kitten, Entire or Neutered, born after 19/10/71 with one or both parents, grand-parents or great grand parents unregistered shall be eligible for the Breed Classes. All Pedigree Cats, Kittens or Neuters exhibited at a GCCF show must be registered. All registered exhibits which have changed hands, must have been transferred to their new owner at least 10 days before the Show. All registrations and/or transfers must have reached GCCF Office at least 10 days before the Show.

Cats which are not normally resident with their registered owner should be transferred into the ownership of their keeper if they are to be shown. Exhibitors are reminded that in the event of rejection, all exhibits in the same registered ownership may also be rejected and clearance may be required for both households.

VETERINARY

Exhibits will be received at the entrance of the Show Hall from **9.00am until 10.15am** on the morning of the Show. All exhibits must be brought to the Show in baskets or suitable containers and must be accompanied by the owner or owners representatives Each exhibit will be examined by the Society's Hon Veterinary Surgeons who are authorized to exclude any exhibit they consider unfit, this includes exhibits showing skin lesions. No exhibit may be penned before being examined. Exhibits must have clean ears and be free from pests. Pregnant or lactating queens may not compete. No exhibit that has been de-clawed will be admitted. Unfit exhibits must be removed by the owners and Entry Fees forfeited. If in the Veterinary Surgeons opinion, it is desirable, all other exhibits from the same household and owner shall be debarred from attending the Show. The Veterinary Surgeons decision is final. When an exhibit has been rejected or withdrawn from the Show by a Veterinary Surgeon, it shall not be re-presented to a second Veterinary Surgeon. The procedure to be adopted in such cases is clearly stated in the GCCF Rules.

VETERINARY CLEARANCE CERTIFICATES

Exhibitors whose cats have been rejected at Shows please note the following points:

1. When sending your clearance certificate to the Veterinary Officer, please include your copy of the rejection slip.
2. Please DO NOT send these certificates by recorded delivery as this can cause considerable delays in the receipt of your certificates. If you wish to satisfy yourself that your letter has reached the Veterinary Officer please enclose a stamped addressed postcard for acknowledgement of receipt, and this will be signed and returned to you.
3. Exhibitors should not attend Shows until they have received a letter from the Secretary confirming clearance. It is recommended that this letter be taken to Shows within a month of the issue of the clearance letter. If an exhibit is unable to attend the Show for what ever reason, the Show Manager/s must be notified in writing. No fees will be returned after the official closing date of entries as published in the schedule.

Section 5 VETERINARY SURGEONS rule 3.

1. a) All cats exhibited at shows held under GCCF rules must have a current certificate of vaccination against Feline Calicivirus (FCV), Feline Herpes Virus (FHV) and Feline Panleukopenia * (FPV).
2. The full primary course (first set of vaccinations) in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations, must have been completed more than seven days before the show.
3. b) Booster vaccinations against FCV, FHV and FPV must be given at the manufacturer's recommended intervals. Where a variable interval of 1-3 years for FCV and FHV is recommended the minimum interval applies. ie all cats attending shows MUST receive annual booster vaccination against FCV and FHV.

For Boosters only note: Exhibitors are advised to leave at least a week between a booster vaccination and show attendance to allow the vaccine to take effect and in case of any adverse reaction.

* Previously termed Feline Infectious Enteritis

EXHIBITORS

Any exhibitor in any way interfering with or **removing any exhibit from its pen during the Show, except with the consent of the Show Manager/s, will forfeit any awards which may be due to his/her exhibit**, no one may remove any exhibit from its pen except the owner or Show Official. All exhibitors are forbidden to carry their exhibits around the Hall and they must not be held in such a way as to annoy other exhibits.

Judges are empowered to withhold any prize or Challenge Certificate in any Class if the exhibits do not, in their opinion, Possess sufficient merit. Prizes will be awarded from the Judge's slips. In an emergency, Judges may be changed during the course of the Show, with the consent of the Show Manager/s.

Rule 18, Section 4, of the Rules of the GCCF. Exhibitors are reminded that the decision of the Judge's are final. Any attempt to influence such decisions will render the offenders liable to disciplinary action.(amended 1.6.84)

COUNTERSIGNATURES

In the event of a change of Judge of an Breed/Open/Title Class occurring after the closing date of the Show, and provided that the exhibitor informs the Show Manager/s prior to judging that a Certificate has previously been awarded by the replacement judge the Show Manager/s shall appoint one other judge who shall judge the cat and if the cat is considered worthy, countersign the Certificate which shall then count towards championship status.

