GCCF Clubs and the Supreme

There are a variety of ways in which GCCF clubs can be involved in and support the Supreme Show and also promote their clubs and their breeds to a wider audience.

Meet the Cats

is an area within the Supreme Cat Show specifically for Breed Advisory Committees to showcase their breeds and also the work of GCCF member clubs. All GCCF clubs, both full and provisional, are invited to support their BAC and take part in this area **FREE of any cost to their club.**

It is a great opportunity to engage with the many members of the public eager to learn more about pedigree cats and specific breeds and to educate and inform them about your breed and club. This is an area for visitors to chat to someone about the benefits of pedigree cat ownership and also to help them to choose the right breed for their personality and lifestyle. You can give out club and breed information and allow visitors to see and handle examples of your breed/s. This is your chance to meet the public, whilst they 'Meet the Cats' and by doing so helping your breeders and your Clubs.

Each club may have a 6 foot table, where in addition to breed information and club publications, you may also sell exclusive club merchandise – pens, car stickers, calendars, greetings cards, badges, T-shirts and other articles with your club logo or name on them.

You may not sell foodstuffs, human merchandise or general cat goods, including toys. No tombola or raffles may take place within 'Meet The Cats'. No balloons or inflatable may be used in the show halls,

Rosette and Judge Sponsorship

is an ideal opportunity for all GCCF clubs and other organisations, charities and individuals to sponsor Rosettes or Judges; to show your support for GCCF and the Supreme.

A club can sponsor the Rosettes for their own breed classes, or in memory of a special cat or a person who has contributed to the breed. You can sponsor the judge who will be judging your cat or you can sponsor a class even if you are unable to enter your cats this year.

For sponsorship of rosettes and donations your dedication will be listed in the show catalogue. Either in a list for the major awards, including Best of Variety or at the heading of each class sponsored.
