

EXOTIC SHORTHAIR REGISTRATION POLICY

Approved at Council 29 October 2022

This document should be read in conjunction with the Breeding Policy for Exotic Shorthairs.

This Registration Policy defines how Exotic Shorthair cats will be registered by the Governing Council of the Cat Fancy (GCCF). Cats imported from outside of the United Kingdom and/or registered by another registering body will have to comply with the policy laid out in the following pages in order to be registered by the GCCF.

The Breeding Policy for Exotic Shorthairs describes the ideal way in which these cats should be bred to ensure the health, well being and vitality of the breed is maintained. The Registration Policy determines how the progeny from the various possible matings will be registered in order to ensure and maintain clarity of eye colour, coat colour and/or pattern and will attempt to explain the reasons behind the registrations.

THE REGISTERS

Full Register

This register is used for Exotic Shorthairs with Full status which have within the three preceding generations (Parent, Grand-Parent, and Great-Grand Parent) **only** Exotic Shorthairs or Exotics of the varieties listed for registration on the Full Register for that colour/pattern.

Supplementary Register

This register is used for Exotic Shorthairs with Full status which have within the preceding three generations **only** Exotic Shorthairs or Exotics of the breeds listed for registration on the Supplementary Register for that colour/pattern.

Cats registered on either the Full or Supplementary Registers may be shown in the relevant championship breed classes at GCCF Shows.

Reference Register

This is used to register cats of Exotic Shorthair appearance where the breeding does not conform to this Registration Policy. They will be registered as 'no recognised breed'.

If a breeding programme for a new colour/pattern is subsequently submitted to the Breed Advisory Committee an application for breed (colour/pattern) recognition may be made to the GCCF Board of Directors and if successful the cats involved will be treated as if registered on the Reference Register but not transferred to that register.

Cats (and their progeny) with registered parents who conform sufficiently to the breed phenotype, as defined by the Standard of Points, may be re-allocated to the Supplementary Register from the Reference Register and so be eligible for competition in GCCF shows. The opinion of at least three Full Judges of the breed is required in support from occasions when the cat is shown as an adult in Exhibition with Critique classes. [Section 1 rule 12 c ii]

BREEDING REGISTERS

In addition to the registers above which can affect breeding and showing, the suitability for breeding only can also be controlled by the Breeder with the following three additional registers.

Active Register

The breeder has registered the cat as suitable for breeding. The cat/kitten can also be shown in the relevant breed classes at GCCF shows if it is on the Full, or Supplementary Register Kittens produced may be registered with no restrictions – unless imposed by written agreement with the breeder- provided that the mate chosen is suitable according to the Registration Policy for the colour/pattern.

All Exotics registered with the GCCF from 1st January 2016 may be registered on the Active Register, at the breeder's request, only if:

1. They themselves have been genetically tested as normal (clear) for PKD (Polycystic Kidney Disease).*
2. Both parents have been tested normal (clear) as in 1
3. They are from parents deemed normal (clear) because of the results from testing (as in 1) of cats on every pedigree line in previous generations. Pedigree line in this case refers to both of the parents, or 4 grandparents, 8 great-grandparents, 16 great-great-grandparents and so on, or any combination of the same which is inclusive of the ancestors of both the sire and dam.

Smoke Exotics and

Smoke Bi- and Tri-Colour Exotics

All Smoke Exotics registered with the GCCF from **1 January 2023** and all Smoke Bi- and Tri-Colour Exotics registered from **1 January 2023** may be registered on the Active Register, at the breeder's request, only if:

1. They themselves have been genetically tested as homozygous (clear) for non-agouti*, or
2. Both parents have been tested homozygous for non-agouti (clear) as in 1, or
3. They are from parents deemed clear because of the results from testing (as in 1) of cats on every pedigree line in previous generations. Pedigree line in this case refers to both of the parents, or 4 grandparents, 8 great-grandparents, 16 great-great-grandparents and so on, or any combination of the same which is inclusive of the ancestors of both the sire and dam, or
4. They have one parent homozygous (clear) for agouti as in 1-3 above and one parent self coloured longhair or tortoiseshell longhair (table 1 or table 2).

* Cats must be micro chipped for identification purposes, and the microchip number shown on the laboratory test results, and the cat's veterinary record.

Cameo Exotics and

Shaded and Tipped Bi- and Tri-Colour Exotics

All Cameo and all Shaded and Tipped Bi- and Tri-Colour Exotics registered from **1 January 2023** may be registered on the Active Register, at the breeder's request, only if:

1. They themselves have been genetically tested as homozygous or heterozygous for agouti*, or
2. One parent has been tested homozygous for agouti.

* Cats must be micro chipped for identification purposes, and the microchip number shown on the laboratory test results, and the cat's veterinary record.