THE COMMITTEE RESERVE THEMSELVES THE RIGHT TO:

- a) Appoint other Judges should those advertised be unable to fulfil their engagement and to appoint further Judges if deemed necessary
- b) Fix and limit the number of exhibits at the Show and refuse entry without giving a reason.
- c) Cancel, amalgamate or divide classes.
- d) Publish a catalogue of the show containing information as to the exhibits and the names and addresses of the exhibitors.
- e) Exhibitors will be charged any fees the Society may incur due to their cheques being returned by their bank marked 'Refer to Drawer' ie. NOT HONOURED BY THE BANK currently £10-20.

ADVICE TO EXHIBITORS AS FROM 1.6.92

- a) You are advised against purchasing any shampoos /powders that change a cat's colour as this can lead to disqualification.
- b) Homeopathic Vaccinations are not acceptable to the GCCF for the purpose of vetting-in.
- c) Any alteration to your Entry Form must be in writing which will be attached to the form by the Show Manager/s. You may also make corrections to the form up to the close of the Show.
- d) Kittens under the age of fourteen weeks (14) may not be shown.
- e) Any person whose cat/s have been rejected under sections C or D must not officiate as a Judge or Steward or in any other capacity which requires the handling of cats at Shows until a clearance certificate as required by the GCCF has been obtained.
- f) The use of small battery driven fans in pens can be dangerous, and could be considered a distinguishing mark.
- g) When Open Judging has been completed you may place one toy in the pen for the exhibit to play with.
- h) Please note that in addition to the Classes you have entered, your cat may also be handled for the purposes of assessing candidates in the GCCF appointment scheme.
- i) Queens who have kitted within 12 weeks of the date of the Show may not be shown.
- j) In the unlikely event of an exhibit requiring veterinary help beyond the capability of the Duty Vet, we have arranged facilities with a local Veterinary Practice, For the owners to use. Any costs incurred are the exhibitors full responsibility.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS & MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC

No one may take photographs of any exhibit/s at this Show without first getting permission from the Show Manager/s and then getting permission from the cats owner/s **ANYONE CONTRAVENING THIS ORDER any person WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE SHOW HALL AND THEIR CATS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.**

The Show will close at 4.30pm. We will make every effort to close the Show early but Exhibitors are reminded that leaving the Show hall before the official close can result in disqualification (GCCF Rules: sec 4 rule 22.)

No exhibit may be removed from its pen until the Show Manager/s have announced that the Show is closed.

Visitors are requested not to touch the cats or kittens as this may transmit infection. No written or printed matter of any description other than official notices and award cards may be put on competitive pens.

CORRESPONDENCE

All correspondence must be accompanied by a stamped, addressed envelope. Any complaint related to the Show must be forwarded to the Show Managers within seven (7) days of the Show.

NOTICE OF CHANGE

An announcement in the GCCF website of any alterations or additions made to the schedule or in these regulations shall be sufficient notice thereof.

ABBREVIATIONS

LH- Longhaired, SLH- Semi-longhaired, SH-Short Haired, AV- Any Variety, AC- Any Colour, AOC- Any Other Colour, AOV- Any Other Variety, M-Male, F- Female, N-Neuter, SP-Seal Point, BP- Blue Point ,CP-Chocolate Point. LP- Lilac Point, AOD- Any Other Dilution, GCCF –Governing Council Of The Cat Fancy

CHAMPIONS AND PREMIERS

The title of Champion for Cats and Premier for Neuters shall be granted to exhibits winning three Challenge certificates or Premier Certificates at three Shows under separate Judges. A GCCF Challenge/Premier Certificate will be offered for each cat/neuter Breed Class of the recognised Breeds with Championship Status.

GRAND CHAMPIONS & GRAND PREMIERS

The title of Grand Champion will be granted to a cat winning three Grand Challenge Certificates at Three Shows under three different Judges. To compete in the Champion of Champions Class a cat must be a full Champion on the date the Show closes. Only one prize with a reserve in case of disqualification will

be awarded. The title of Grand Premier shall be granted to neutered cats under the same rules and conditions as those for Grand Champion.

IMPERIAL GRAND CHAMPION & IMPERIAL GRAND PREMIER

The Titles of Imperial Grand Champion & Imperial Grand Premier shall be attained by the awarding of FIVE Imperial Grand Challenge/Imperial Grand Premier Certificates as appropriate by five different Judges at shows licensed by the GCCF.

OLYMPIAN CHAMPION/PREMIERS

The title of Olympian Imperial Grand Champion/Premier will be granted to a cat winning Five Olympian Imperial Grand Certificates at Five Shows under Five different Judges. Only One prize with a Reserve in case of disqualification will be awarded.

A cat will still be eligible for Best Of Breed if not entered in the relevant Breed class.

