

## **SHOW REVIEW GROUP – PJ BURSARY**

A Bursary is a way to invest in GCCF's future and assist in the process of assisting Judges to meet the criteria required, especially within minority breeds, to qualify sooner. Clubs Show Managers will be allowed to claim up to a total of £100 (per Club not per PJ) in expenses from GCCF for inviting PJs to judge relevant classes.

In the first instance, this will be run as a pilot scheme for approximately two years and it will be reviewed periodically.

This pilot is based on the knowledge that there were 117 Clubs that held shows in 2023 therefore:

- Individual Shows will be able to claim up to a total of £100 expenses (per Club not per PJ) for eligible PJs – based on 117 Club Shows the total cost to GCCF, for the first twelve months, will be £11,700.
- To claim the Bursary Show Managers must allocate the appropriate PJ classes.
- To claim a Bursary payment, Show Managers must fill out the official Bursary form and return to office. All Bursary payments will be made after the show has been cleared by the office. The maximum any one club can claim is £100. PJ judge expenses should be split across clubs if they are judging eligible classes on the same show day.
- The list of eligible PJs to which the Bursary will apply will be available on the GCCF website
- Once schedules are published, Show Managers may still claim the Bursary even if the PJ becomes a full judge of the relevant breed between publication and event date. This also applies if PJ classes allocated receive no entries.
- This Bursary pilot will be reviewed one year after the date of implementation.