Genetic Register

If a cat is on the Active Register but the registration form also dictates that it is on the Genetic Register (which will be printed on the registration form) then the cat can be bred from but there will be restrictions on the registration of kittens. It is used for cats which are known to carry genes of an undesirable genetic disorder, the spread of which within that breed is controlled. The animals themselves are fit and healthy and if mated to a suitable cat will produce some kittens which are suitable to be used to continue the line. Only cats where those conditions that can be determined by a simple DNA test for the presence or absence of the particular gene can be placed on the Genetic Register. With effect from **1st January 2019**:

Polycystic Kidney Disease (PKD)

1. All Exotics which have been genetically tested as positive for PKD, shall be registered on the Non-Active register -
2. All Exotics which are not eligible for registration on the Active Register, shall be registered on the Non-Active register
3. Offspring of cats registered on the Genetic Register may only be registered on the Active Register if they have themselves been genetically tested as normal (clear) for PKD.
4. All other offspring of cats registered on the Genetic Register shall be registered on the Genetic register, or on the Non-Active Register if so requested by the breeder.

* Cats must be micro chipped for identification purposes, and the microchip number shown on the laboratory test results, and the cat's veterinary record.

Non-Active Register

At the time of registration the breeder only may elect to place one or more kittens from a litter on the Non-Active Register. The GCCF **will not** subsequently register progeny from this cat. Only the breeder may ask for a cat registered on the Non-Active Register to be transferred to the Active Register.

Cats placed on the Non-Active Register may be shown as Kittens, Entire Adults, or Neutered Adult cats in the relevant championship classes at GCCF shows provided that they are on the Full, Supplementary or Experimental Register for that breed, or in the Pedigree Pet section of GCCF shows but the GCCF **will not** subsequently register progeny from these cats.

Outcrossing

Shorthair kittens from mating an Exotic carrying LH, to a Exotic LH or an Exotic carrying LH mated to an Exotic carrying LH would be registered as a Exotic Cat on the Supplementary Register according to the registration policy above provided that any Exotic cats in the pedigree have been bred in accordance with the registration policy for that variety of Exotic. Progeny from matings of these kittens would remain on the Supplementary register while there is an Exotic SH within the first three generations i.e. parent, grand-parent, great-grand parent.

Progressive Retinal Atrophy (PRA)

This is a condition in which young kittens go blind by the age of about 15 weeks. Any cat imported into the UK must be tested negative for PRA before it can be registered on the Active Register. This provision is advisory from approval of this registration policy by the GCCF and will be **mandatory from 1 January 2016**.

Red or Cream cats

Any red or cream, red and white, cream and white, red pointed or cream pointed cat with one or more tabby parent **will be** registered as a tabby unless shown by DNA testing not to be a tabby.

Green-Eyed Breeds

Progeny of matings with no progression.

Cats of Colourpoint appearance that have within the first five generations the following breeds shall be registered as with NO PROGRESSION: all colours of Silver Tabby table 5; Smoke LH table 6; Cameo and Pewter table 7; Black Tipped Silver, Shaded Silver & Golden table 8 A, B, C, D, E, F; Cats whose registration is over stamped 'Has Silver in the Pedigree' or Exotic cats with these colours/patterns in their pedigree within the first five generations.

INBREEDING POLICY

Many breeding programmes contain an element of inbreeding however breeding animals that are too closely related can lead to the fixing of undesirable traits and is to be discouraged. Matings between mother/son, father /daughter, full brother/sister are not considered desirable and any kittens from these matings will be registered on the Non-Active Register, unless the mating has been recommended by veterinary or genetic counselling and supported by the BAC and GCCF Genetics Committee. Under these circumstances the breeder should apply in the first instance to the Exotic Shorthair BAC for the above mentioned support. (See the table below for Levels of Coefficient of Inbreeding). See also GCCF Rules Section 1, 1(d)

Levels of Coefficients of Inbreeding (COIs)		
EXOCentage	Level	Comments
0 to 10%	Low	COIs which fall within this low banding are ideal
10 to 20%	Fair	COIs which fall within this banding are reasonable and acceptable
20 to 25%	Close	COIs which fall within this banding represent close matings approaching the higher end of what breeders should normally consider.
25 to 40%	High	Matings producing higher COIs than the first degree matings should only be undertaken by Experienced breeders for very specific reasons. If offspring are retained for breeding they should only be used for matings producing low COIs.
40%+	Not advised	The welfare and health of cats with such high levels of inbreeding is highly likely to be compromised and such matings should not be undertaken.

The following pages detail the registration policy for each of the separate colour/pattern groupings of the Exotic Shorthairs.

In each table:

- the first column lists the colours/patterns for the breed group.
- the second column lists the most desirable parents. Offspring of these matings will be registered on the Full Register provided that within the previous three generations there are no cats that would prevent this.
- the third column shows less desirable but acceptable colour/pattern matings. Offspring of these matings will be registered on the Supplementary Register.
- the fourth column lists colours/patterns which are not advisable for the reasons given and progeny of these matings will be registered on the Reference Register.