GCCF TITLES FOR HOUSEHOLD PET CATS

OLYMPIAN

The title of Olympian will be granted to a cat winning Five Olympian Imperial Grand Certificates at Five Shows under Five different Judges. Only One prize with a Reserve in case of disqualification will be awarded. A cat will still be eligible for Best Of Breed if not entered in the relevant Breed class.

MASTER CAT TITLE

The Title Master Cat (MC) shall be attained by the awarding of three Master Cat Certificates by three different Judges at participating Championship or Sanction Shows licensed by the GCCF.

GRAND MASTER CAT TITLE

The Title Grand Master Cat (GMC) shall be attained by the awarding of three Grand Master Cat Certificates by three different Judges at participating Championship or Sanction Shows licensed by the GCCF.

IMPERIAL GRAND MASTER TITLE

The Title Imperial Grand Master Cat (IGMC) shall be attained by the awarding of five Imperial Grand Master Cat certificates by five different Judges at participating Championship or Sanction Shows licensed by the GCCF

DEFINITION OF CLASSES

BREED CLASS:	Open to all of the specified breeds. (Must be G.C.C.F. Registered)
CATS:	Not less than 9 calendar months on the day of the show.
KITTENS:	Not less than 14 weeks and under 9 calendar months on the day of the show.
PLEASE NOTE:	As from 1 st June 2001 Kitten Neuters to be entered in their relevant Breed Kitten & Kitten Miscellaneous Classes and will compete for BIS Kitten. Neuter kittens of Preliminary breeds to be included in Kitten Assessment classes where separate classes for A/K/N are scheduled.
NEUTERS:	Neuter adults may only enter Neuter classes and may not compete with entire cats or kittens, except in Club Classes which are scheduled to include Neuters. Where Best in Show is held, the best Neuter shall be considered against the best Entire Adult and Kitten for Best Exhibit in Show.
DEBUTANTE:	Exhibits that have never been shown at a show held under GCCF Rules. (Debutante entry as a Kitten does not count when the exhibit is shown as an Adult or Neuter and Debutante entry as an Adult does not count when the exhibit is Neutered and shown).
MAIDEN:	Exhibits that have not won a First, Second or Third prize in any class at a show held under GCCF Rules.
NOVICE:	Exhibits that have not won a First Prize in any class at a show held under GCCF Rules.
LIMIT:	Exhibits that have not won more than four First Prizes in any class at a show held under GCCF Rules.
SPECIAL LIMIT:	Exhibits that have won 4 first prizes in any class at a show held under GCCF Rules.

BREEDERS:	Exhibits bred by the exhibitor/s. Cats originally registered in the breeders' joint ownership but changed to single ownership of one of the Breeders can still be entered in this class. Cats originally registered in Breeder's single ownership and changed to joint ownership with the breeder should be entered in the Non-Breeders Class.
NON-BREEDERS:	Exhibits not bred by the exhibitor.
ADOLESCENT:	Cats 9 – 15 months old on the day of the show.
JUNIOR:	Cats over 9 calendar months of age and under 2 years on the day of the show.
SENIOR:	Cats 2 – 7 years old on the day of the show.
VETERAN:	7 years and over on the day of the show.
RADIUS:	Under 25 miles from Show venue.
VISITORS:	Over 25 miles from Show venue.

The status of the exhibit for entering restricted classes (ie Maiden, Limit, etc) shall be the cat's Status on the day of entry, except where Sect 2, Rule 15e applies regarding entry into Grand Classes applies. The wins as a Kitten do not count when the exhibit is shown as an Adult or Neuter The wins as an Adult do not count when the exhibit is neutered and shown. Merit awards do not Count as wins for entering restricted classes.

GENERAL GUIDELINES ON ENTERING SHOWS

Full Details of exhibiting at GCCF Shows are given in the GCCF Rules Section 4, available on the GCCF website under "About GCCF" and "Forms and Downloads" at www.gccfcats.org or can be purchased for a small charge post free by telephoning the GCCF Office. The Following provides some additional explanation.

Where possible, always complete your show entry form using details from your GCCF Registration Certificate for the cat that is to be exhibited. Please **print** the details carefully to avoid any misinterpretation of your handwriting. If the Registration Certificate you have does not show your name and address this means that the cat is not registered in your name and you must transfer the cat into your name no later than ****10 days** before the show. Transfer can be done instantly using GCCF "**Online Services**" at www.gccfcats.org.

If you have not received your Registration Certificate at the time of entry, complete the show entry form with the details from the pedigree, giving the first choice of name if it is a non-prefix registration, and put RAF (Registration Applied For) or TAF (Transfer Applied For), or both, in the Regd. No. box. It is wise to enclose a stamped self-addressed acknowledgement postcard with all registration and transfer applications, particularly for cats entered for shows, so that you know that the application has been received by the GCCF.

