



HOUSEHOLD PETS

(Pedigree & non-pedigree)

Important Note: From 1st June 2017 Household Pets will require to be registered with the GCCF in order to obtain titles.

From 1st June 2017 untitled Household Pets may be entered in classes but in order to claim a title they must be registered with the GCCF.

How it works

Pedigree Pets already registered with GCCF need only quote their pedigree registration number when claiming their title.

Pedigree pets with no GCCF registration papers will need to be registered with the GCCF to claim titles prior to, or when claiming the title.

Once registered, future titles will be awarded automatically to your cat once the show results have been processed by the GCCF after each show.

It will help show organisers if you quote your registration number on the entry form and all other correspondence with the GCCF.

If you already have a title and want to continue showing without registering you can do so but you cannot earn any higher titles.

How to register

If you have a non-pedigree pet or a pedigree pet without papers, enrol with GCCF online services and select "Register a Household Pet" from the menu options.

Upload your cat's picture which will appear on the Registration Certificate. Or, if you prefer to work by mail, download or ask us to send you a form in the post and send in your application with a picture. By post or online it's still only £10.

If you have a GCCF registered pedigree pet, enrol or go online, select your cat and press the "Mark as Pedigree Pet" button. You can then insert your cat's pet name or use the pedigree name without the prefix. If you want to register by post, complete and email us your cat's details or send in the form. This is FREE, however if you want a HHP Registration Certificate you can order that for just £5.