It is recommended that you keep a copy of your entry form – then, when you receive registration details and number, check these against the entry form and notify the Show Manager in writing of any differences in the details as well as giving the registration number, if applicable. This may not be in time for the printing of the show catalogue, but the Show Manager should attach your letter to your entry form which will save unnecessary notification of discrepancies when that show is checked. All catalogue errors are checked against the original entry form and any exhibitors' letters are used for reference. Show managements are permitted to accept corrections, at their own discretion, up to the close of the show (on show day). Any such correction must not be an addition or substitution of any exhibit for which proof of entry cannot be validated, or a change of exhibitor/owner.

If you are entering several cats from your household and the registered owners (exhibitors) differ within that household/family, check with the Show Manager whether using one entry form is acceptable or not and, if it is, indicate **very clearly** which exhibitor owns which cat, ensuring all owners sign the entry form. It may be less confusing and more acceptable to the Show Manager for each owner to use separate entry form, but joint owners of an exhibit should always use the same form and ****at least one of the owners has signed the declaration.**

Exhibitors are reminded that the decisions of the judges are final. Any attempt to influence such decisions, or to identify a cat or ownership of a cat to a judge at a show before that judge's engagement has been completed, may render the offender liable to disciplinary action.

IF THERE IS A MISTAKE ON YOUR ENTRY– WHAT TO EXPECT

Minor Errors

Should a small error be made these will be resolved between Exhibitor, Show manager and/or GCCF. Persistent repetition may result in further action being taken.

Incorrect Date of Birth

This is usually classed as a minor error unless it affects an entry into classes based on age groups, when it could warrant disqualification of the exhibit from such classes; but if the incorrect date of birth affects the age suitability as a whole, then the exhibit will be disqualified from the show.

N.B. AGE LIMITS: Kittens – not less than 14 weeks and under 9 calendar months on date of show

Adults – not less than 9 calendar months on date of show

Incorrect Name of Exhibit/Owner

If registration/transfer details were obviously available at the time of entry or before the date of the show, disqualification is inevitable. The following discrepancies are those which usually arise:

EXHIBIT	Totally incorrect name
OWNER/EXHIBITOR	Declaration not signed by at least one of the registered N.B. The exhibitor(s) must be the registered owner(s) of the cat and not necessarily the person who actually takes the cat to the show.

Registration/Transfer Not Received by the GCCF ****10 Days** before the Date of the Show

These entries will be disqualified. Remember, the effective date of all registrations and transfers is the **first date of valid receipt by the GCCF.**

Transfer of Exhibit from Exhibitor to a New Owner Received by the GCCF **More Than **10 Days** before the Date of the Show

Entries such as these will also be disqualified as the exhibitor's entry form becomes invalid.

Incorrect or Ineligibility of Class Entry

These will be disqualified from the class concerned – so always check with the Show Manager if in doubt about which class to enter.

If a breed number is changed officially, it is important that you notify the Show Manager immediately.

Exhibits entered in the Grand, Imperial Grand or Olympian class must have qualified on or before the published closing date of the show **which will include any extension published on the GCCF Website** (amended 21.10.2015) and the title must have been claimed in writing by that date. Exhibitors who enter Grand, Imperial Grand or Olympian classes without claiming the title will be reminded once, but if the title remains unclaimed the cat will be disqualified from this class at subsequent shows.

Cats Registered on the Reference Register

Most cats registered on this Reference Register (CSREF) are not eligible to be shown and, therefore, these entries could be disqualified. One exception to this is when a new breed becomes recognised, and then cats of the breed may be shown, even if they were originally registered on the Reference Register as long as this was the only reason for the Reference registration.

Exhibitors may appeal against any disqualification resulting from show checking, giving their reasons. The appeal will be referred to the GCCF Board if considered valid and, if not, a letter of explanation will be sent to the exhibitor(s). The above advice, however, is aimed at keeping your show entries trouble-free.

The title Grand Master (GM) shall be attained by the awarding of three Grand Master certificates by three different judges at participating GCCF Championship Shows.

IMPERIAL GRAND MASTER TITLE

The title Imperial Grand Master (IGM) shall be attained by the awarding of five Imperial Grand Master certificates by five different judges at participating GCCF Championship Shows.

OLYMPIAN MASTER TITLE

The Olympian title shall be attained by the awarding of five Olympian certificates by 5 different judges at participating Championship or Sanction GCCF shows. Only one certificate is allowed at one breed show at each level. The first five awards will be noted with the title Olympian Bronze, the 2nd five will be noted with the title of Olympian Silver and the 3rd five will be noted with the title of Olympian Gold (total fifteen certificates to reach Olympian Gold).
